DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy bus showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

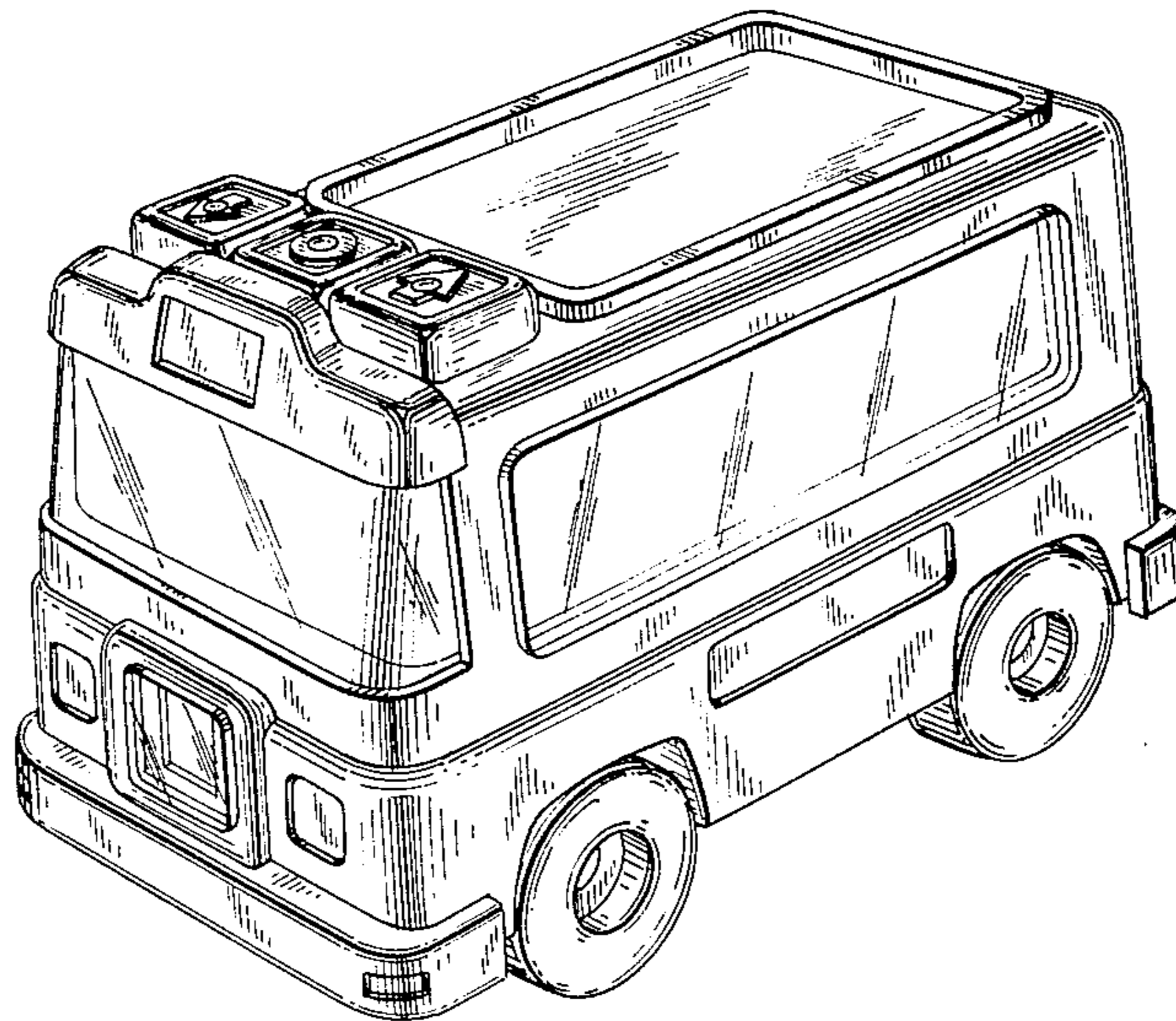

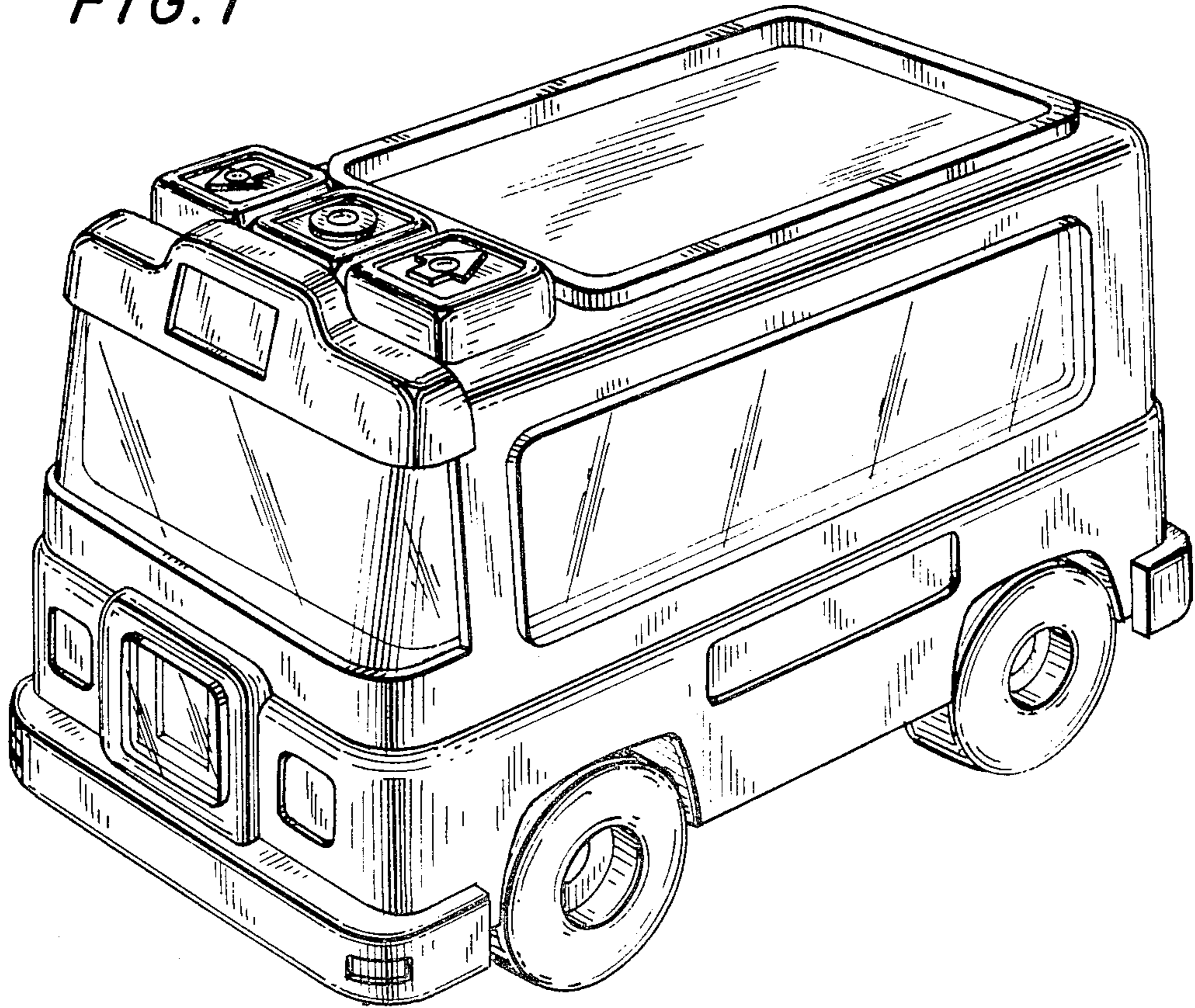

