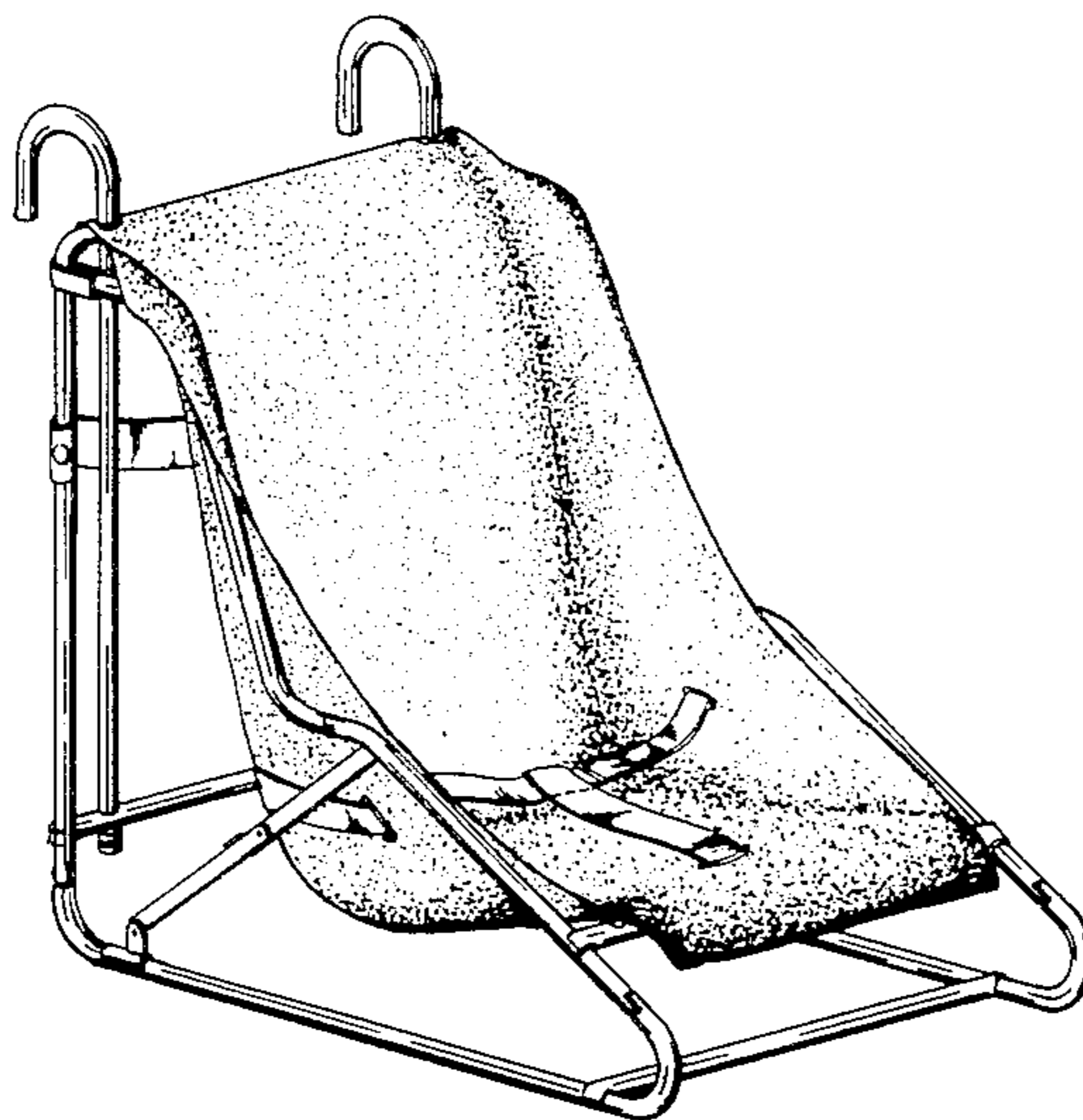

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an infant seat, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an infant seat showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side view thereof as seen from the left-hand side of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.
