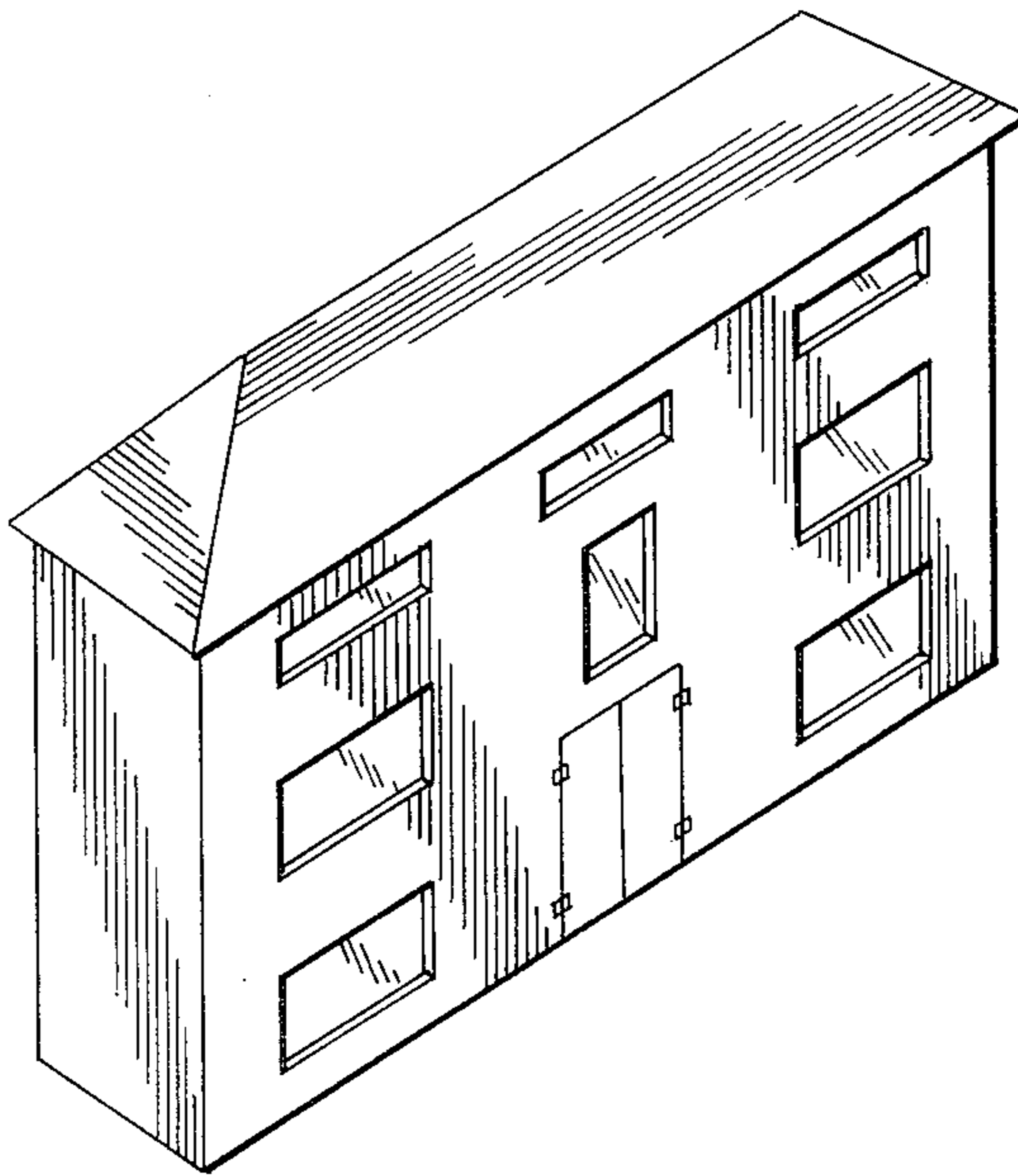

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy doll house showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



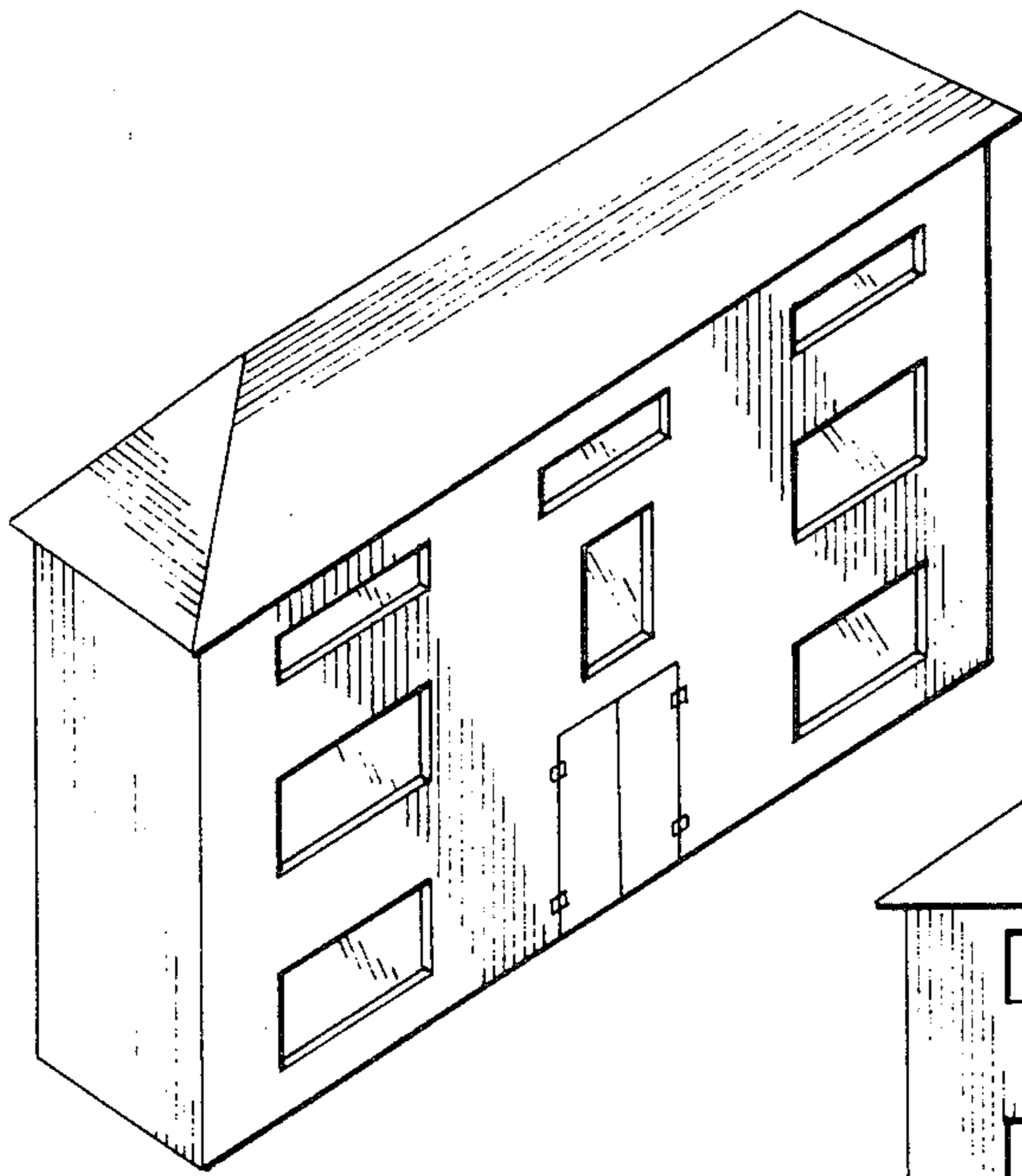

