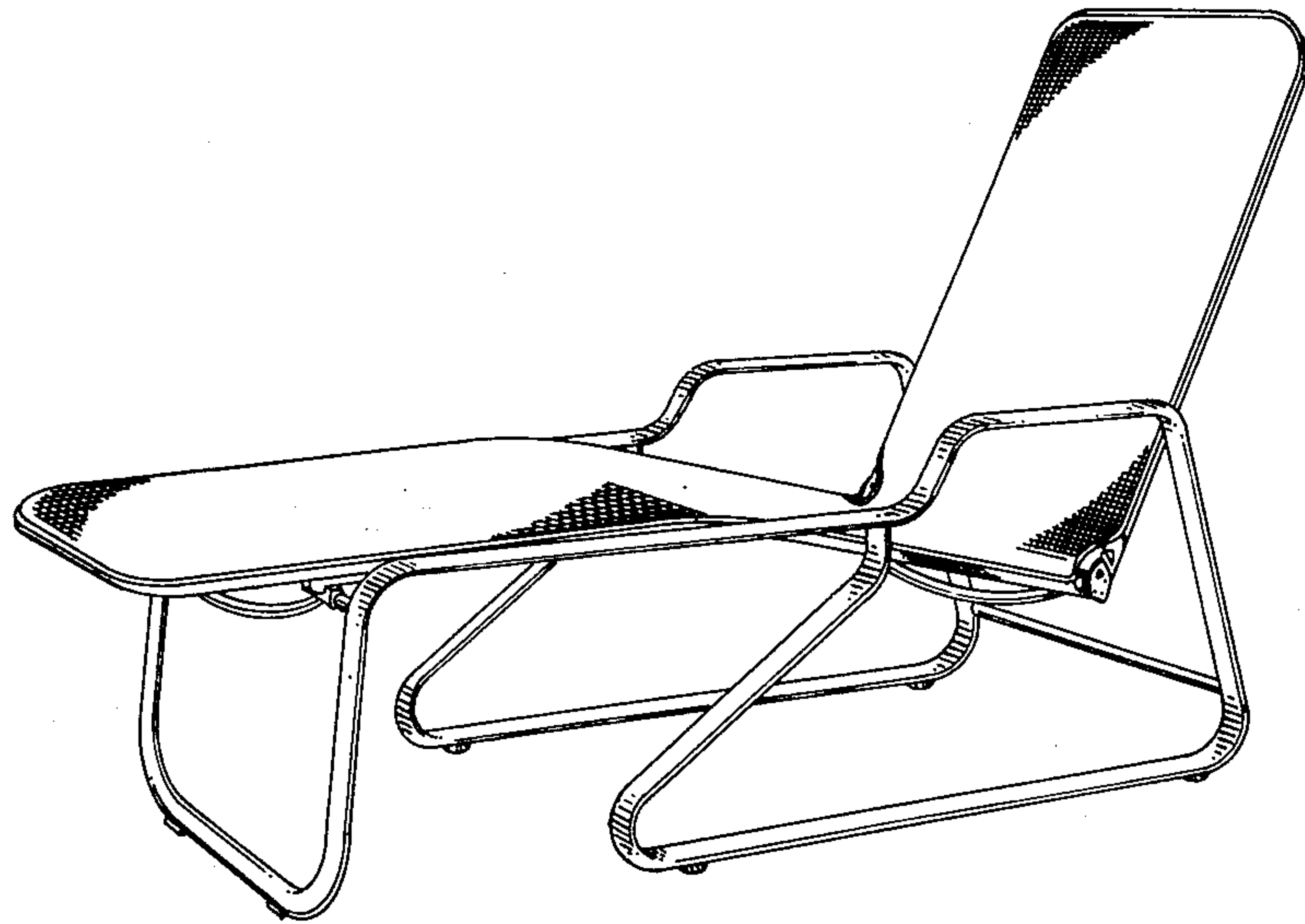

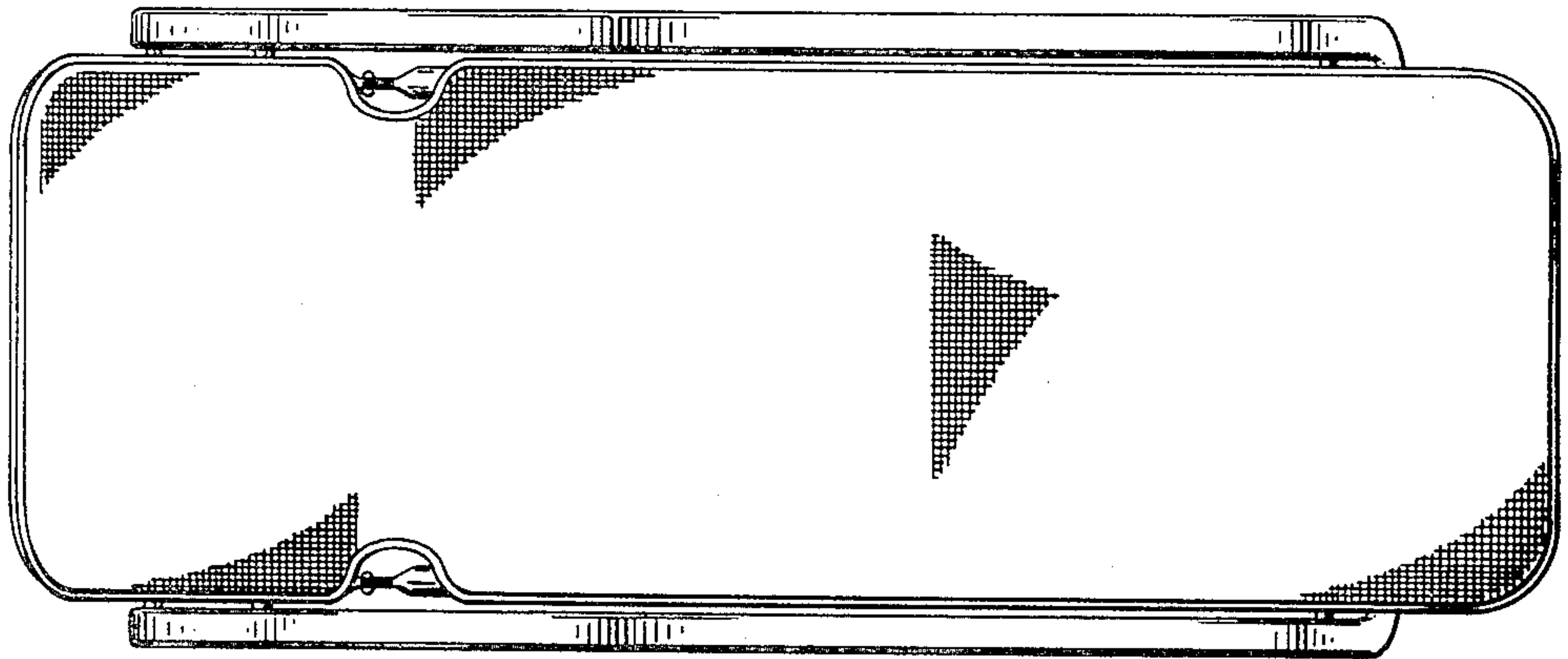
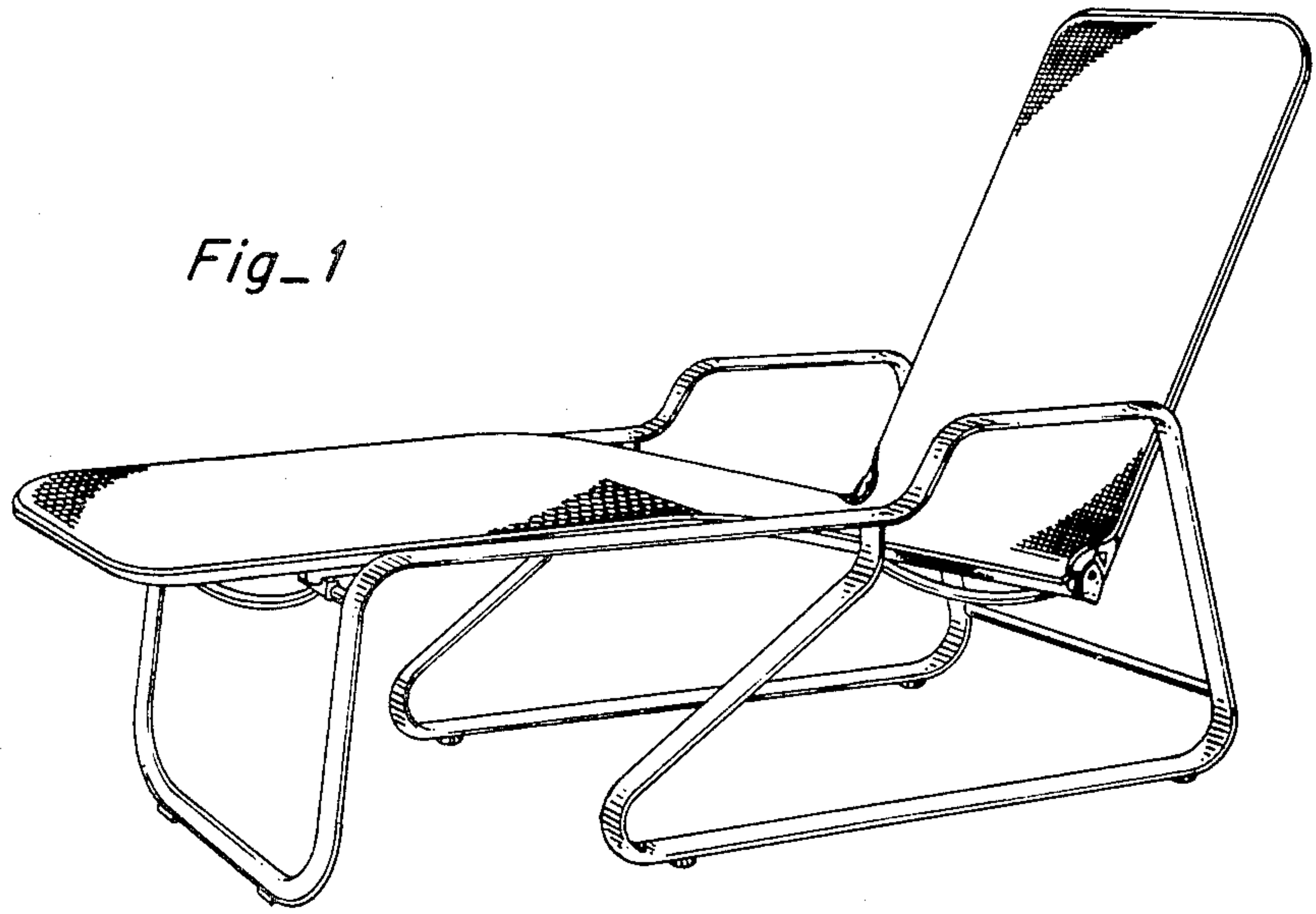
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chaise lounge, as shown and described.

