The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

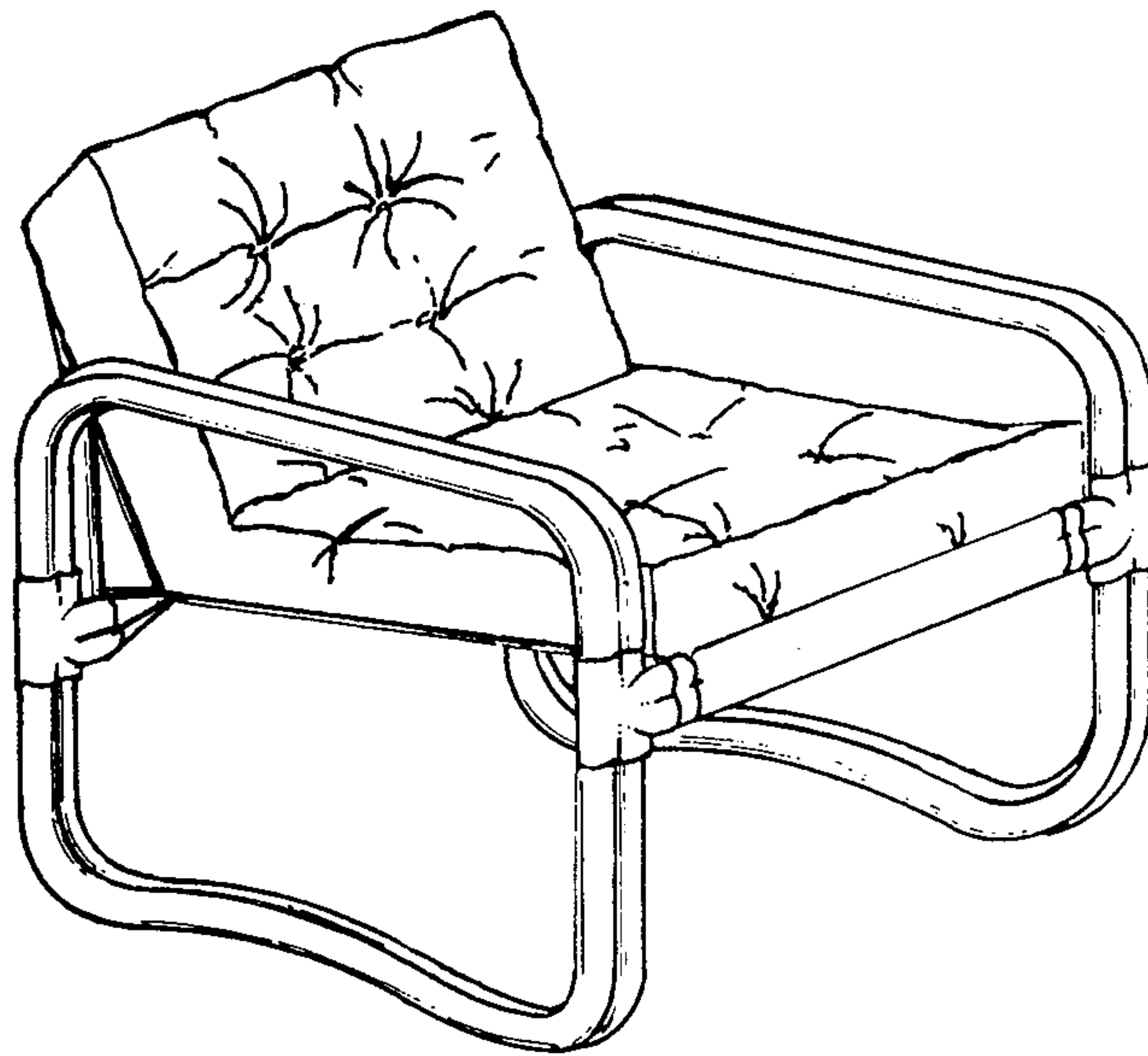
**DESCRIPTION**

The undisclosed rear of the chair is conventional in appearance.



