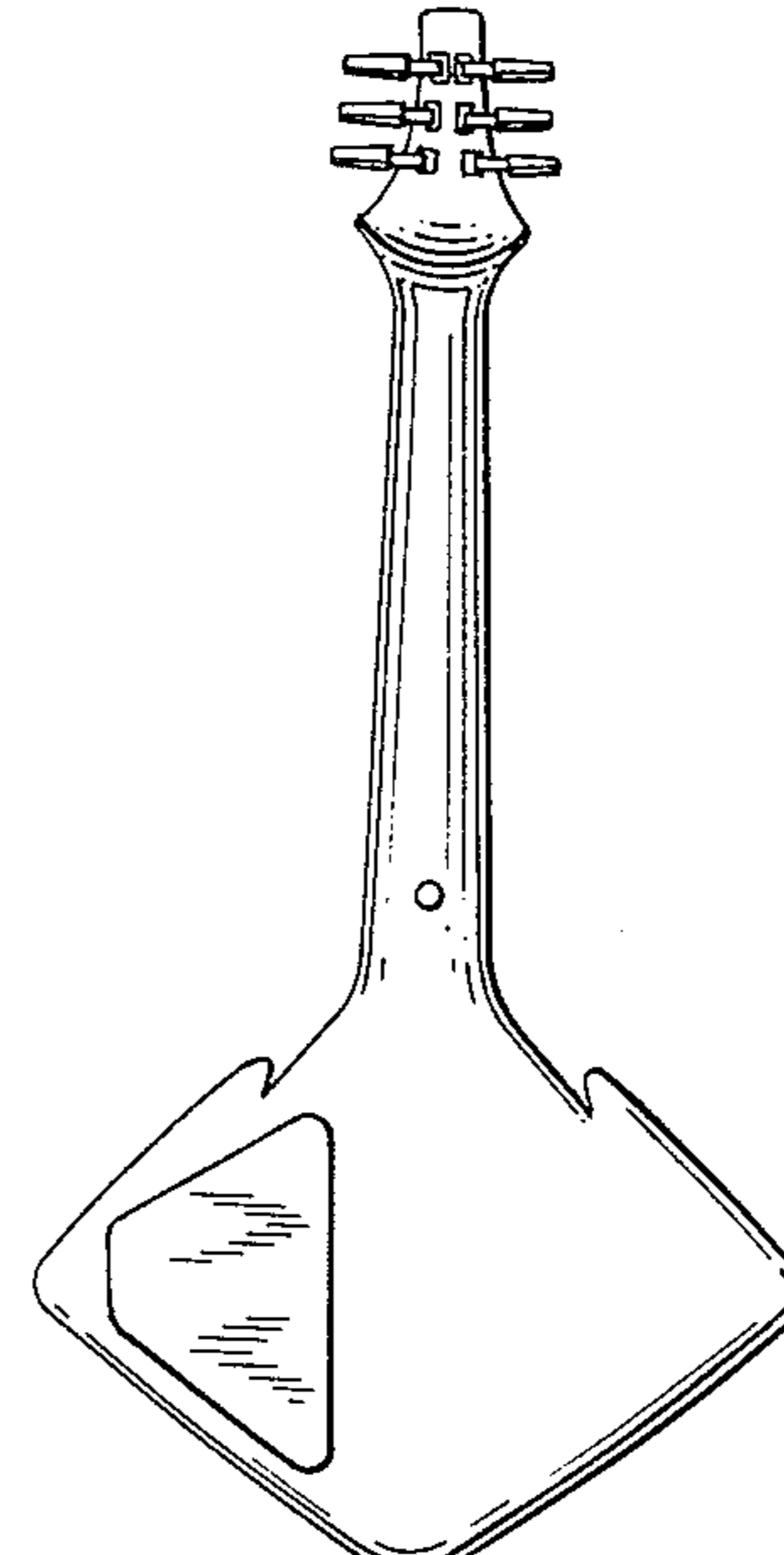
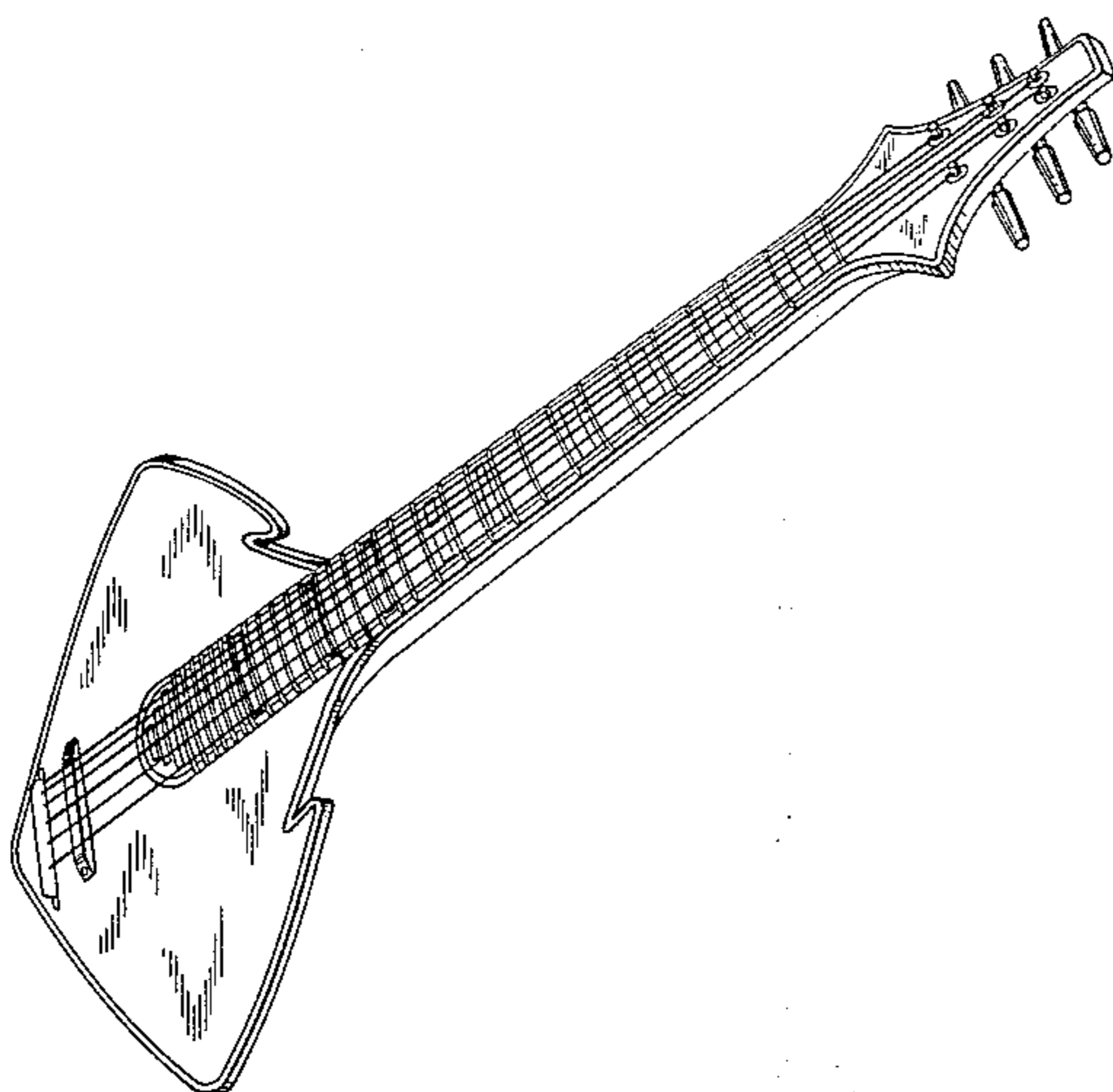

The ornamental design for a guitar or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a guitar or similar article showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;  
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view with pickups and controls added;  
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;  
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view;  
 FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view; and  
 FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view of the neck.