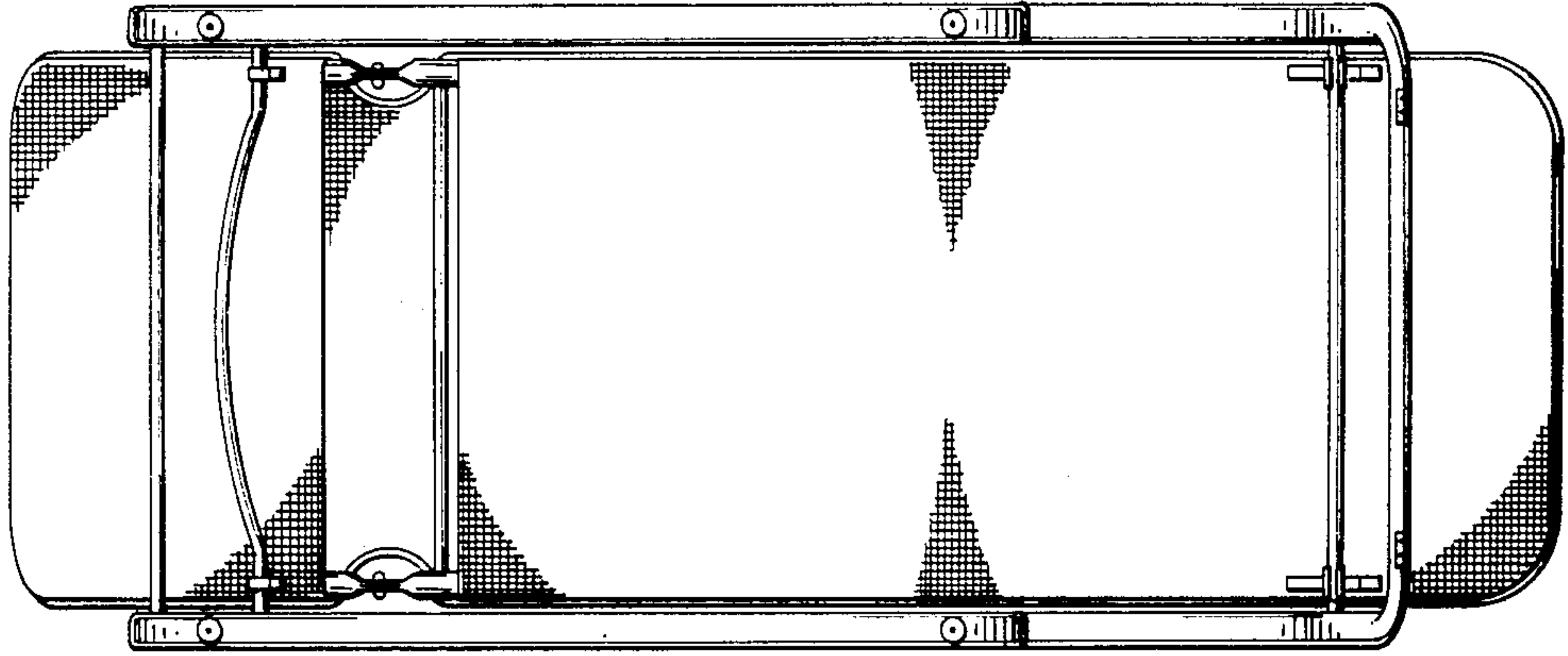
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chaise lounge showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second