[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a soft-sided tote bag, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a soft-sided tote bag showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the tote bag;
FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one end of the tote bag;
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the other end of the tote bag;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the tote bag; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the tote bag.

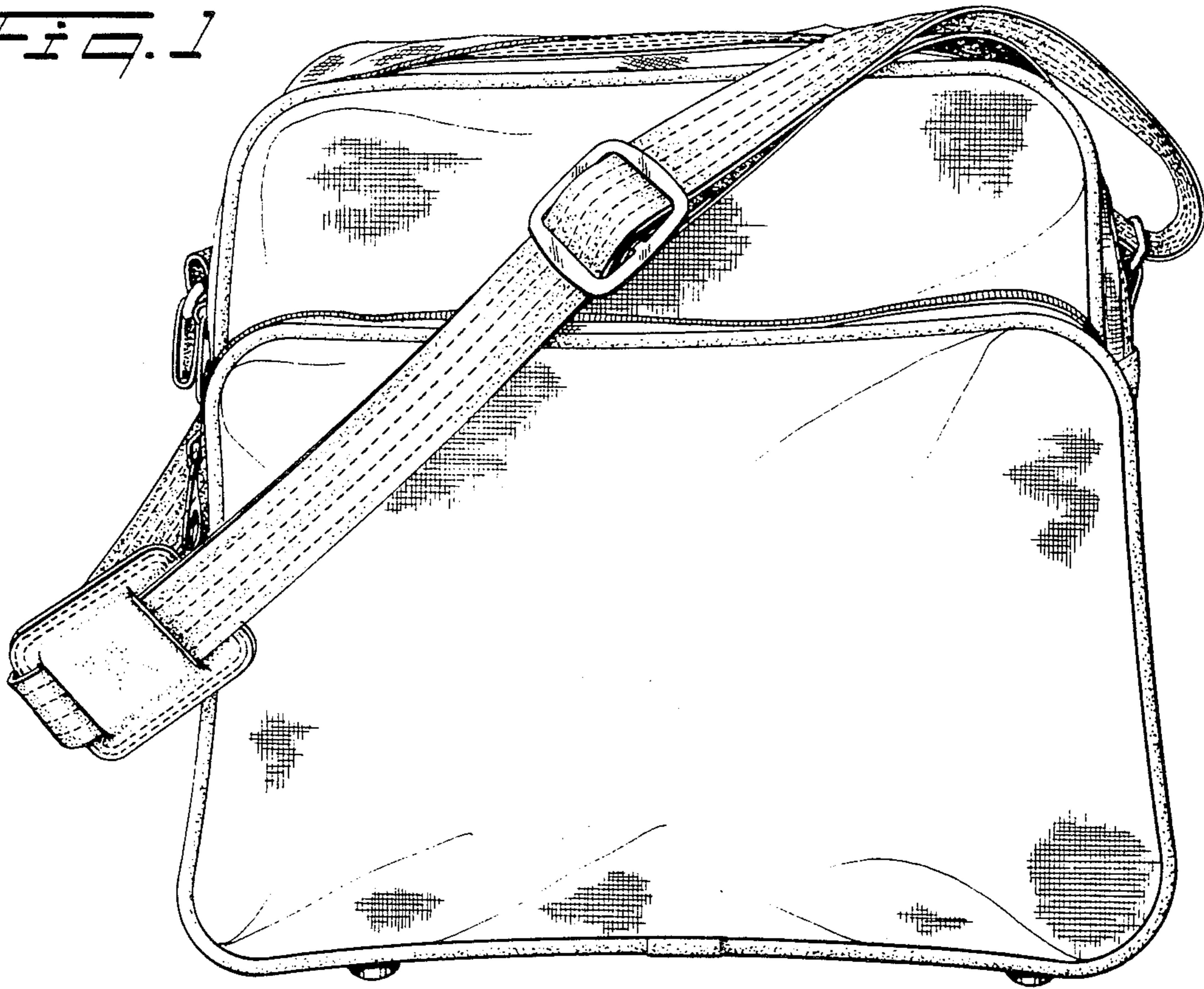

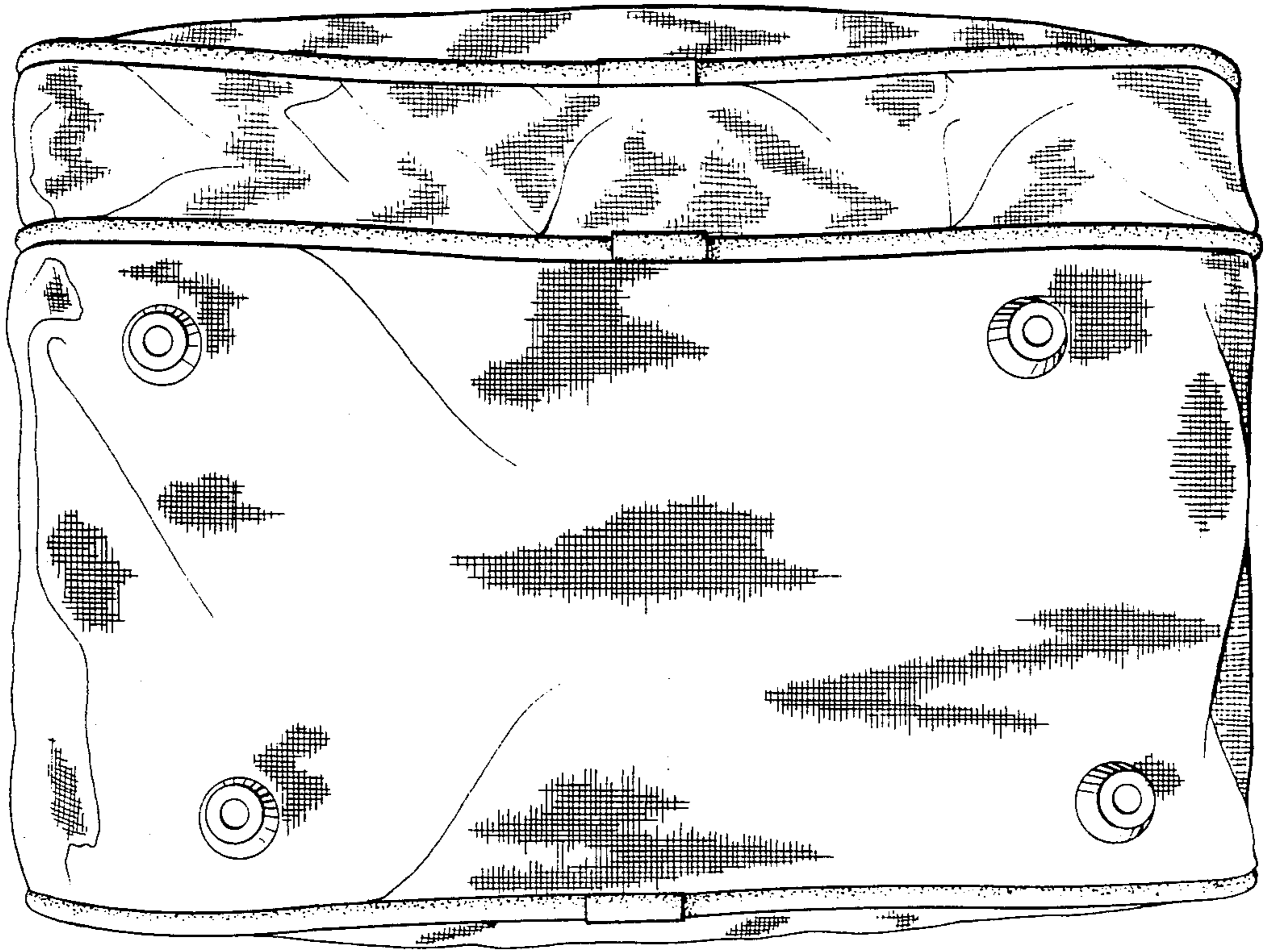
