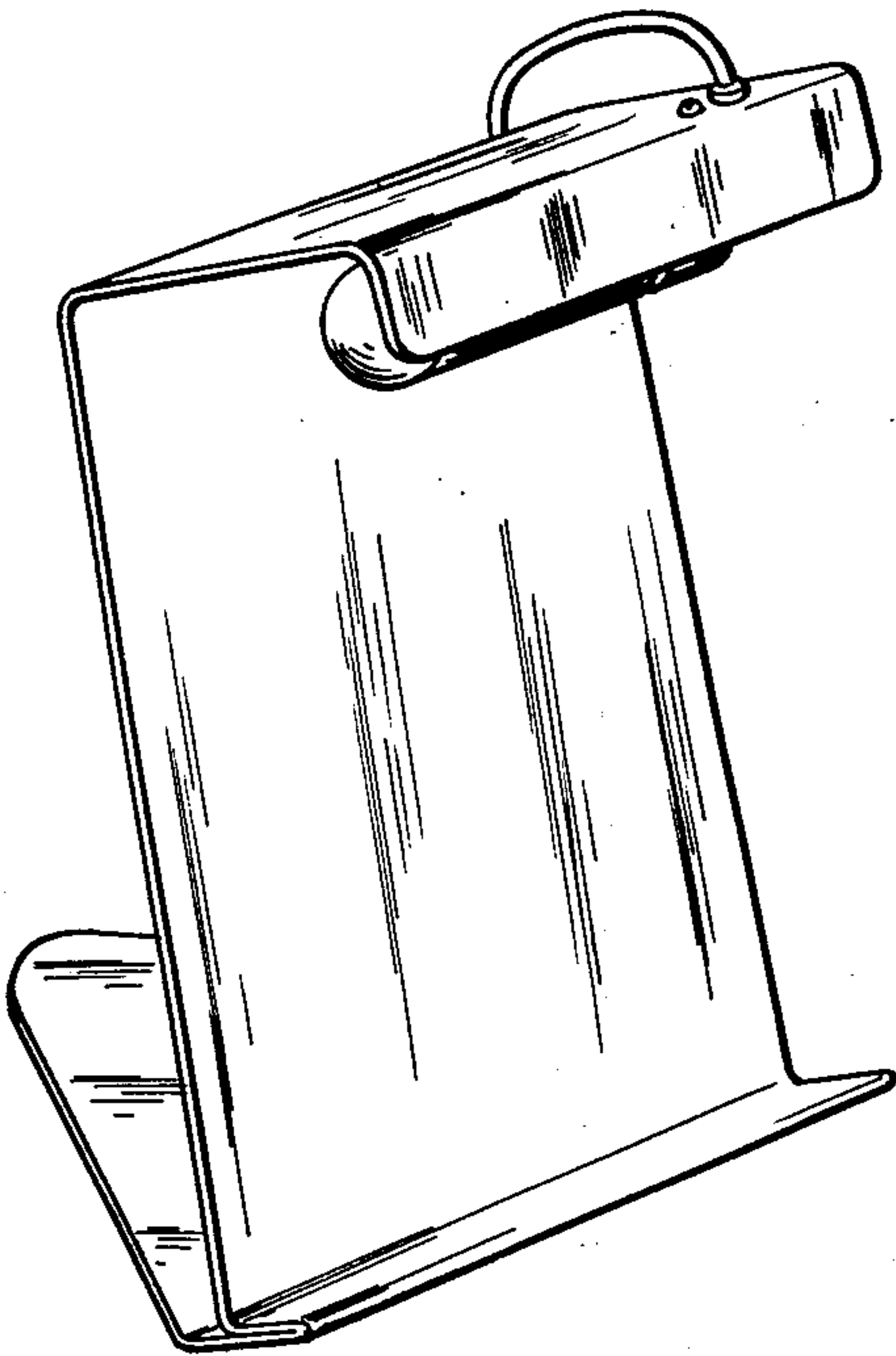

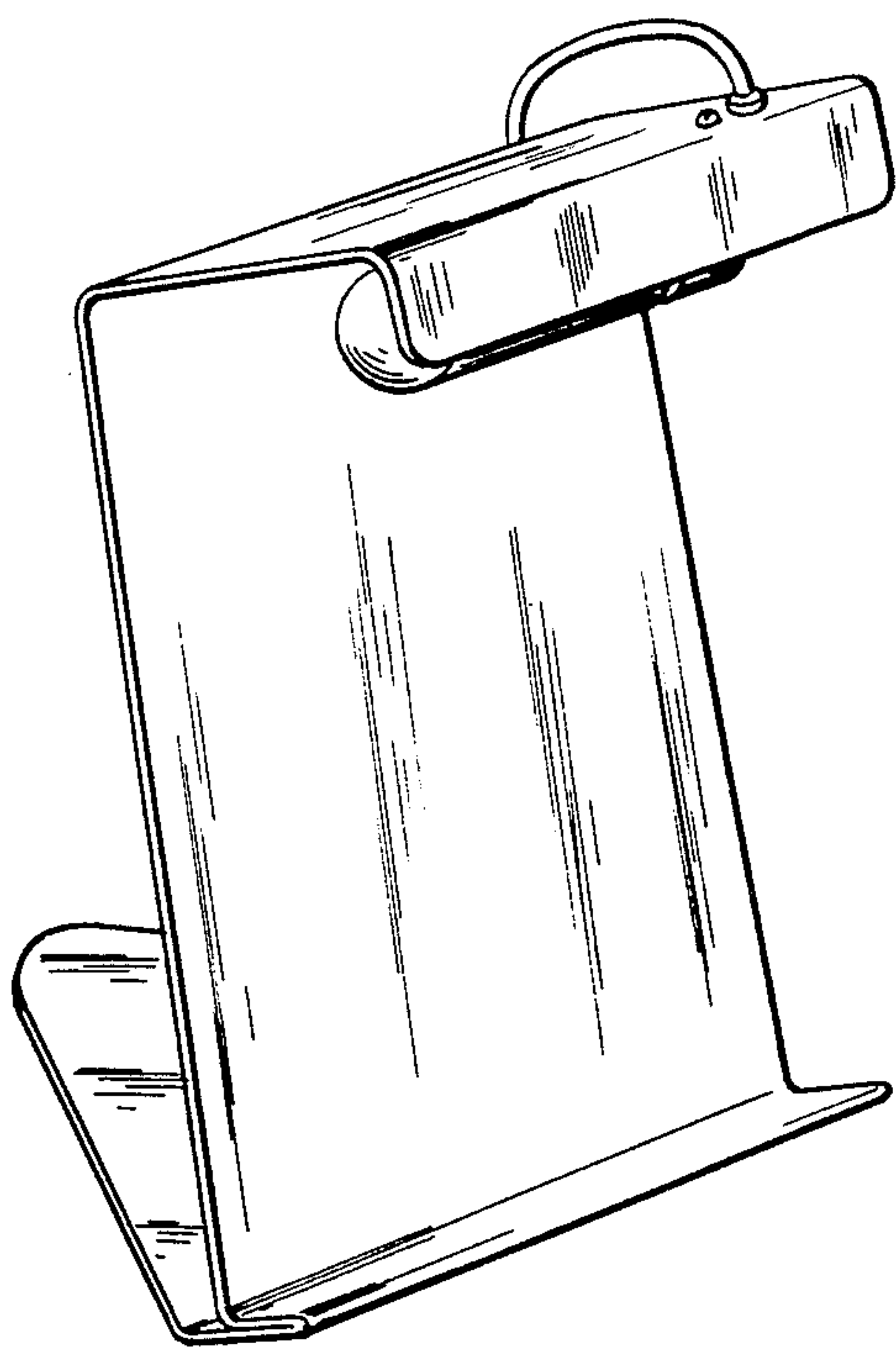
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a workstand lamp, as shown and described.