chaise lounge showing my new design;
 FIG. 8 is a top plan view of said second chaise lounge;
 FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of said second chaise lounge;
 FIG. 10 is a left end elevational view of said second chaise lounge, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of said second chaise lounge; and
 FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of said second chaise lounge.

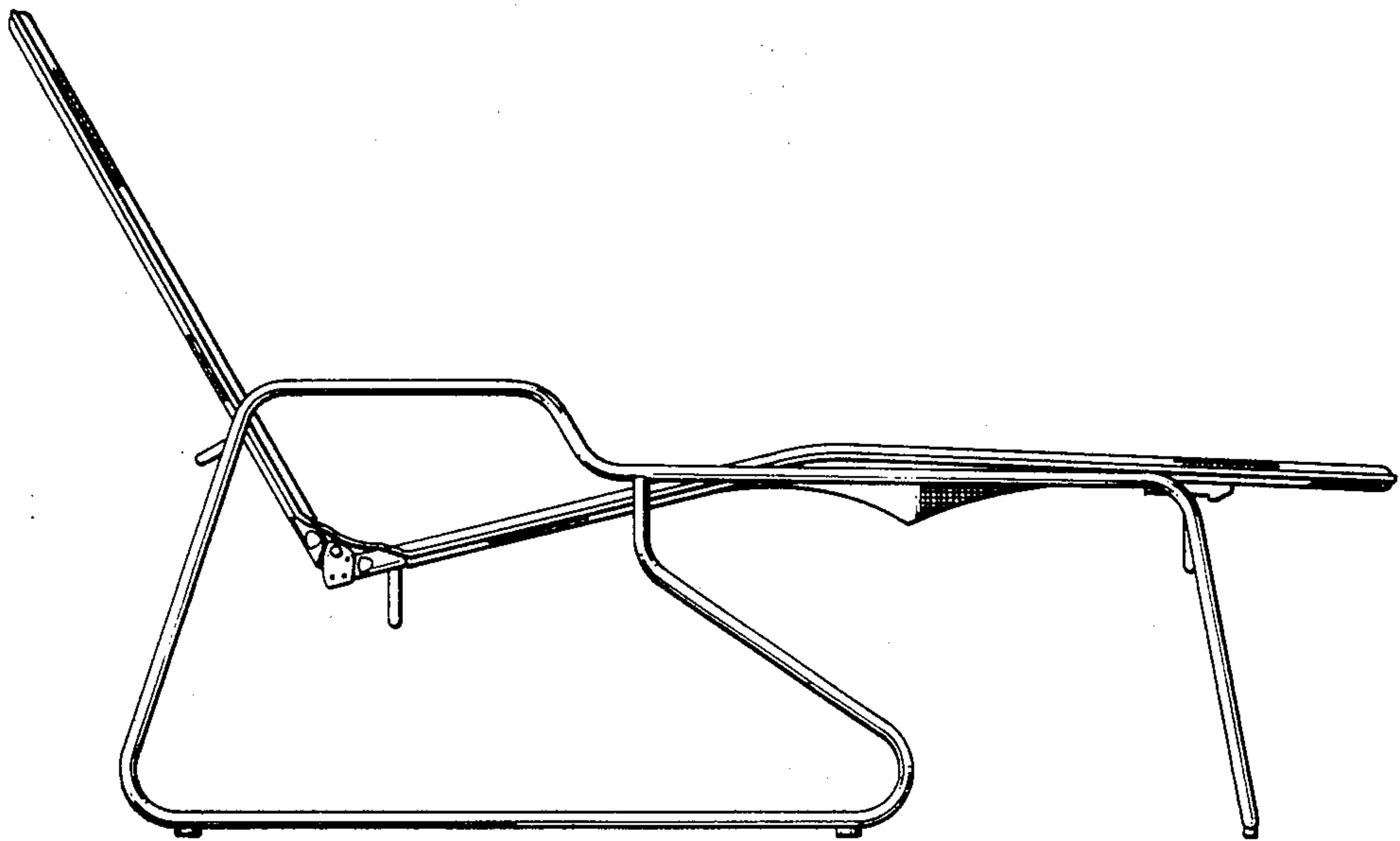