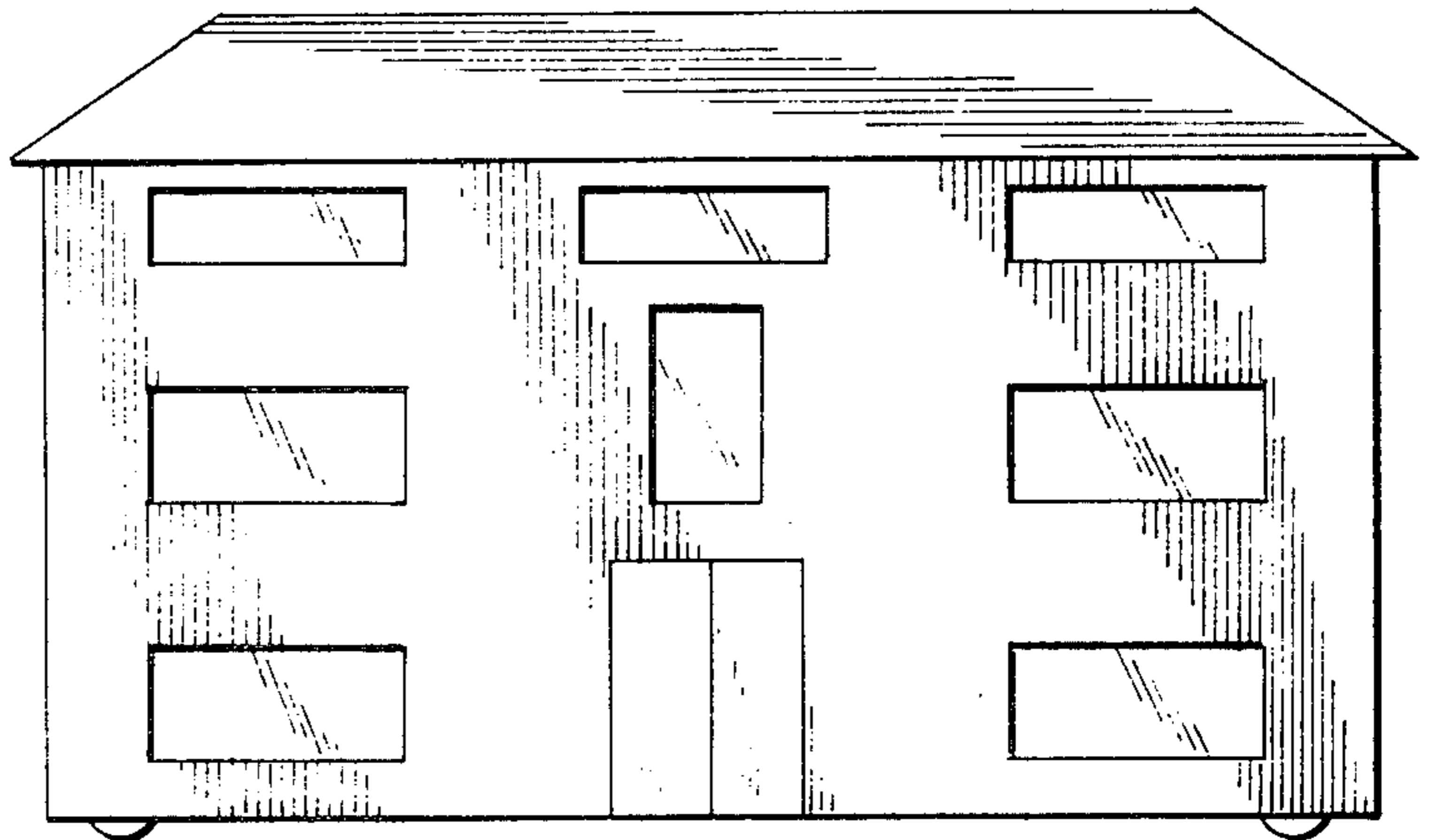

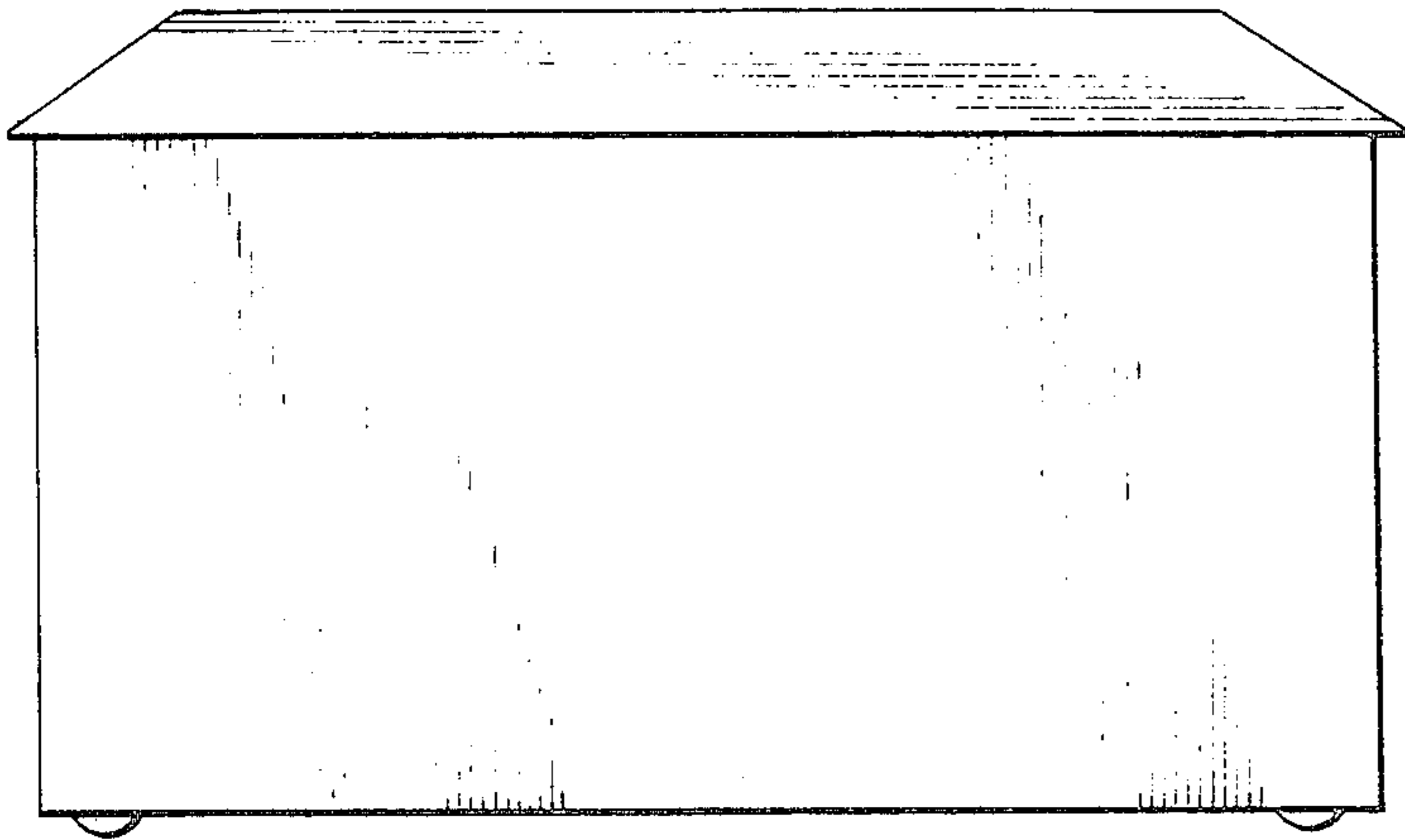

