showing our new design.

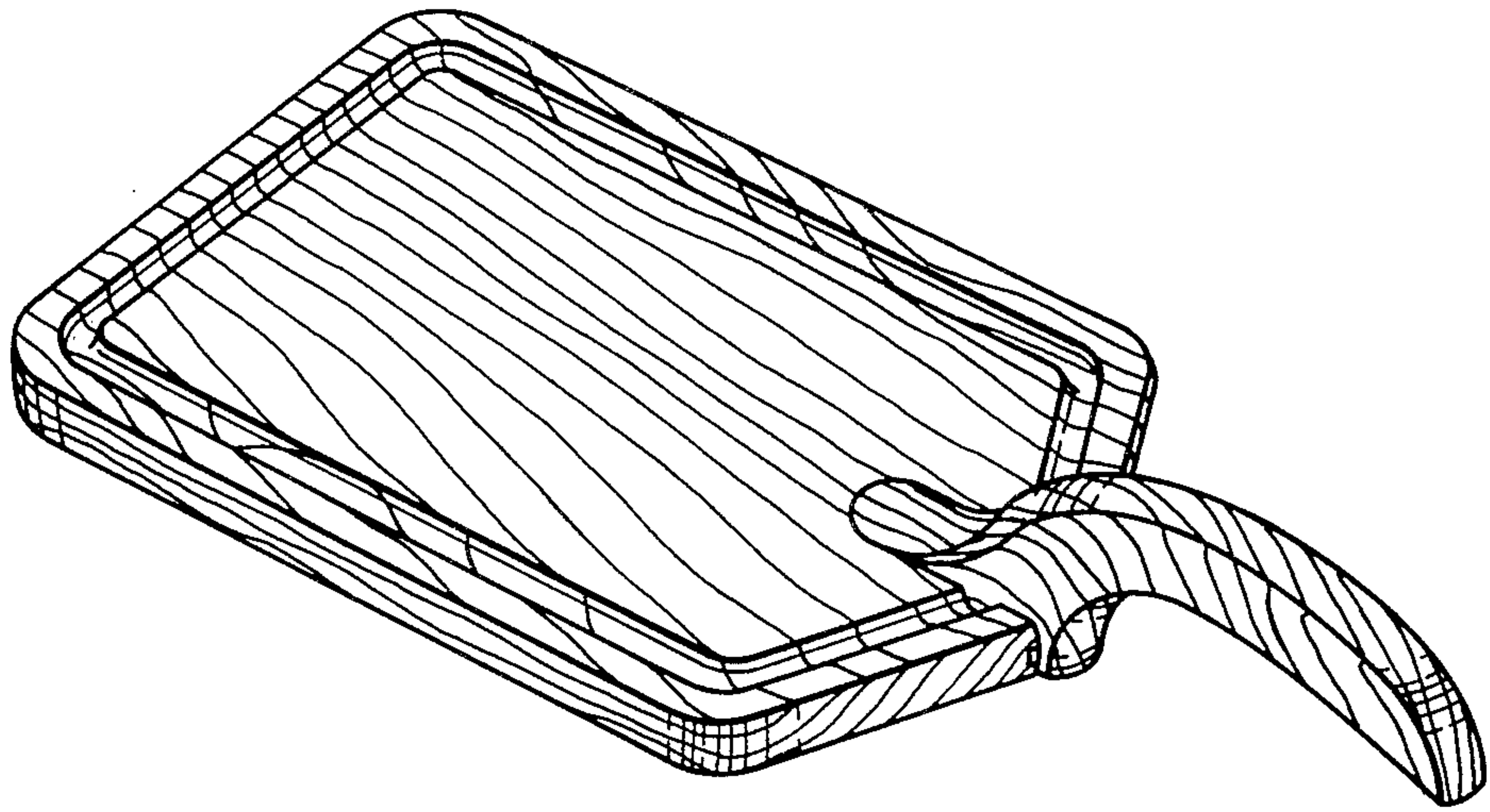
