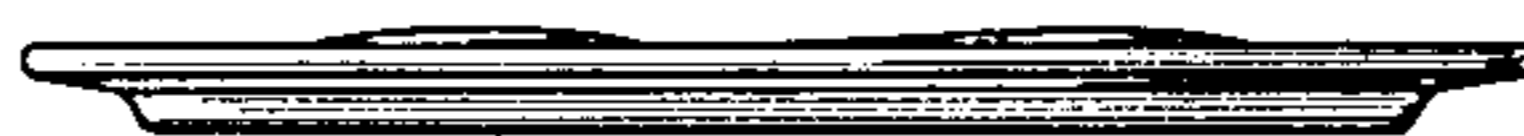
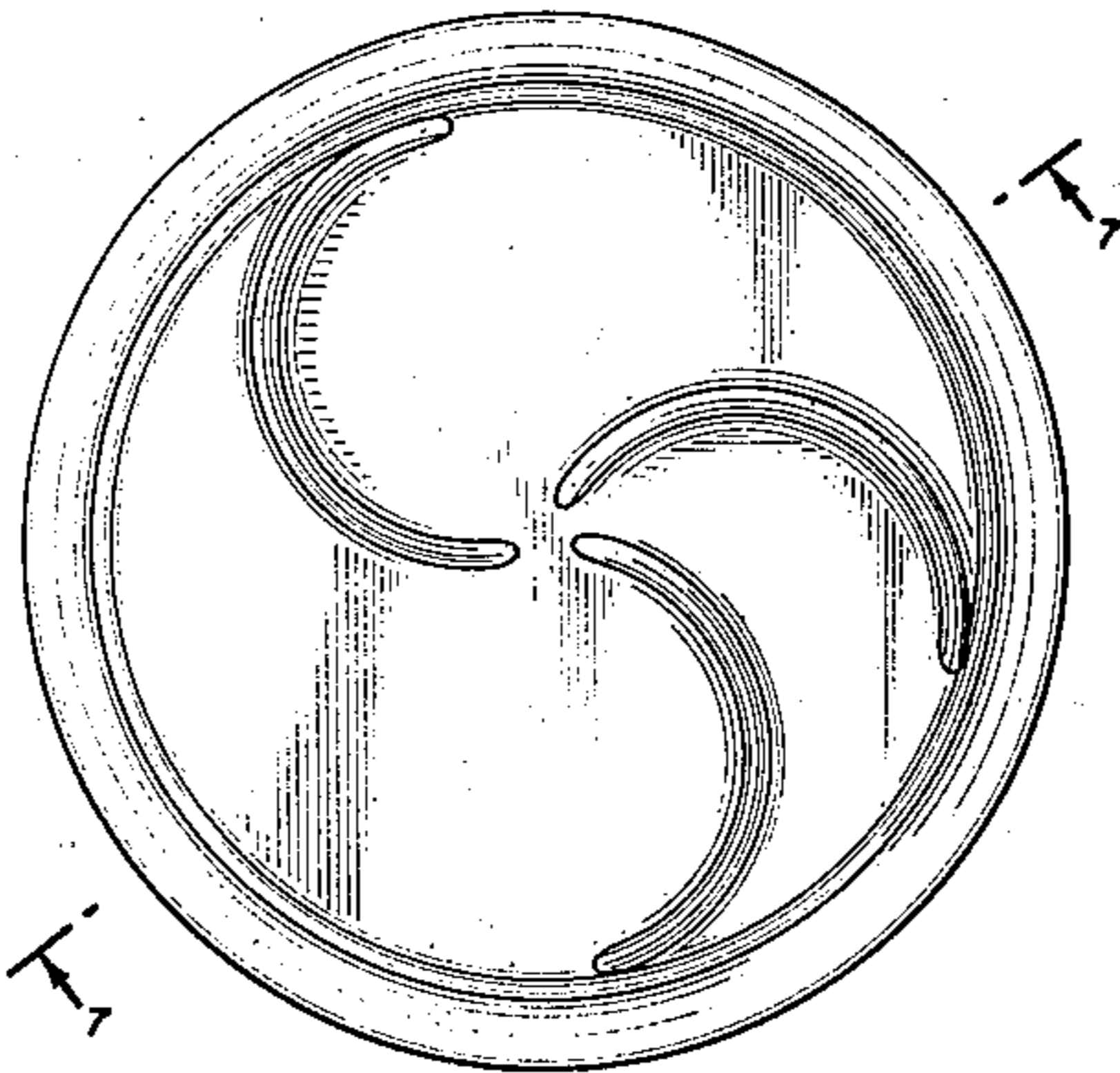

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a diet plate showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 7-7 of FIG. 1.



