[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a dog leash handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a dog leash handle showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a right end elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left end elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is an elevational view taken from one side thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown; and  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
The fragmentary broken line representation of a leash in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.

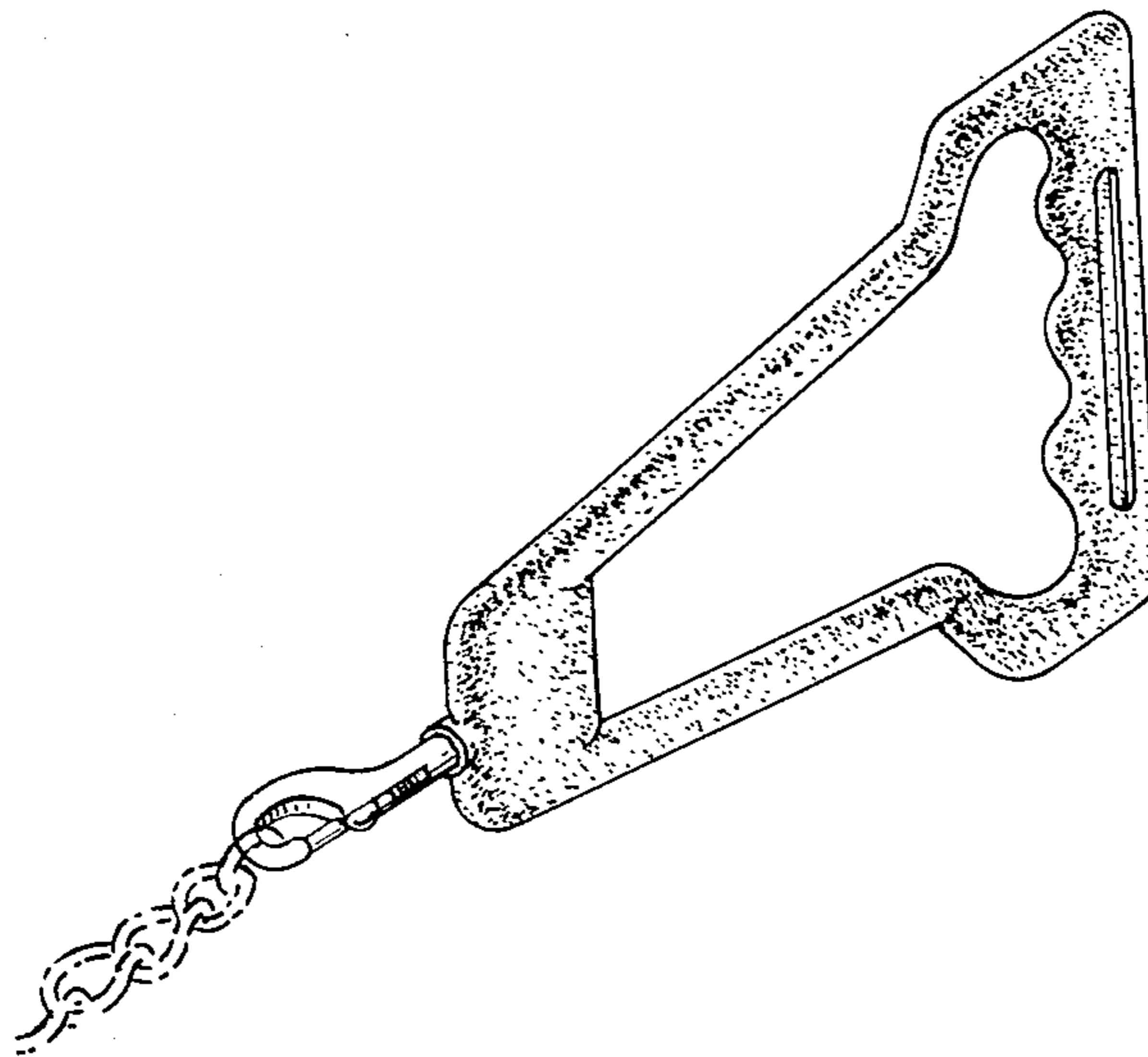

