DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a massager showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof as seen from the left side of FIG. 2.

FIG. 6 is an end elevational view thereof as seen from the right side of FIG. 2.

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of our invention.

FIG. 8 is a side elevational view thereof.


FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof.


FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 11 is an end elevational view thereof as seen from the left side of FIG. 8.


FIG. 12 is an end elevational view thereof as seen from the right side of FIG. 8.

The views of the drawing not shown are identical to those shown.











