The ornamental design for miniature picture frame, substantially as shown and described.

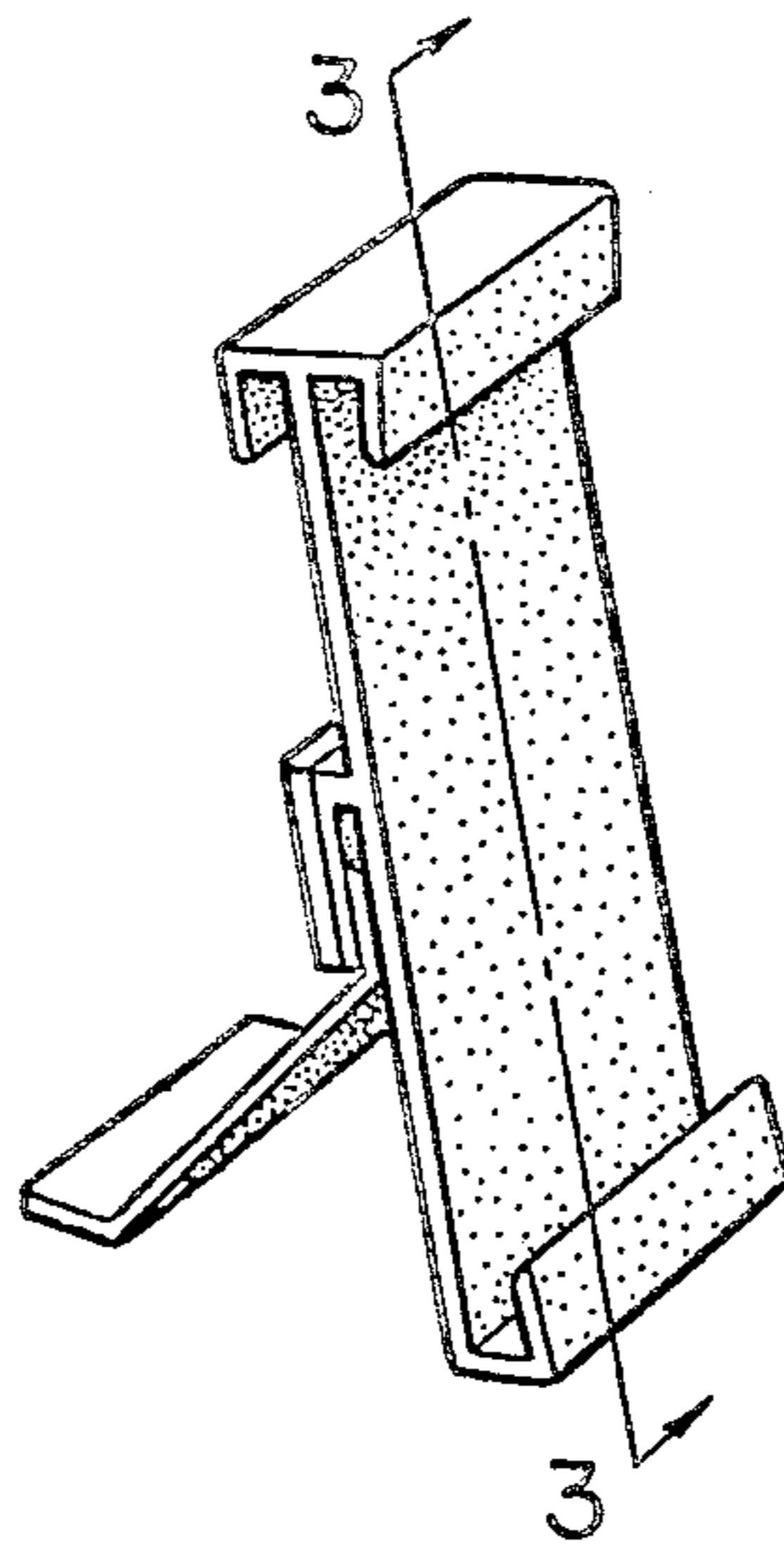