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



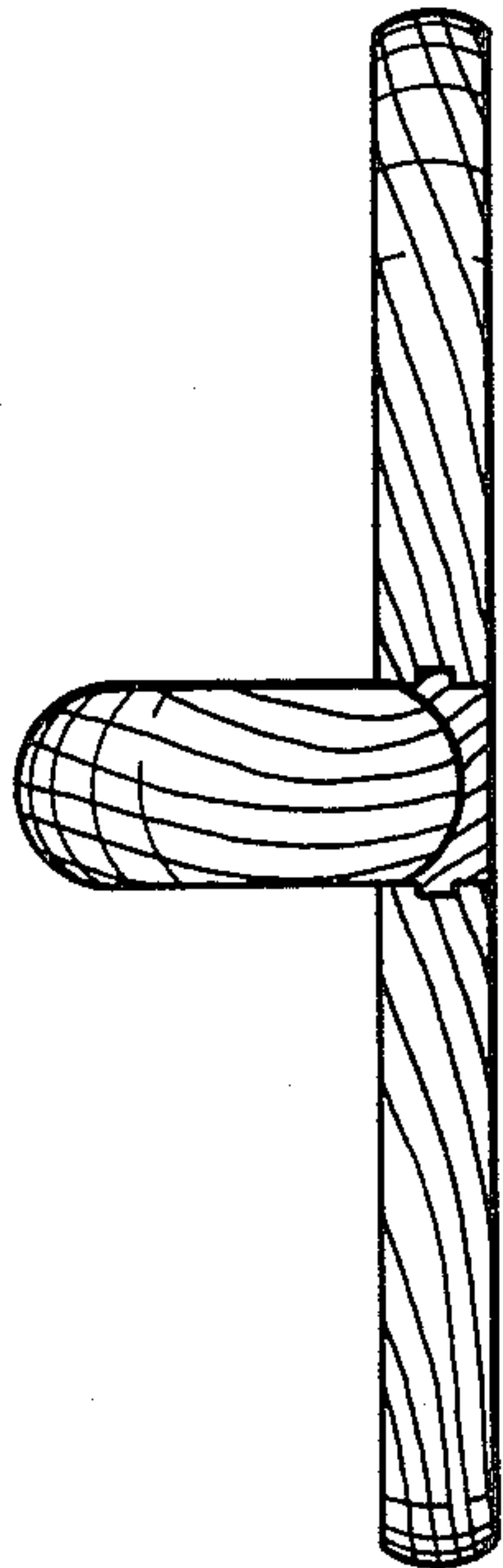

