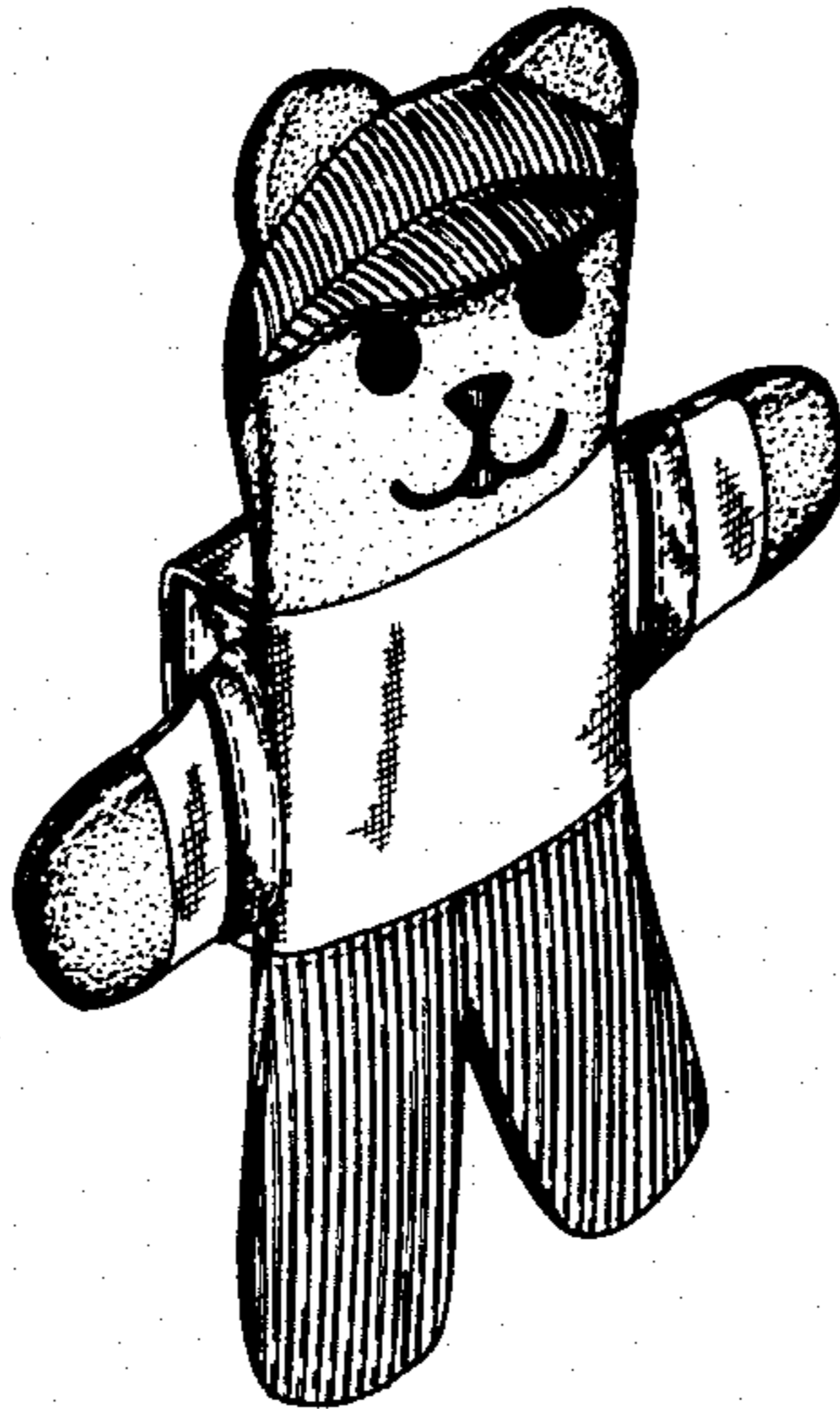

The ornamental design for a toy bear figure with back-
pack, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a back elevational view thereof.