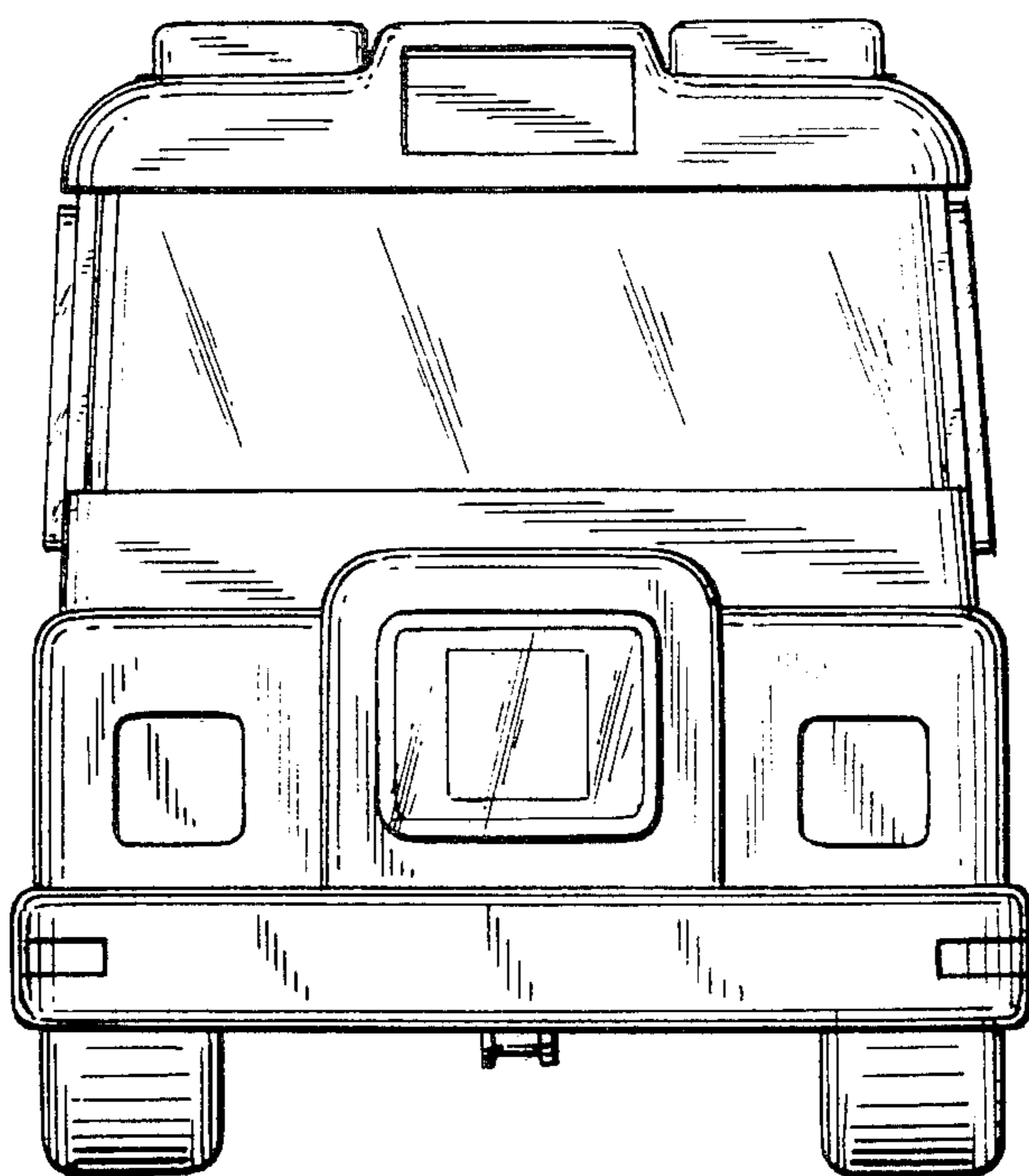

