The ornamental design for an intermittent medical delivery controller, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an intermittent medical delivery controller embodying our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a back elevational view of the intermittent delivery system showing the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1.

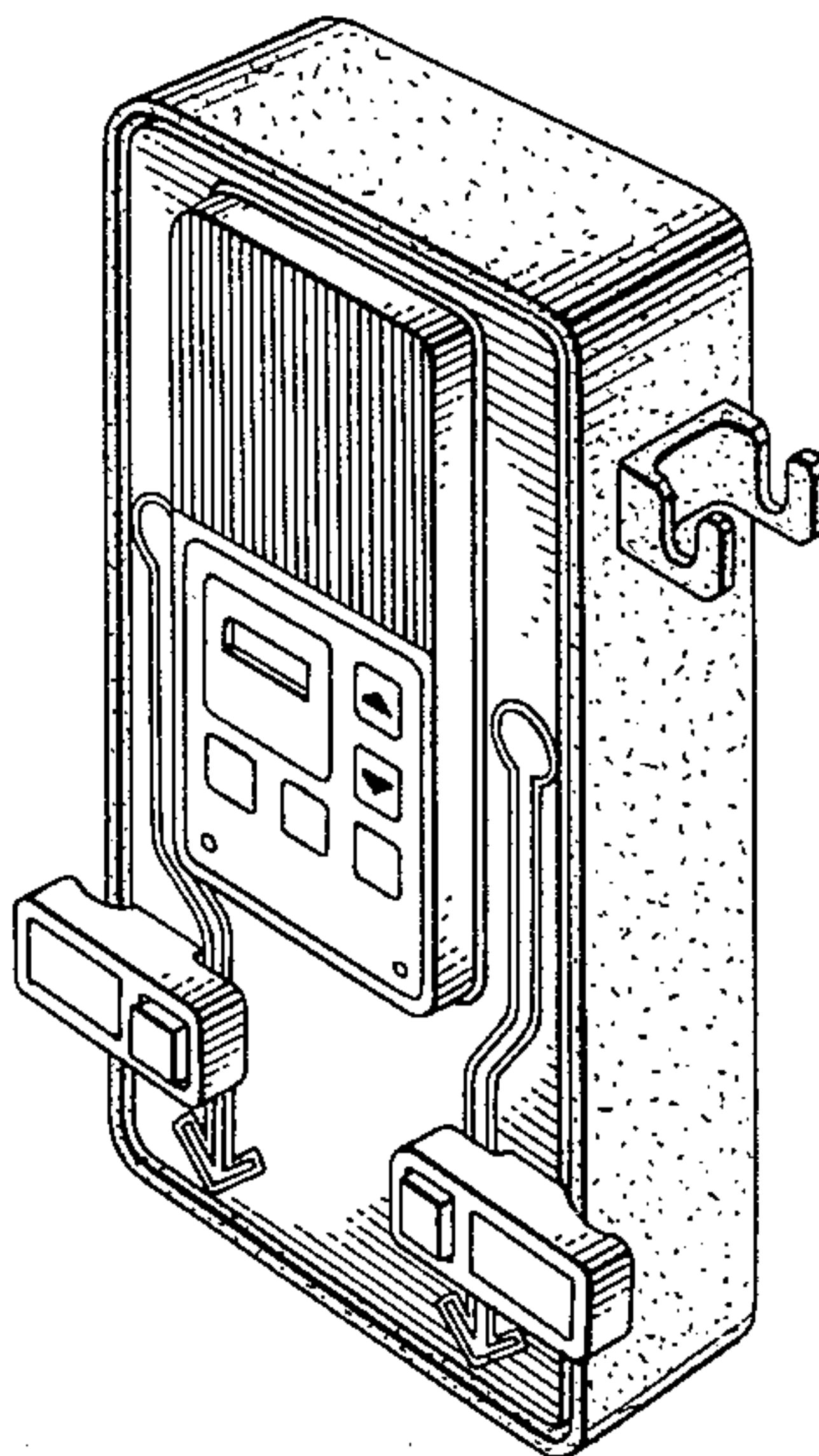