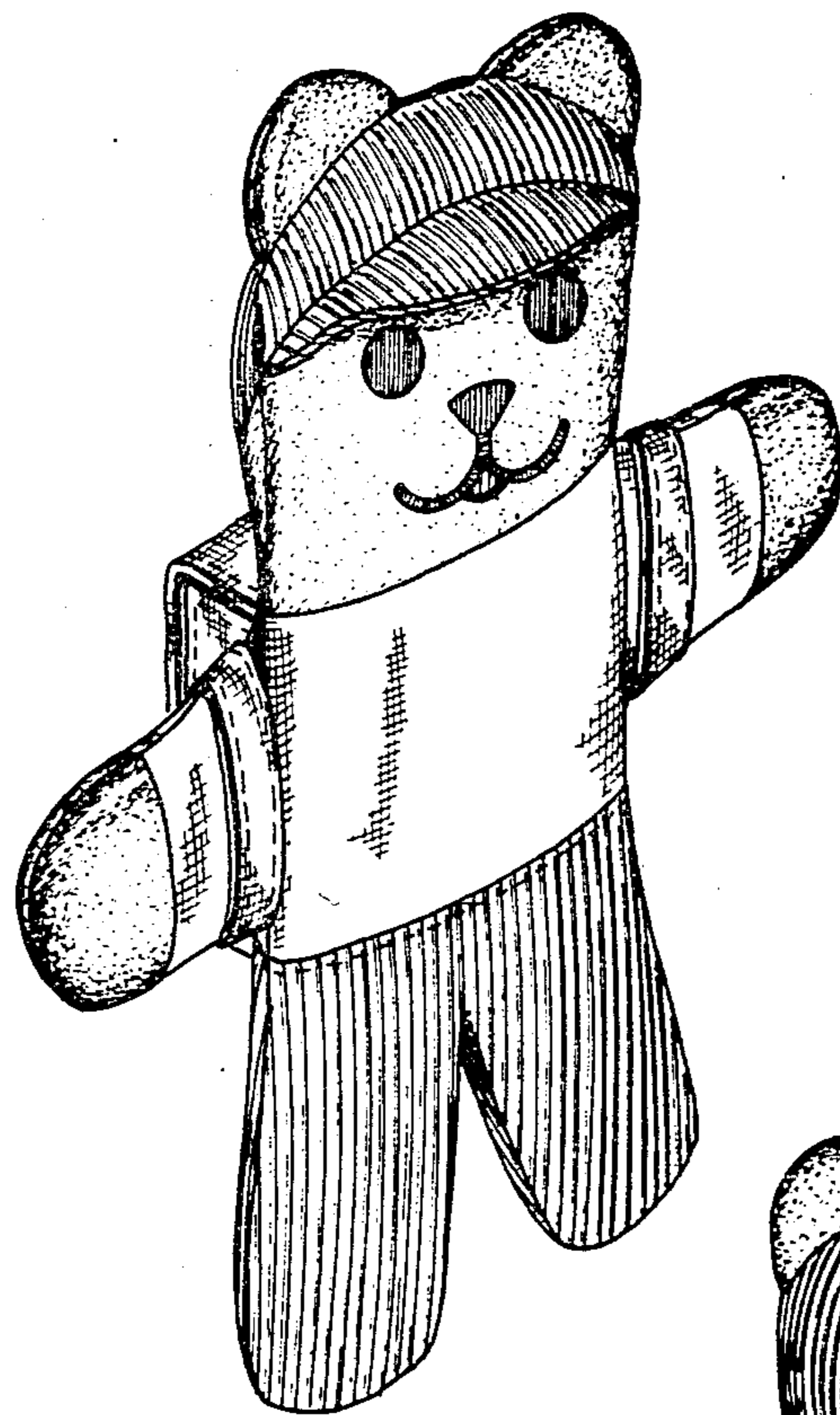

