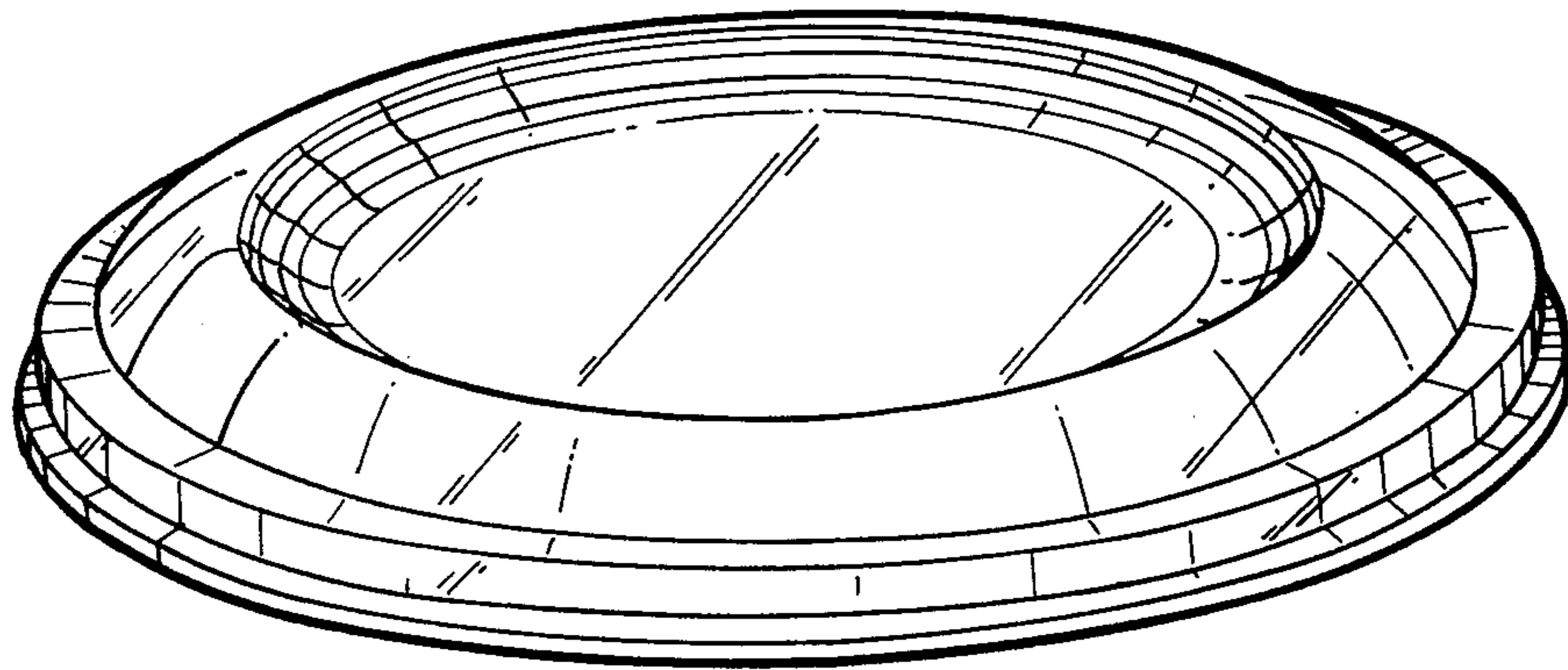

The ornamental design for a resealable closure for a container, