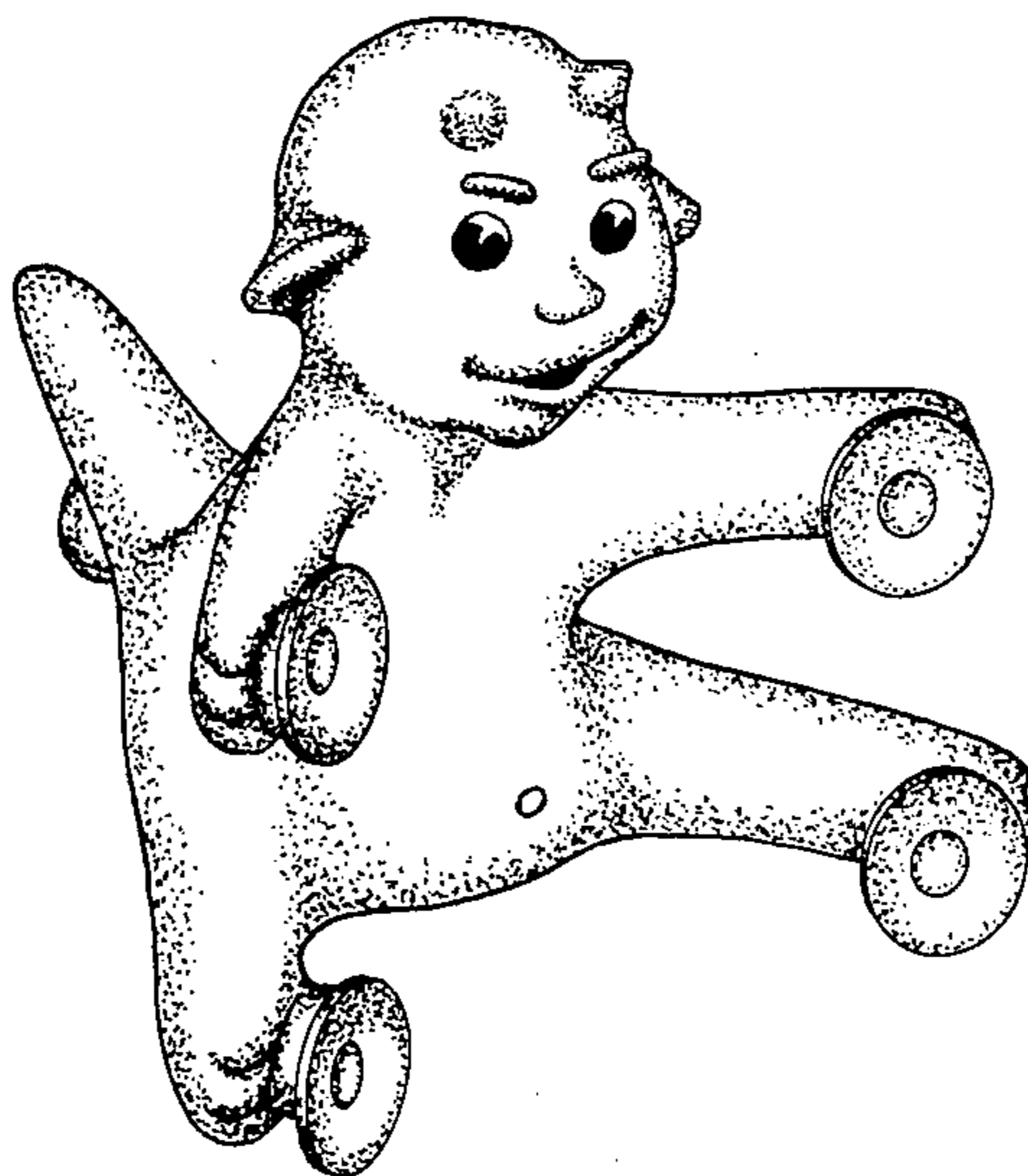

The ornamental design for a