 The side of the infant seat not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 3.



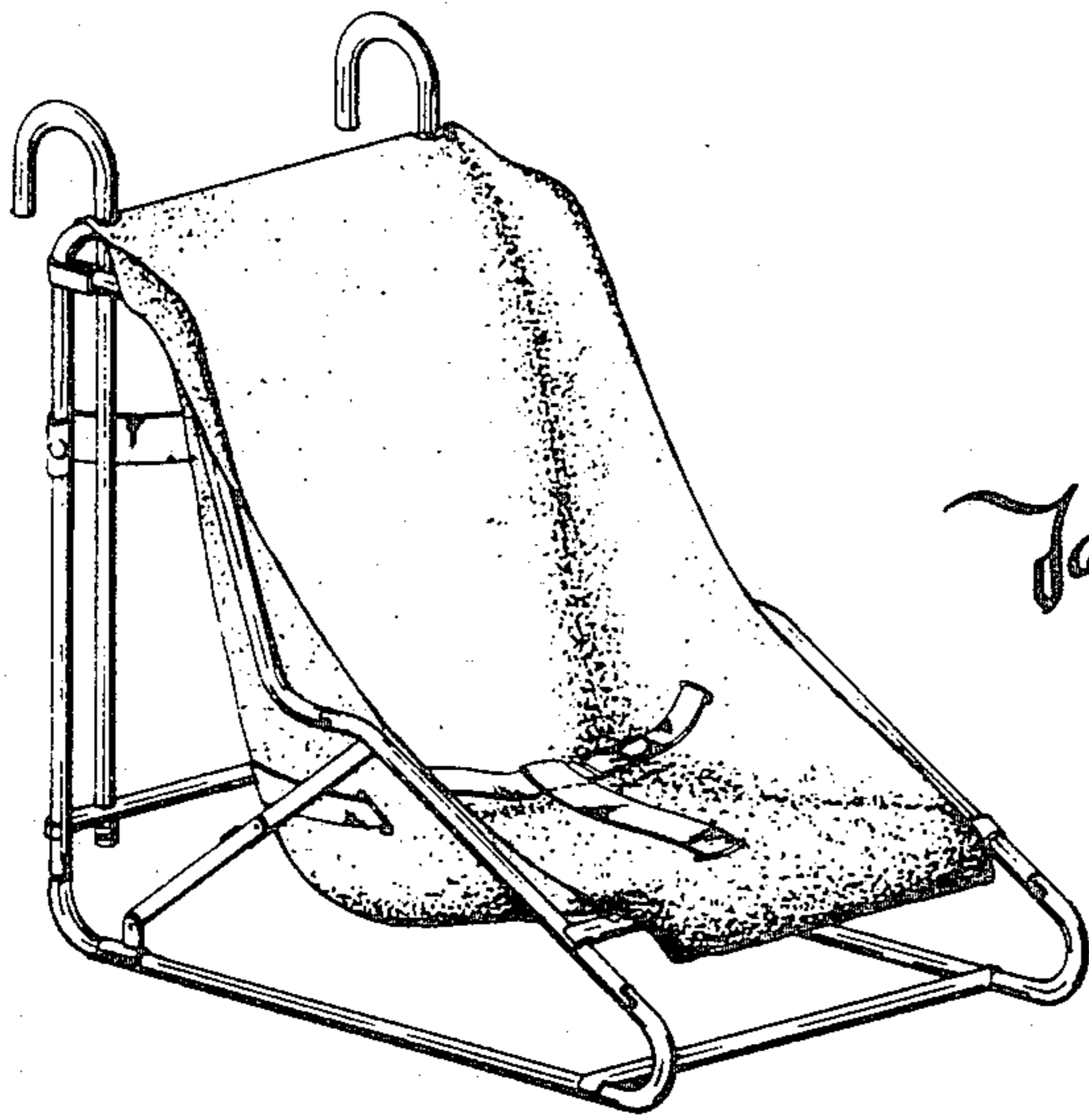