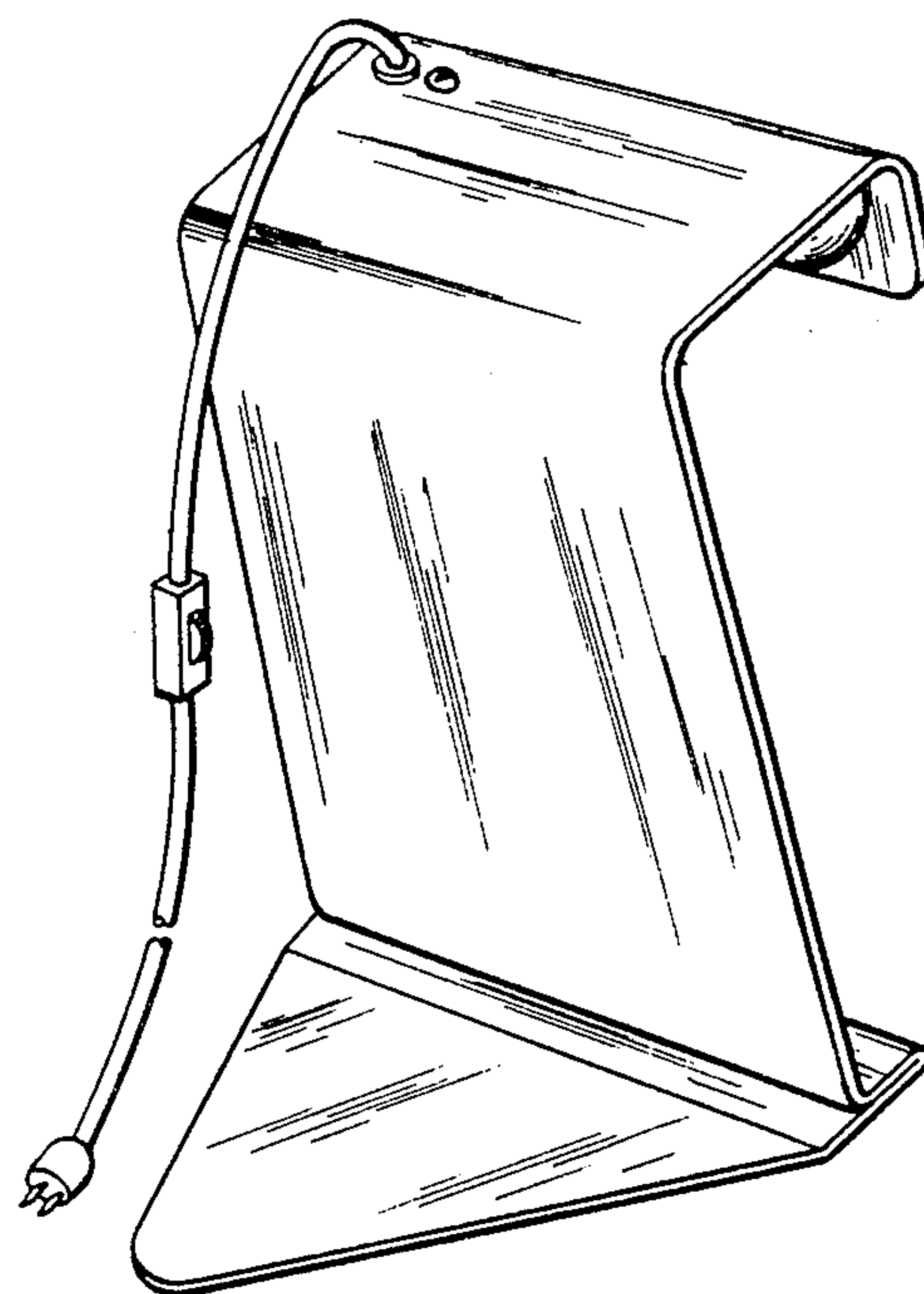
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being identical.