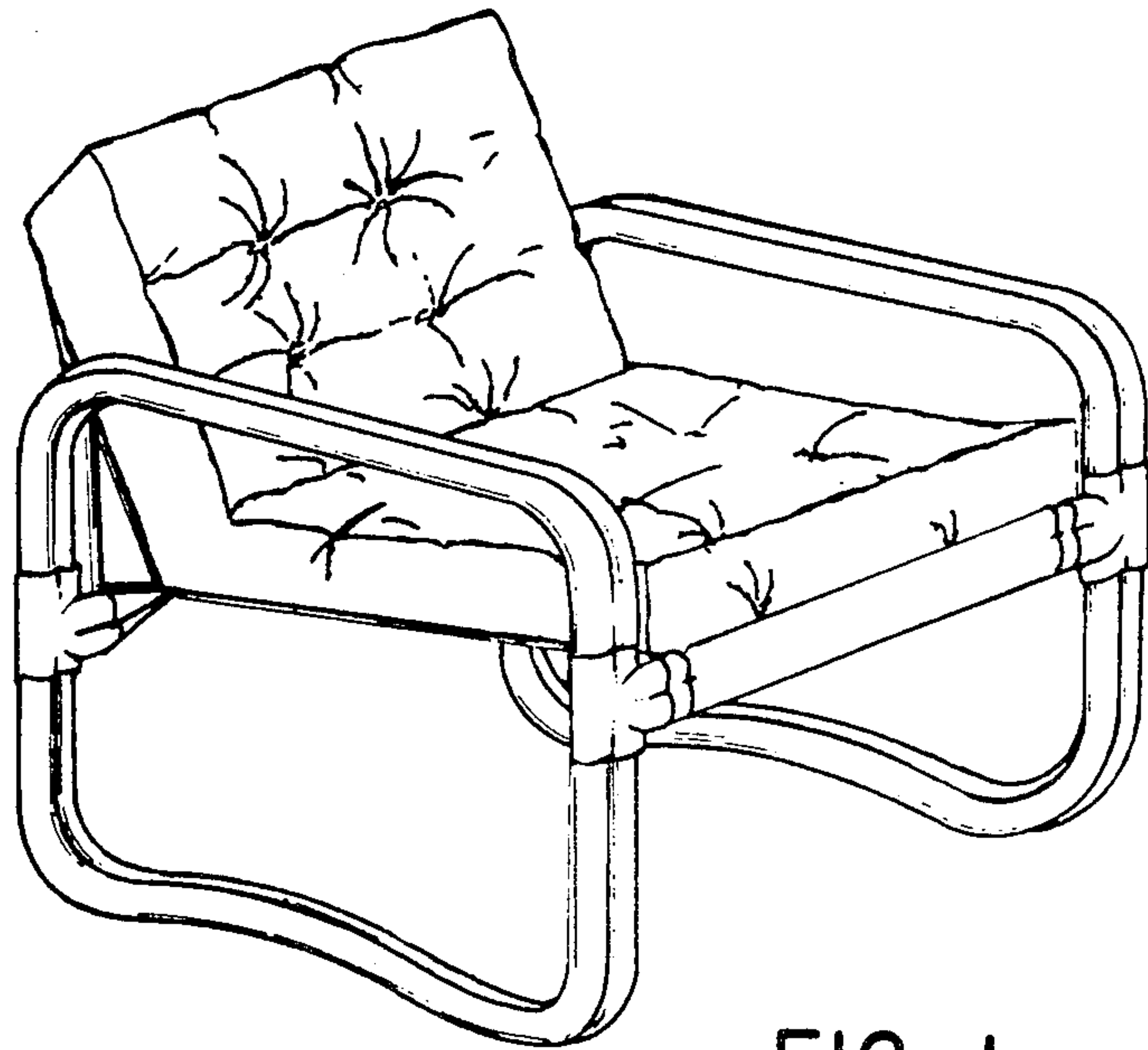

