[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vent for clothes dryer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a louvered vent for a clothes dryer exhaust, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 4.

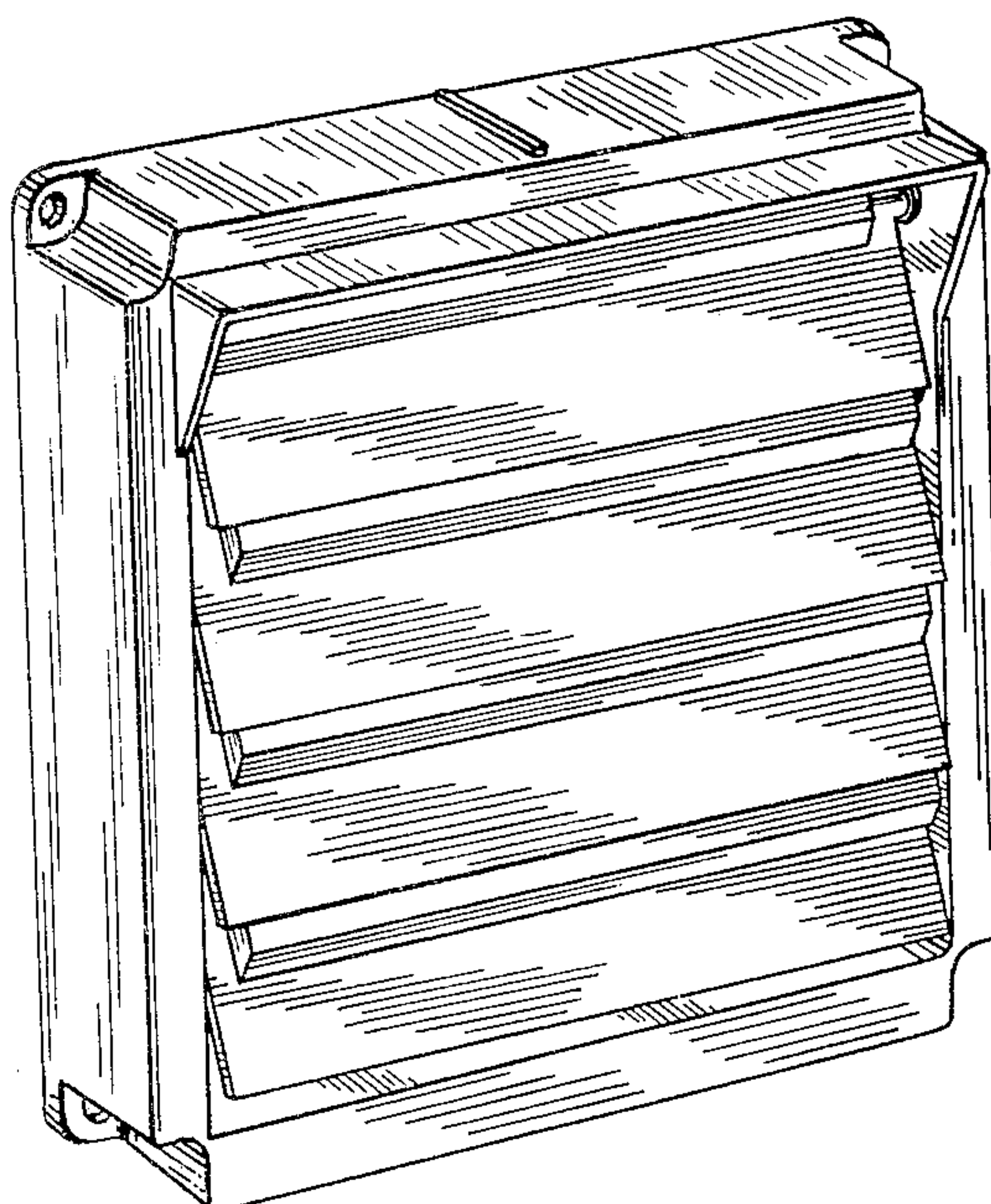