toy monster, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy monster showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



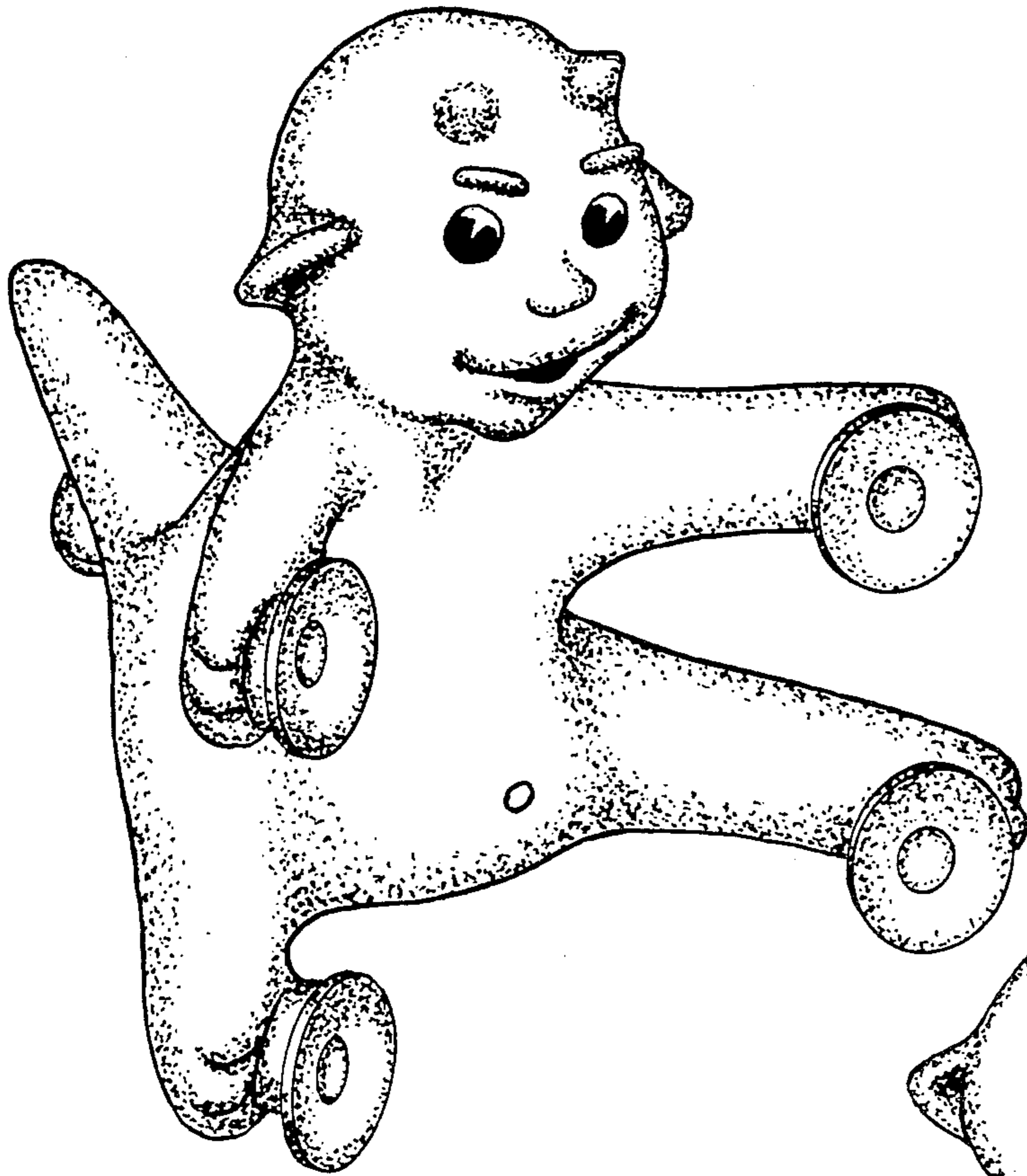

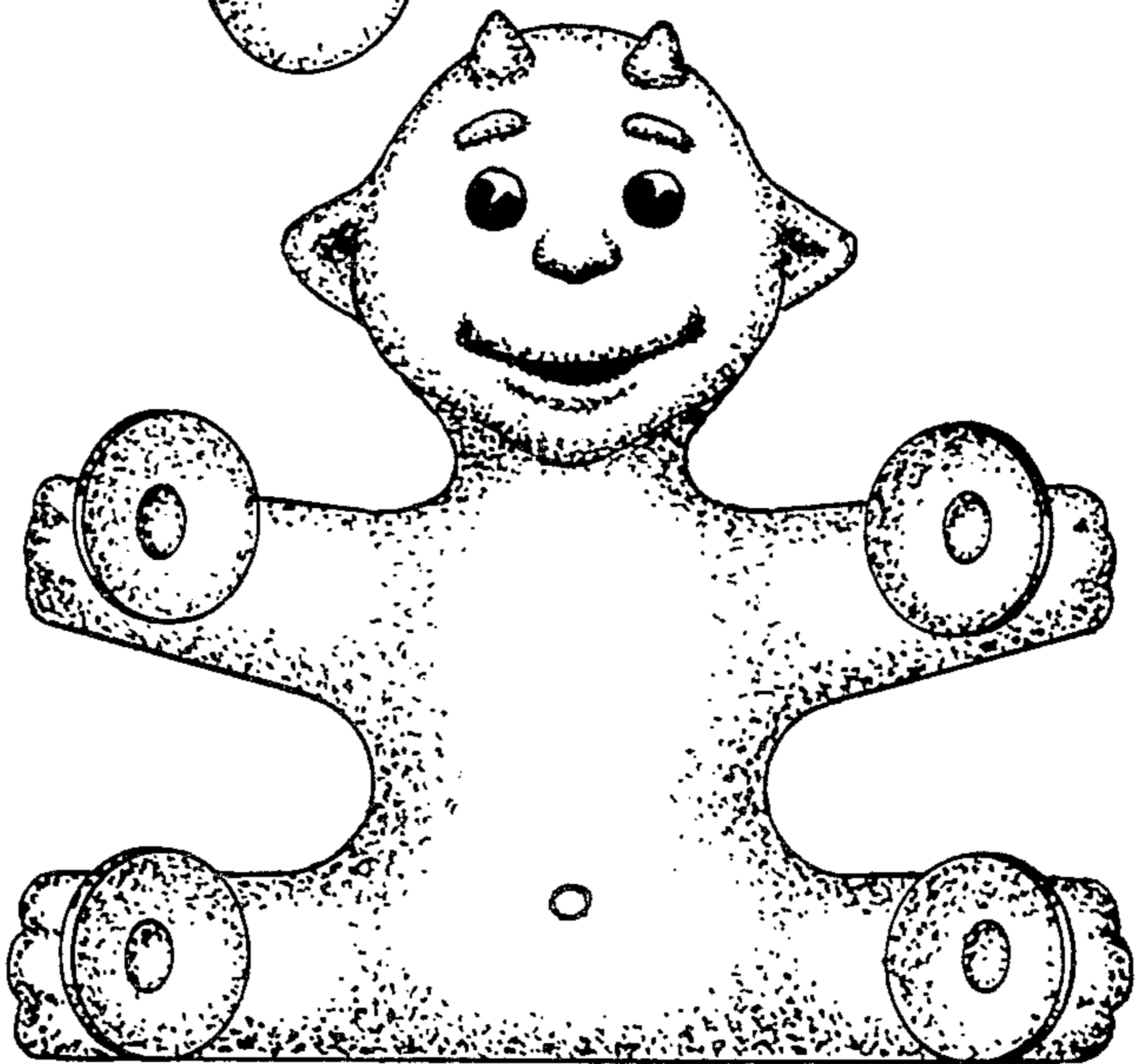

