FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

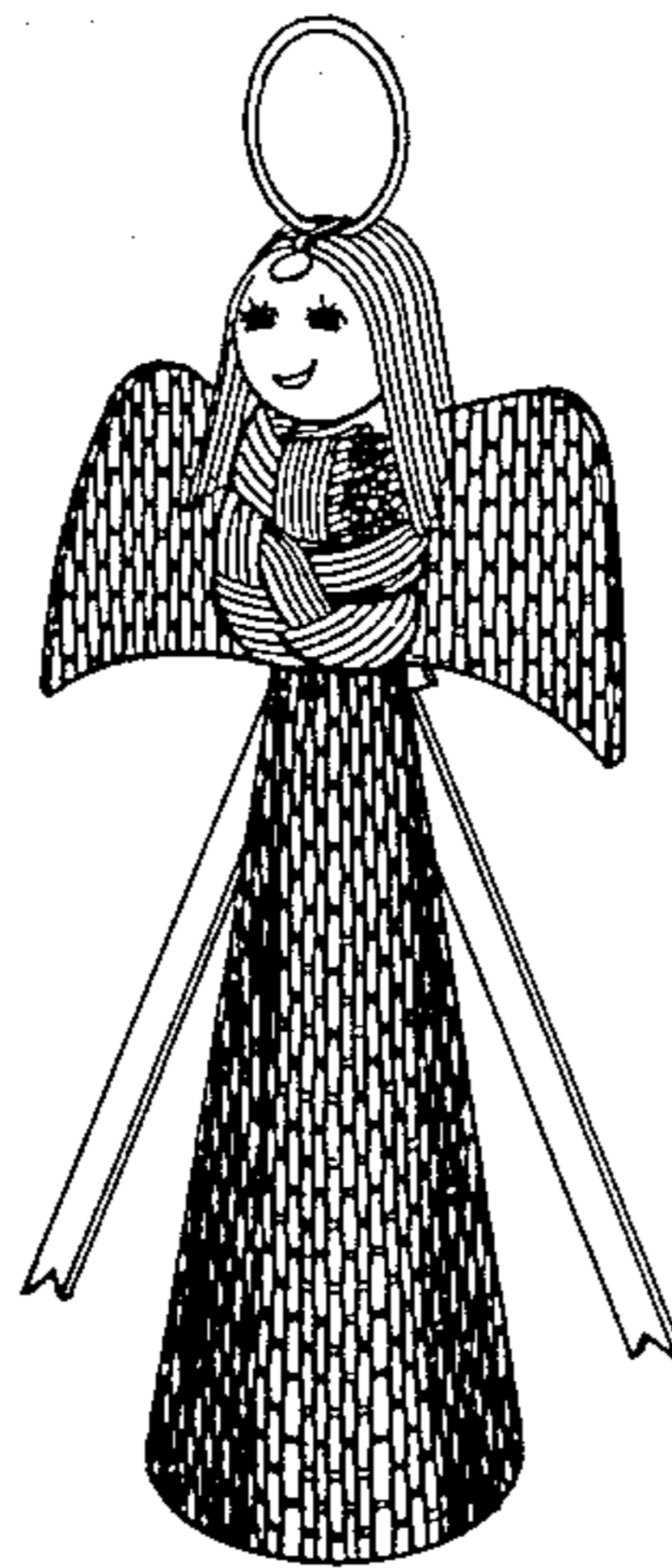
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