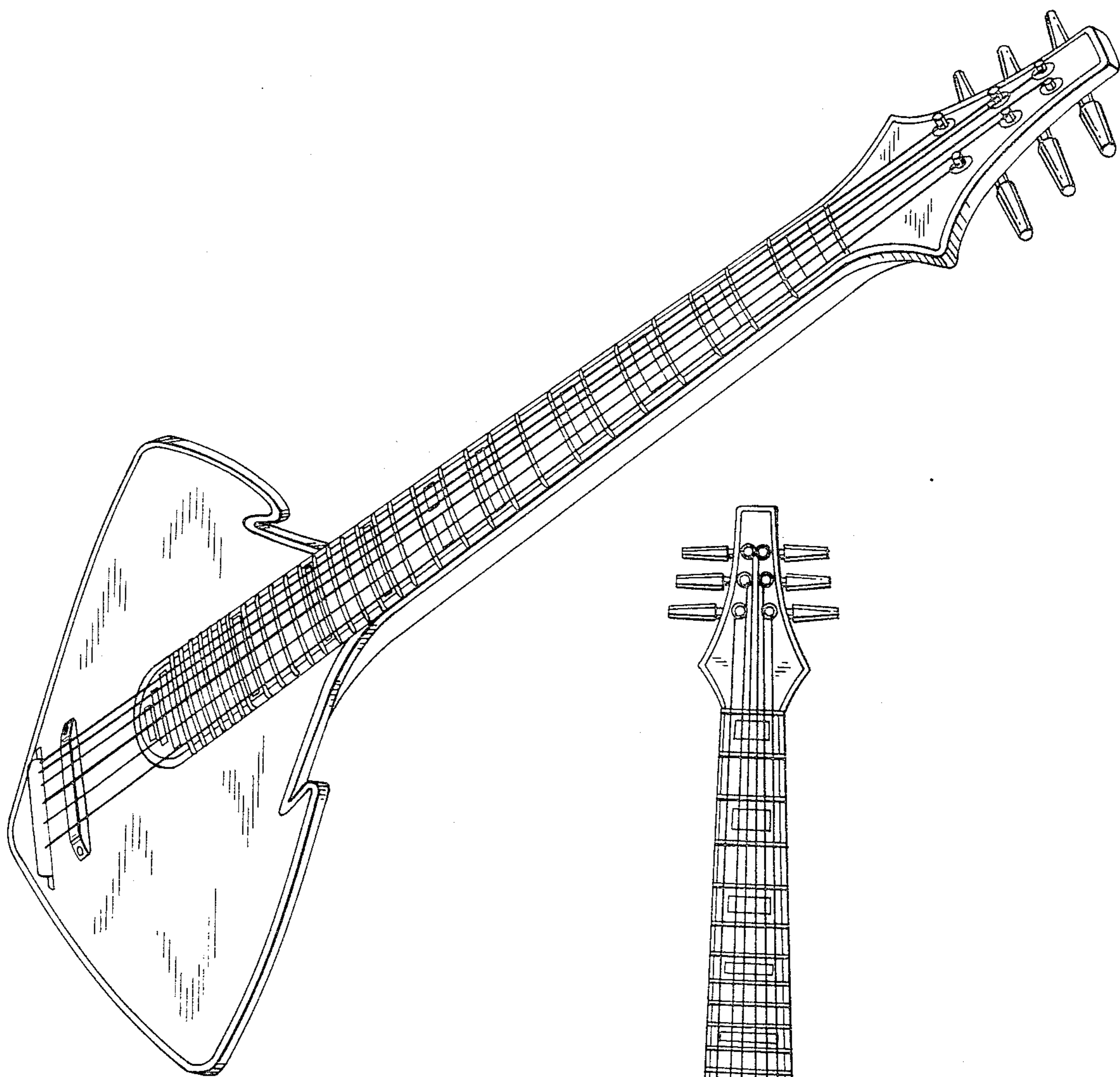