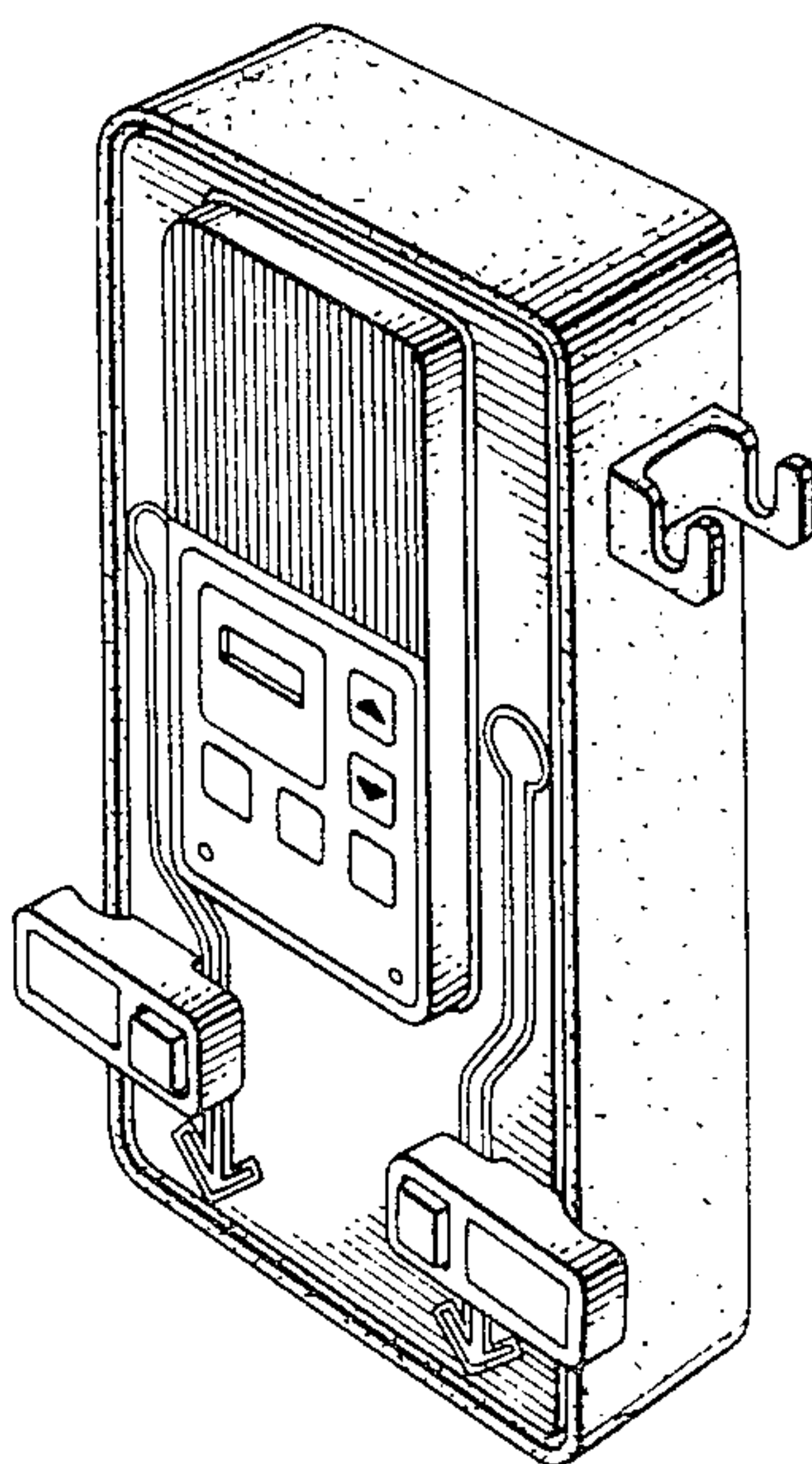

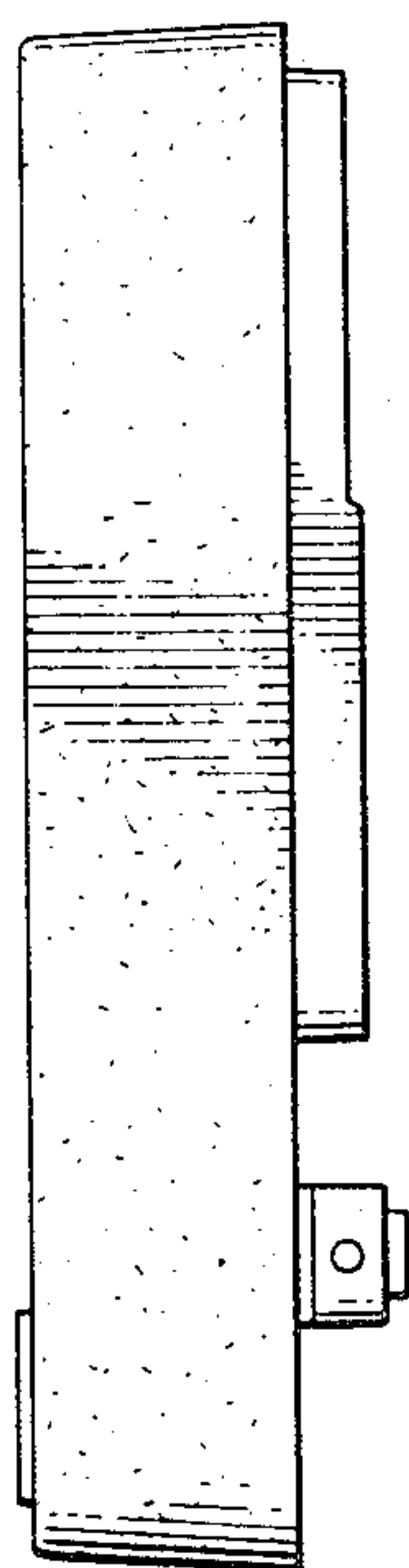

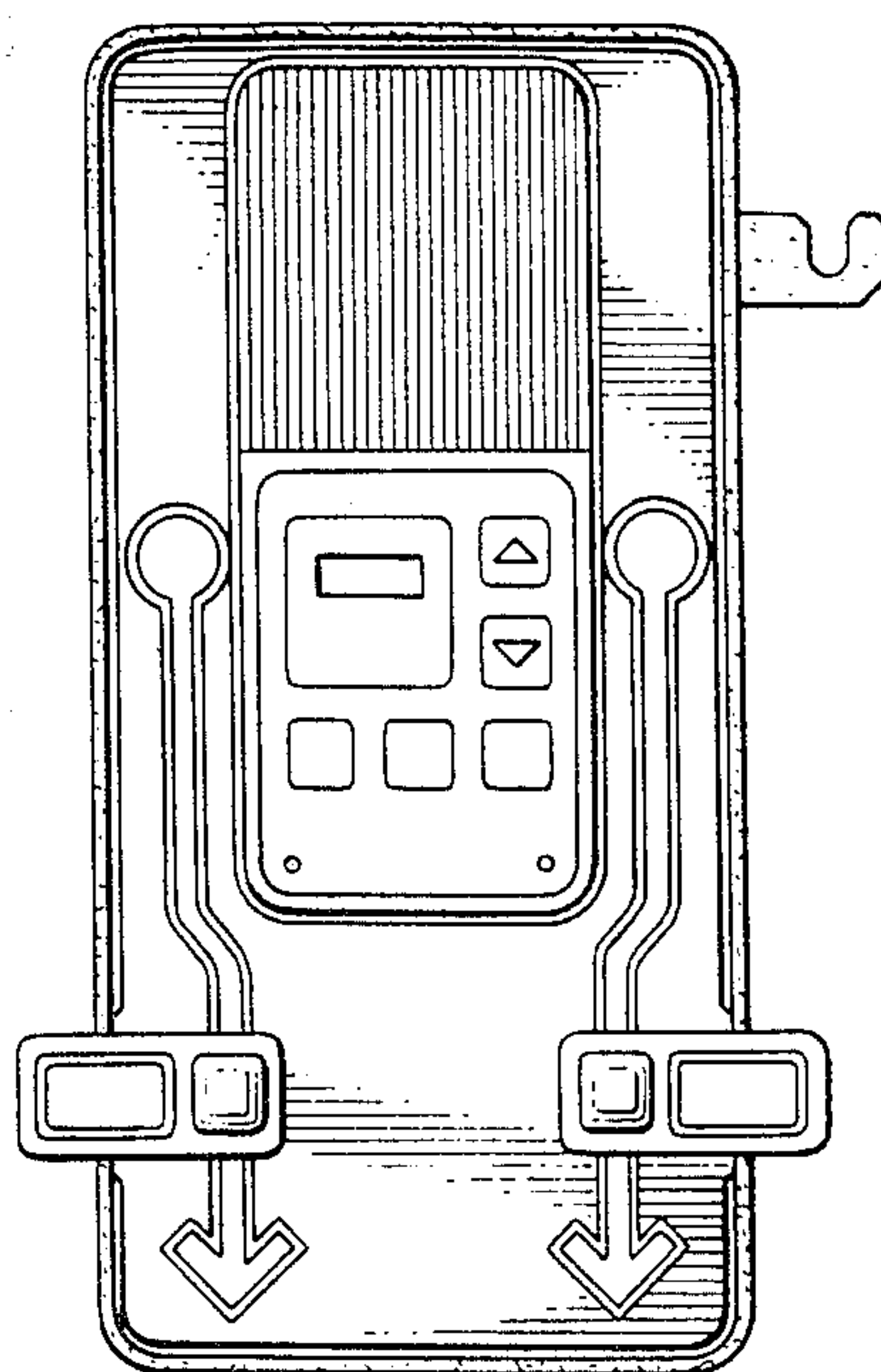