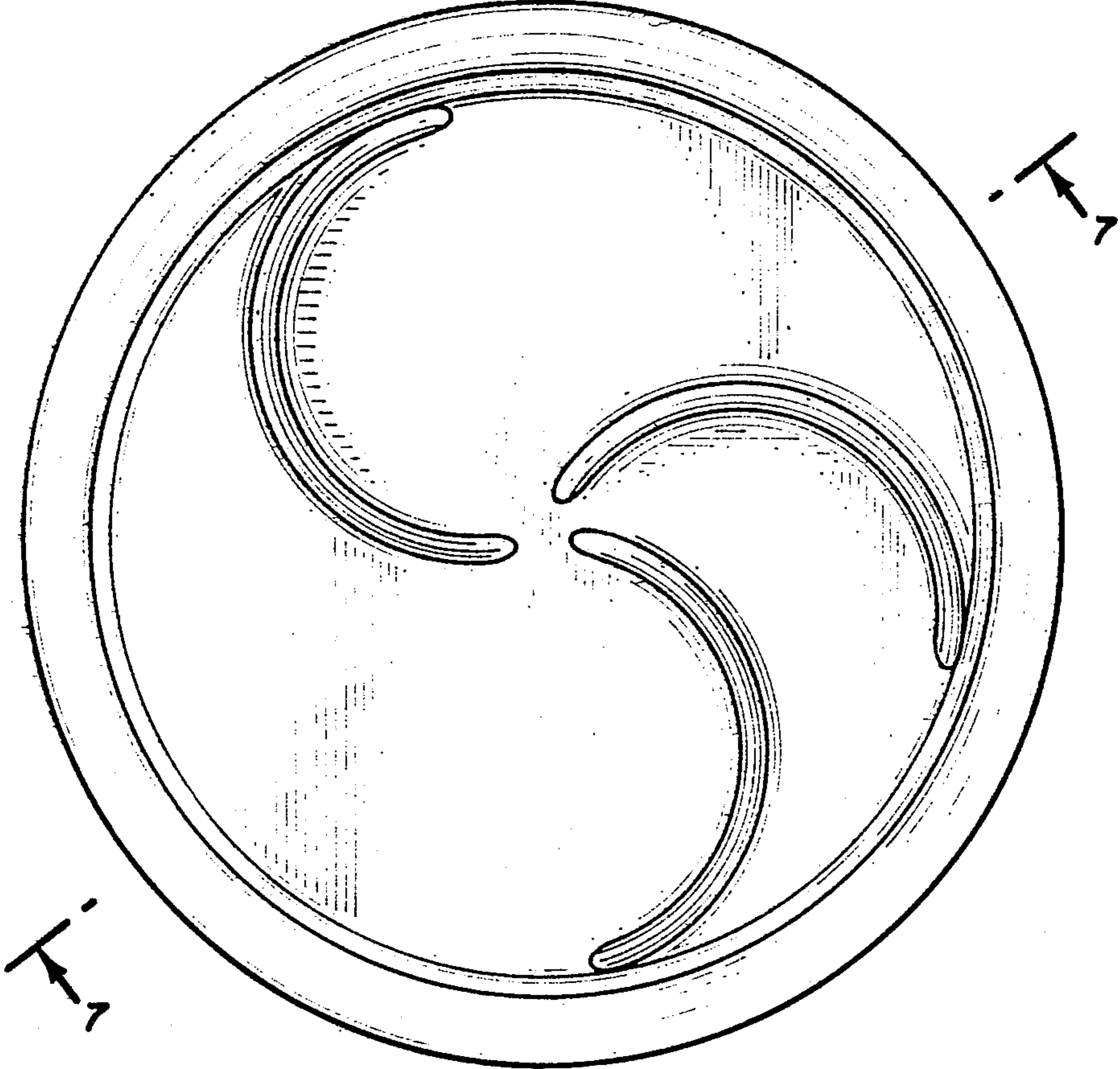

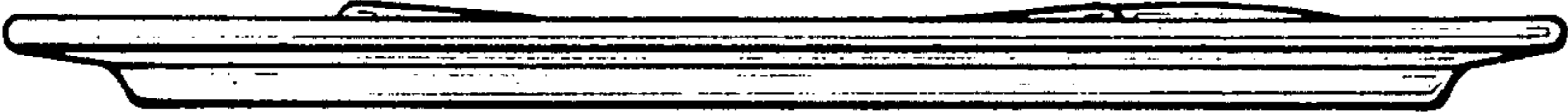

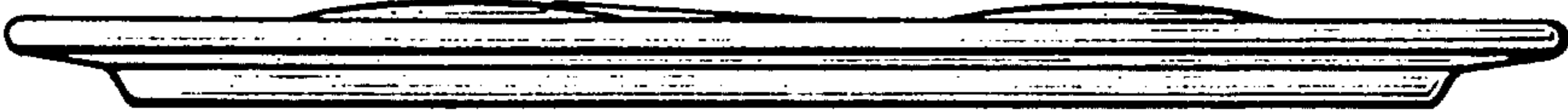