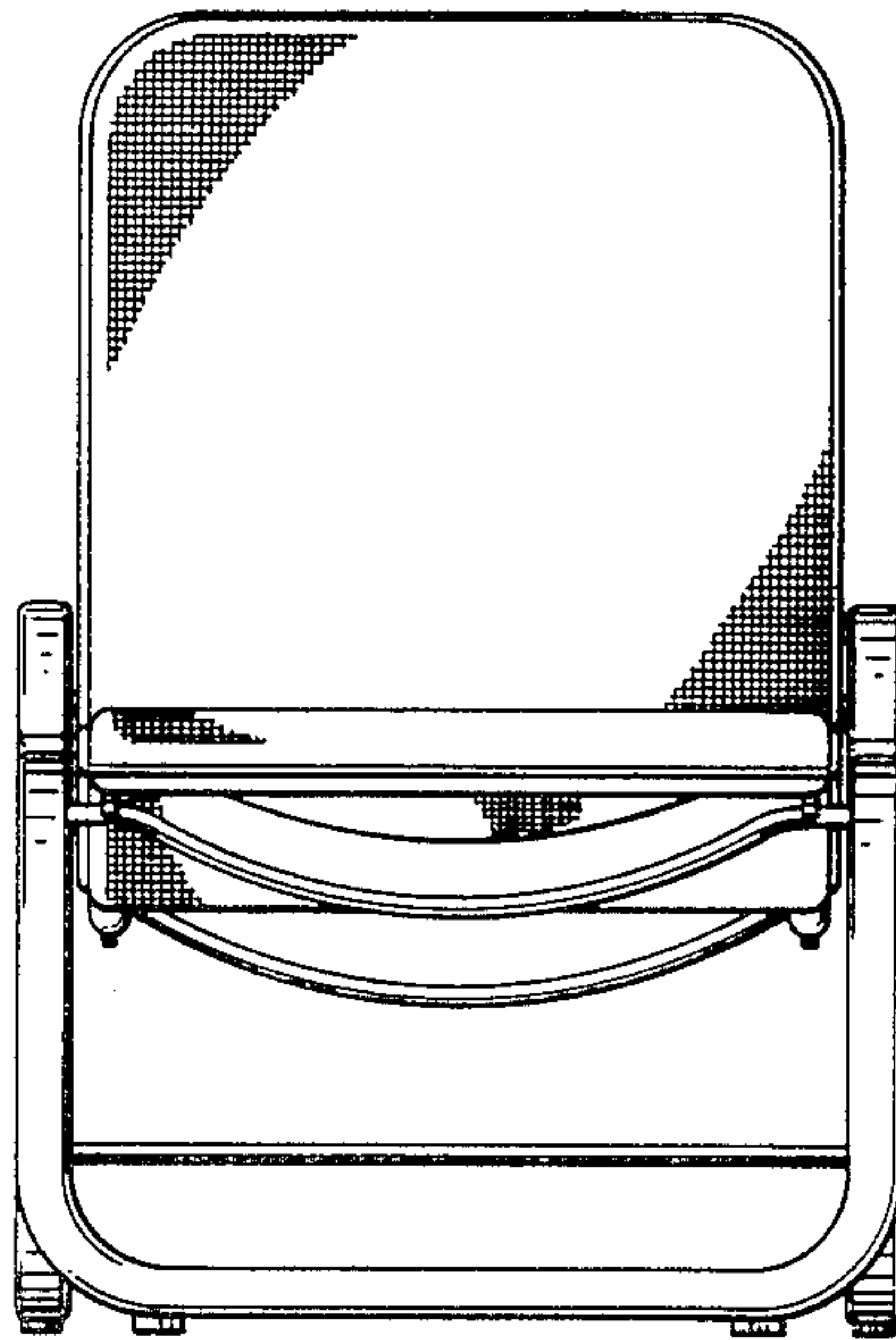

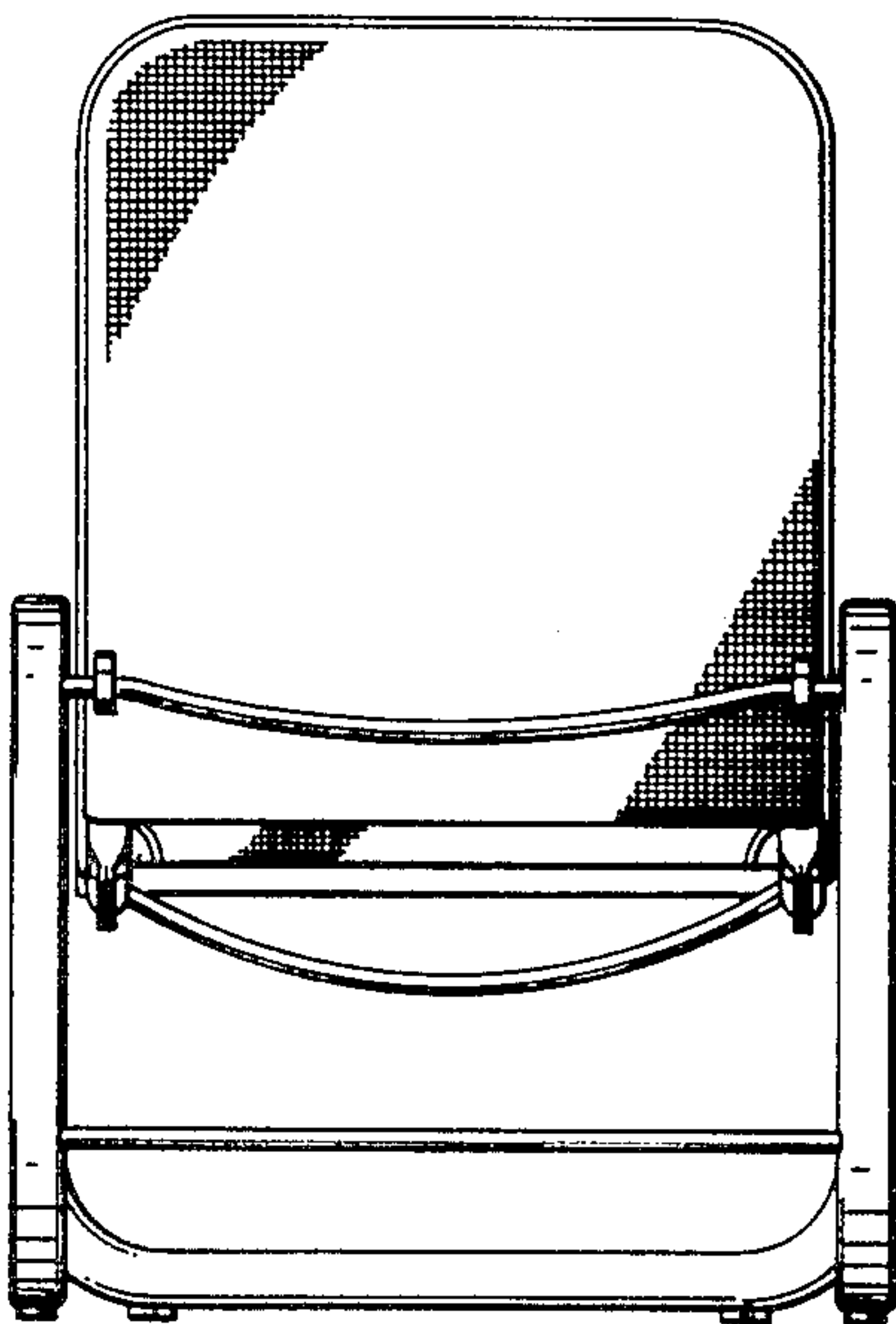

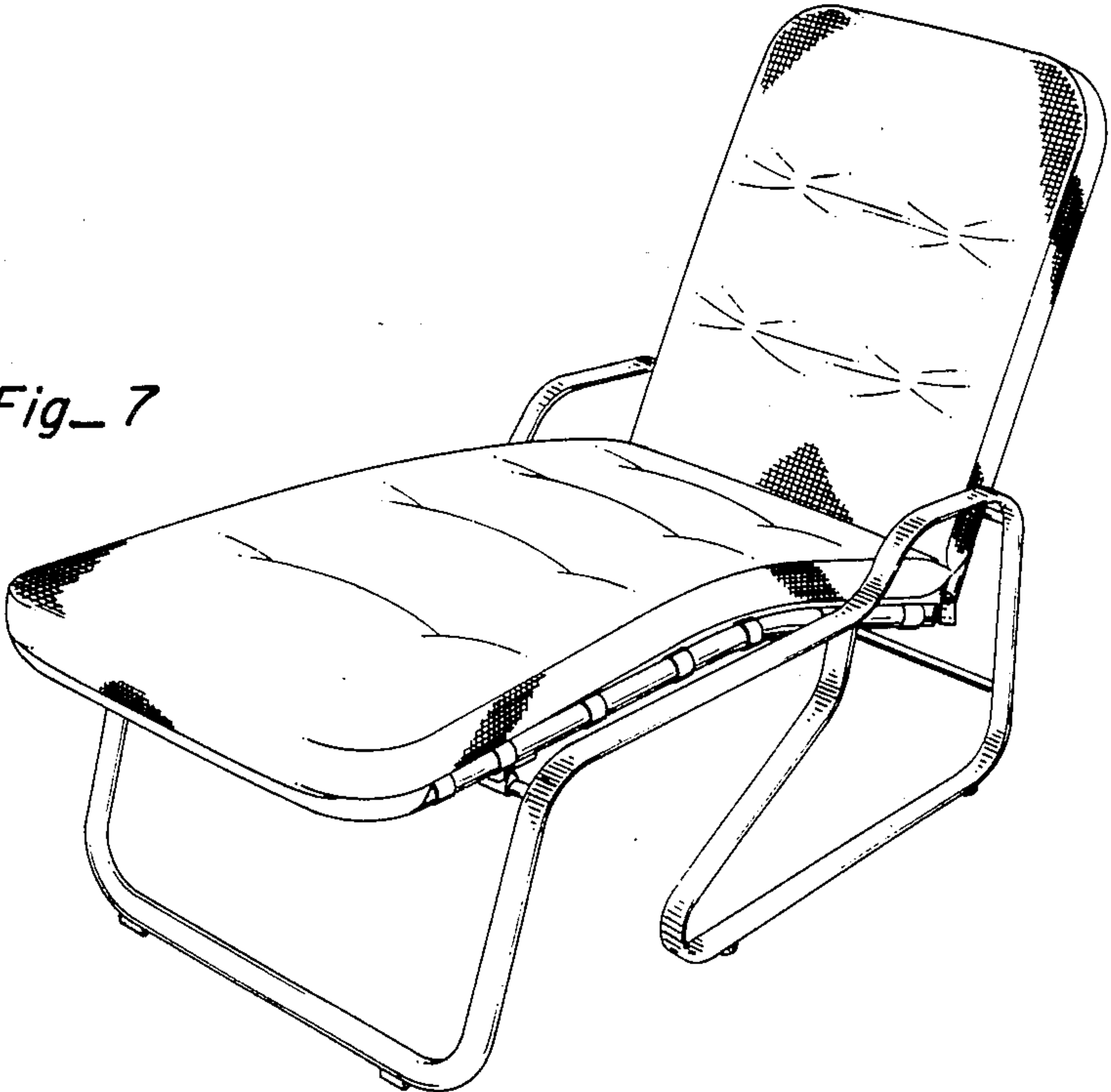