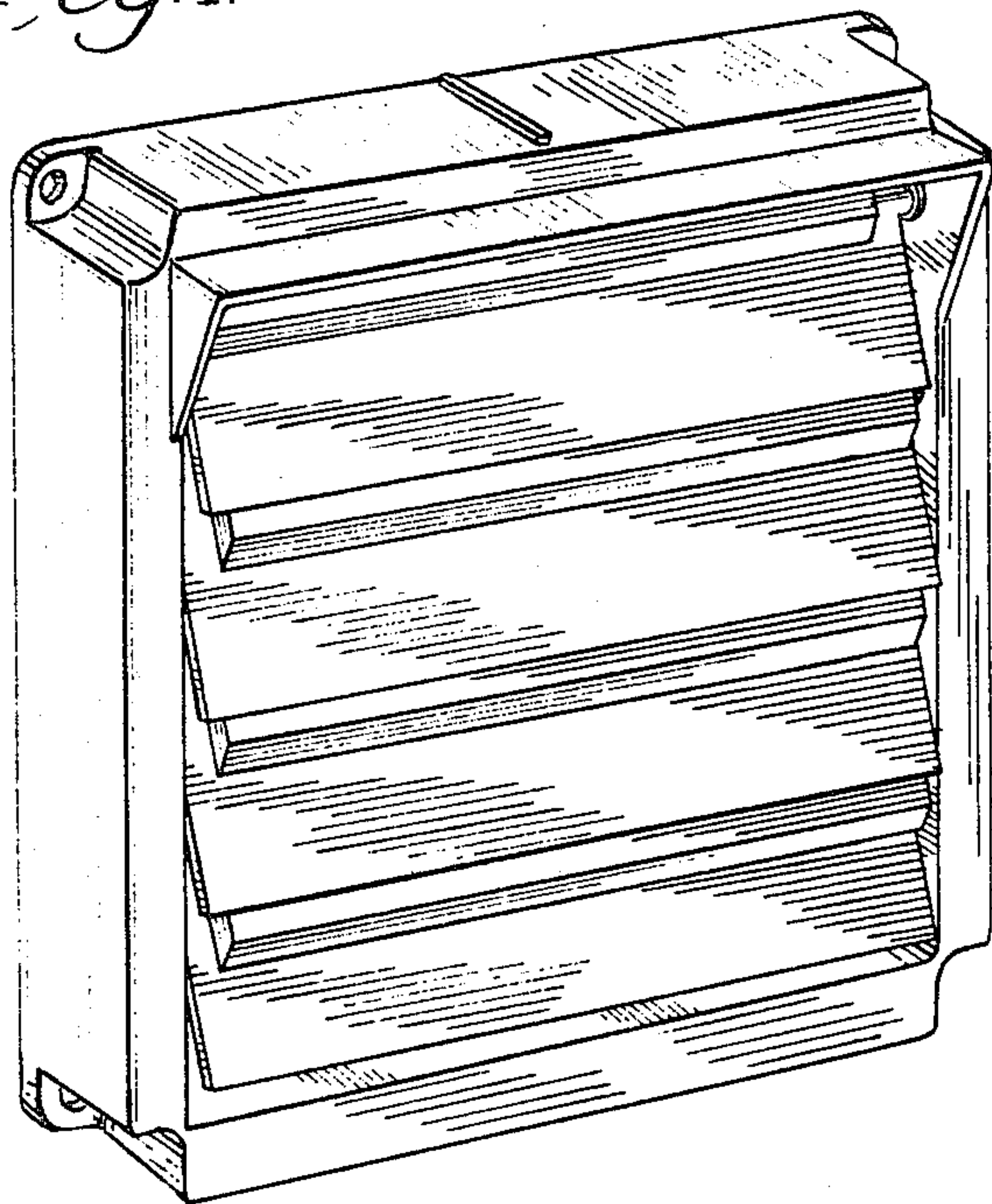

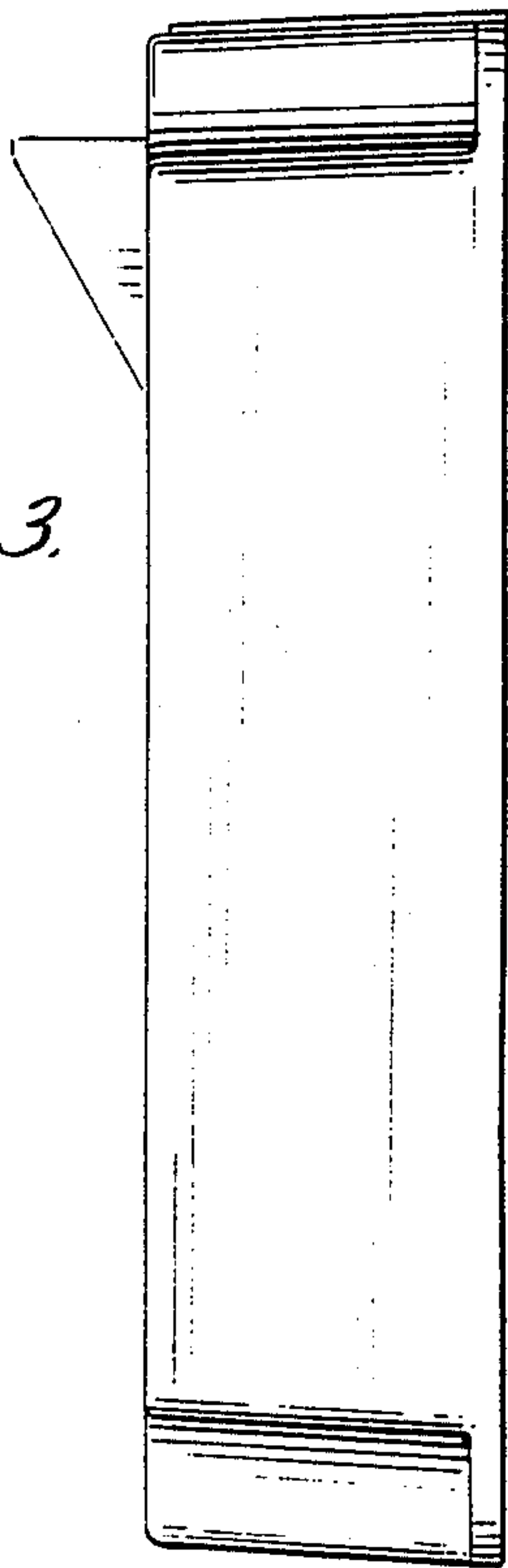