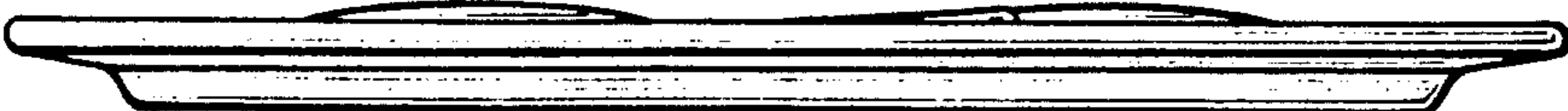

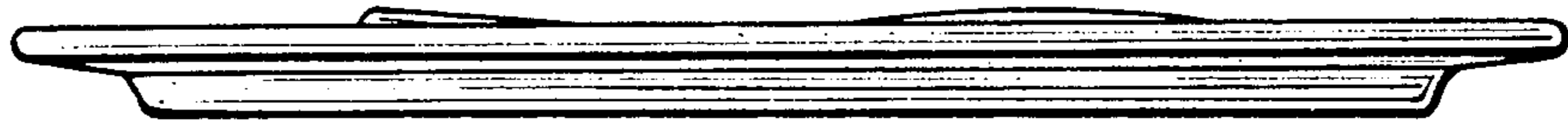

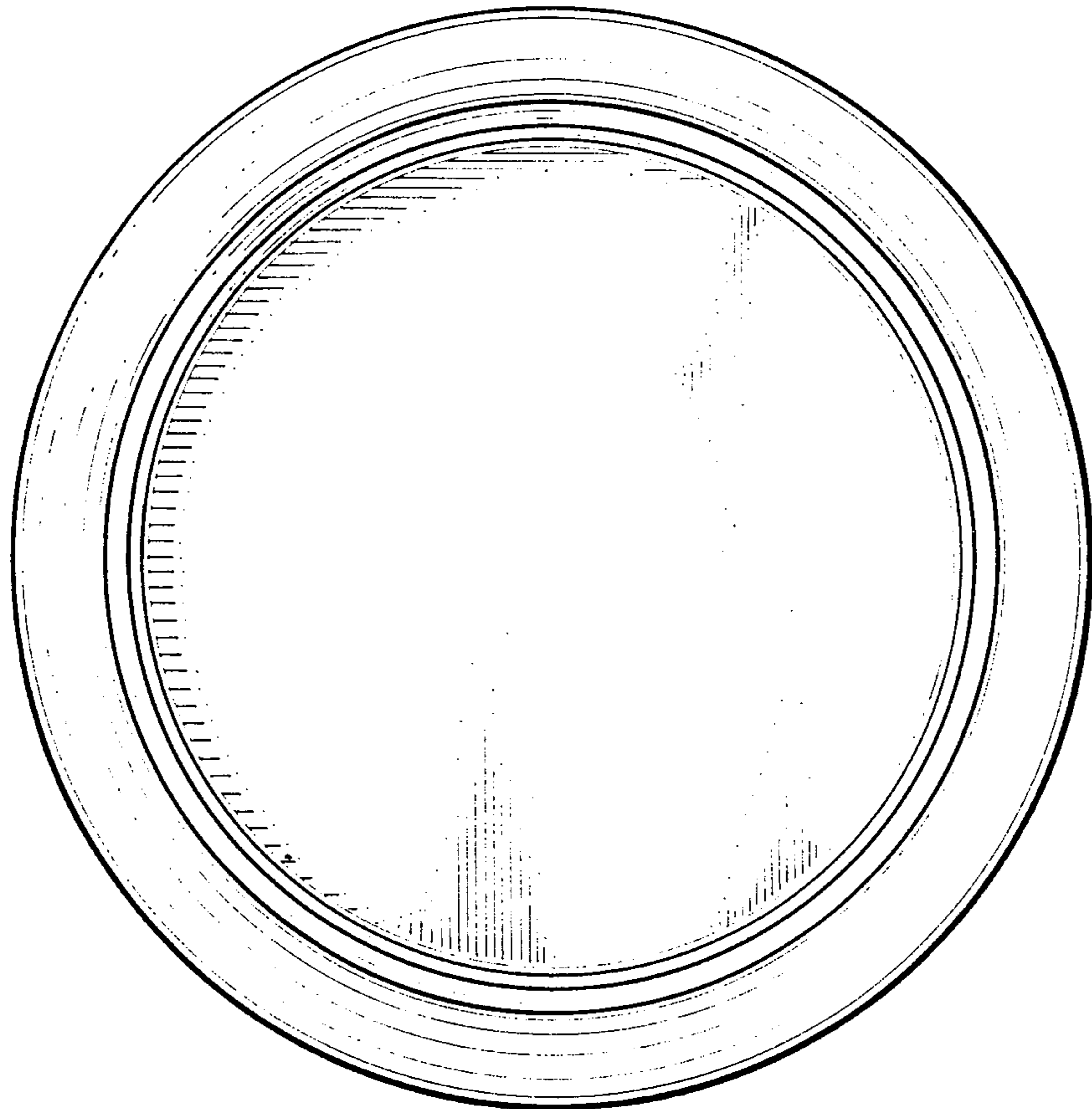