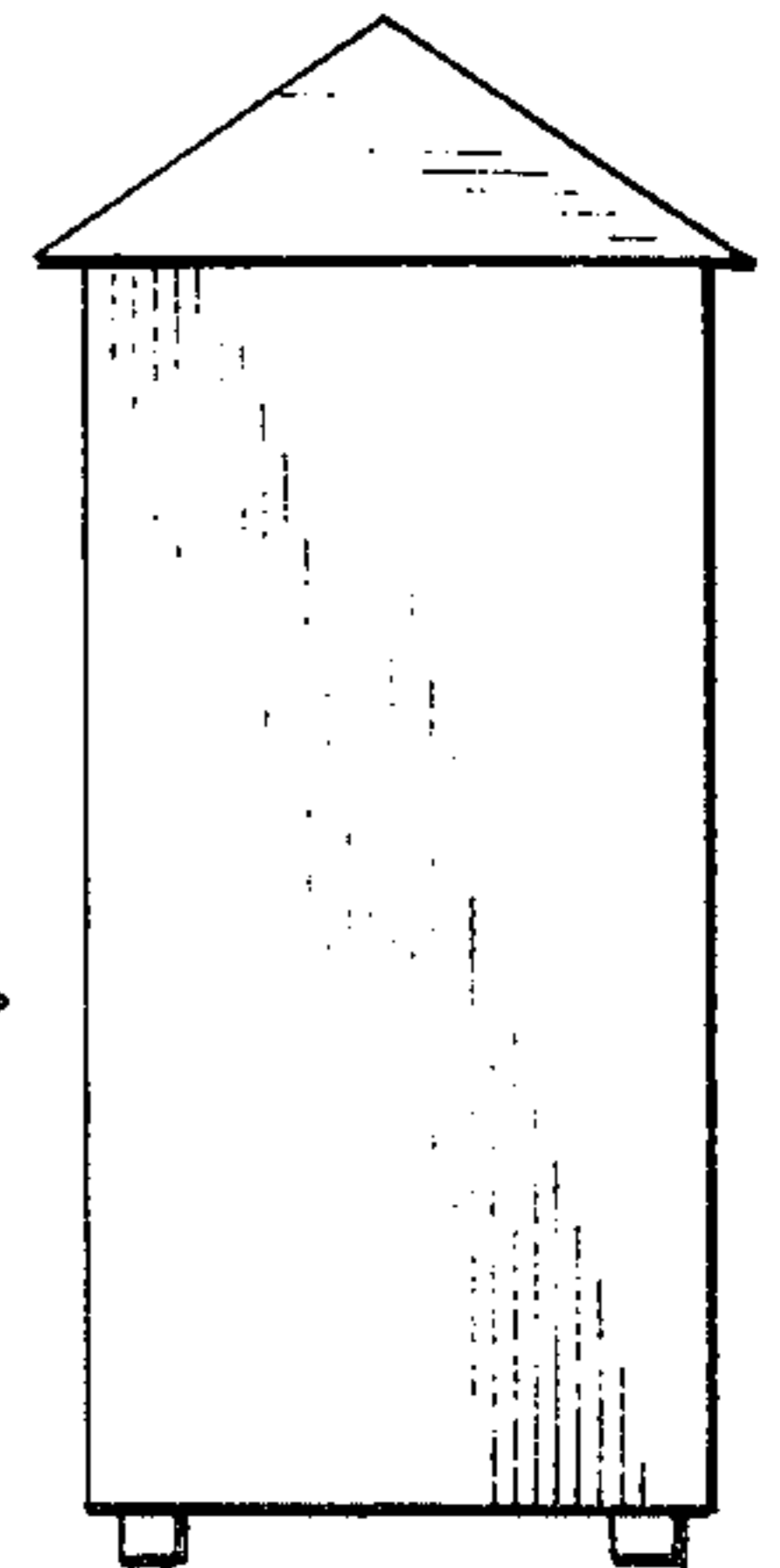

