DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a jewelry chain showing my new design, the bottom view being the same.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being the same.

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side view being the same.

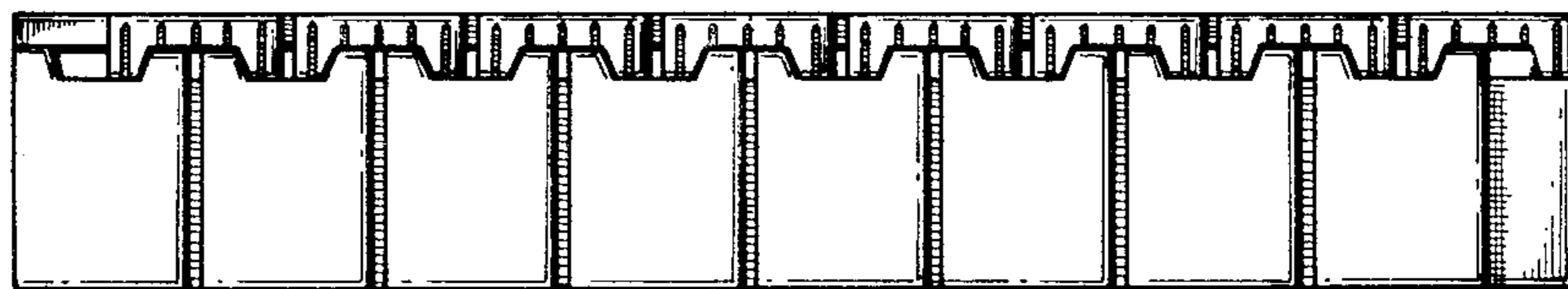

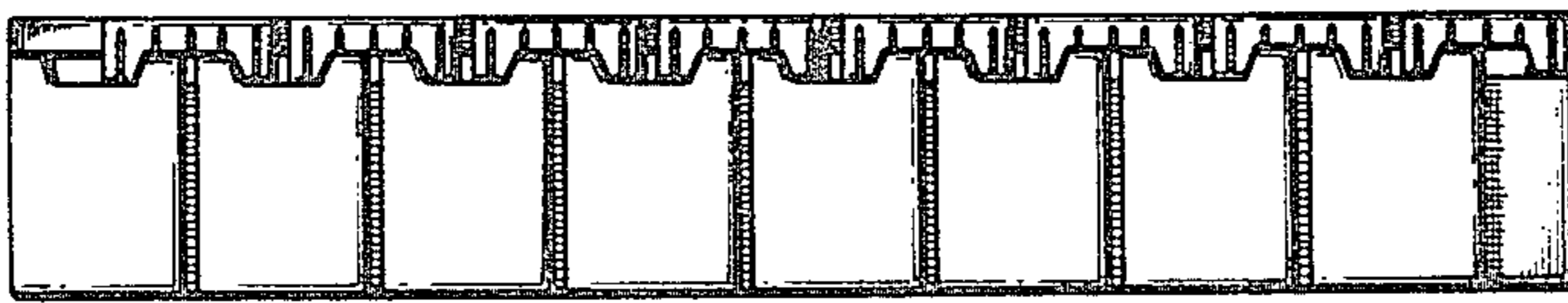