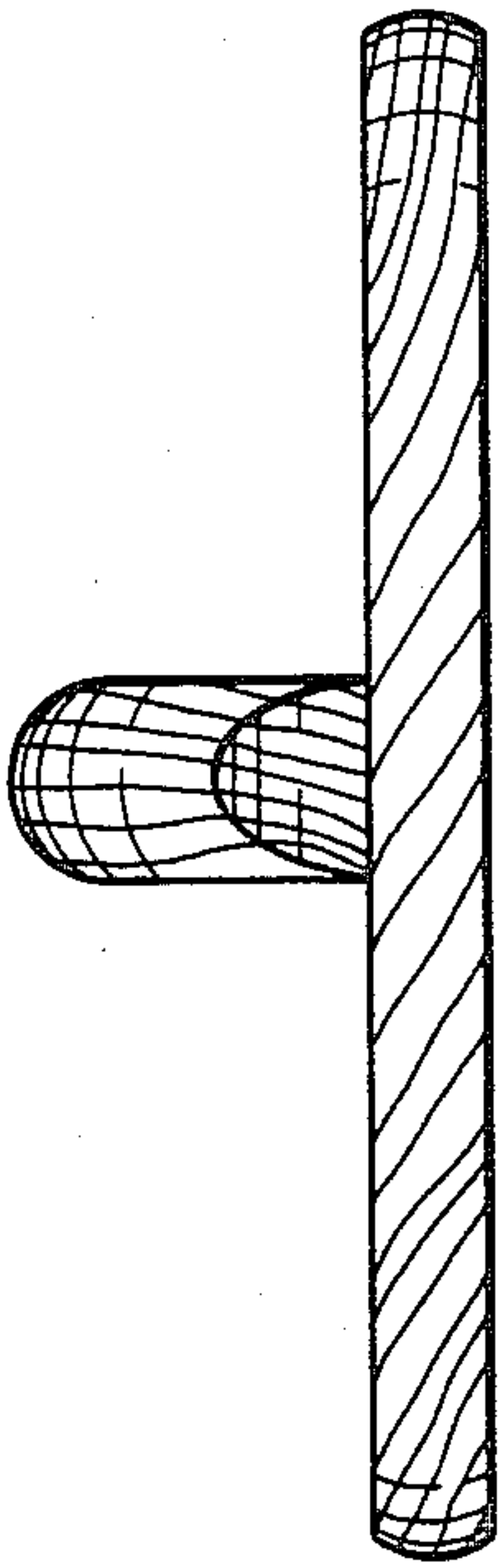