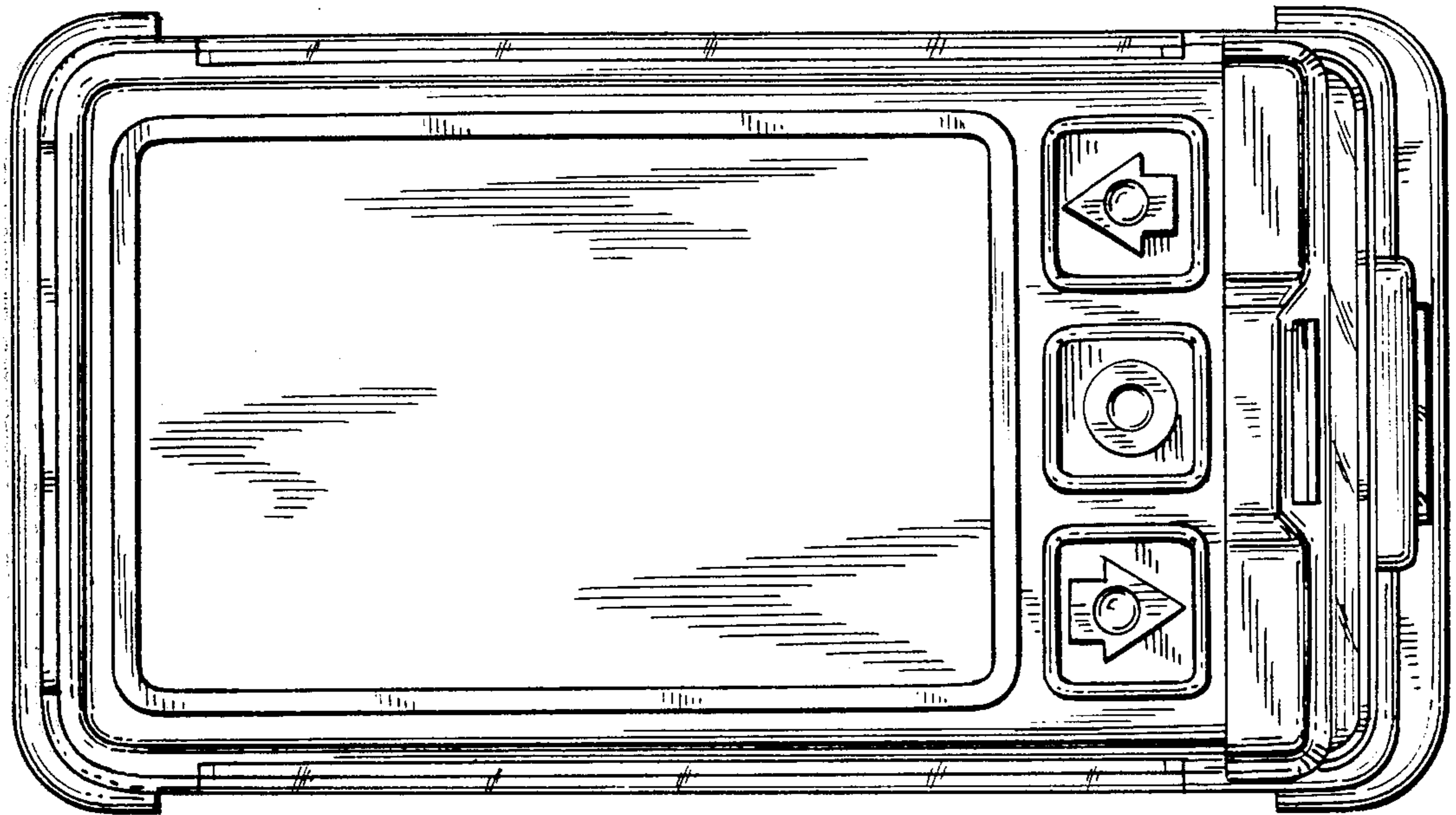

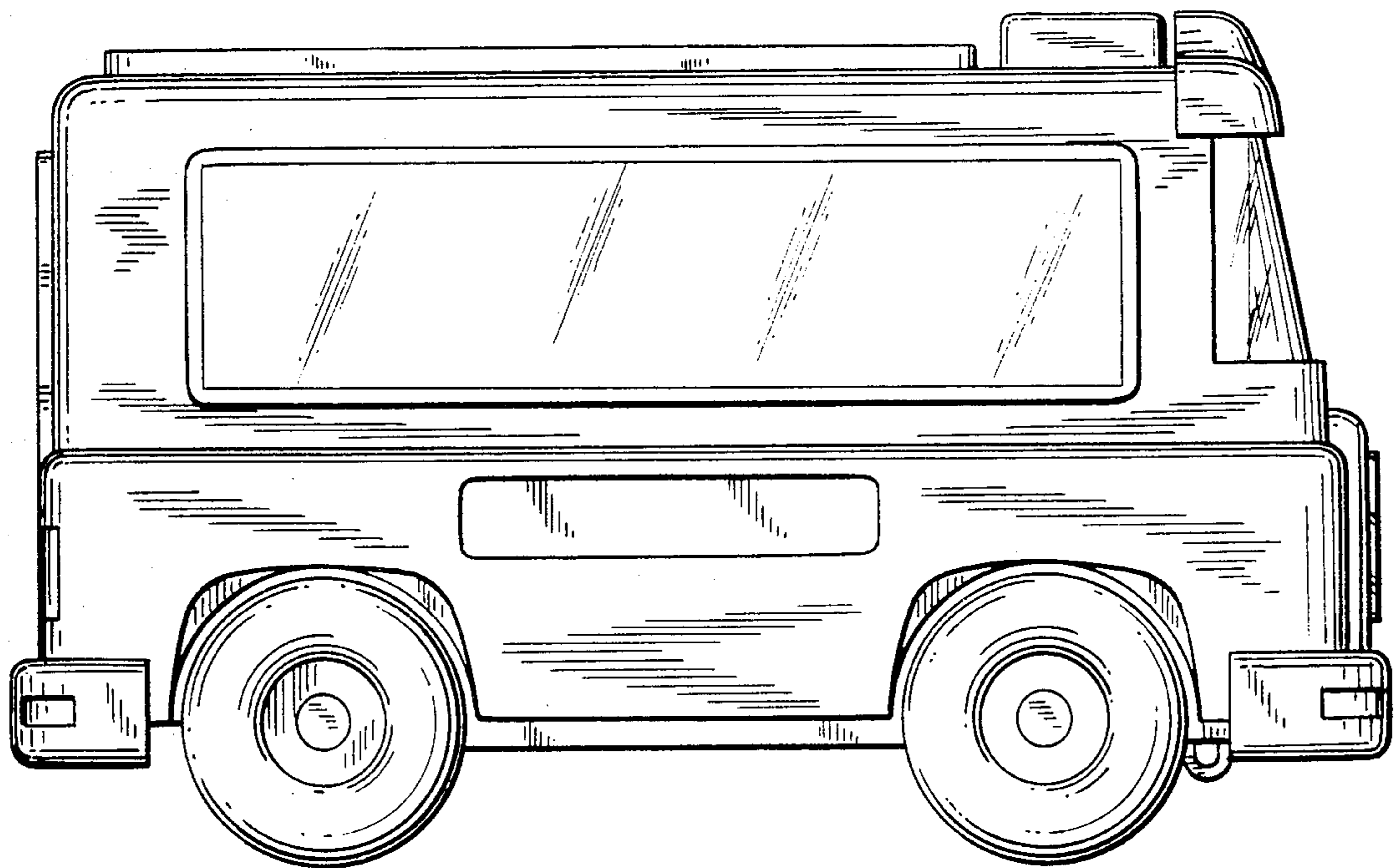