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a resealable closure for a container, showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



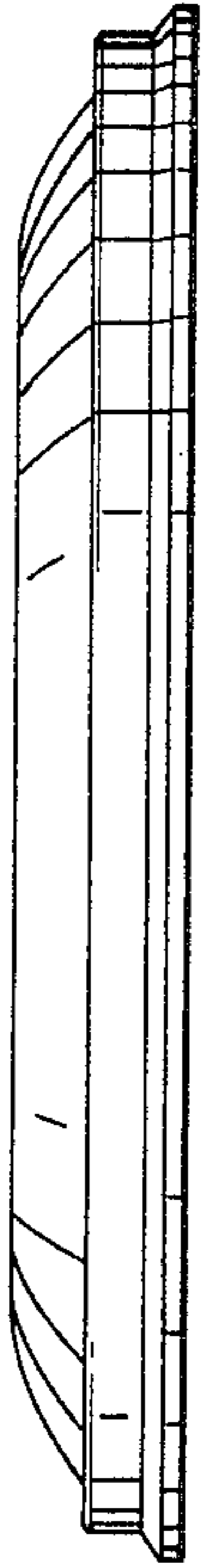

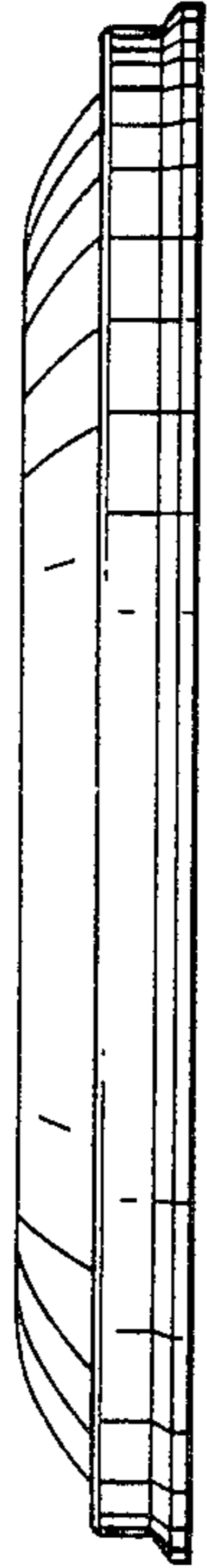