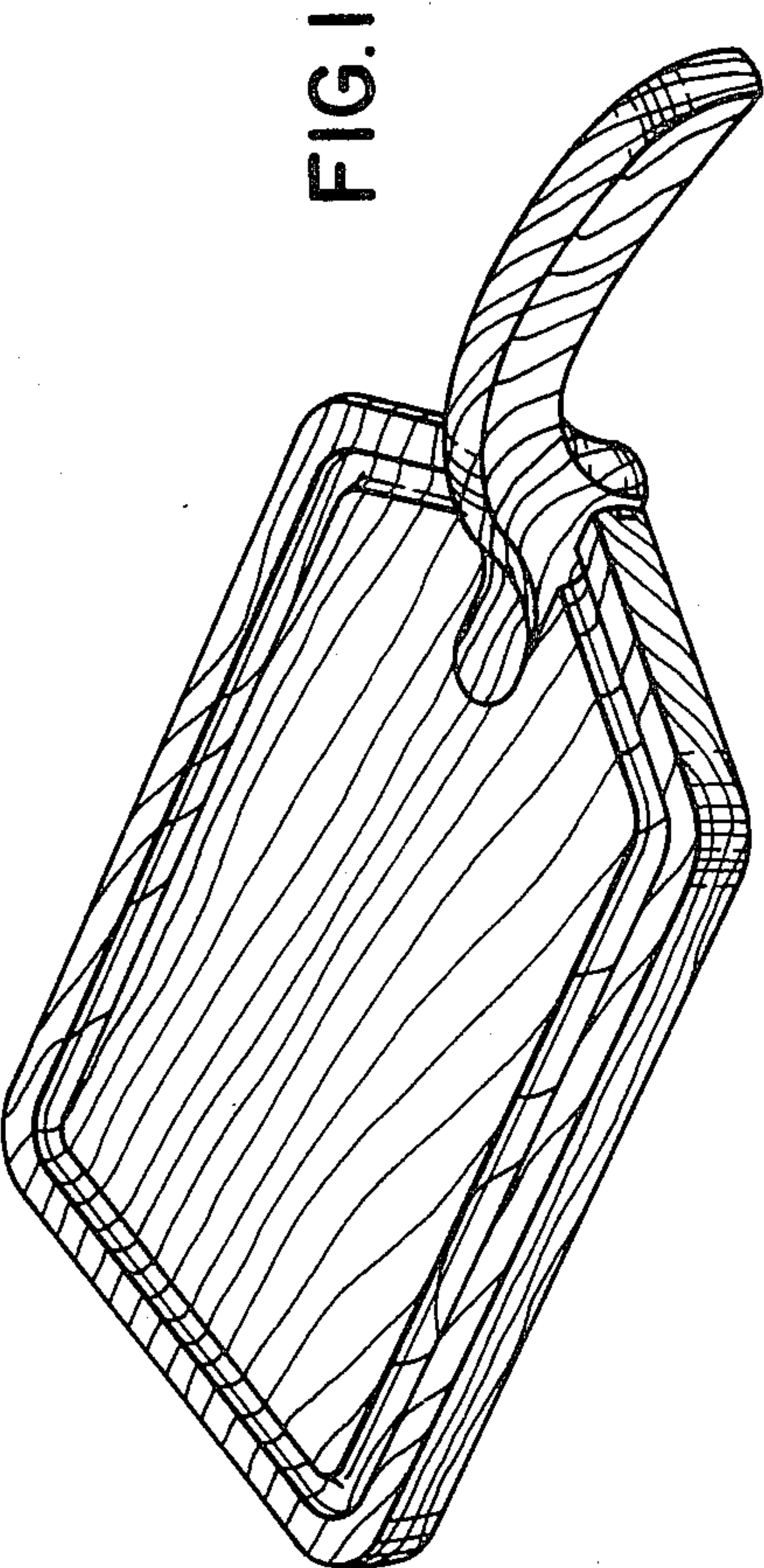

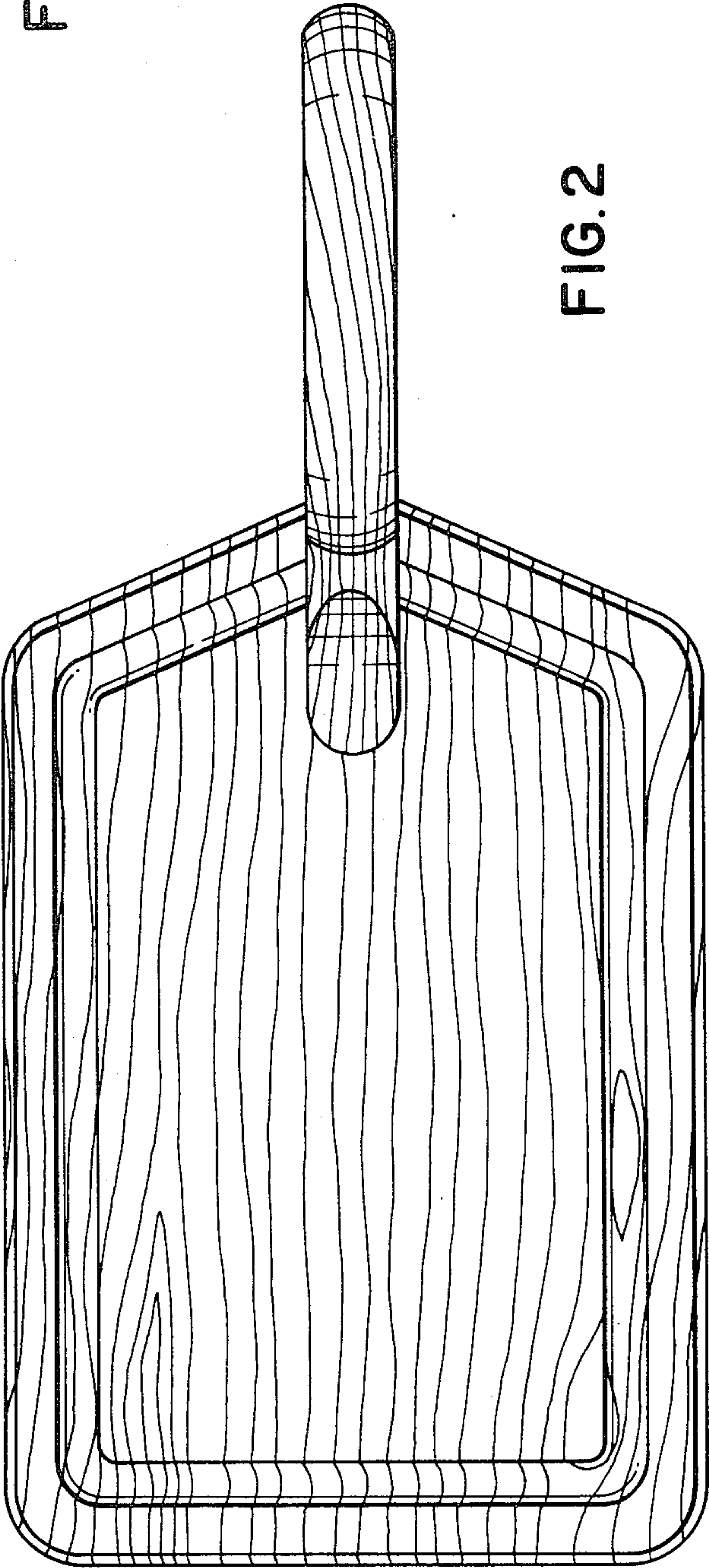

