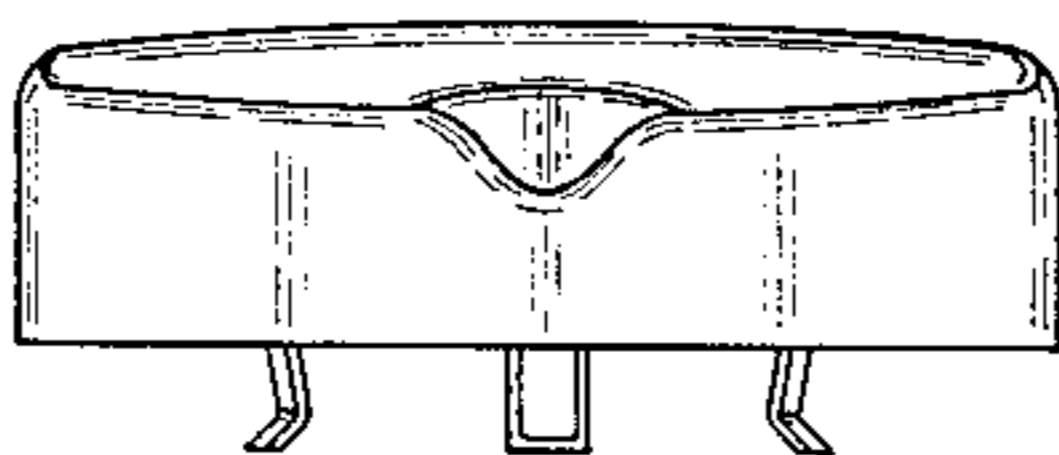
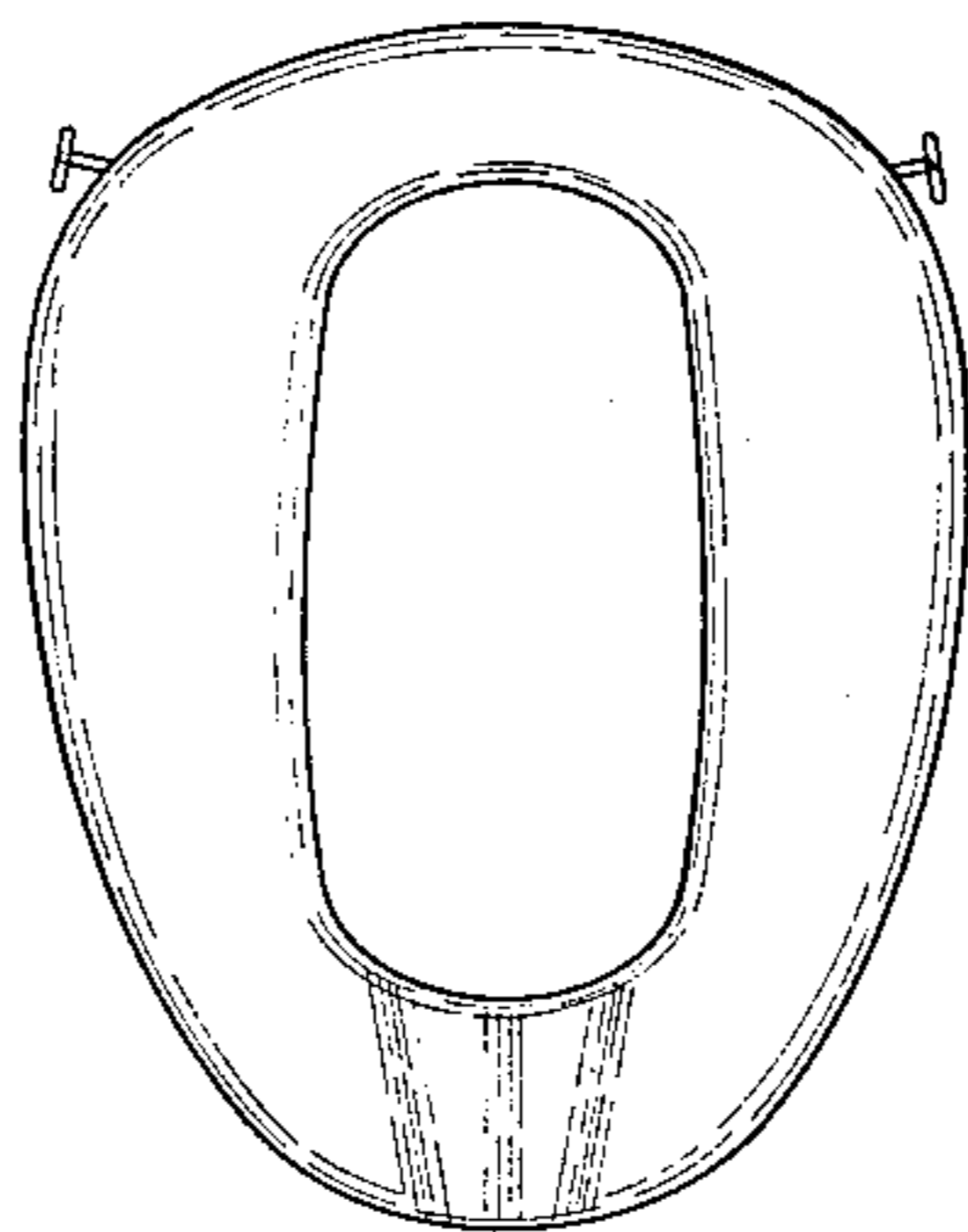

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a raised toilet seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1, is a top plan view of a raised toilet seat showing my new design;
FIG. 2, is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3, is front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4, is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown.