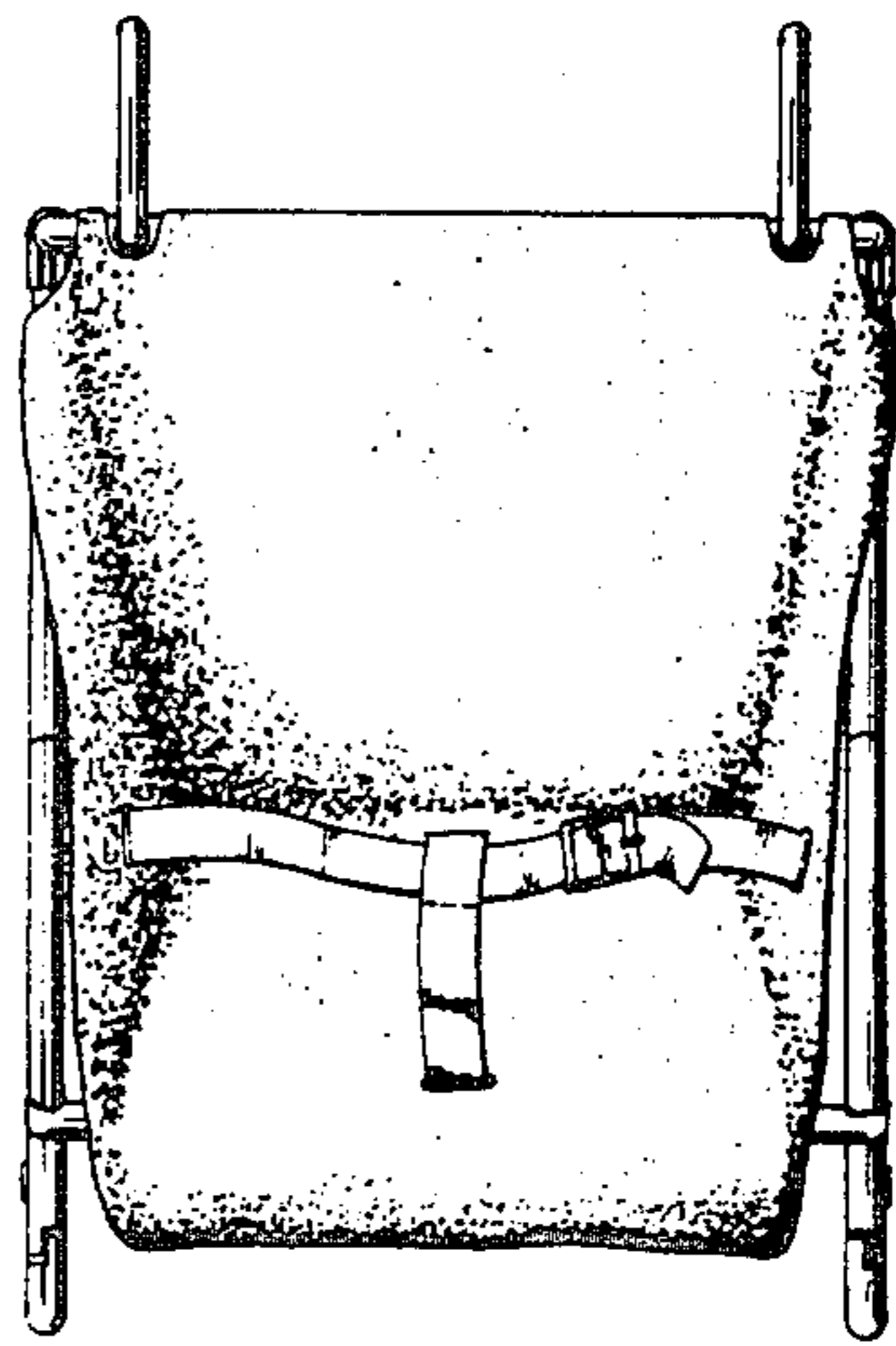