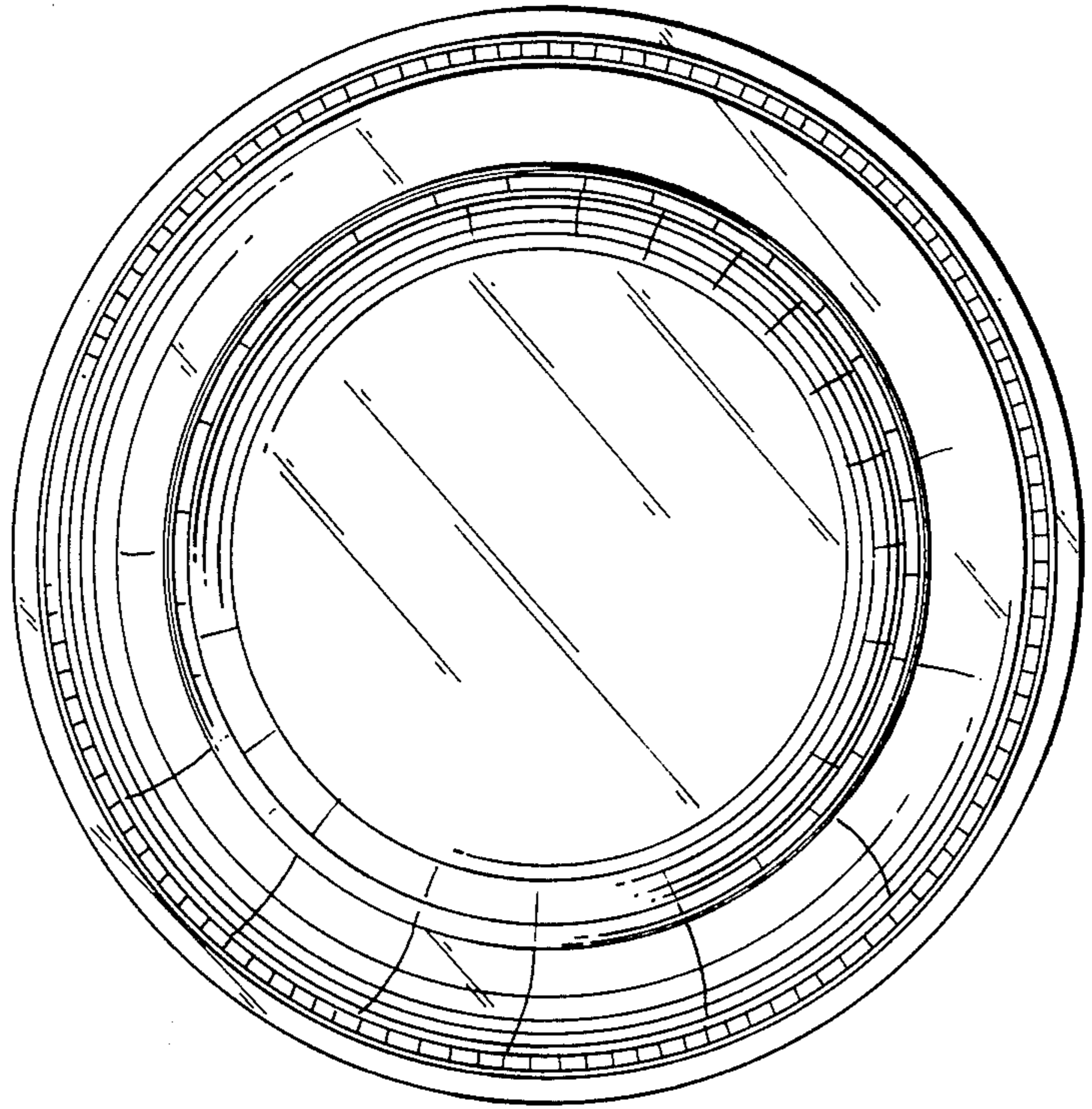

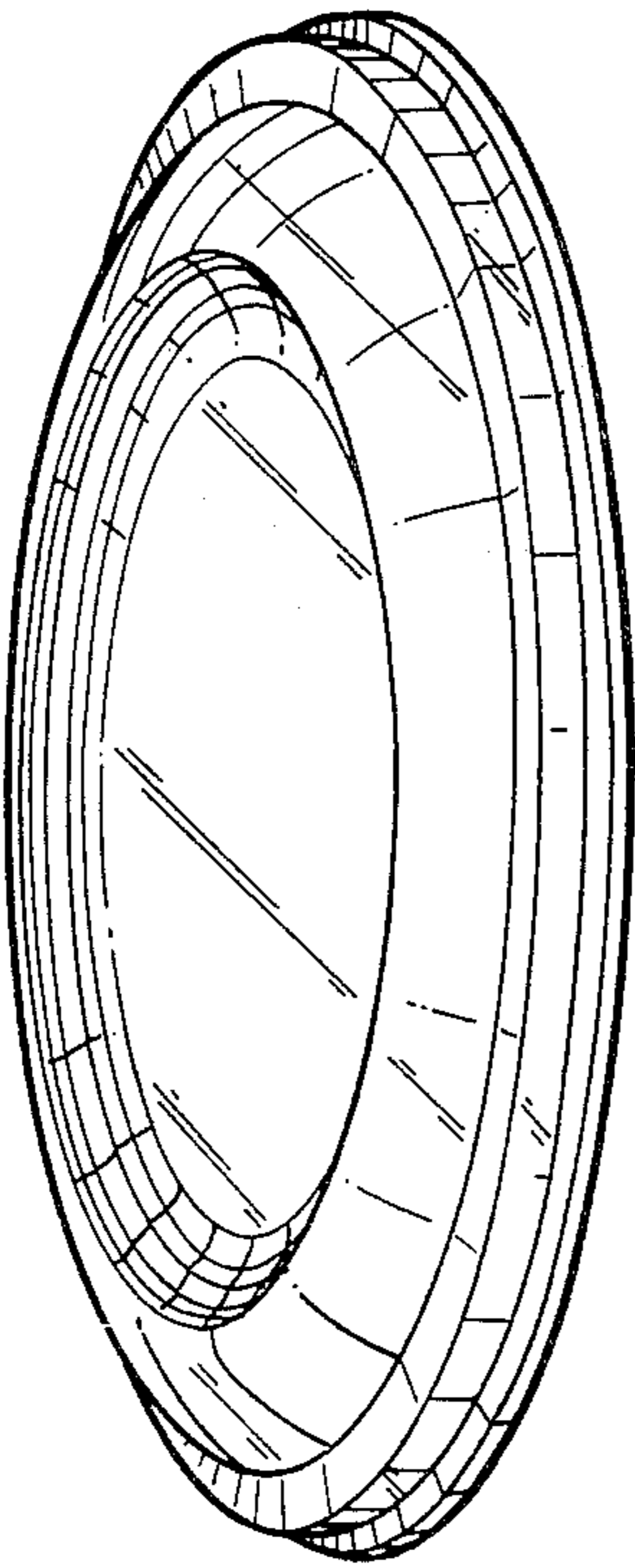

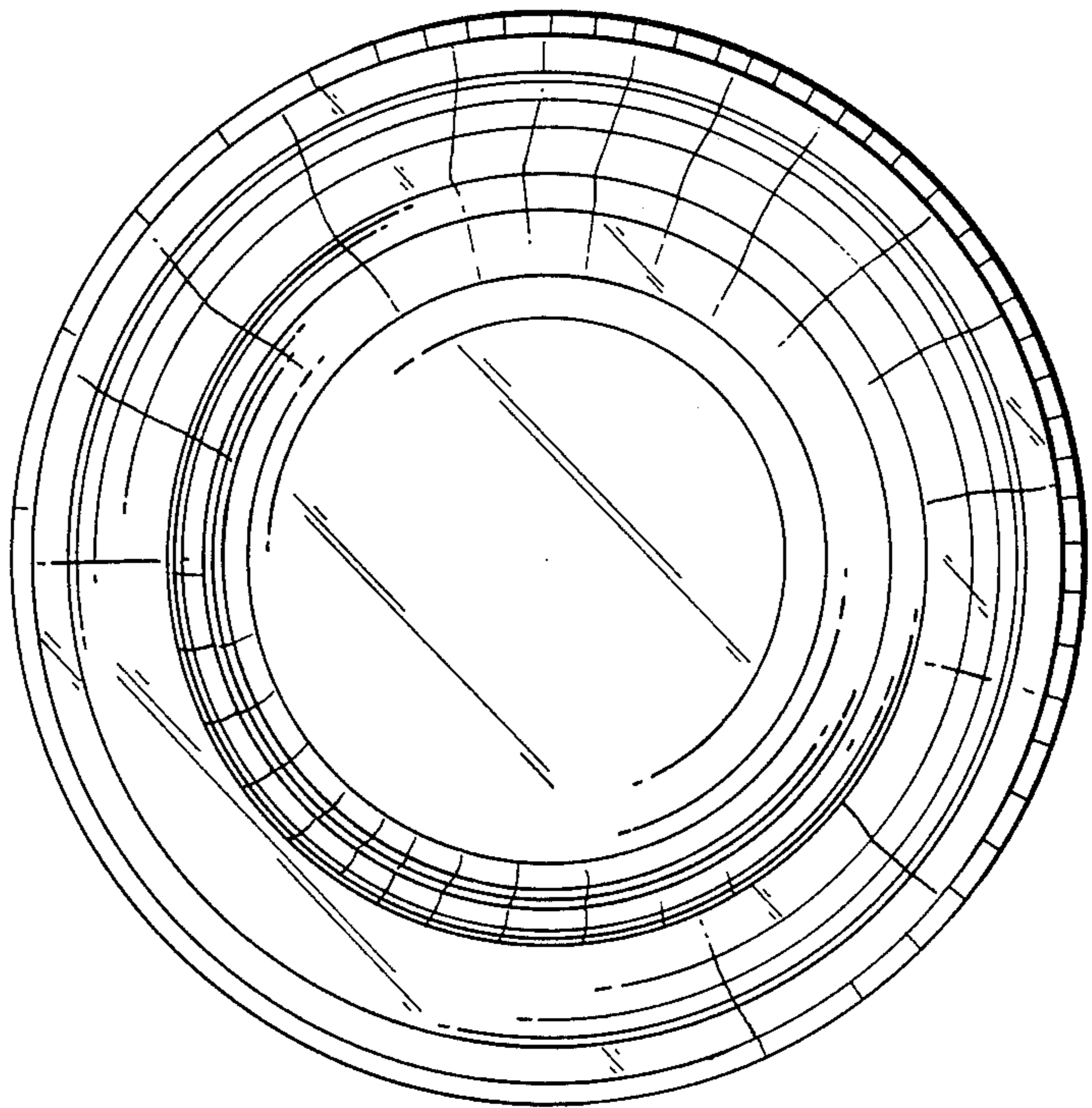