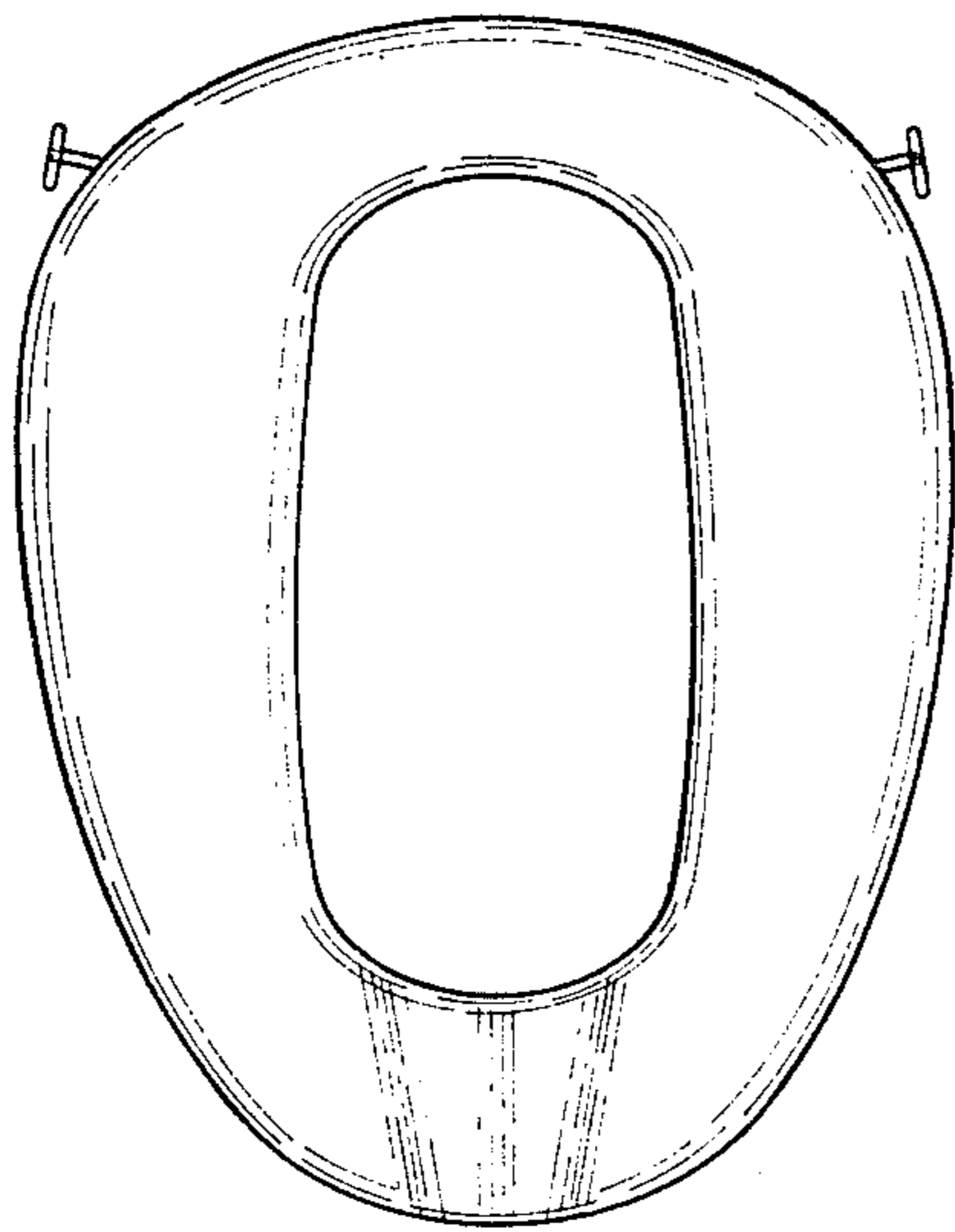