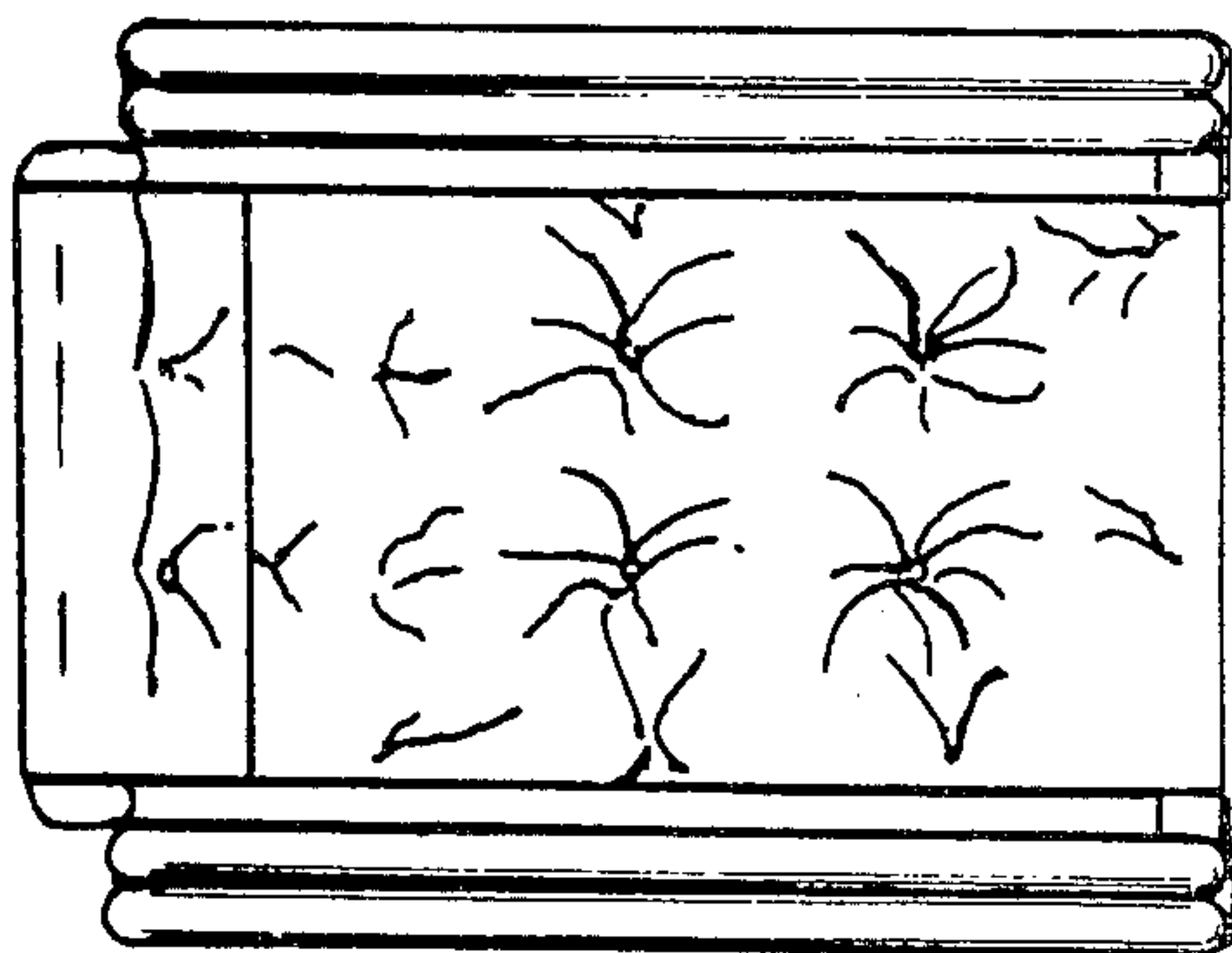