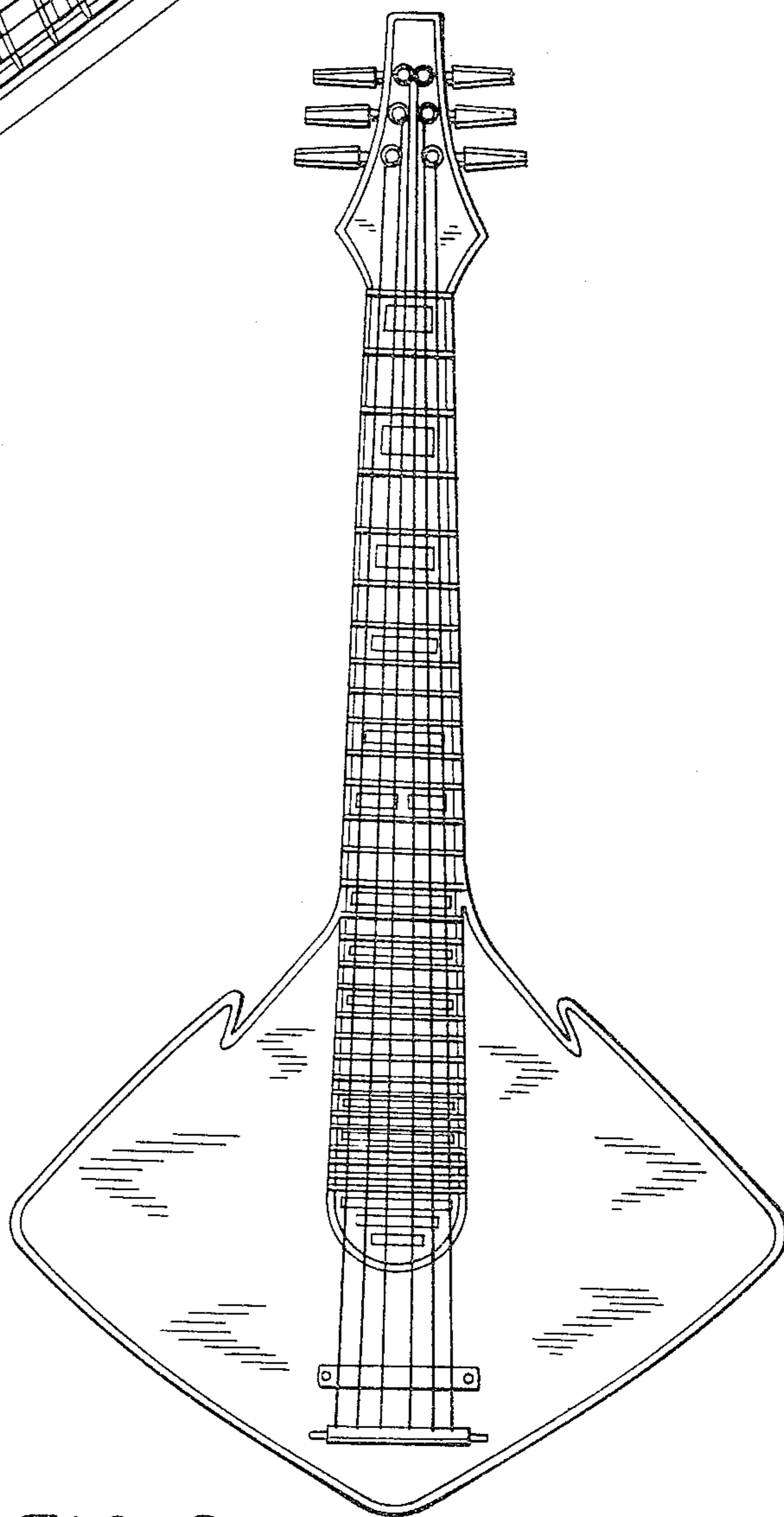