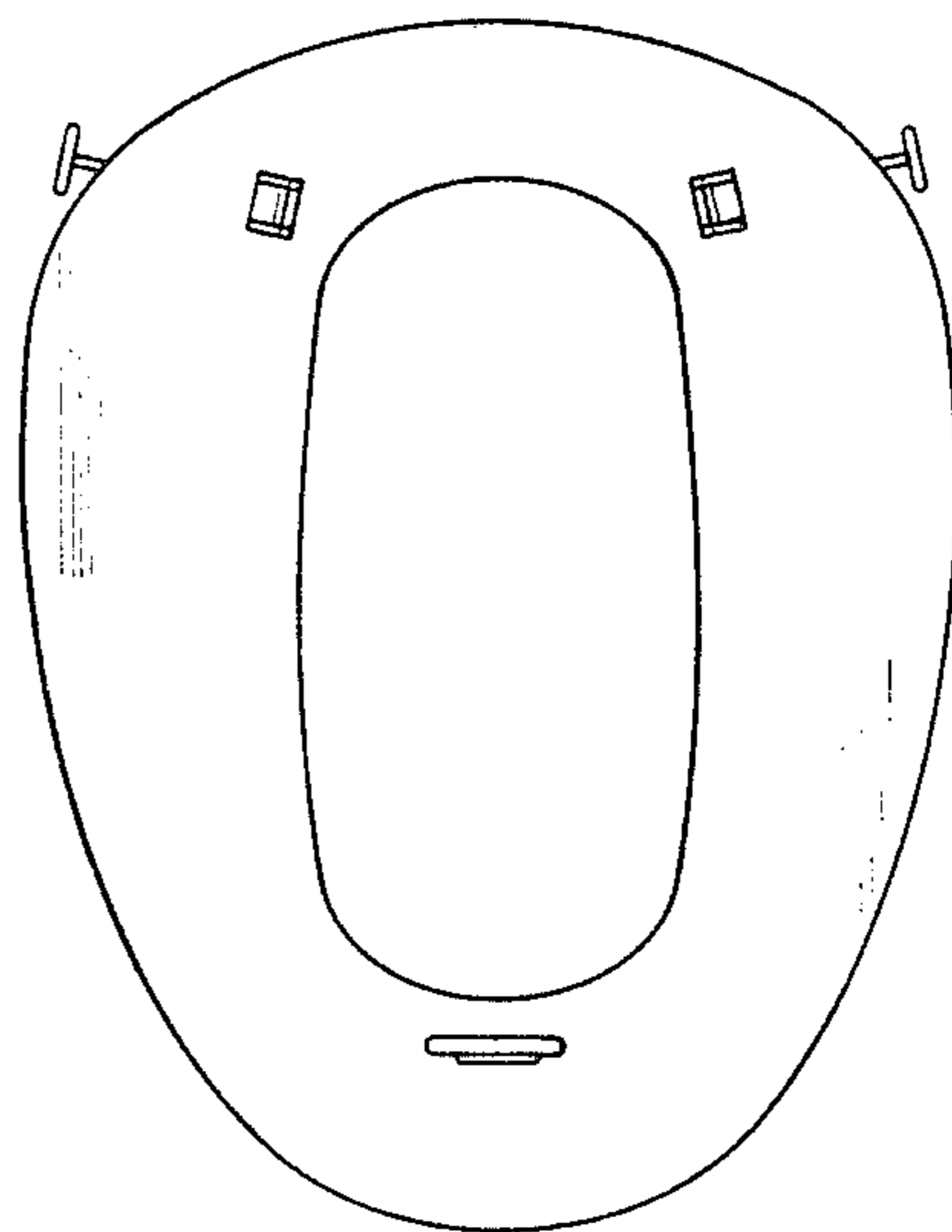