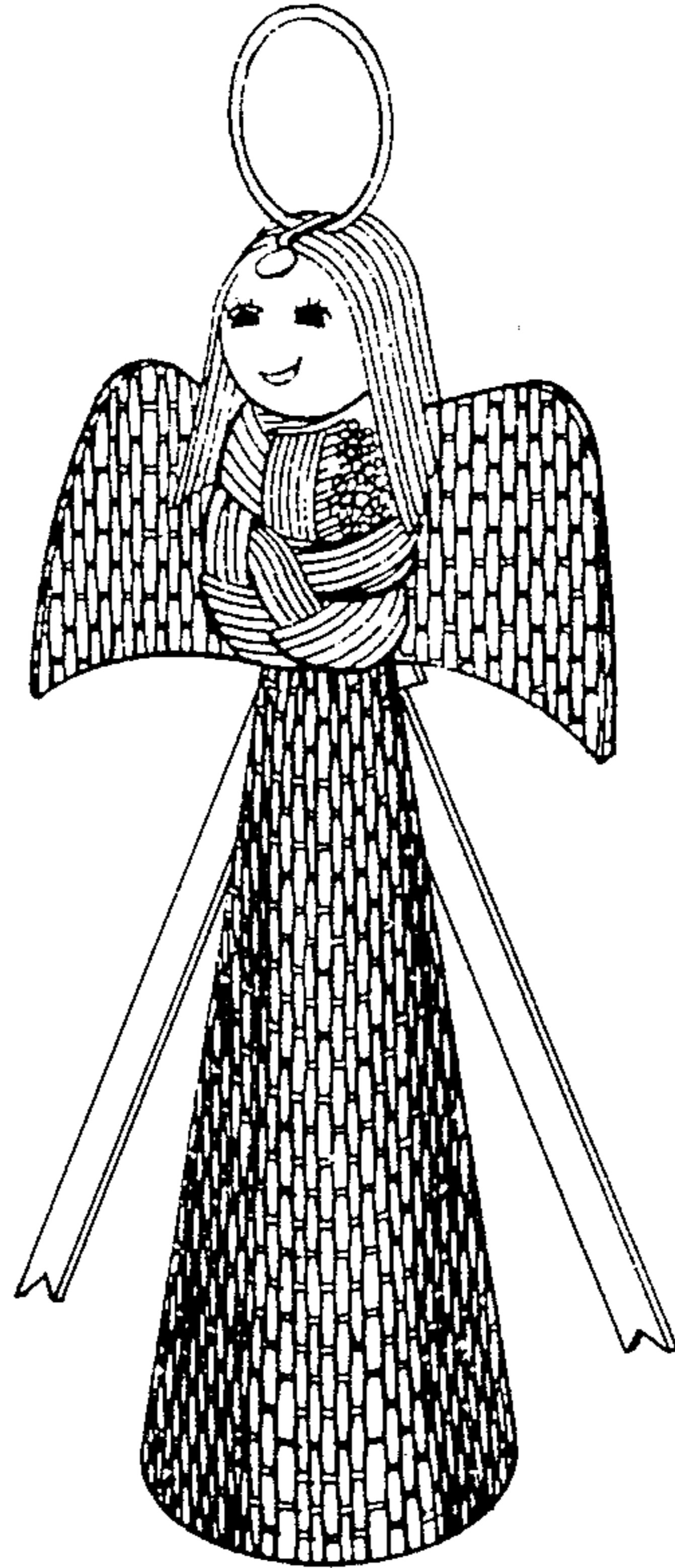