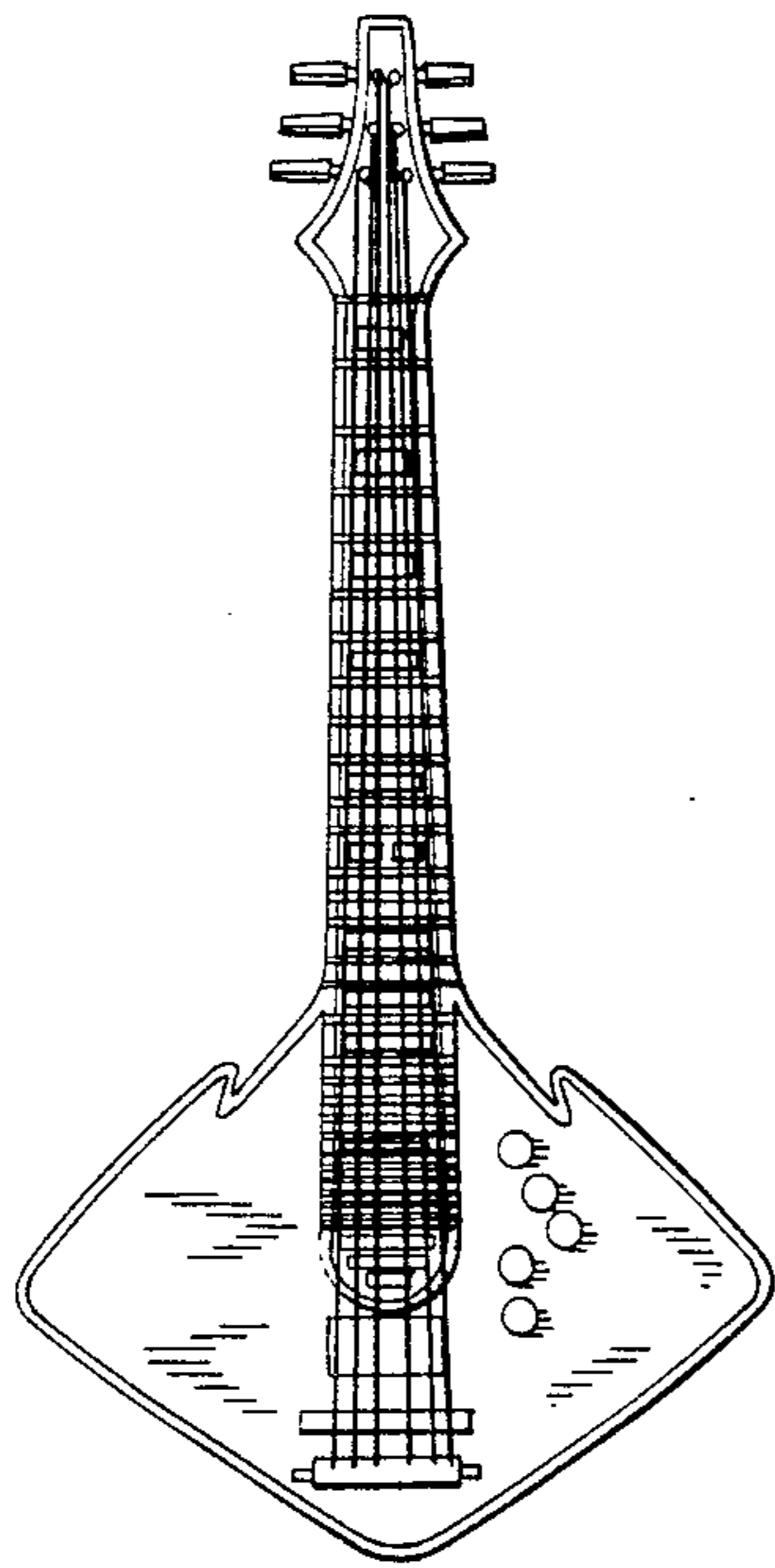

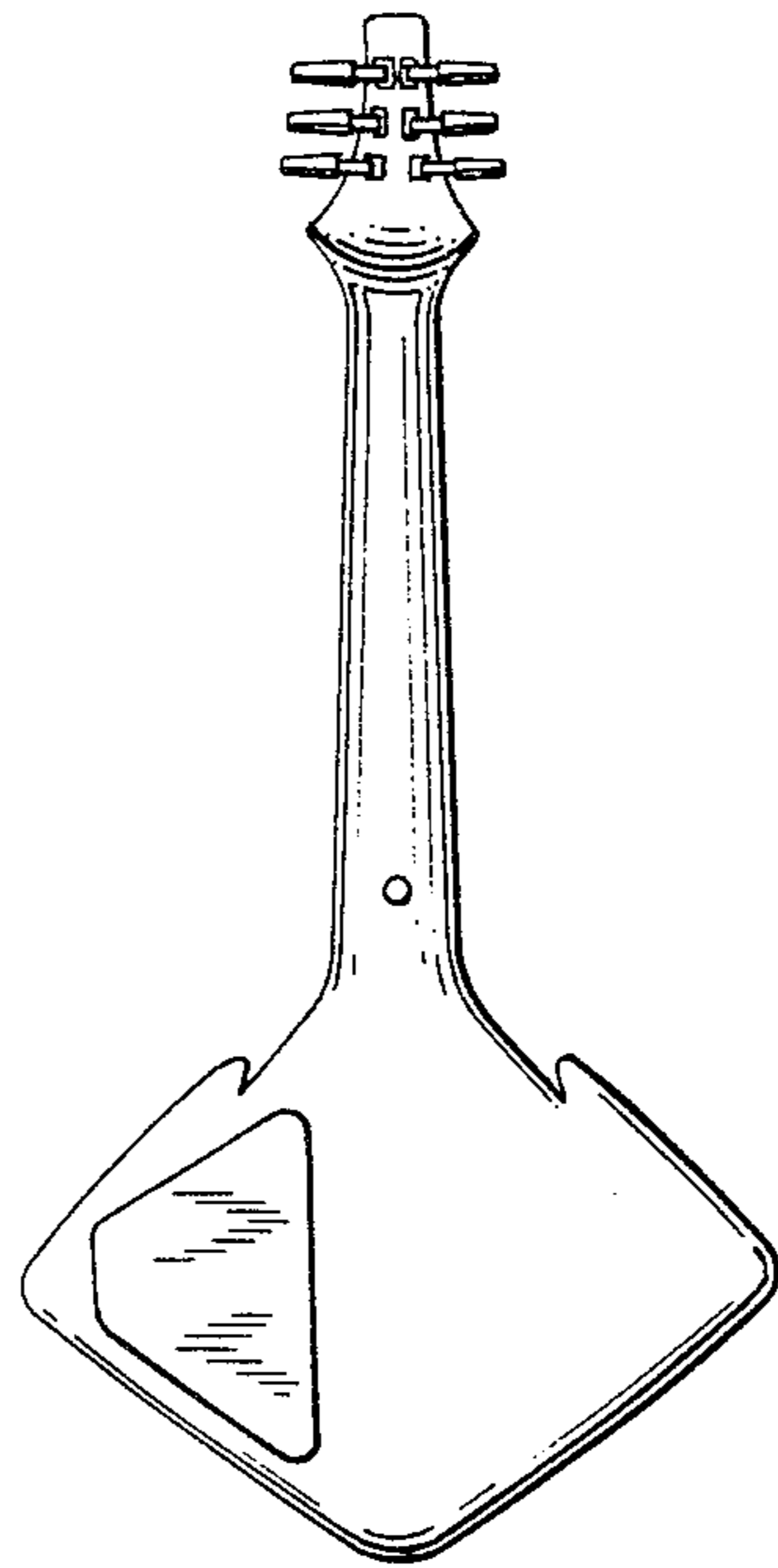