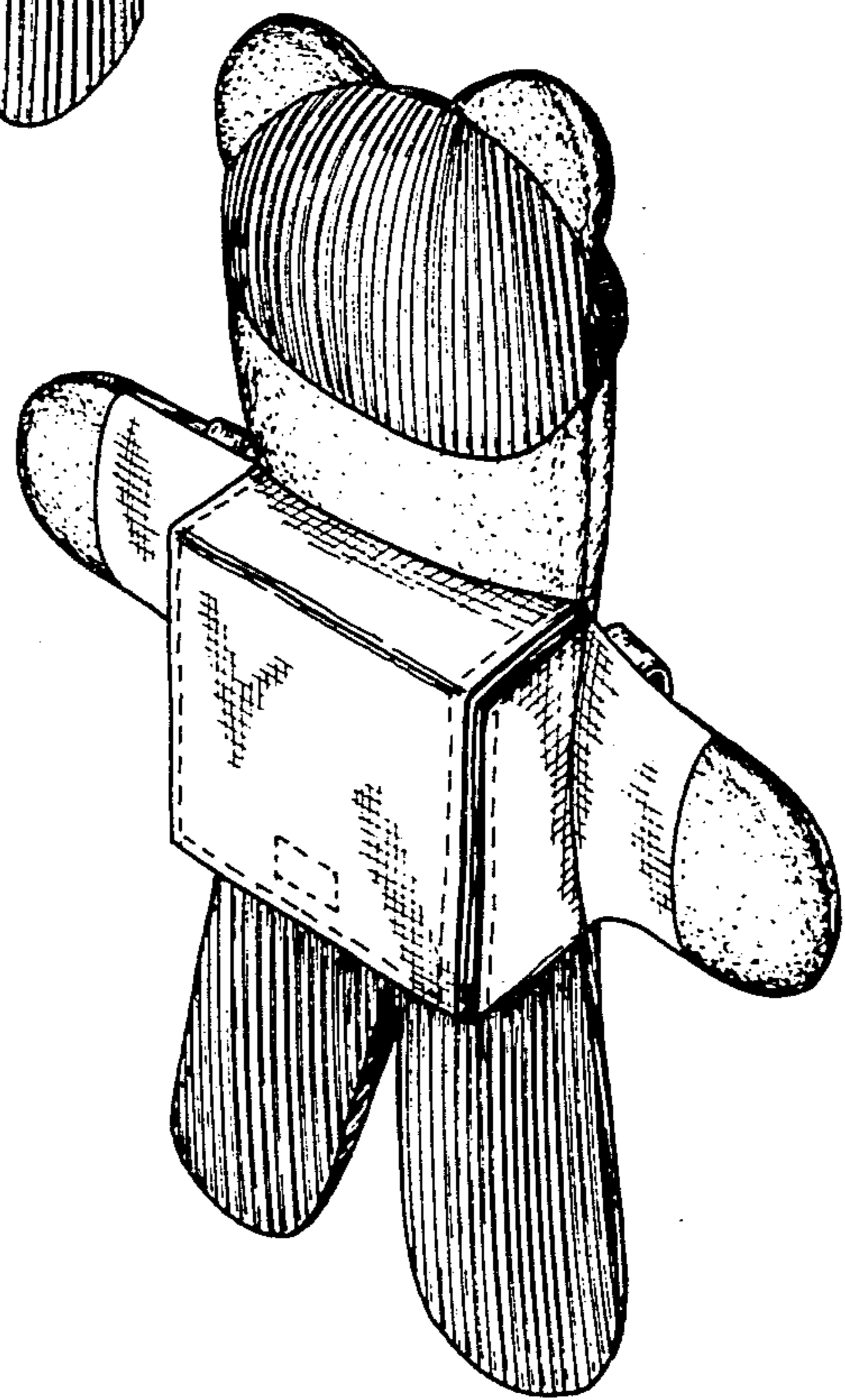