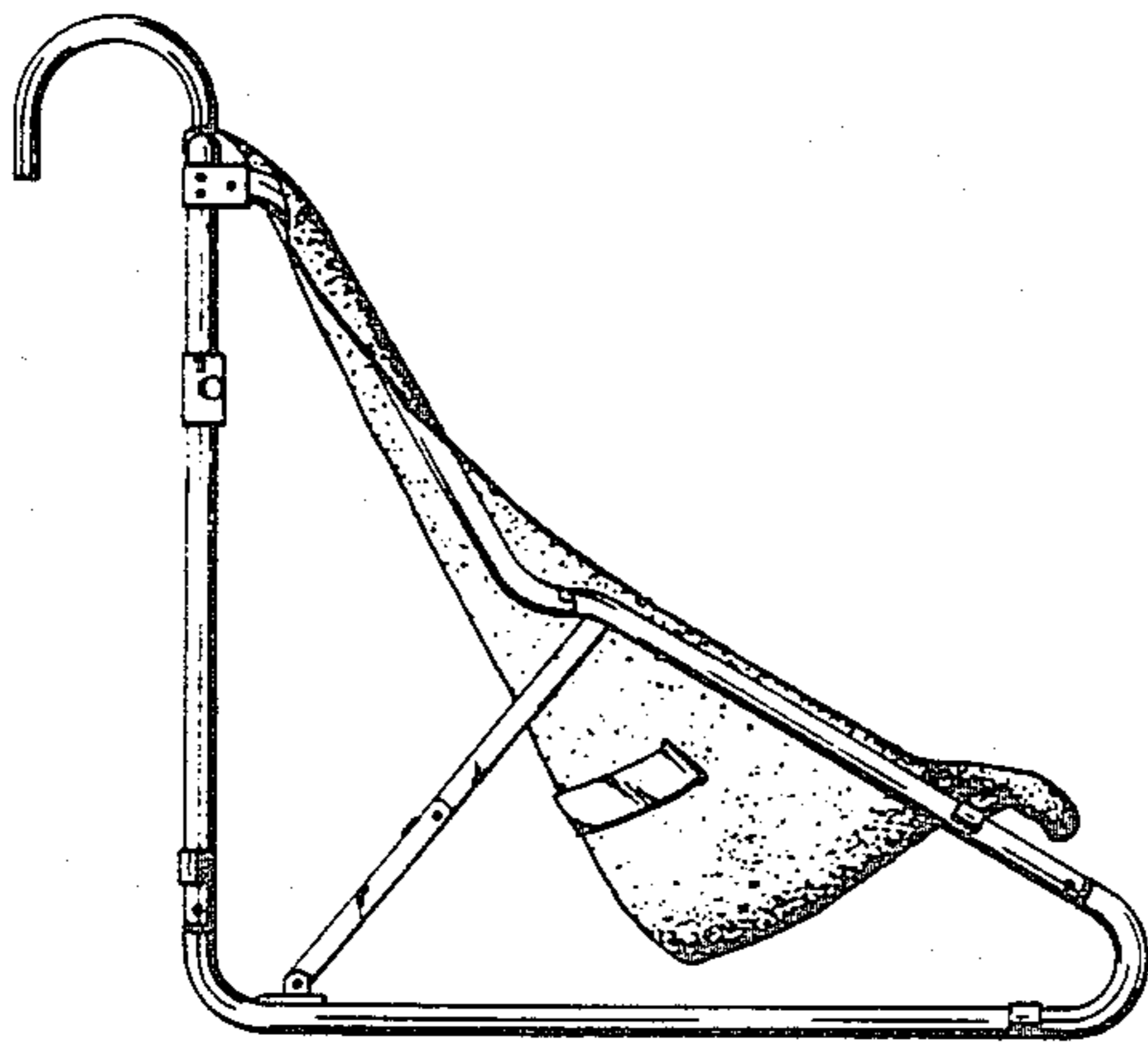

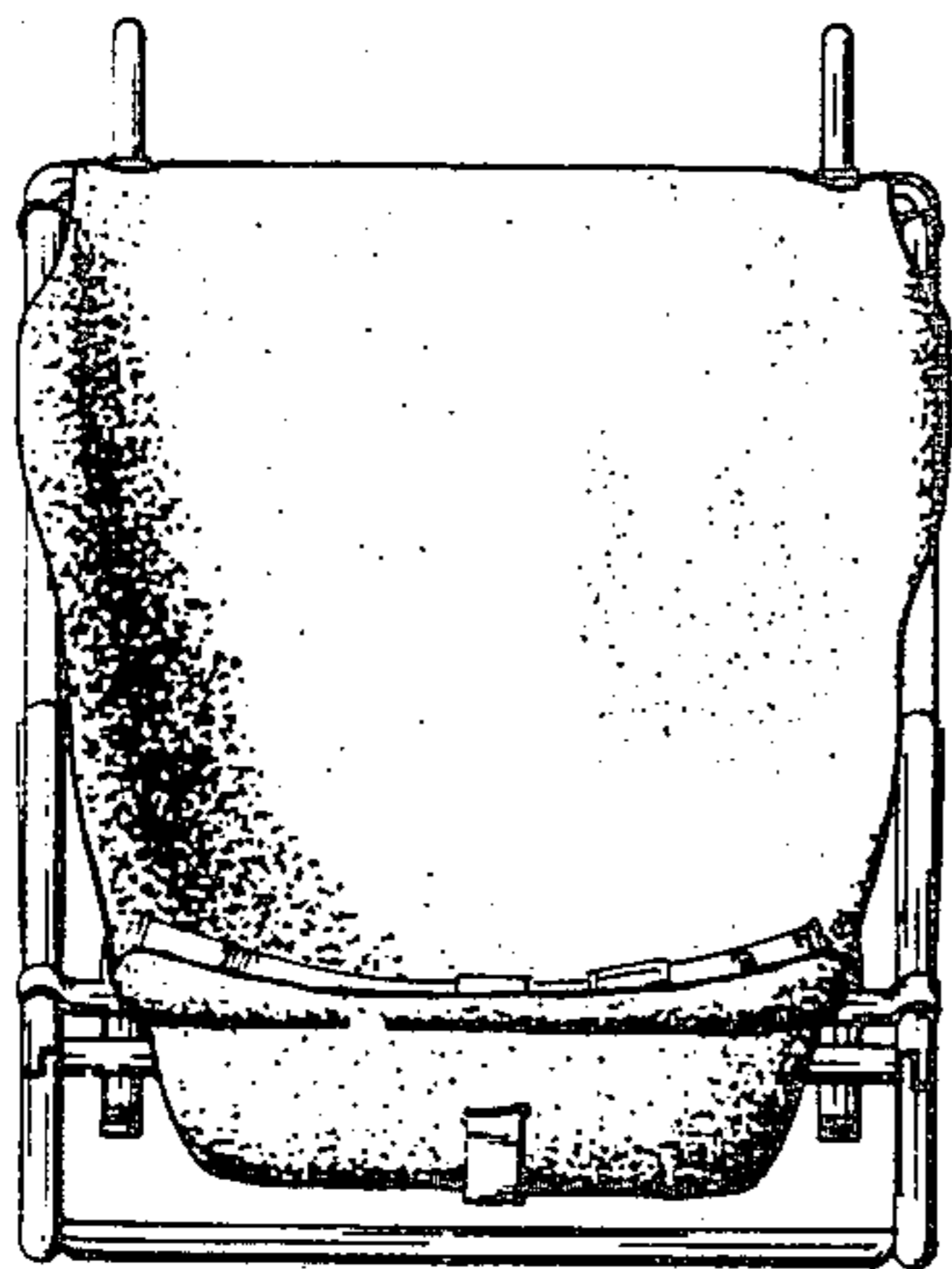

