FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof.

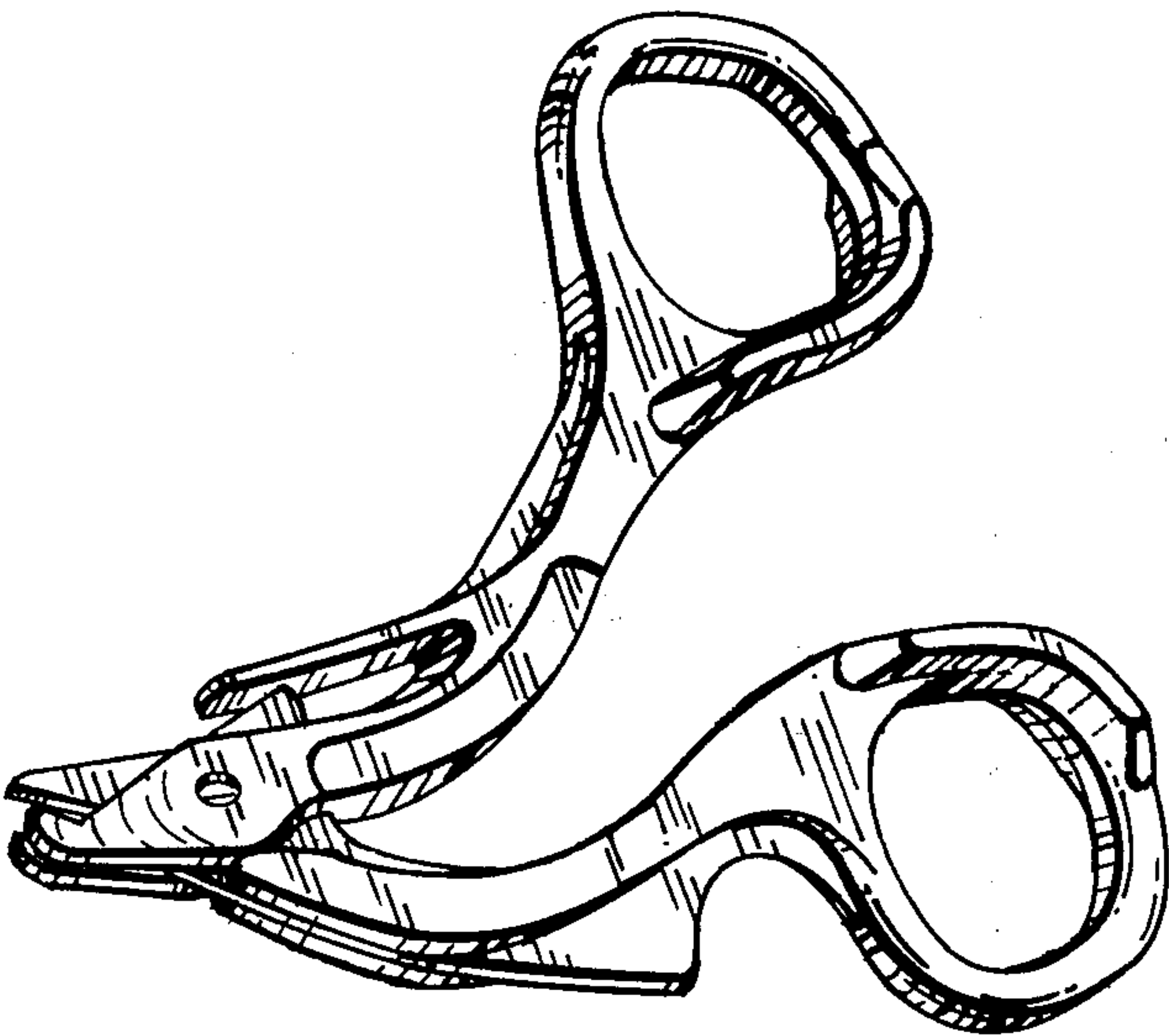

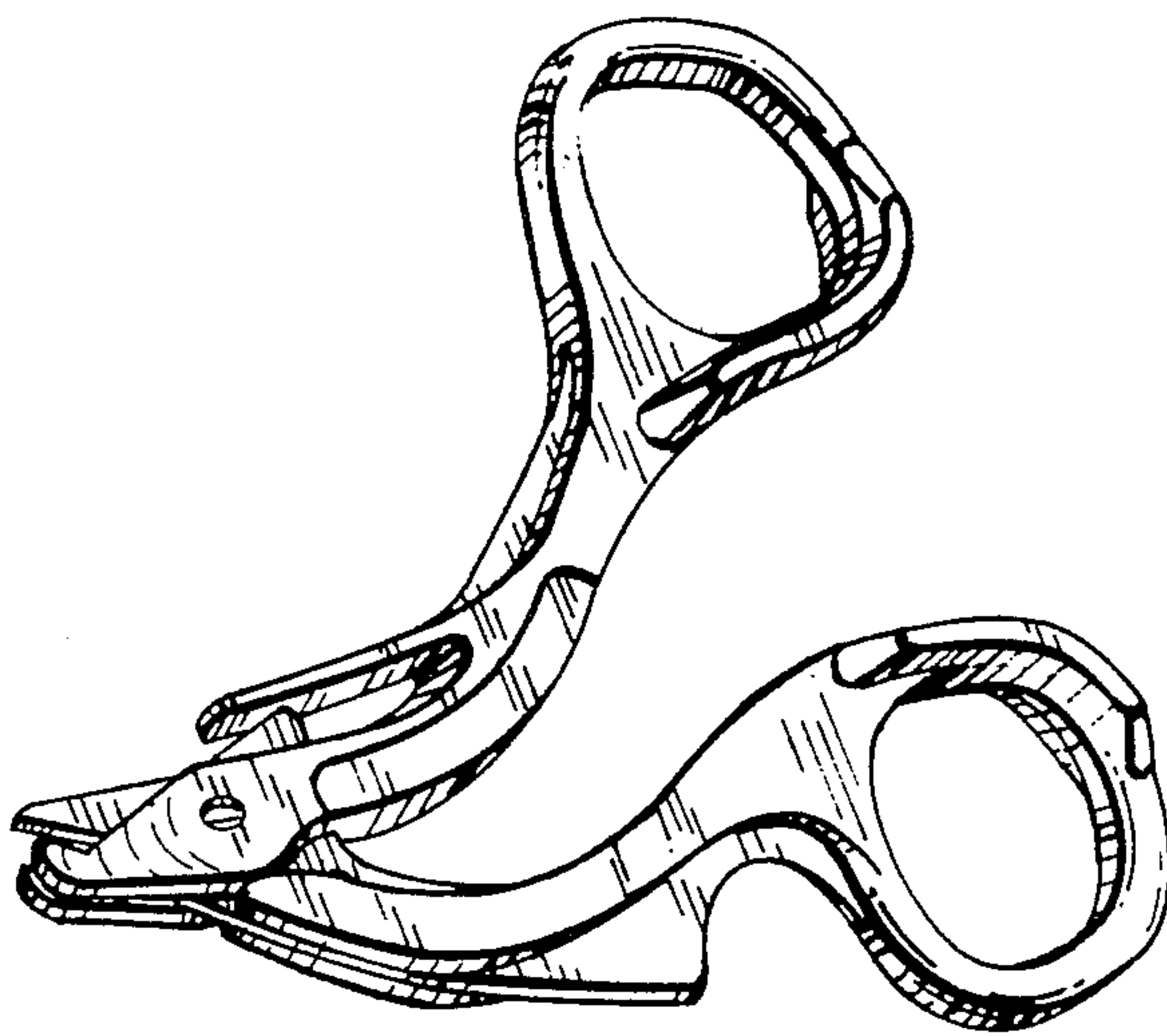