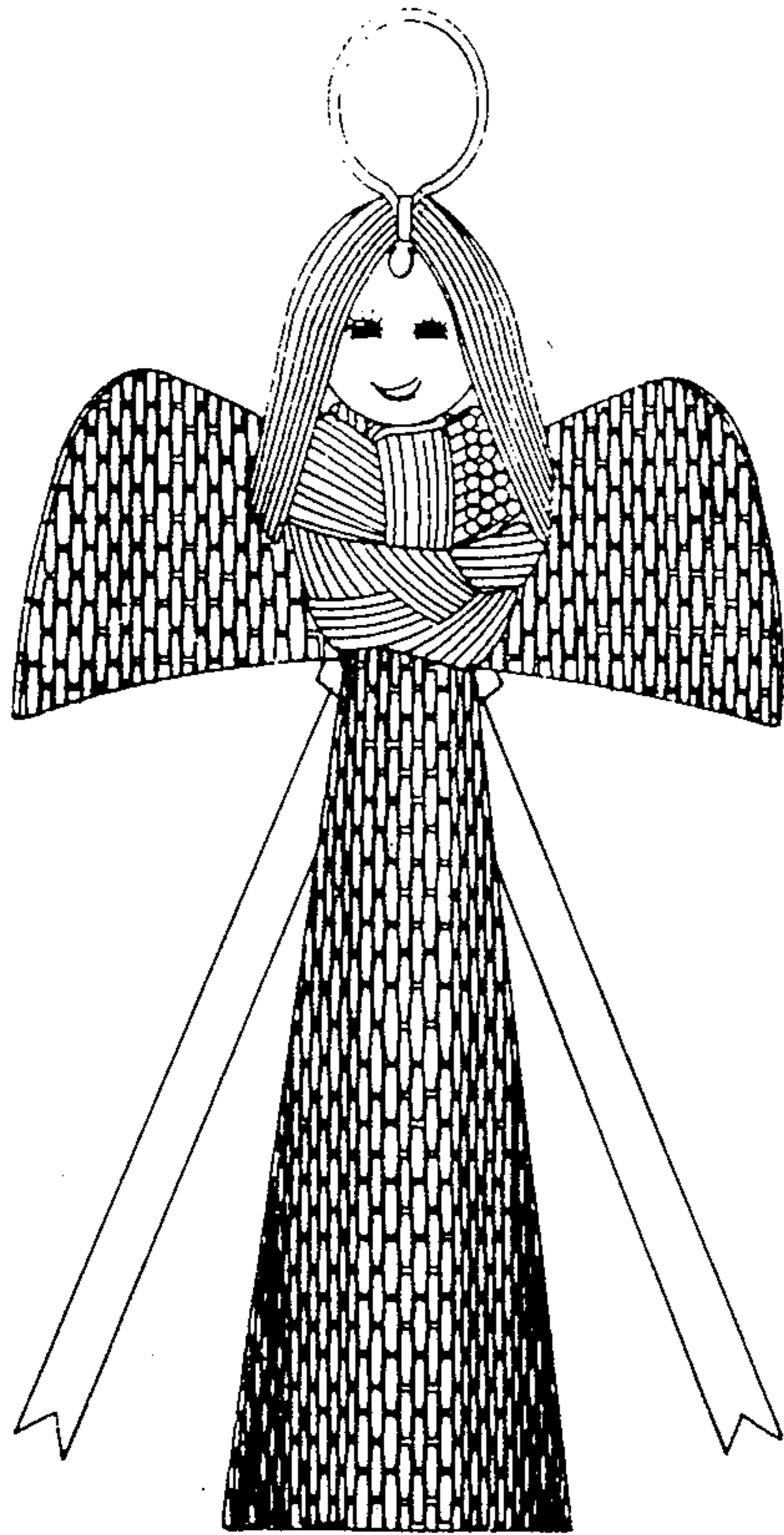

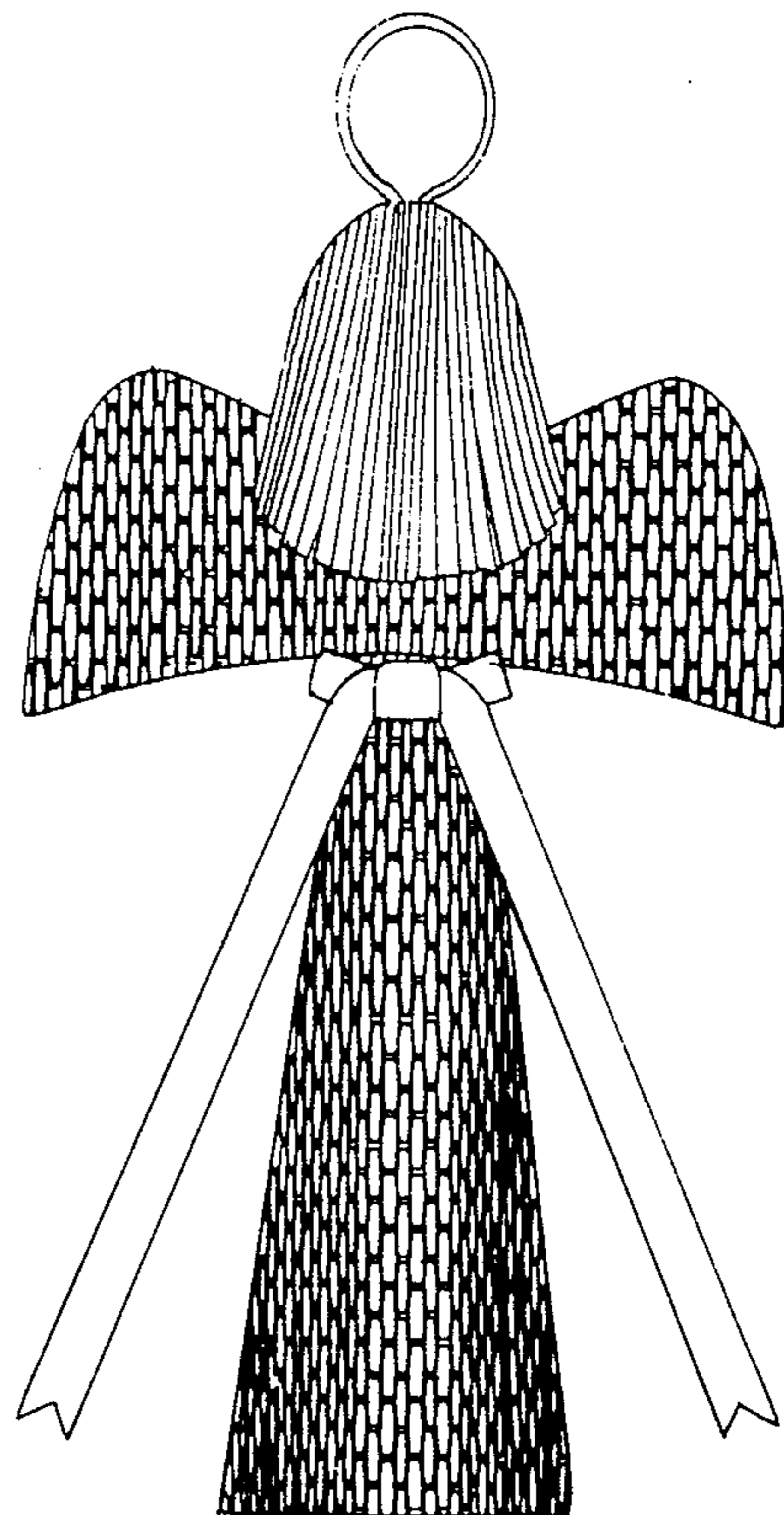