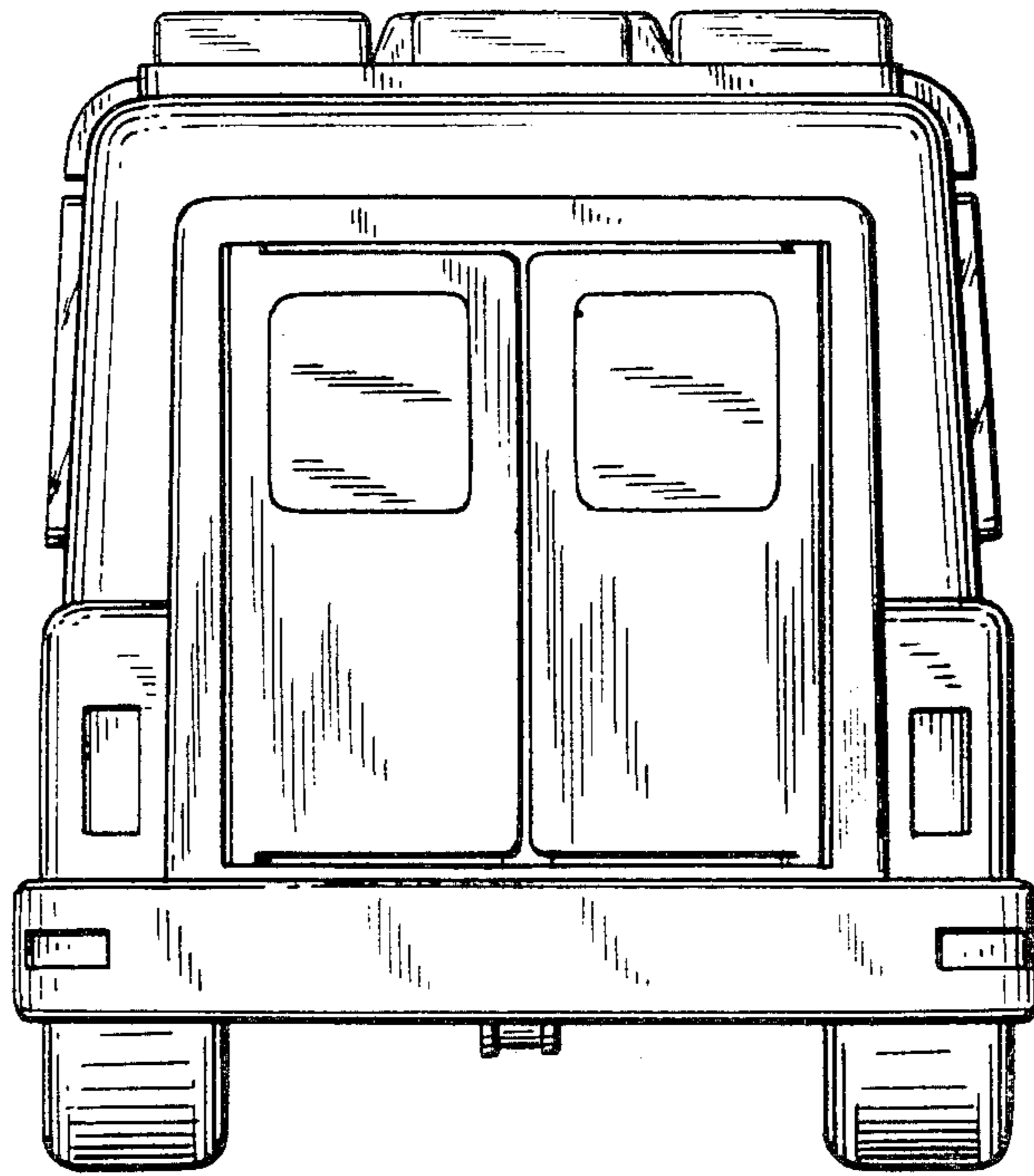