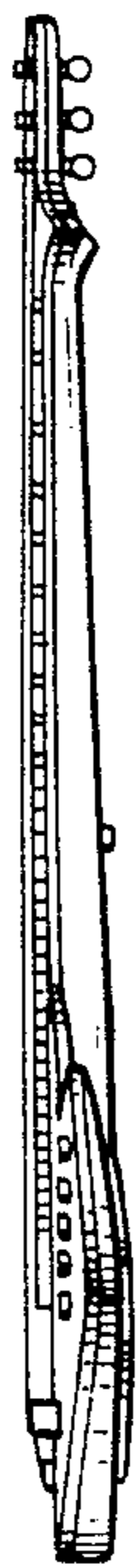

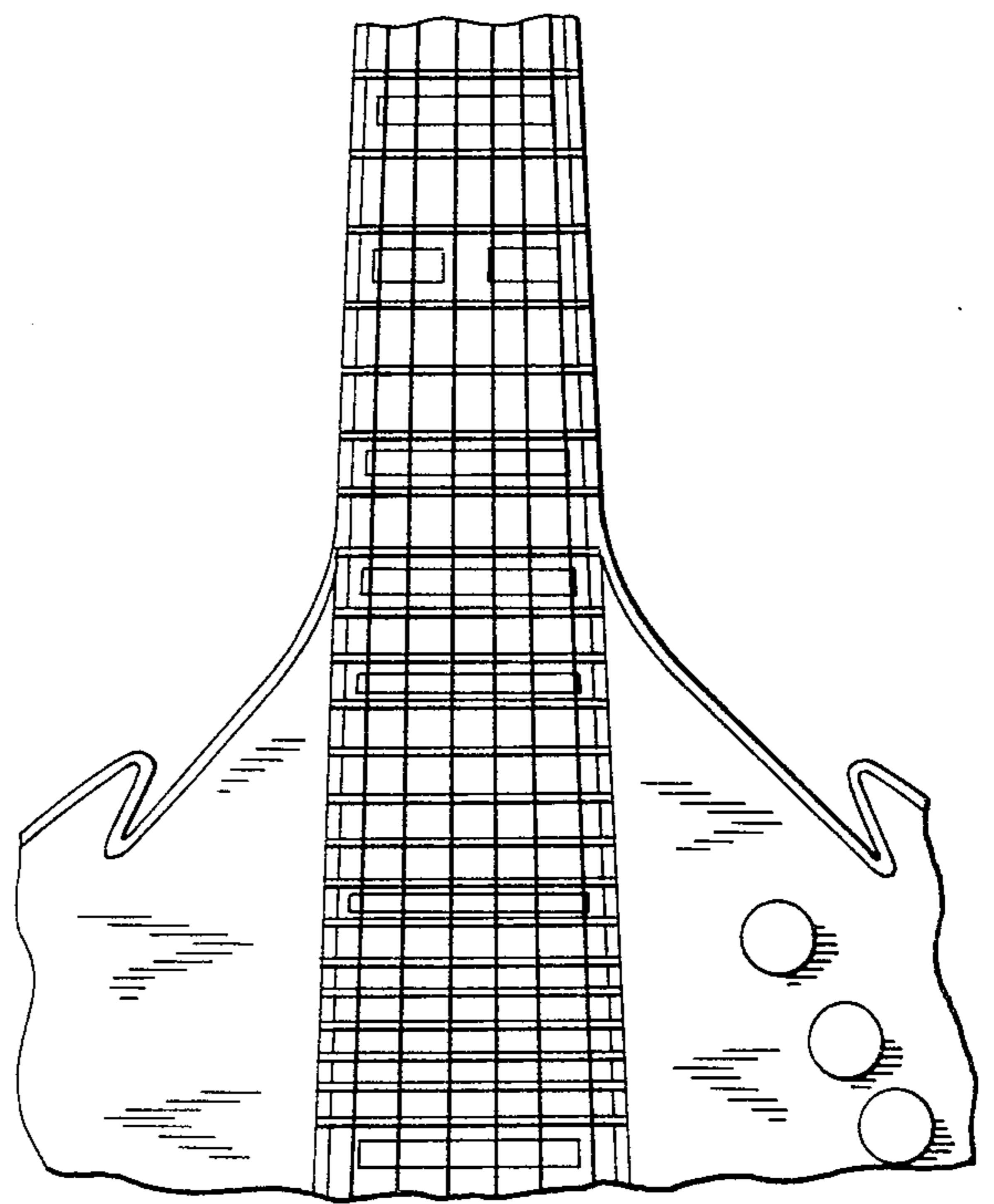