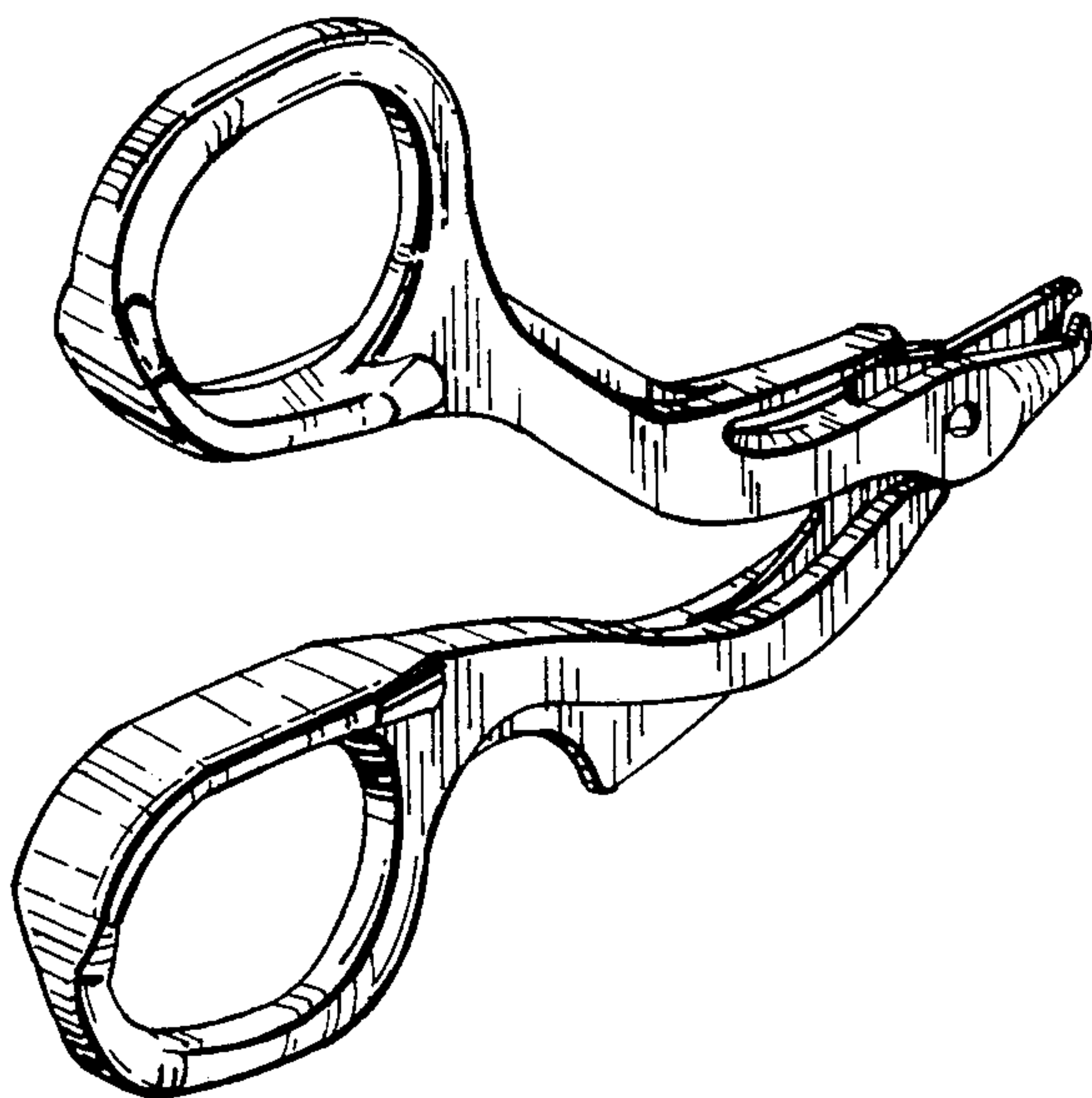

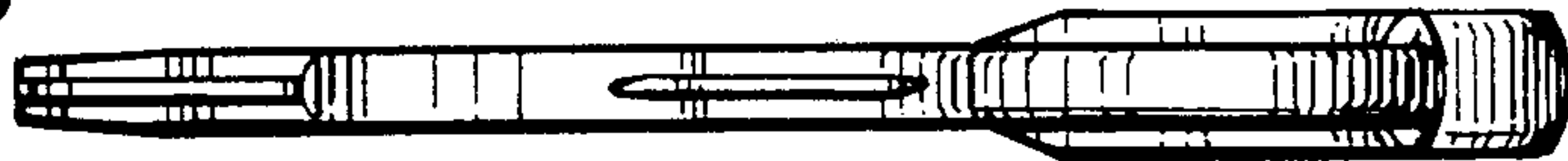