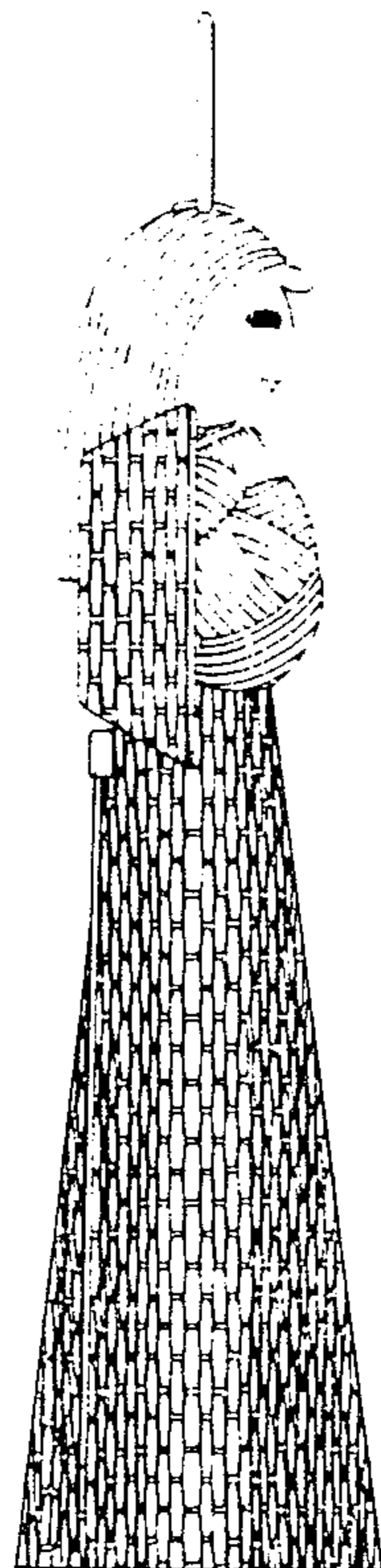

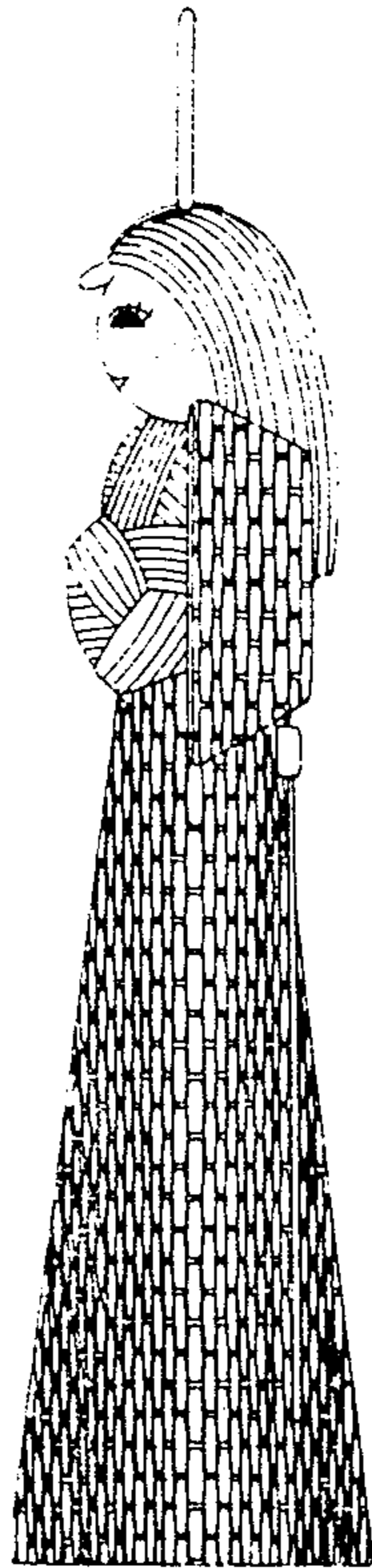