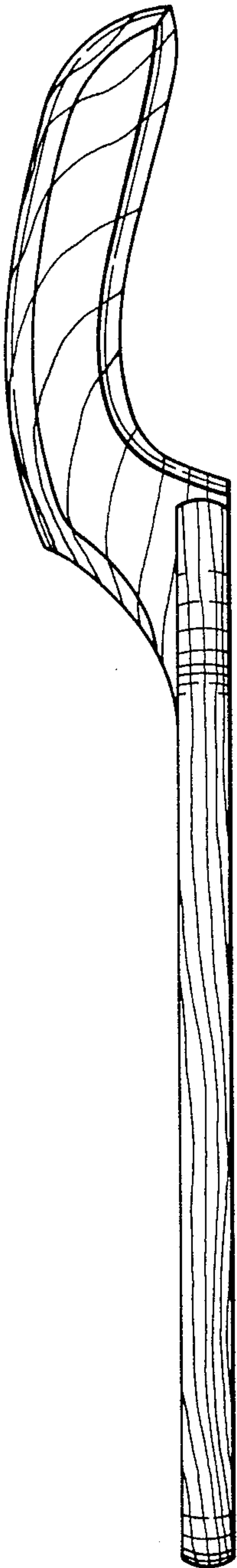

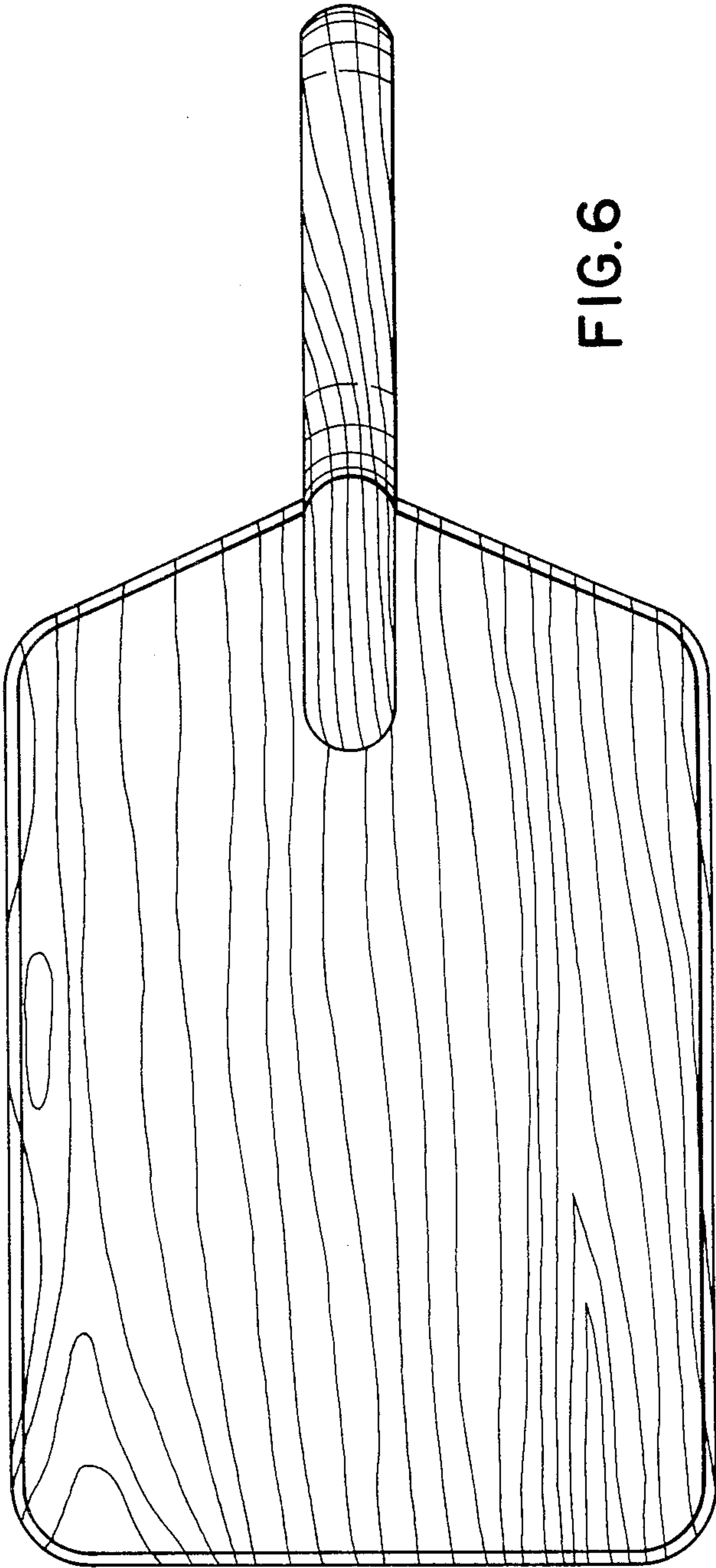