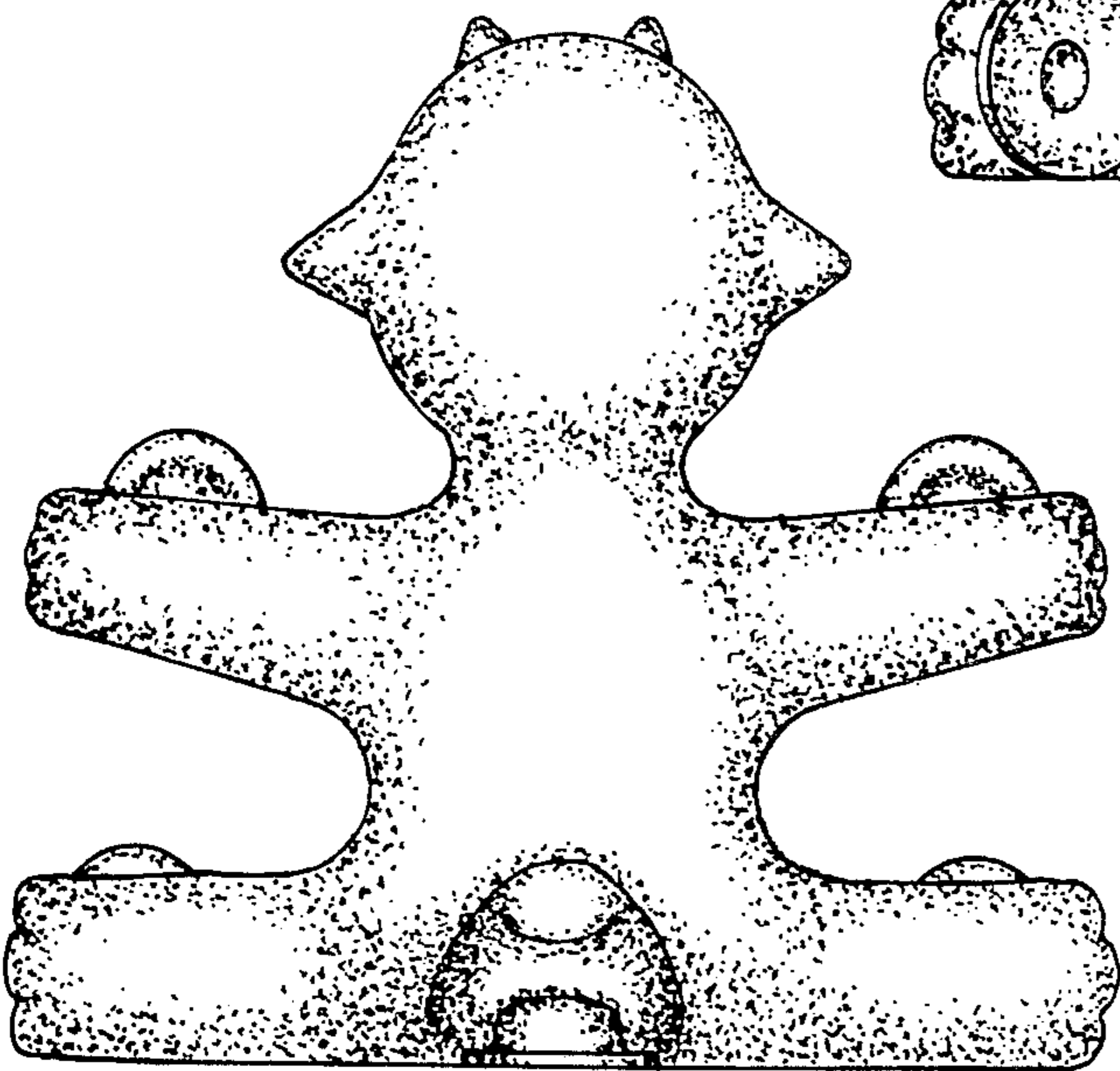