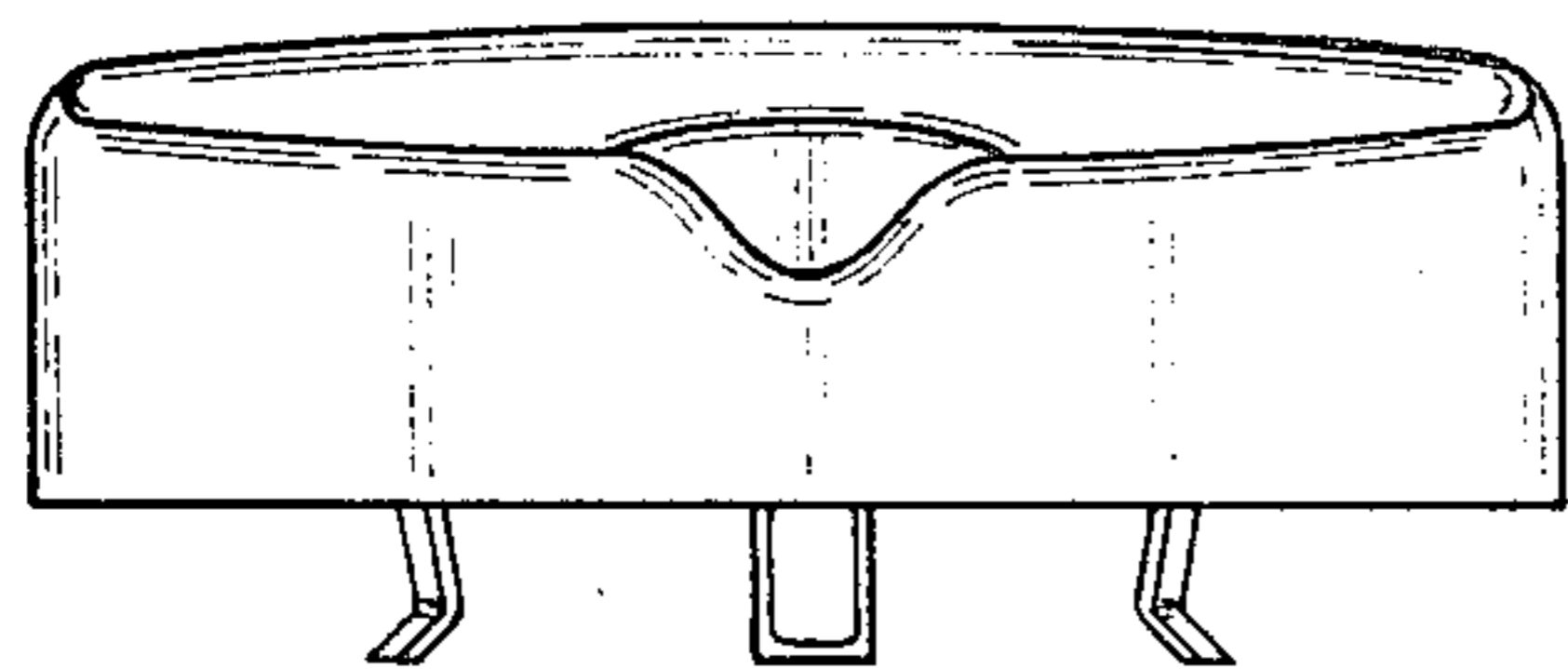

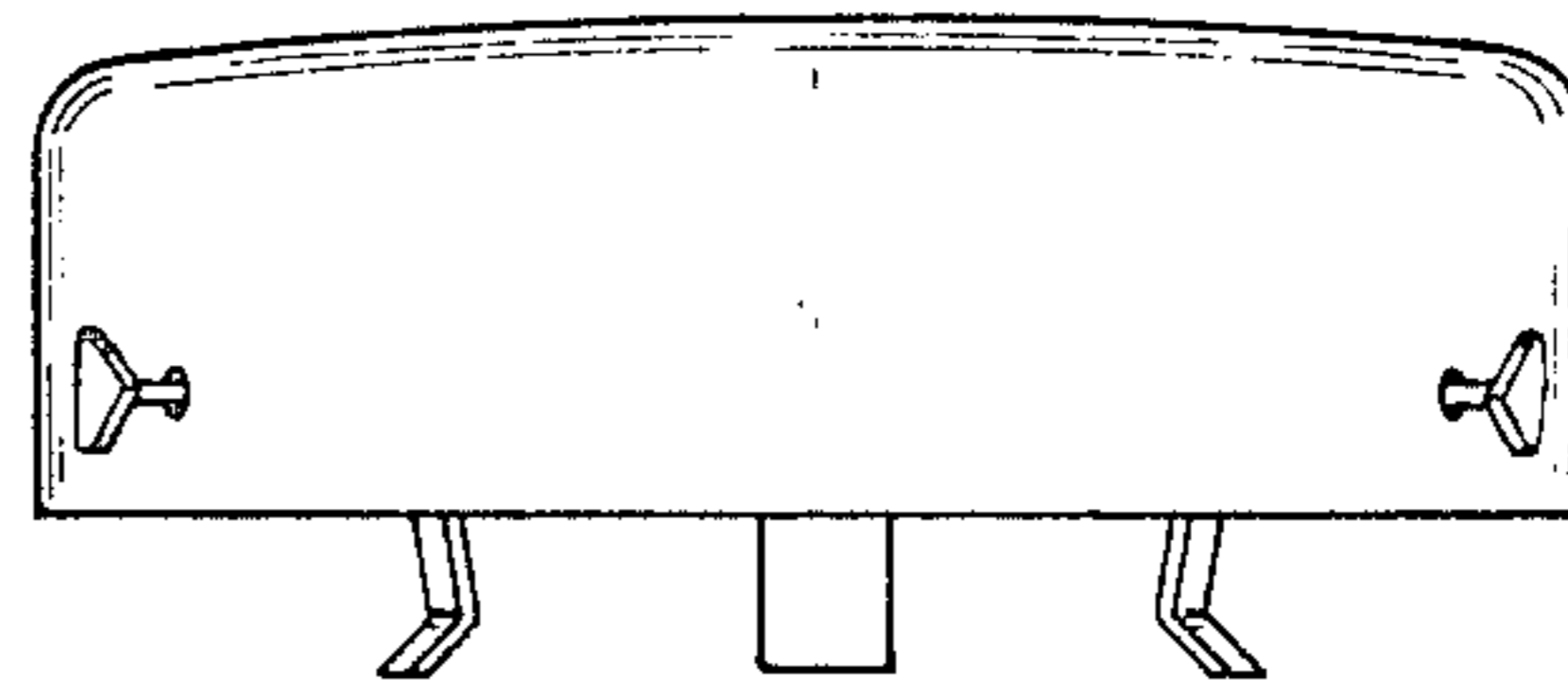