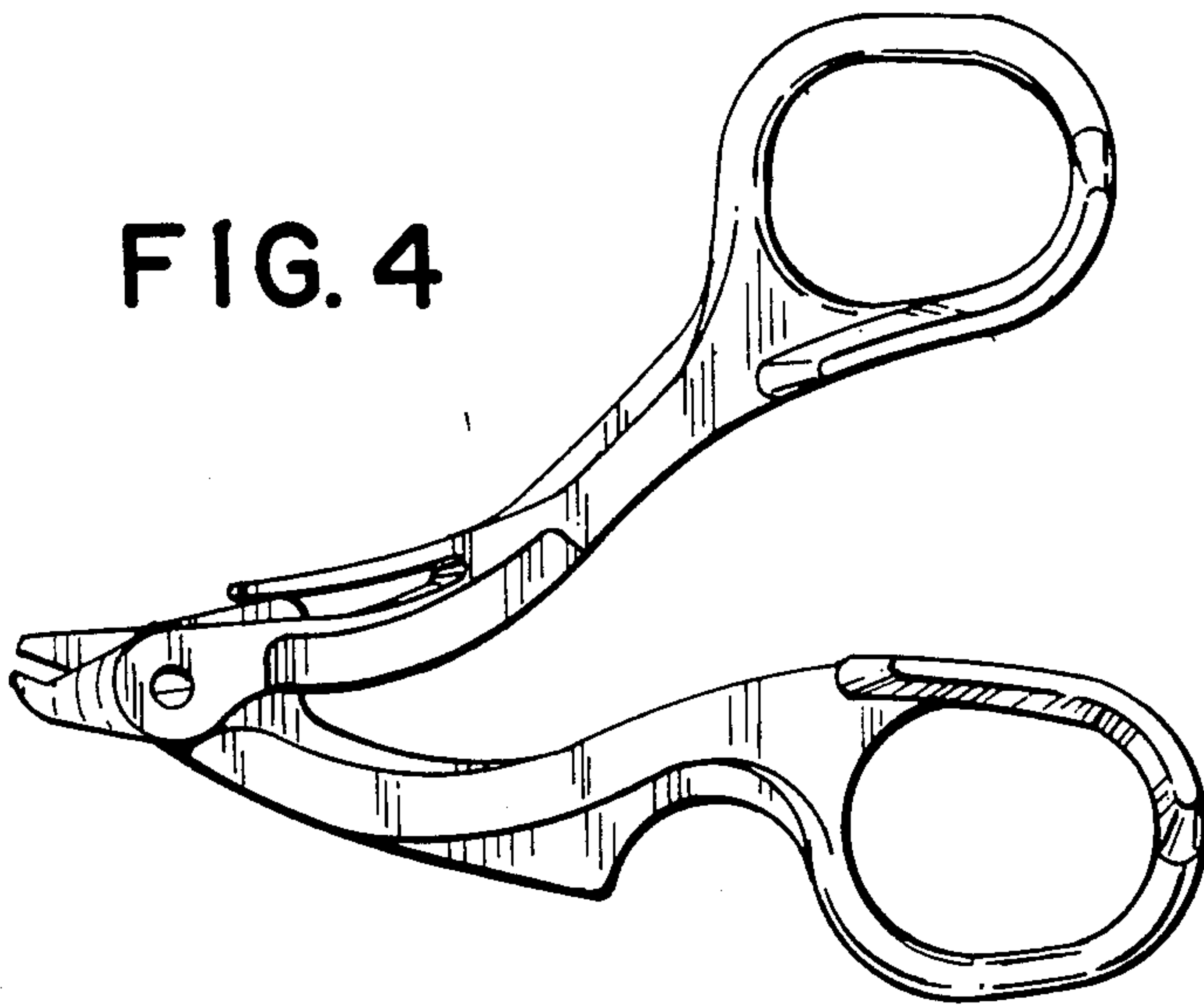

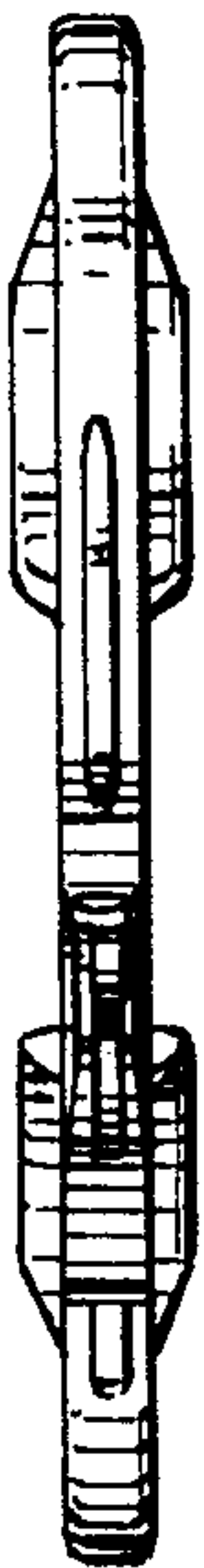