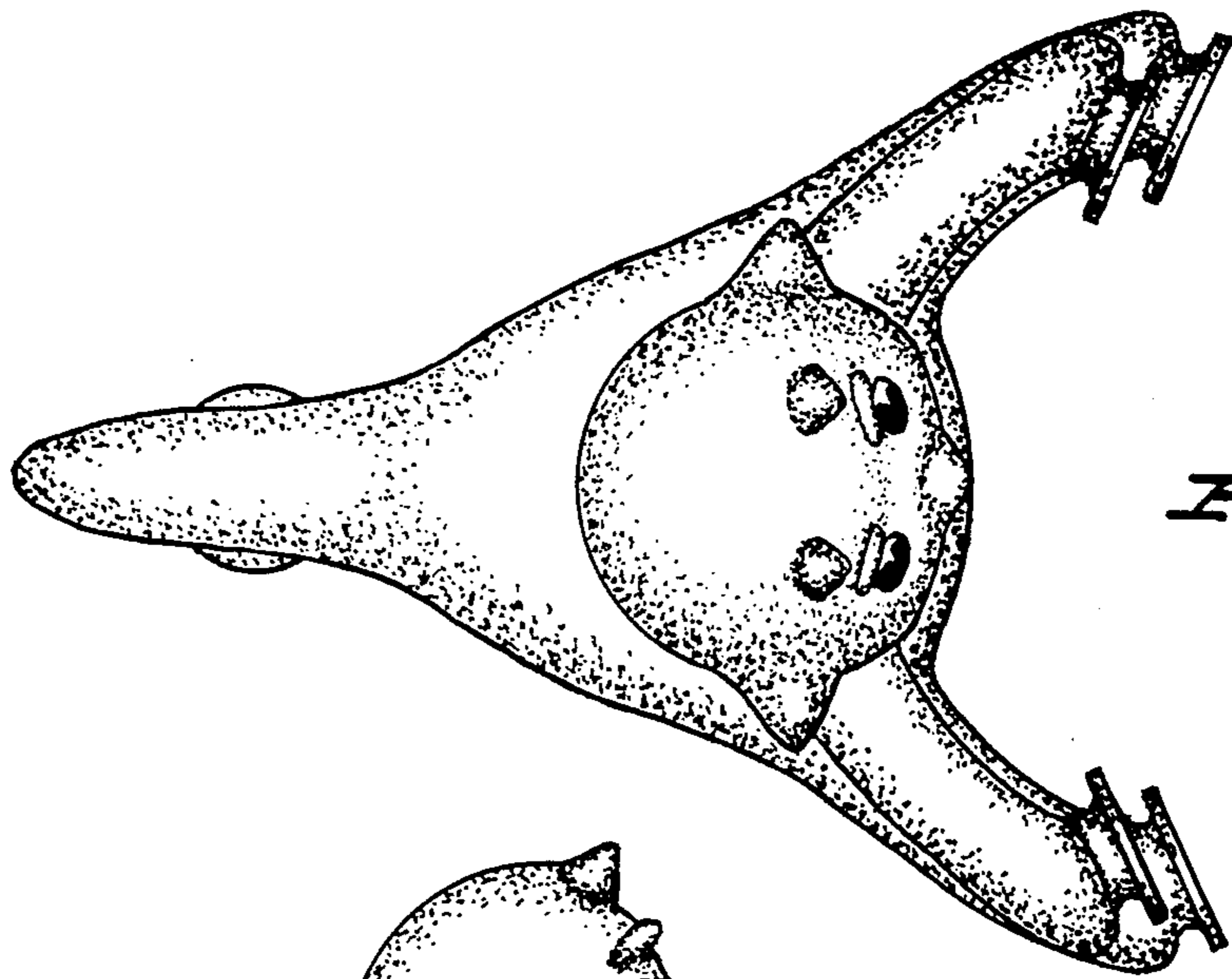

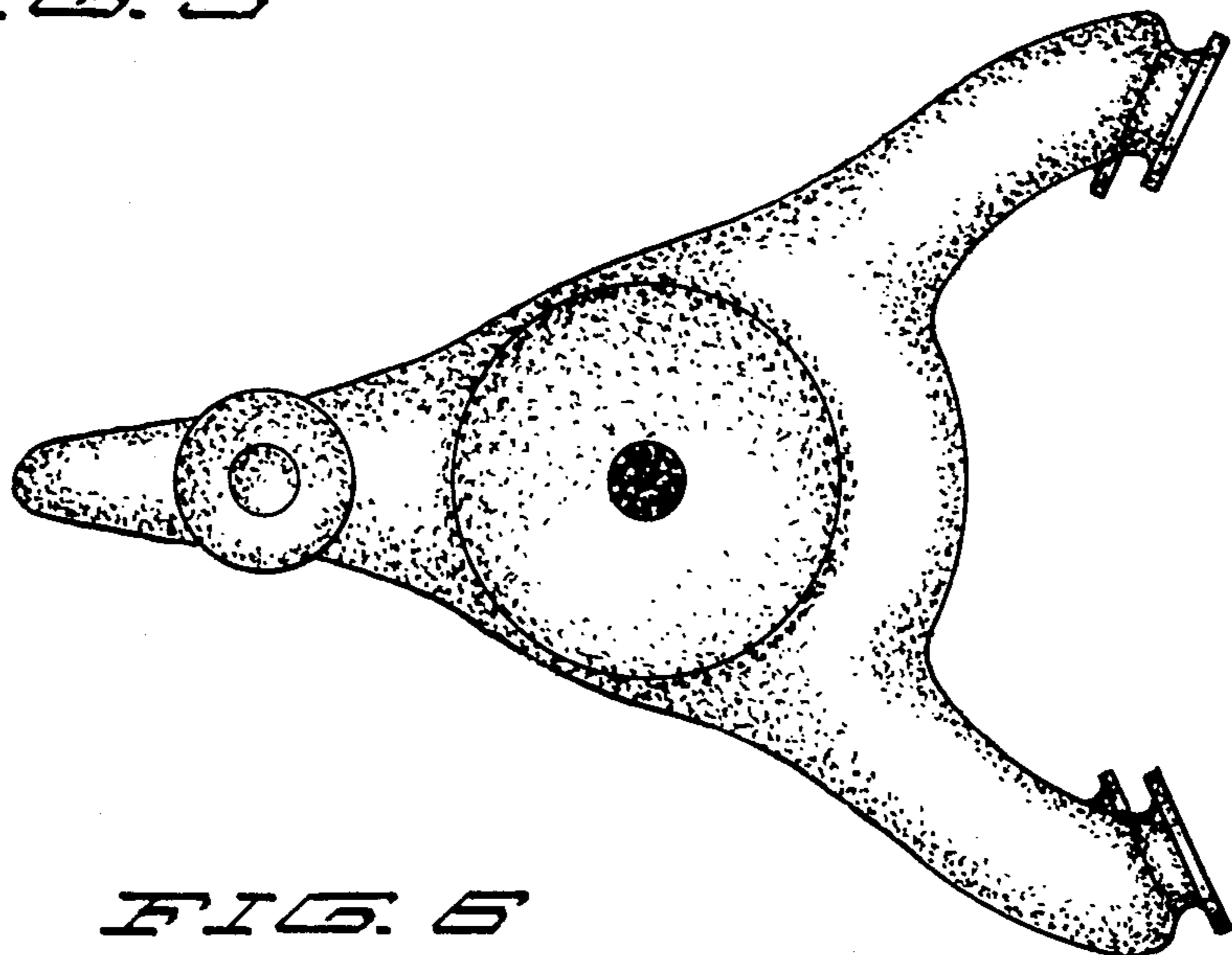