DESCRIPTION

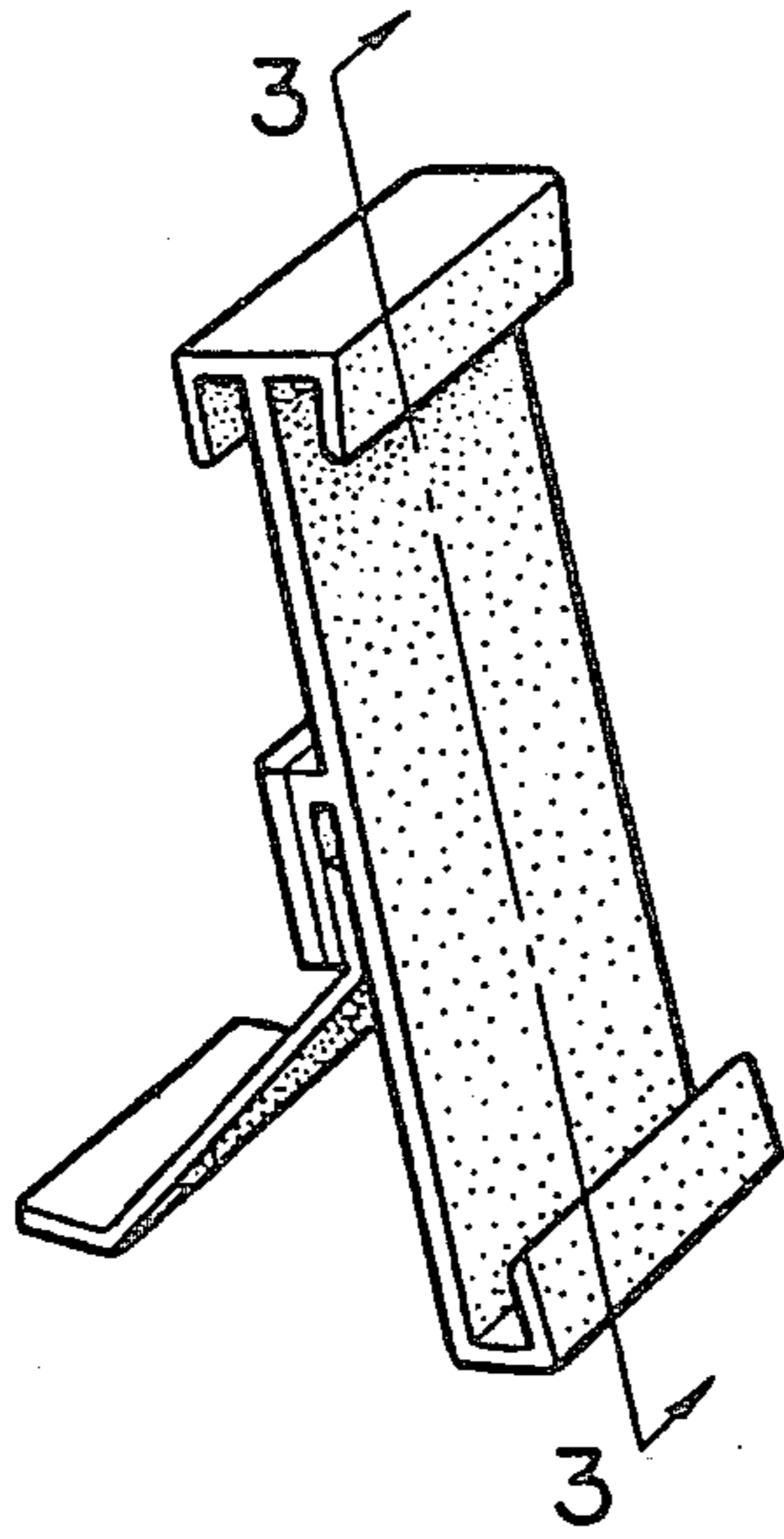