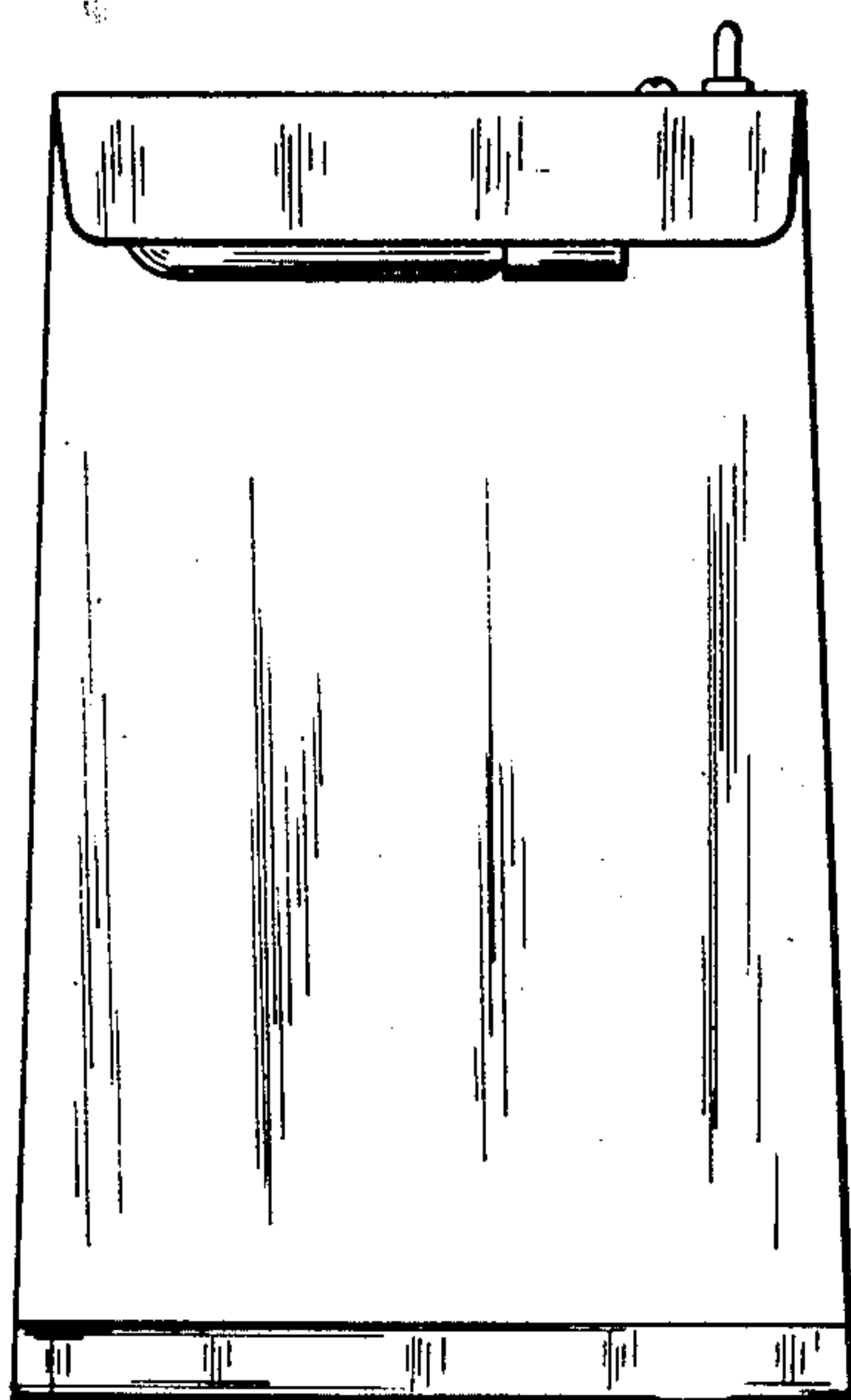