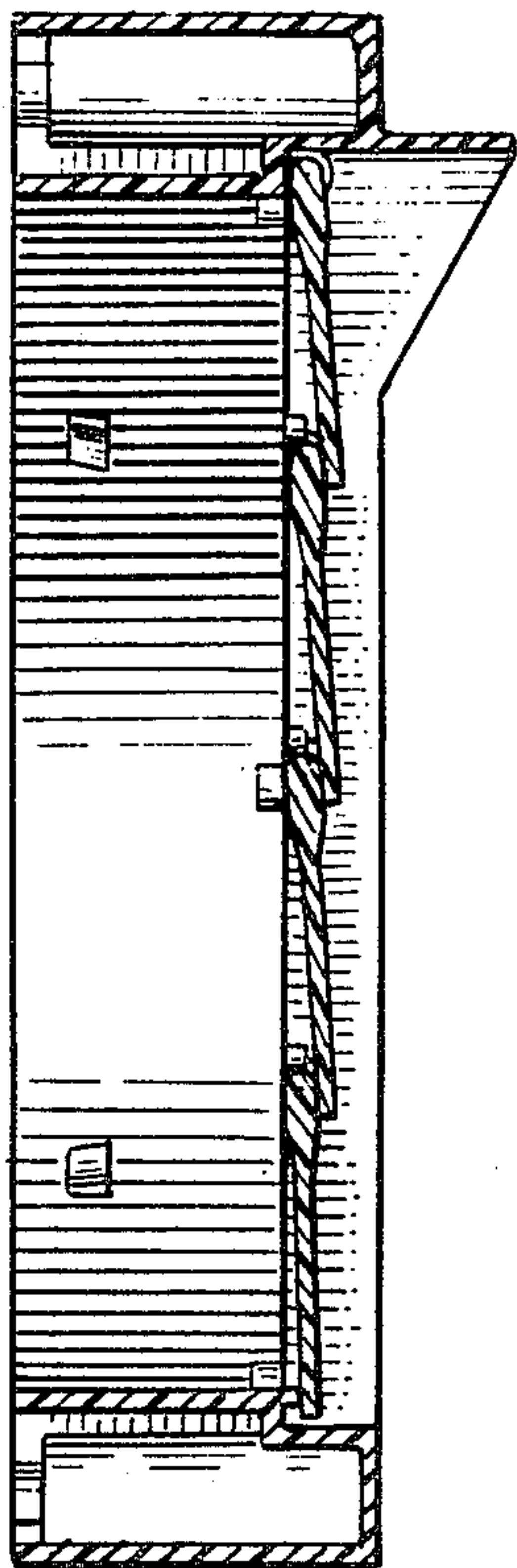

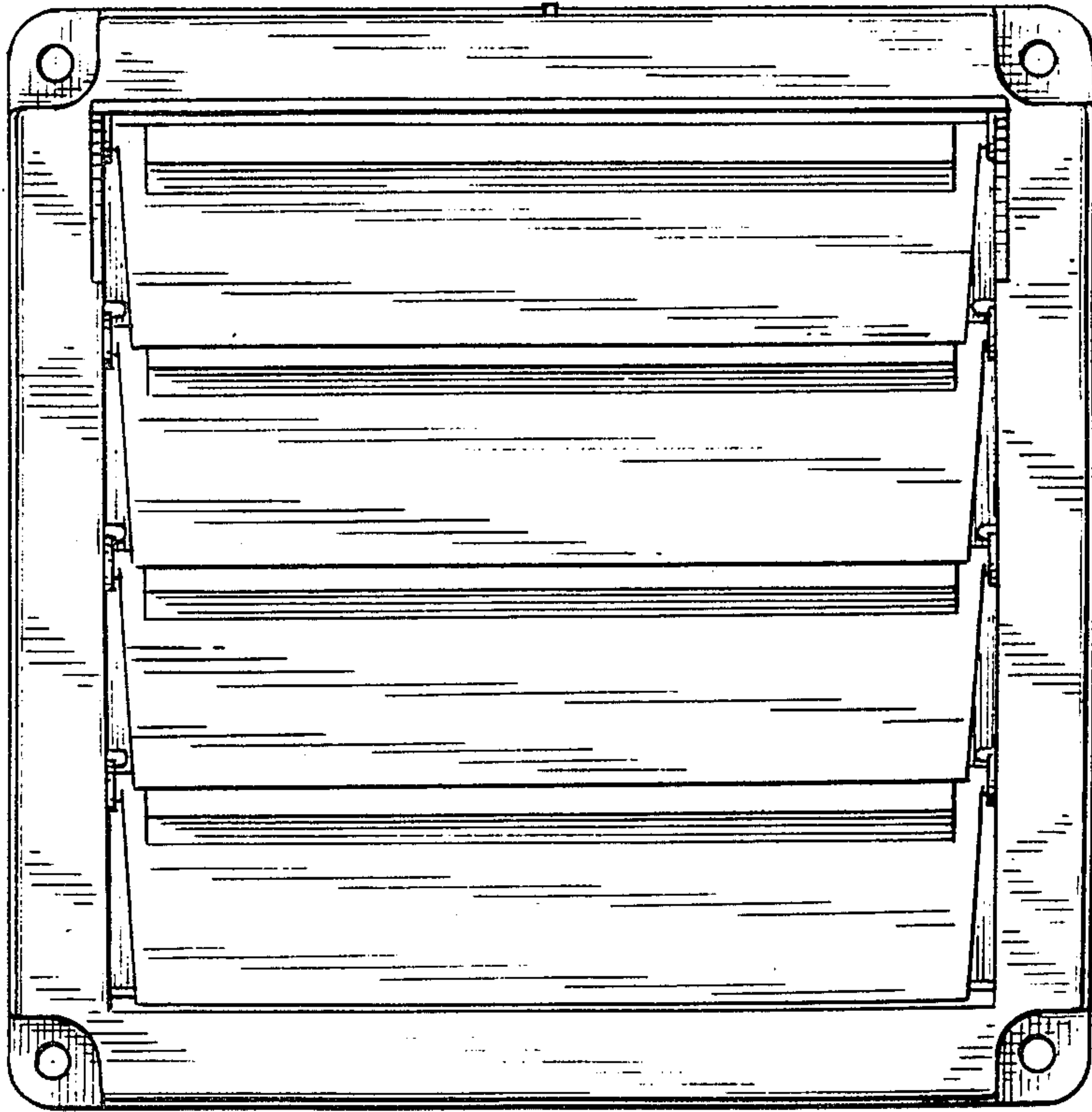