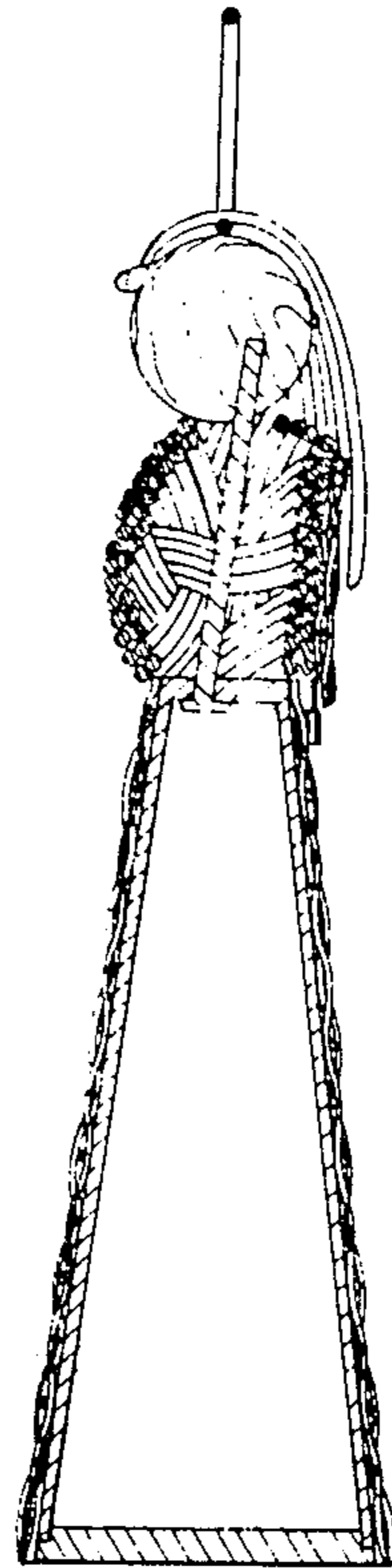