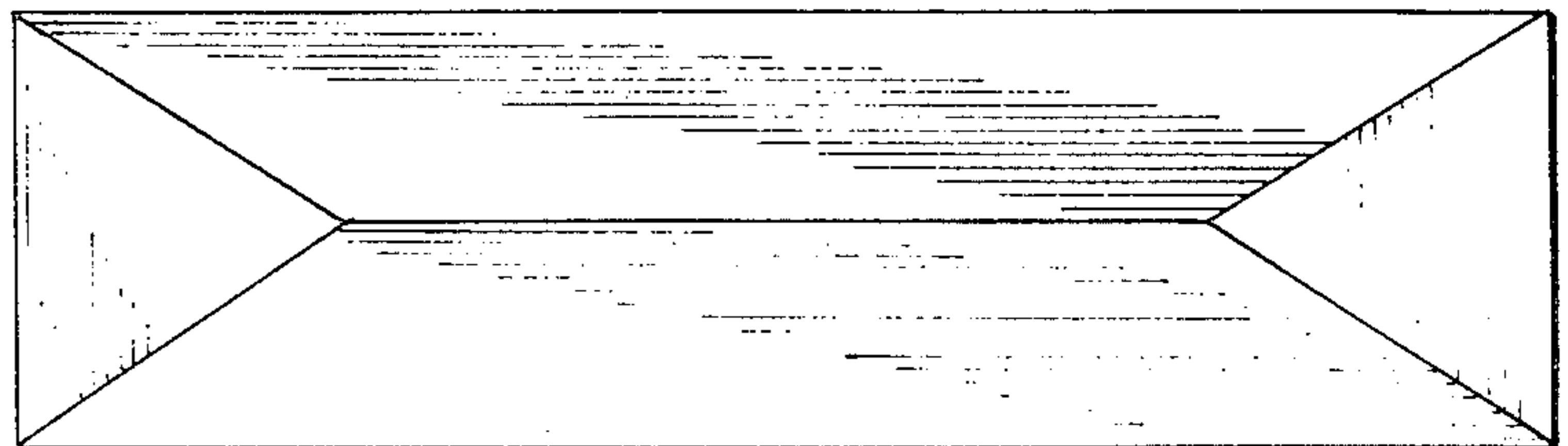

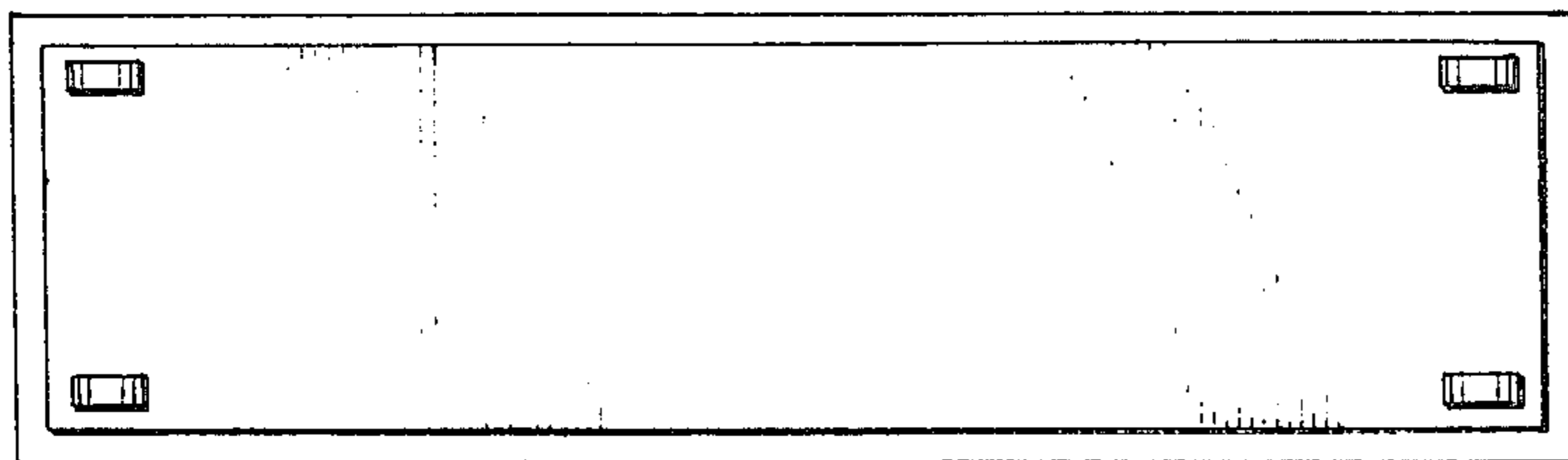