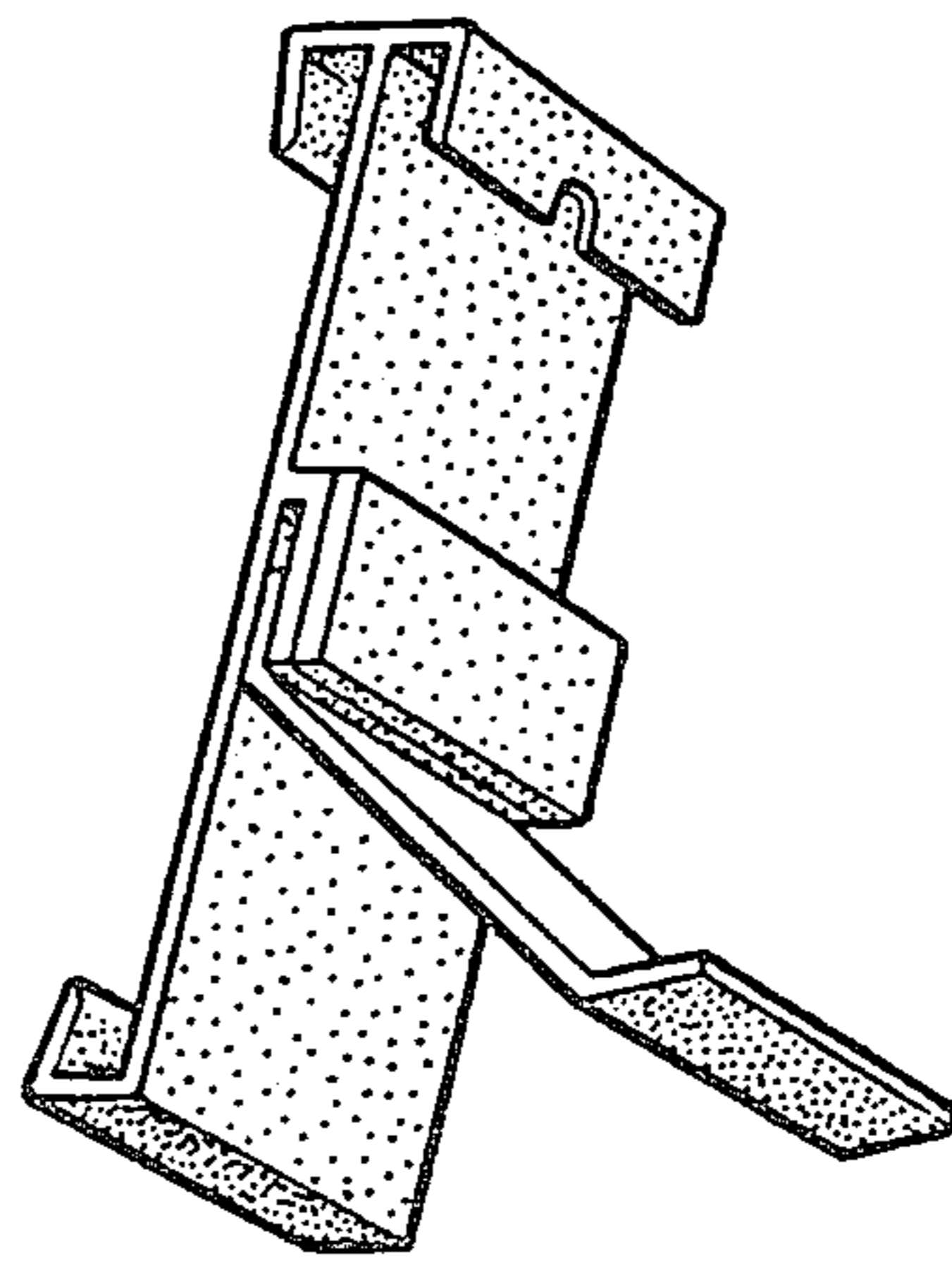

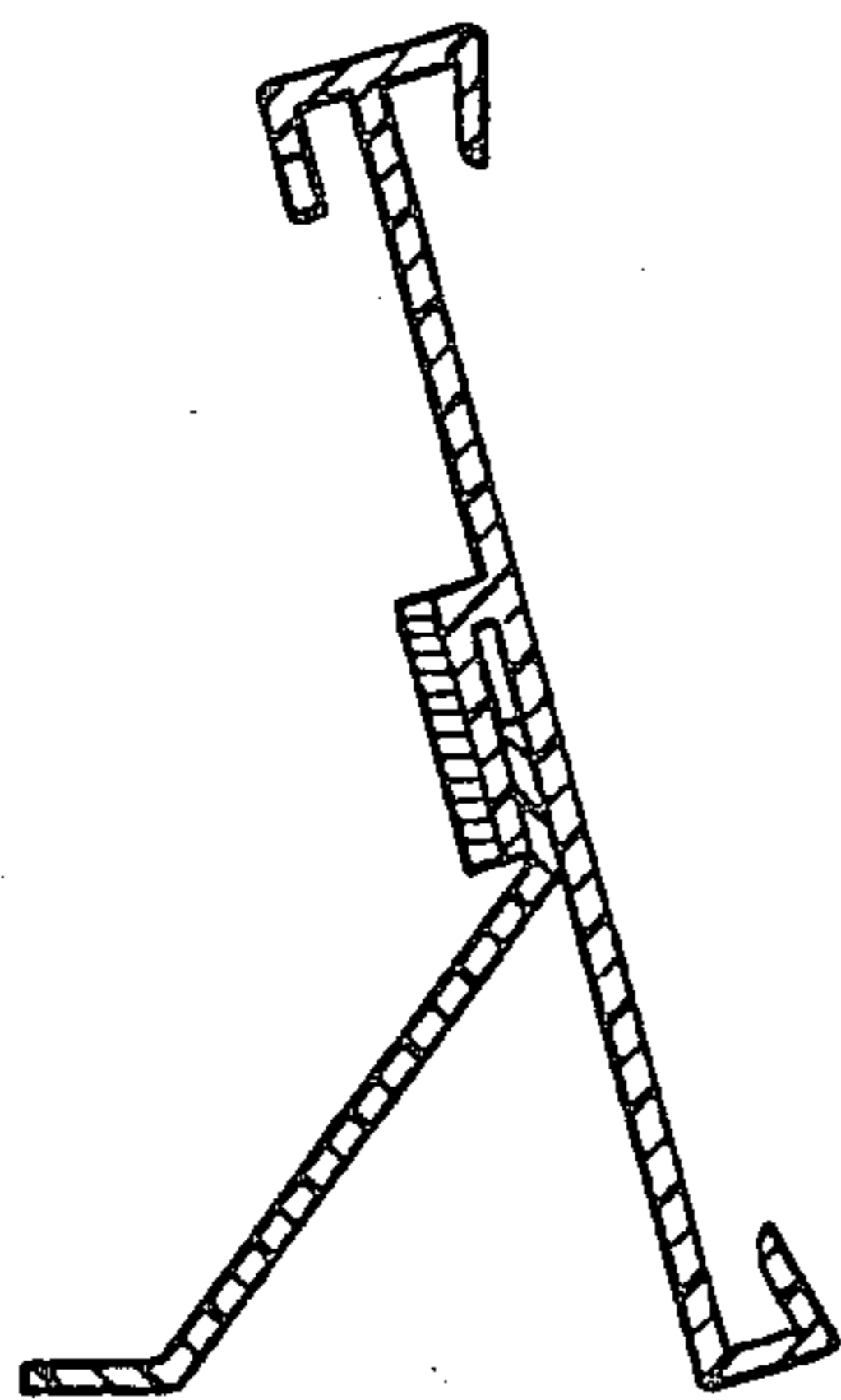