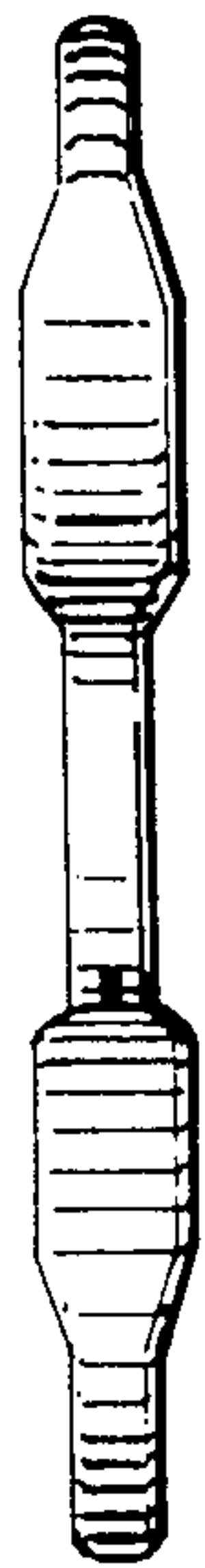

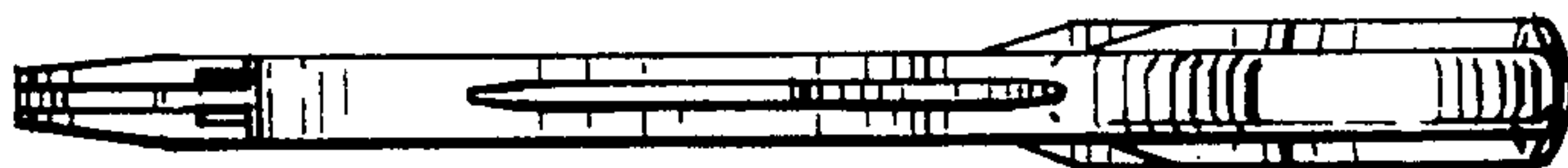