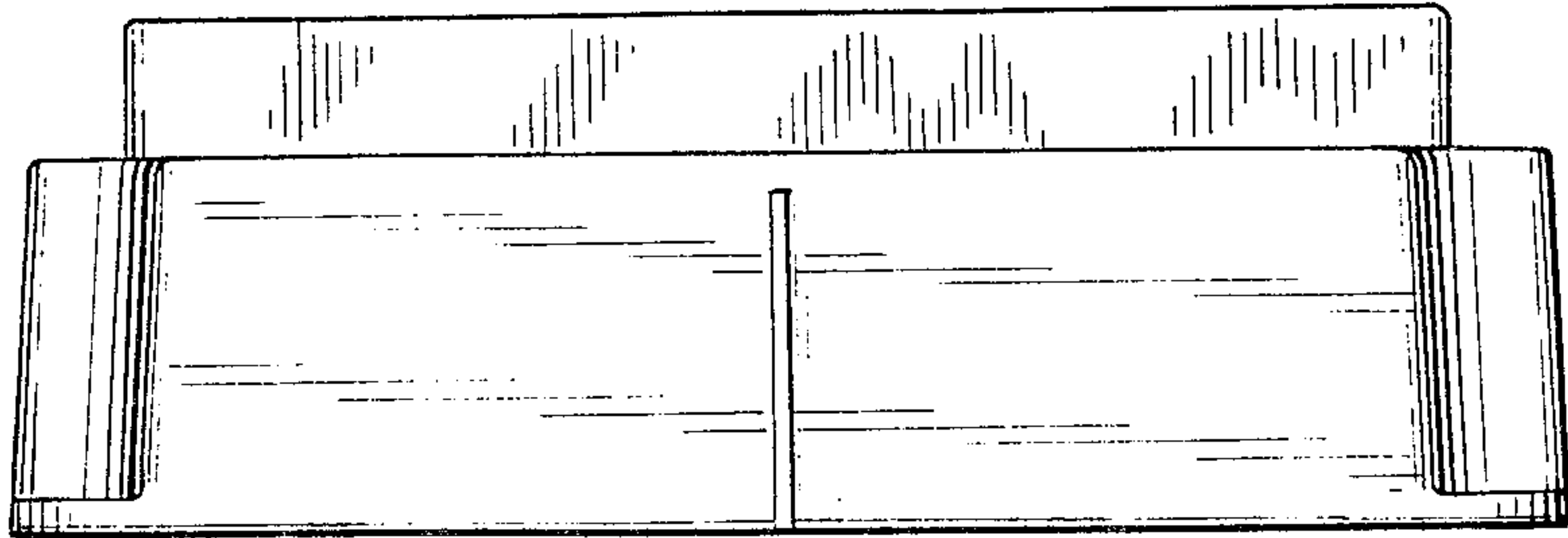

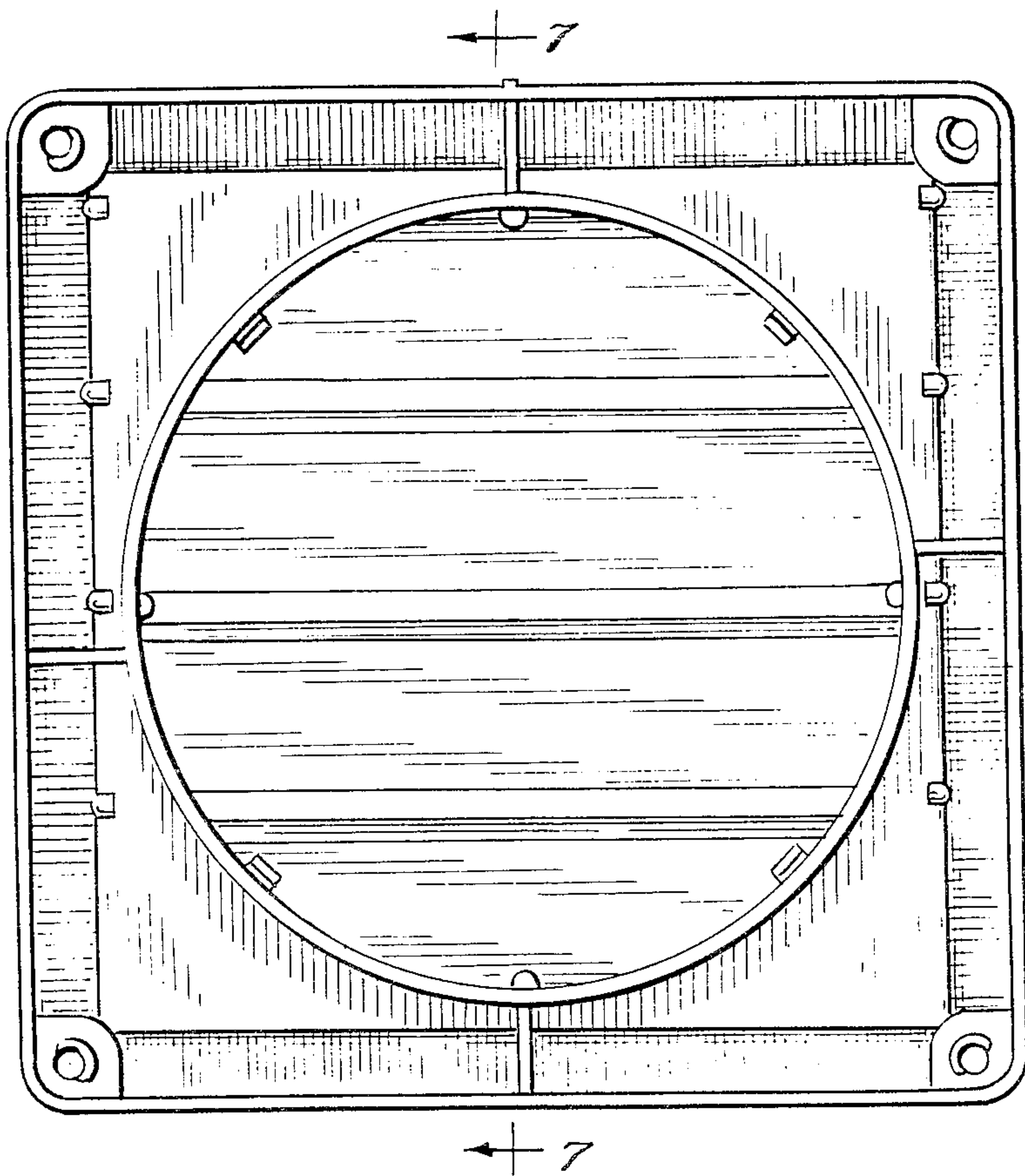