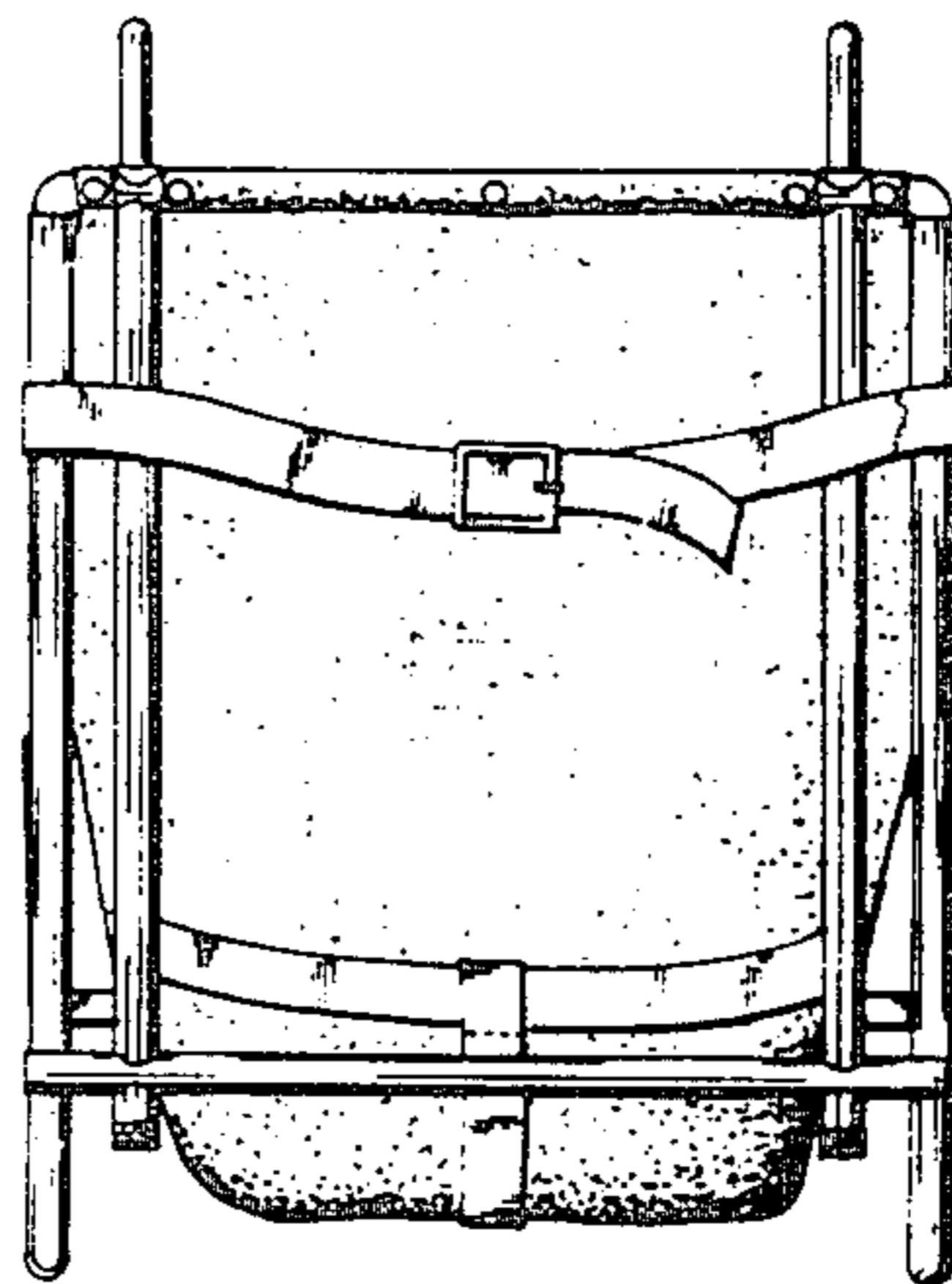