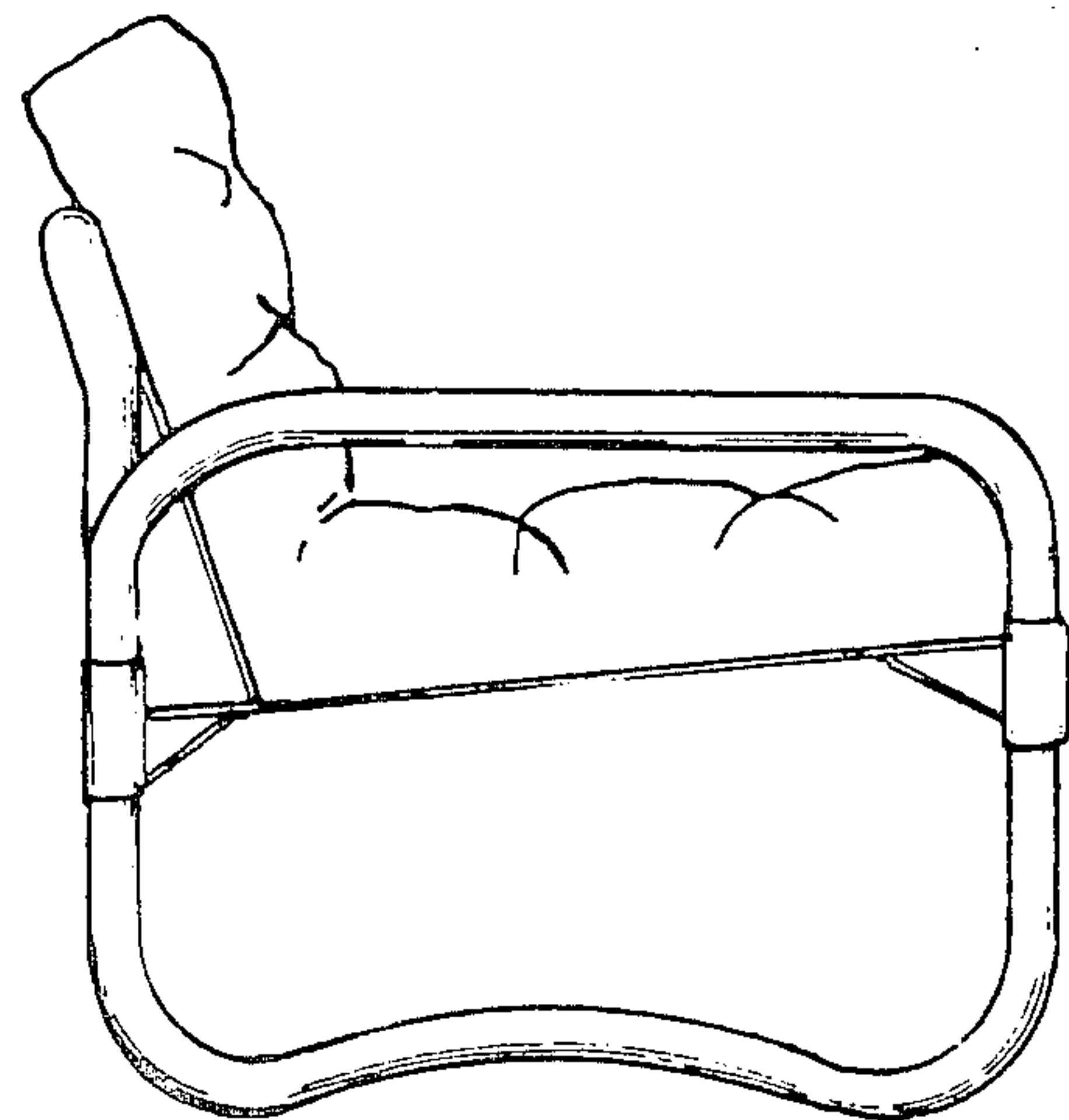