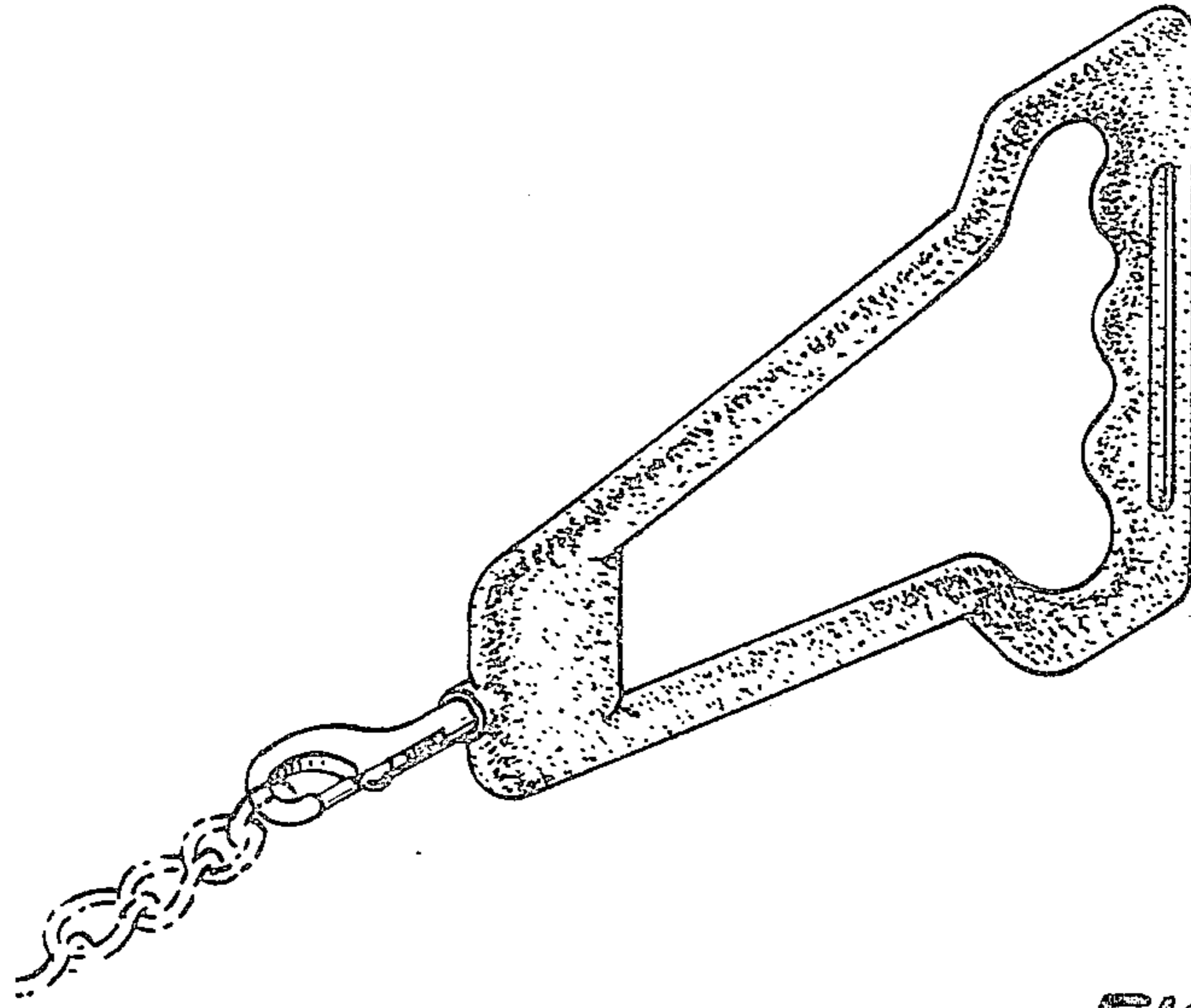

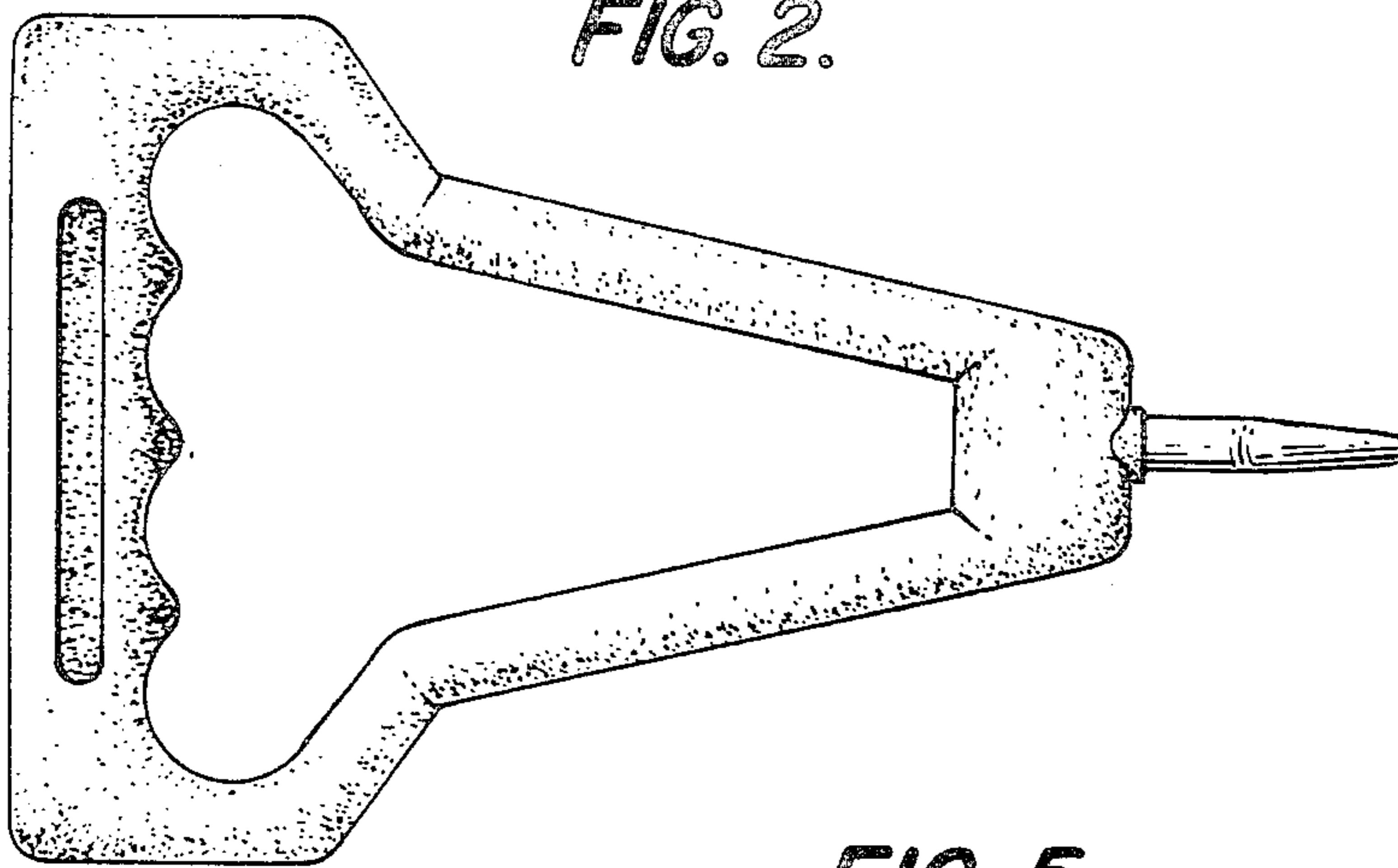

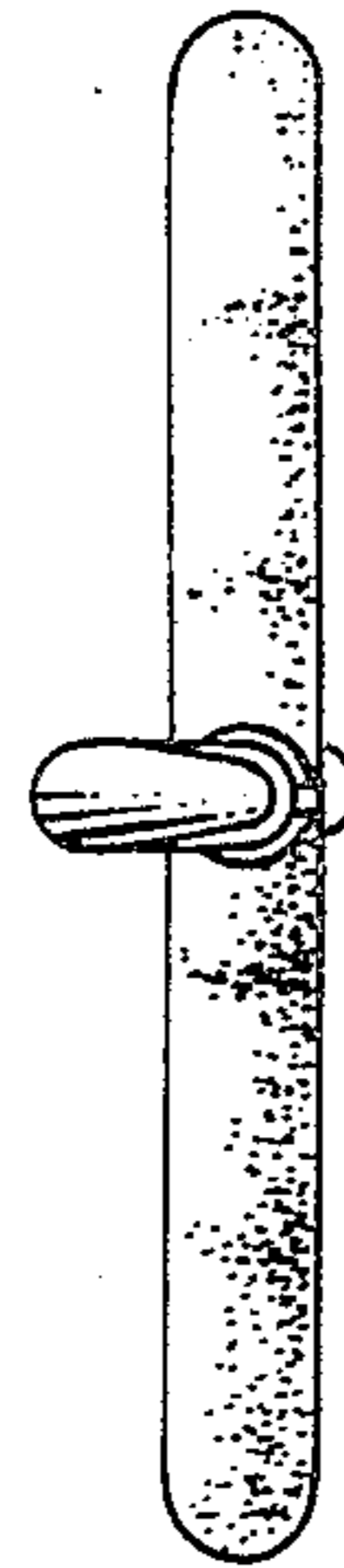

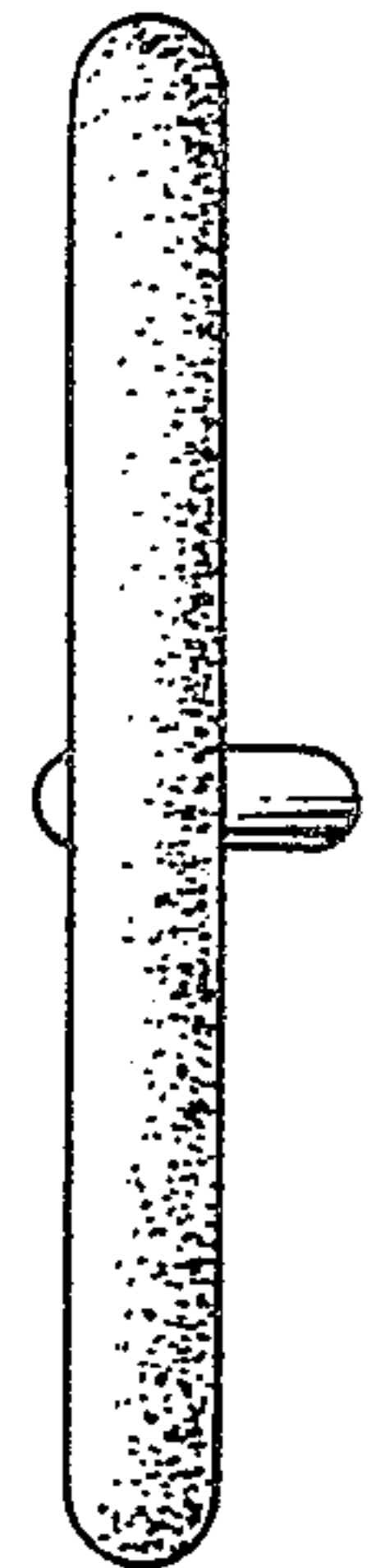

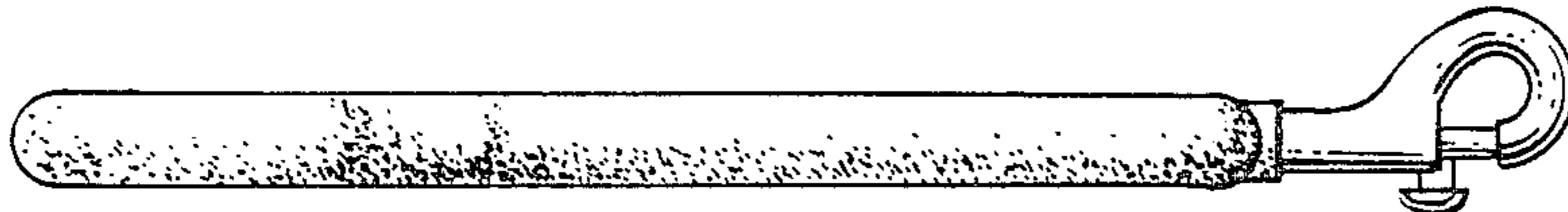
