**DESCRIPTION**


FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bicycle brake block showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the bottom side and one end thereof.