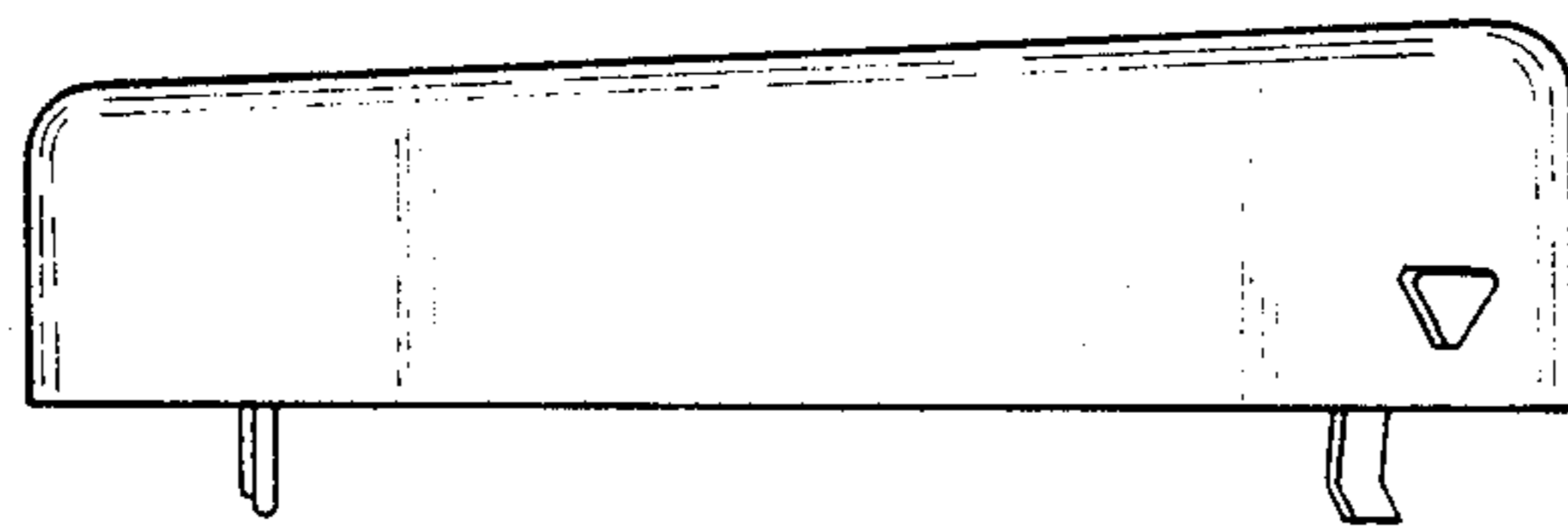