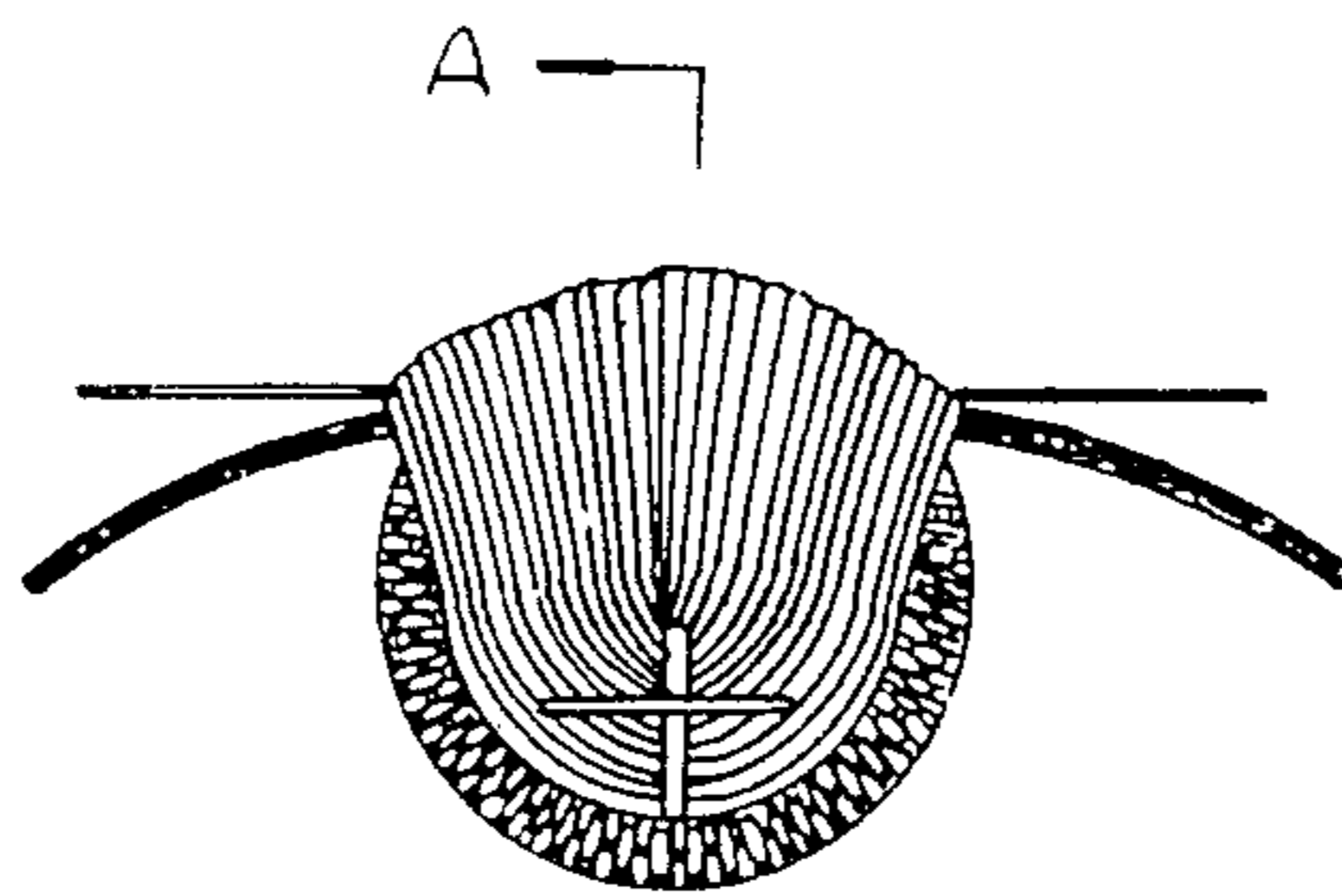

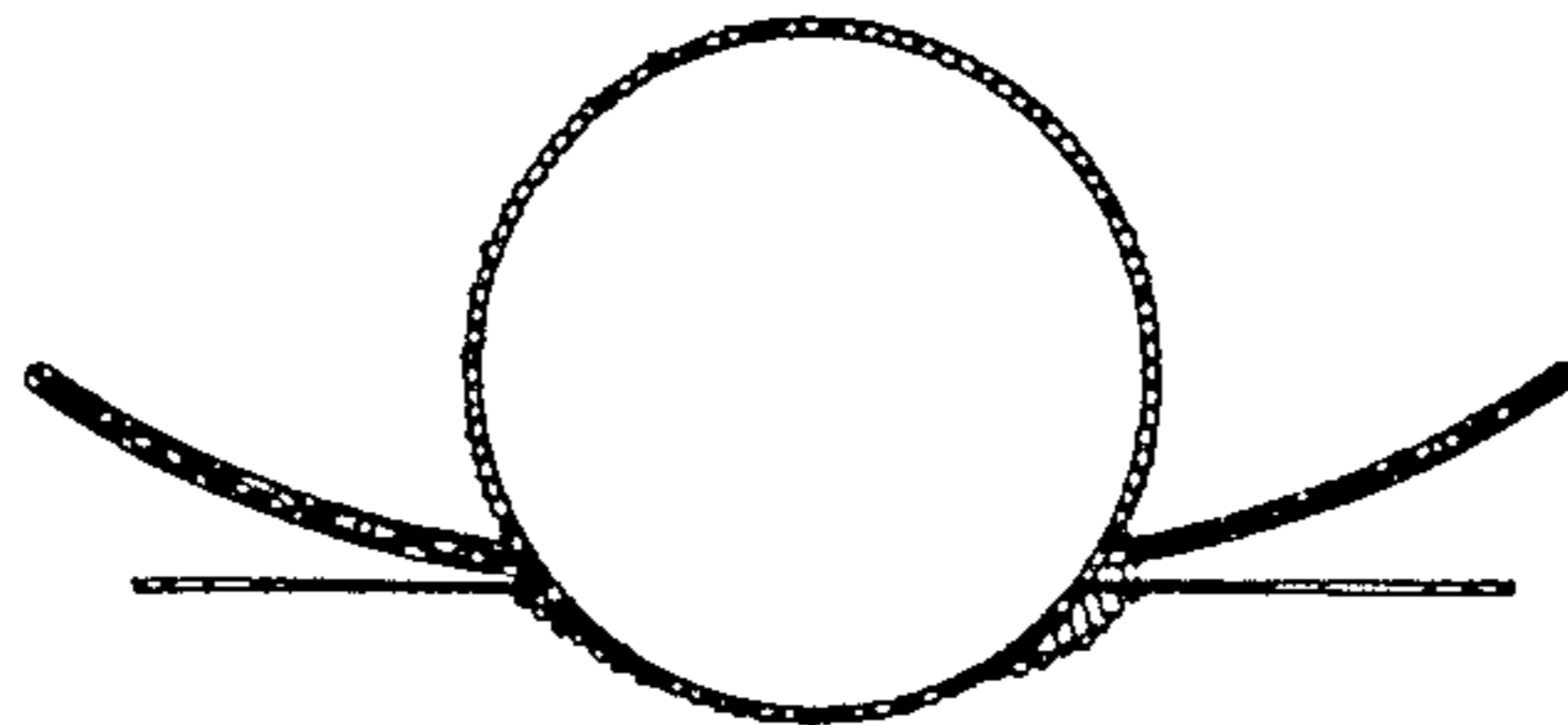
