DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view looking from the top of an eyeglass frame, showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image.

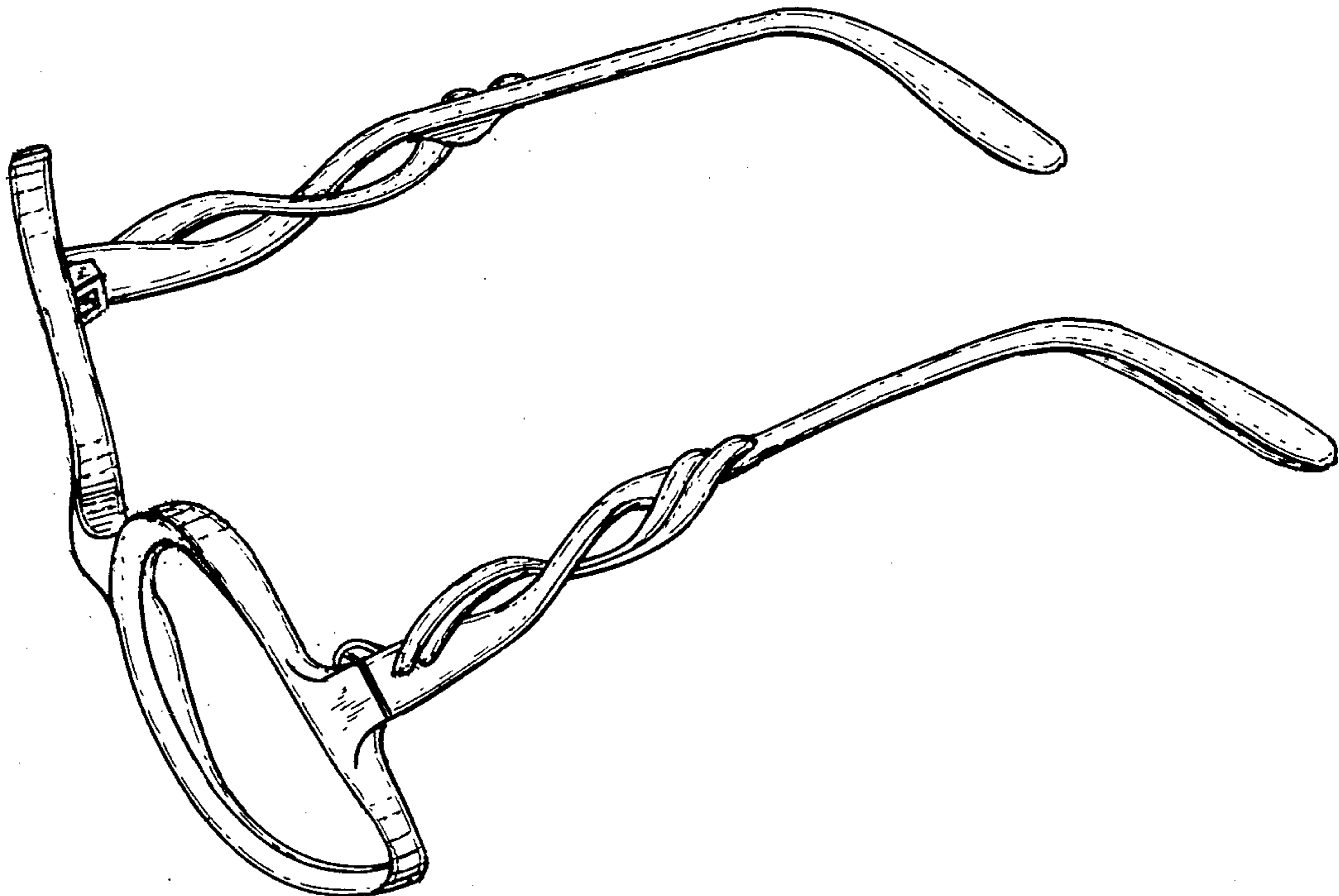