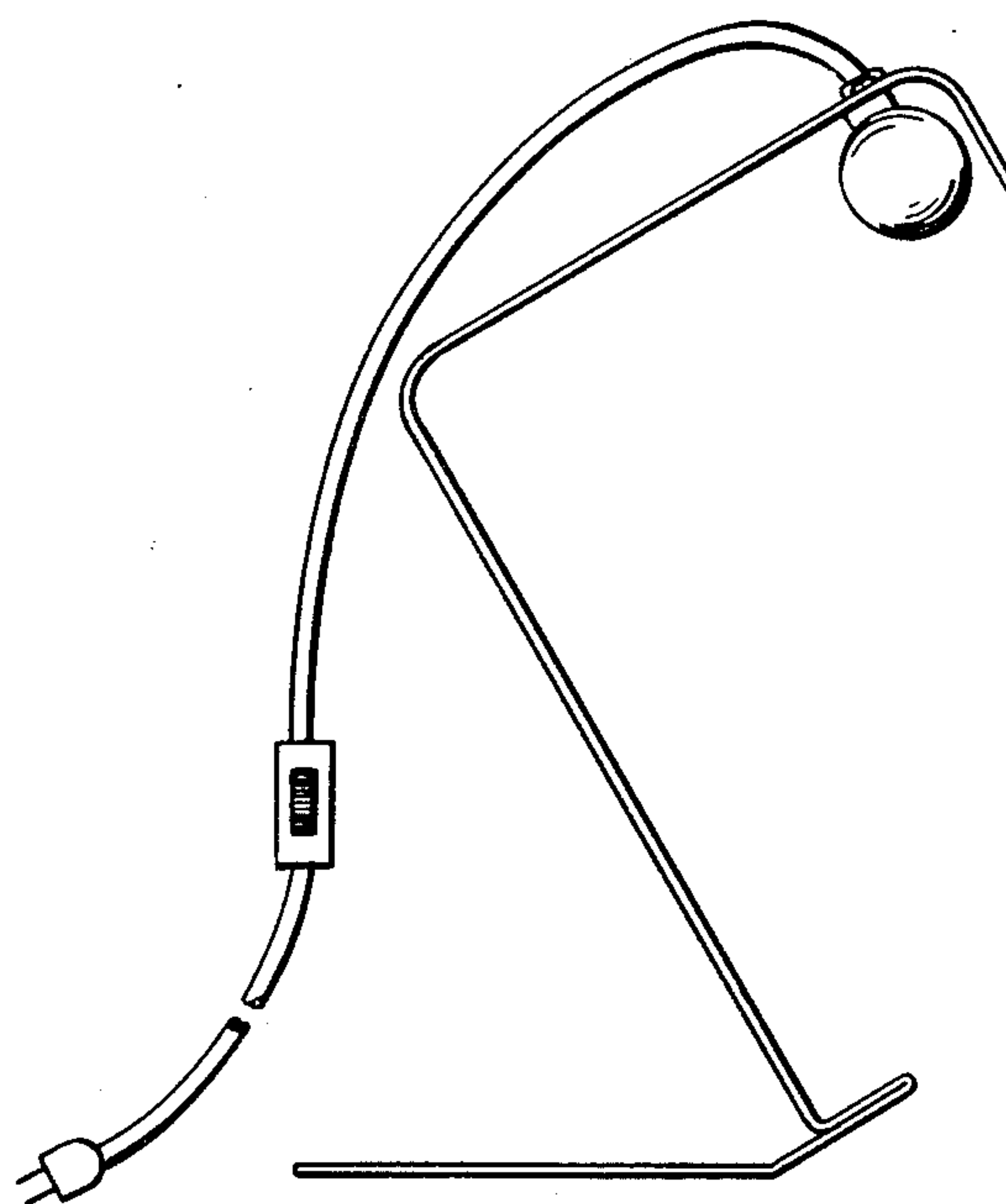