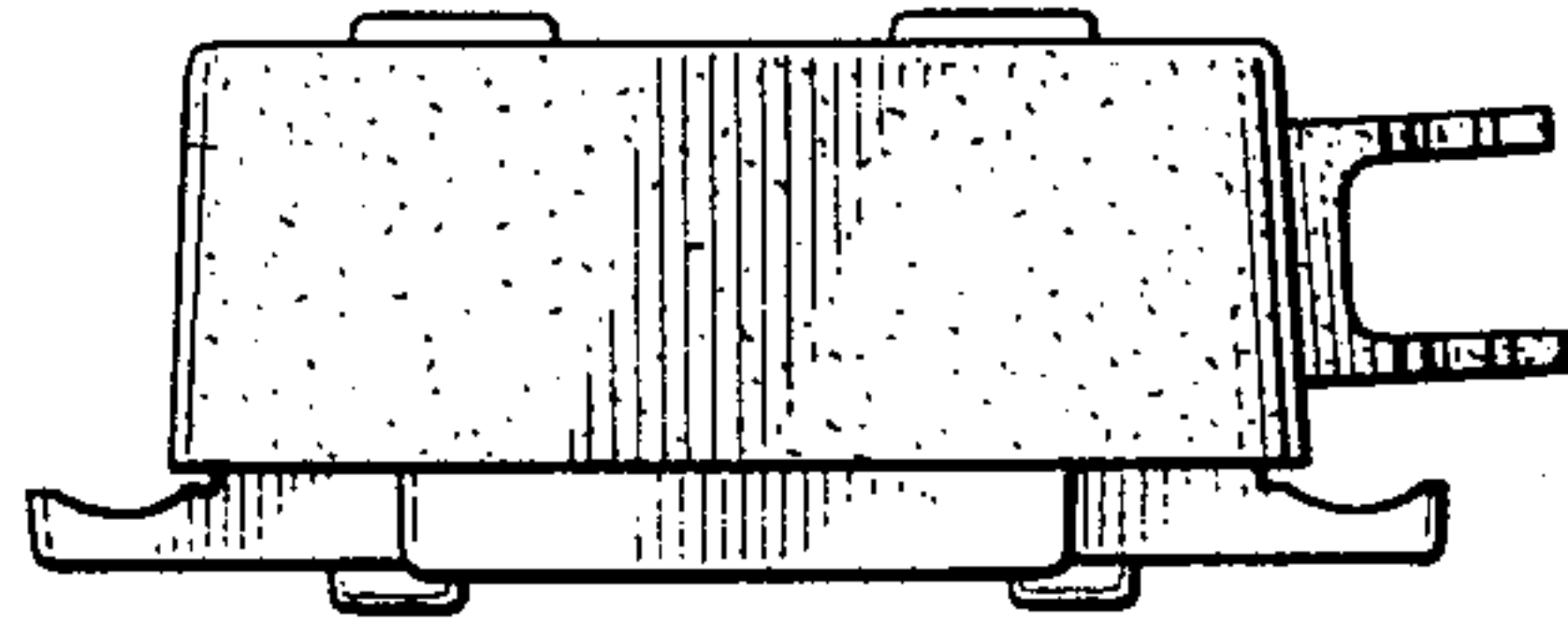

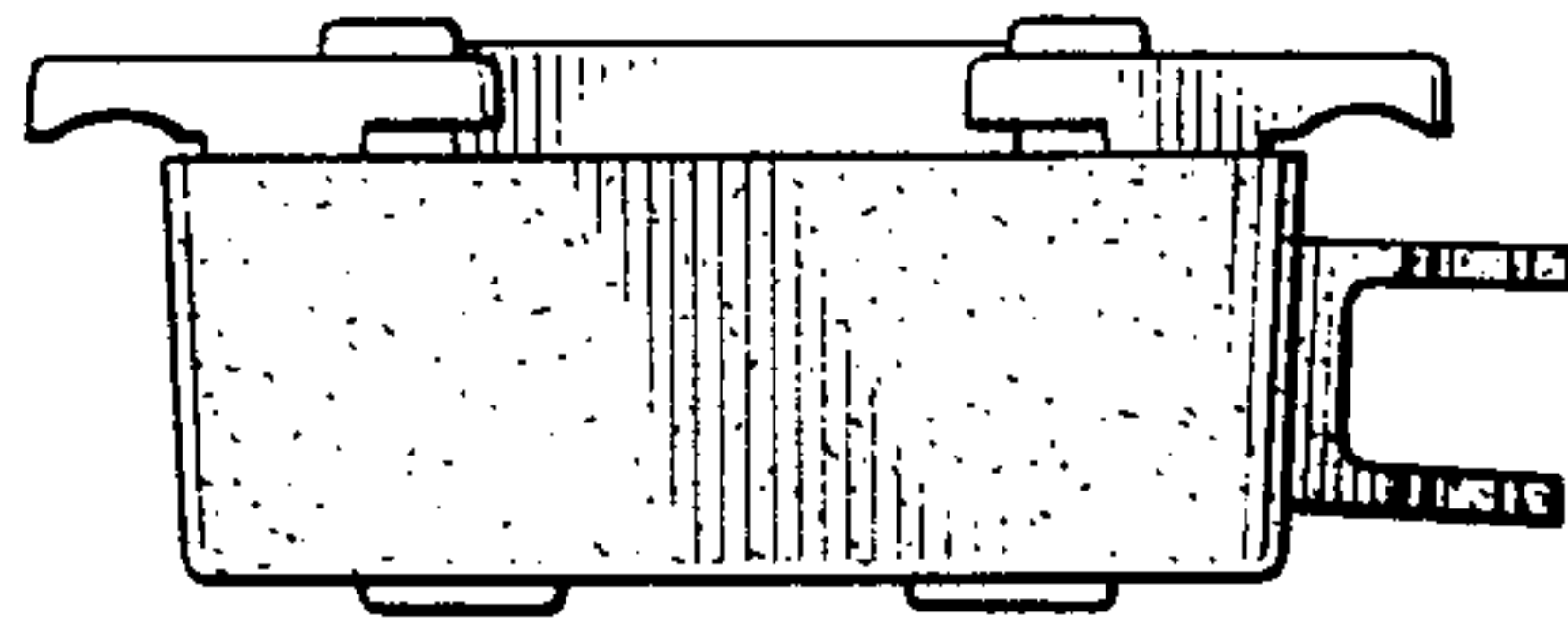

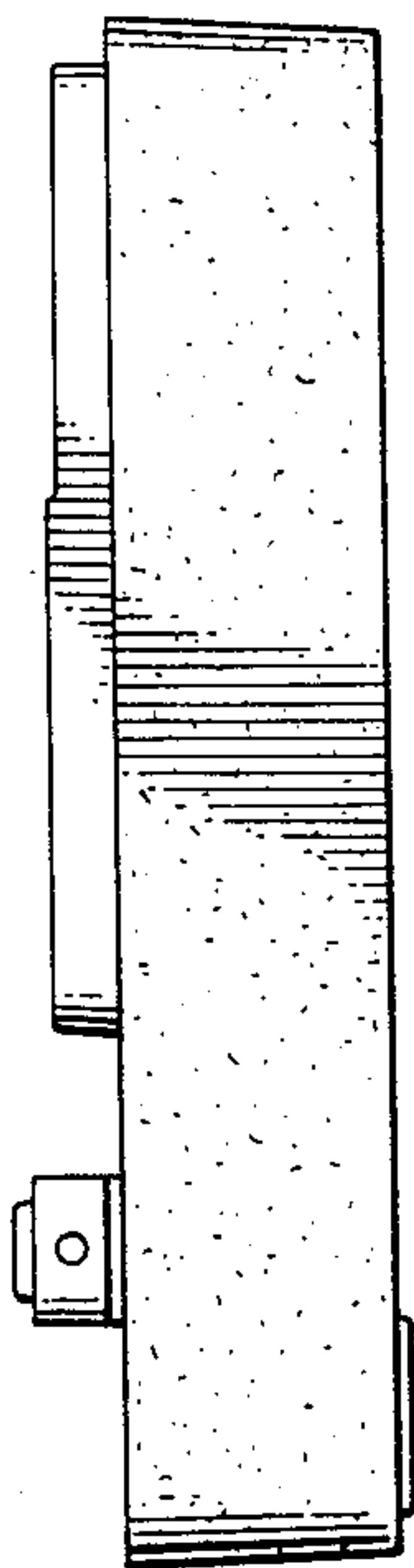