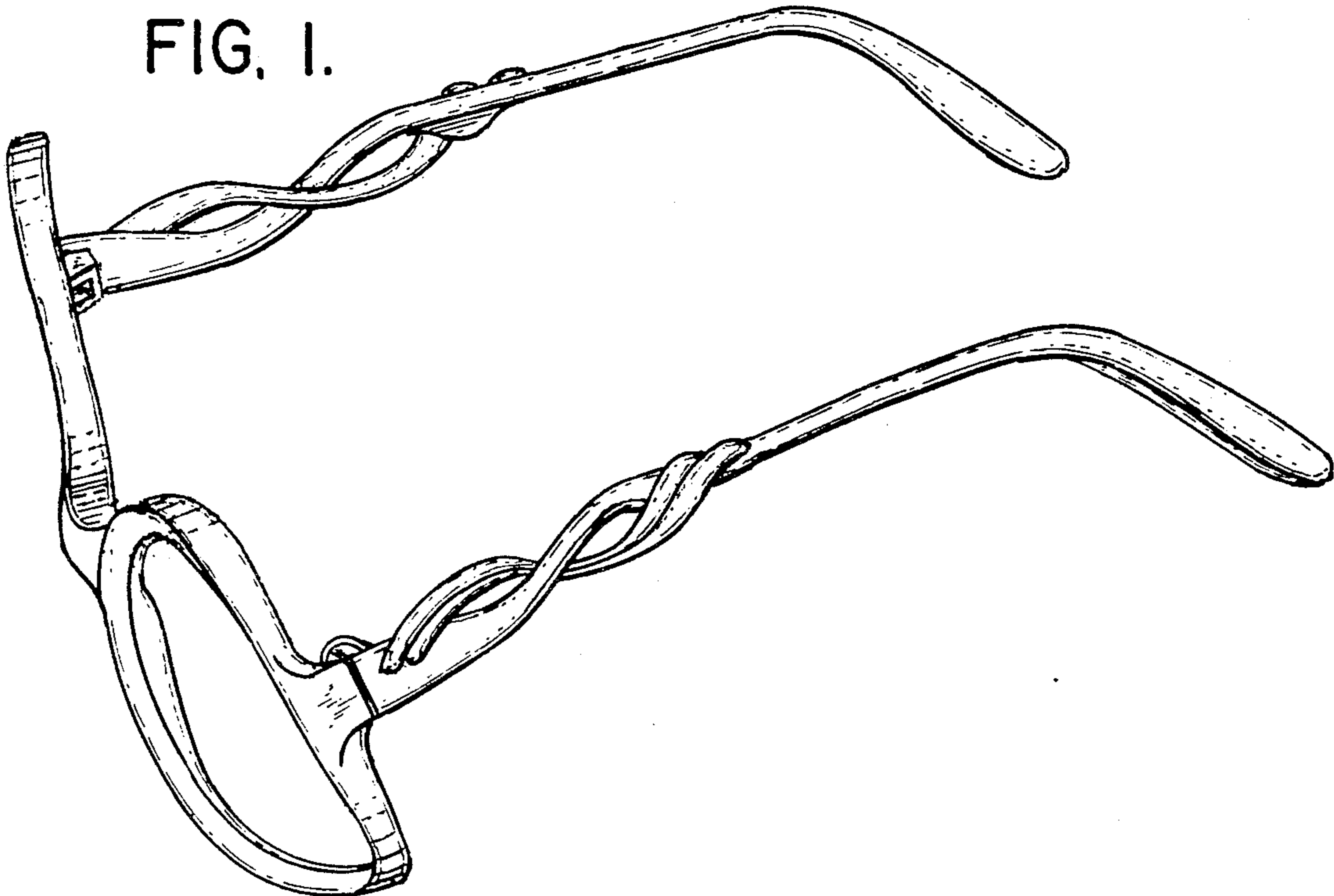

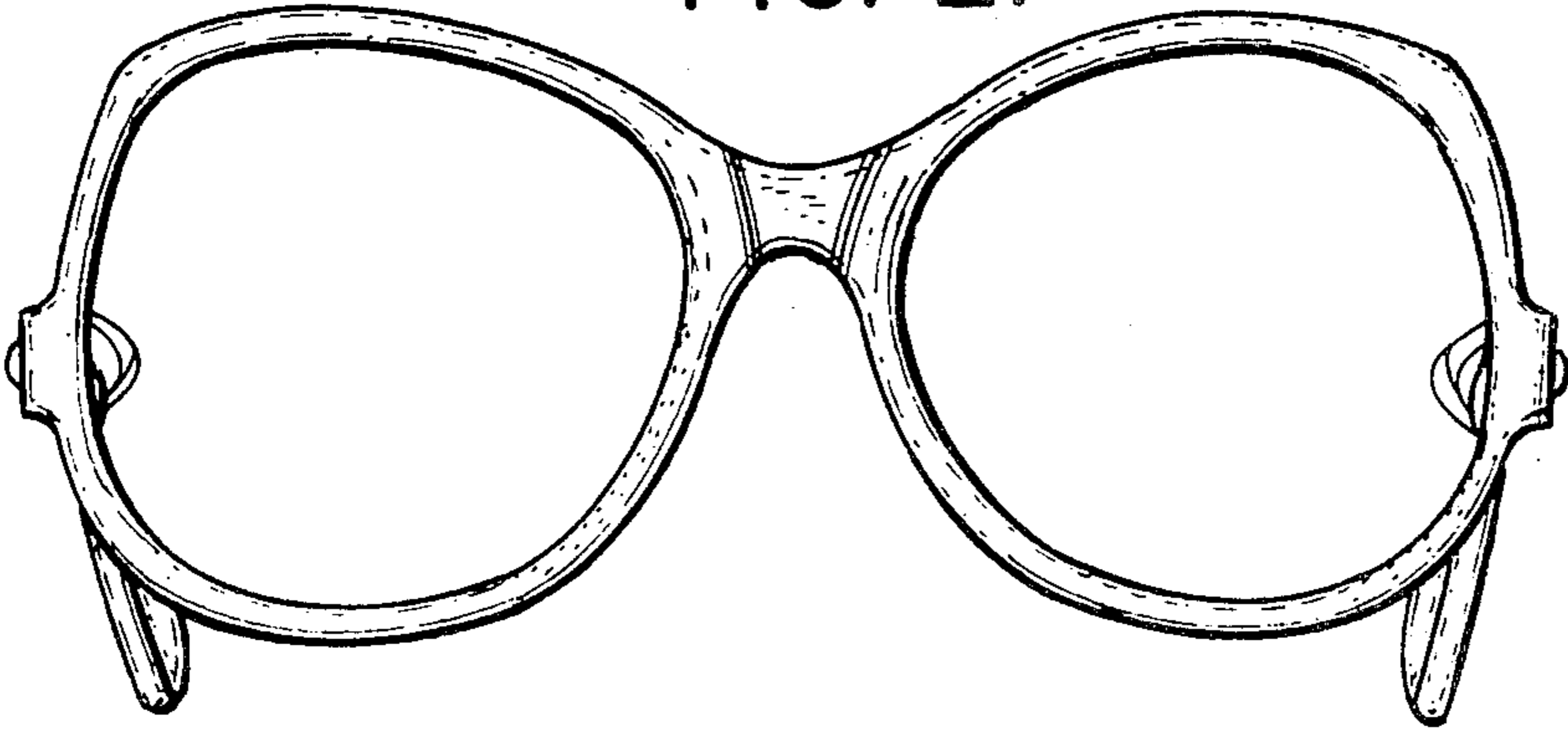