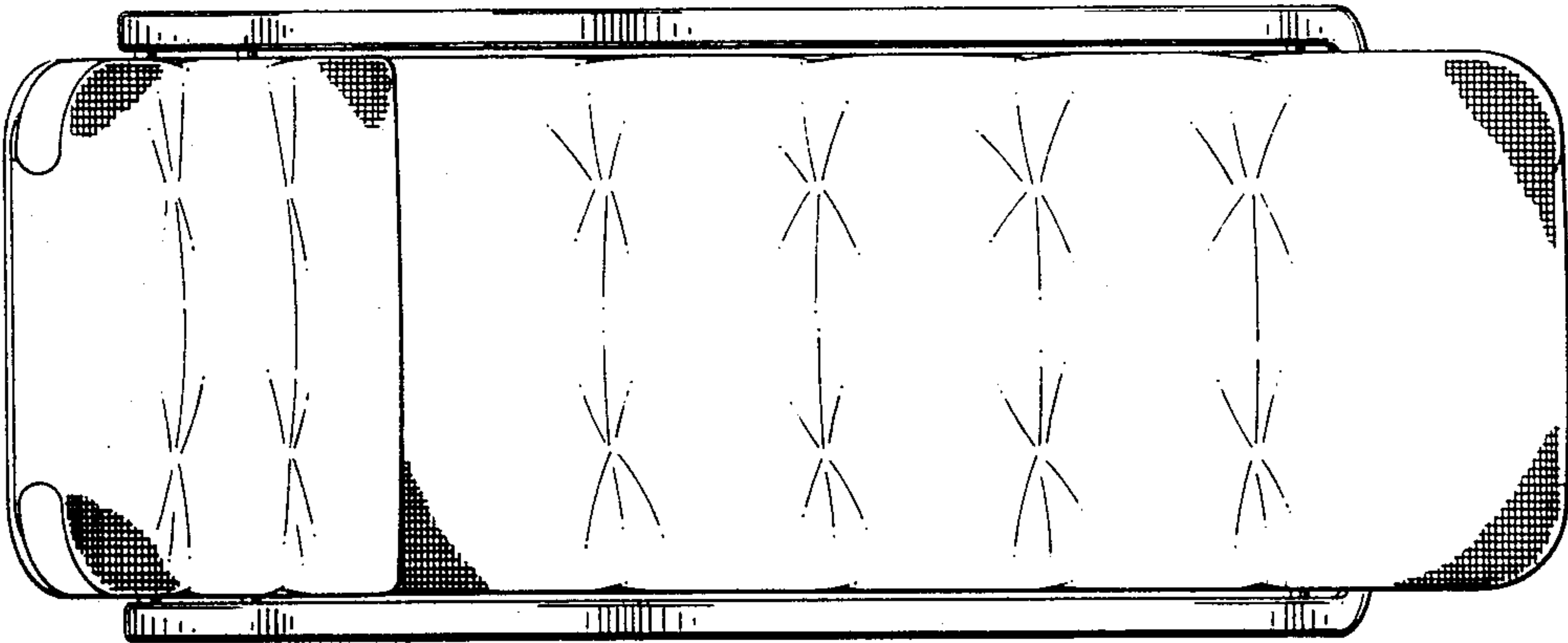

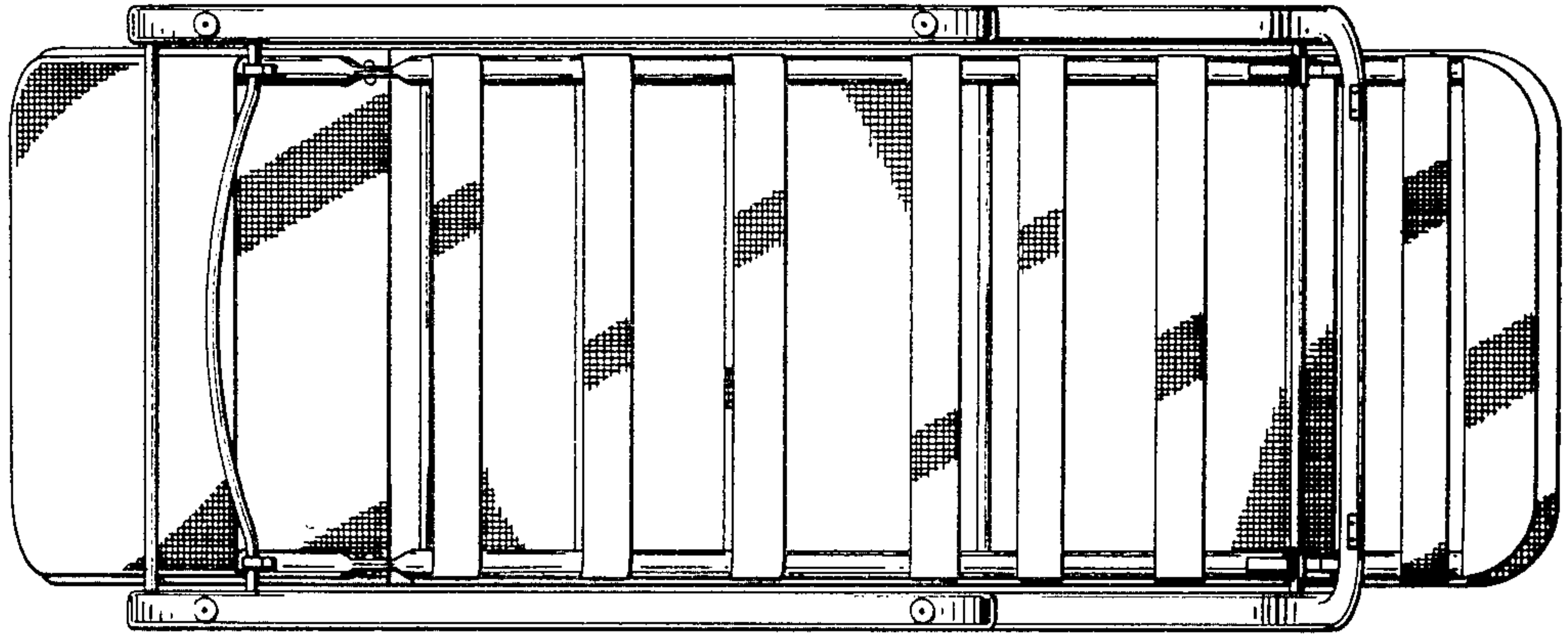

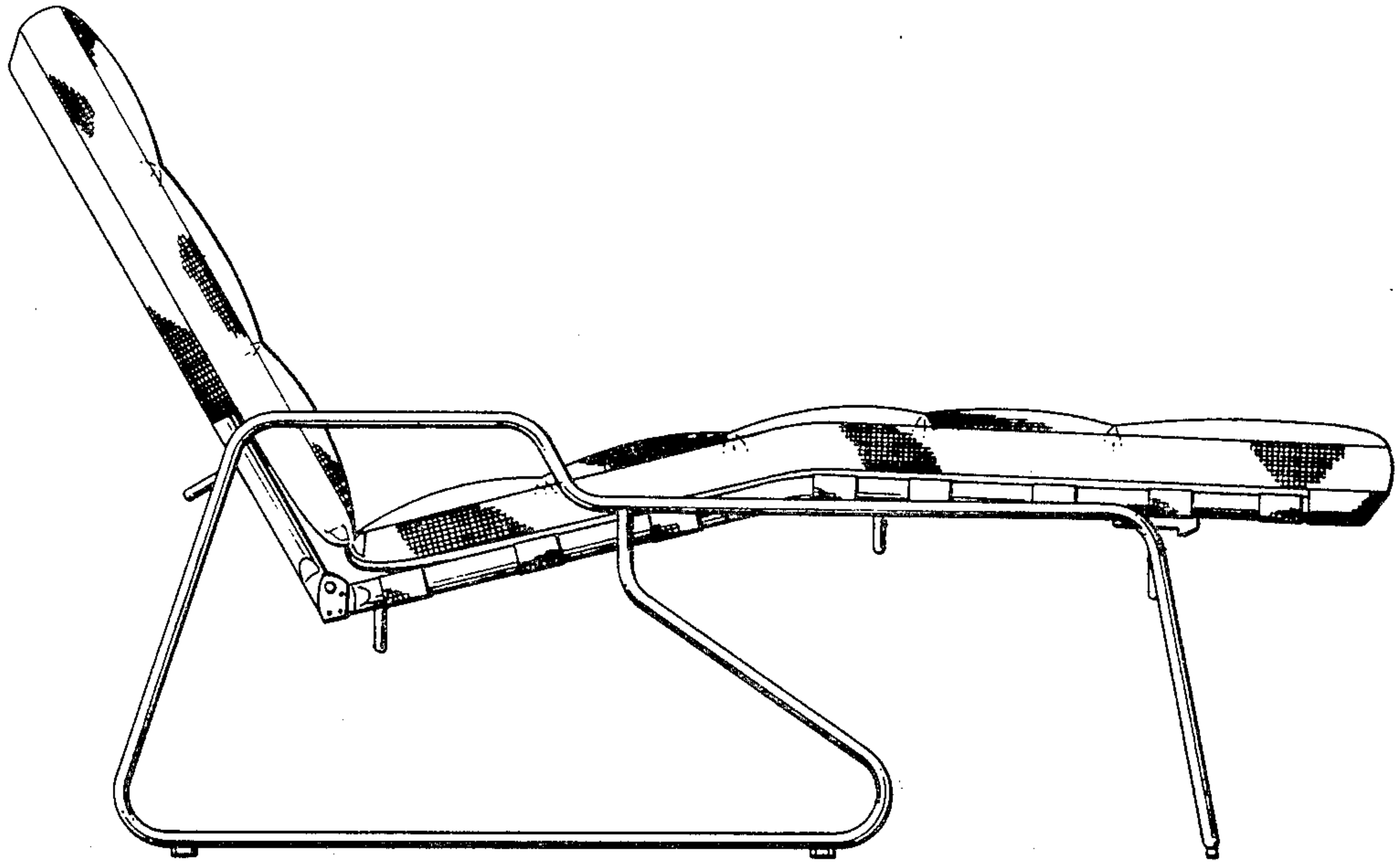

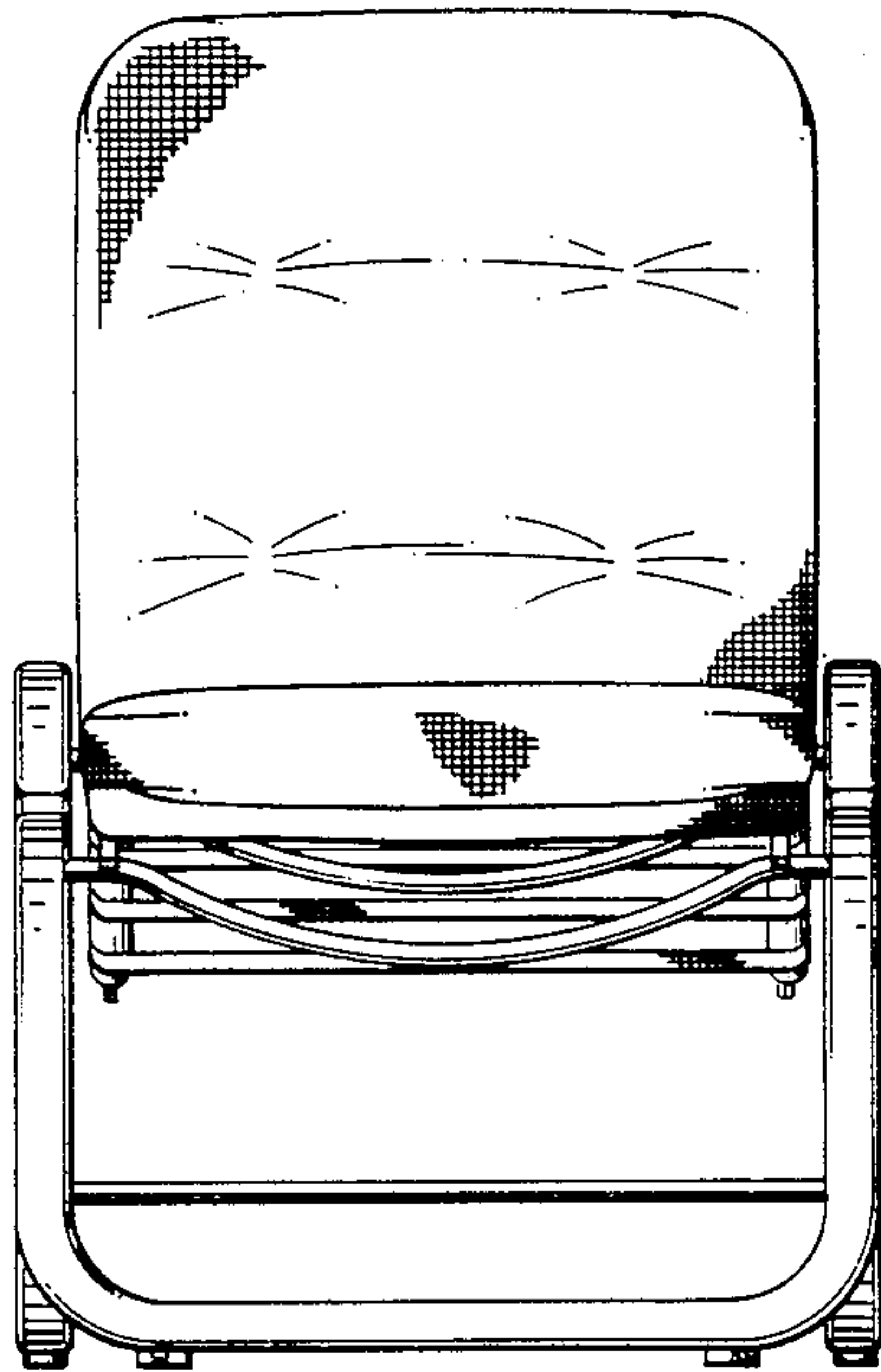