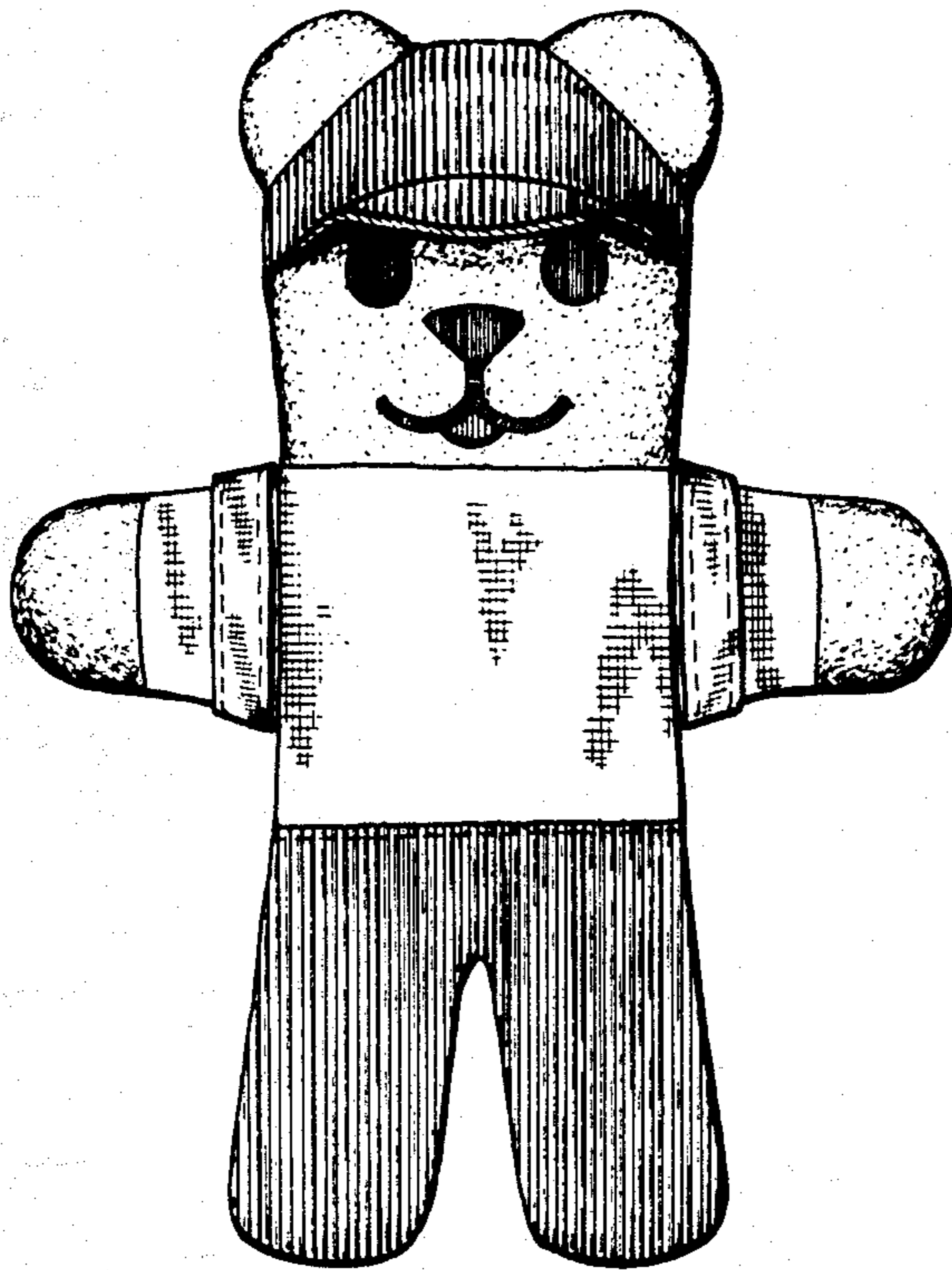

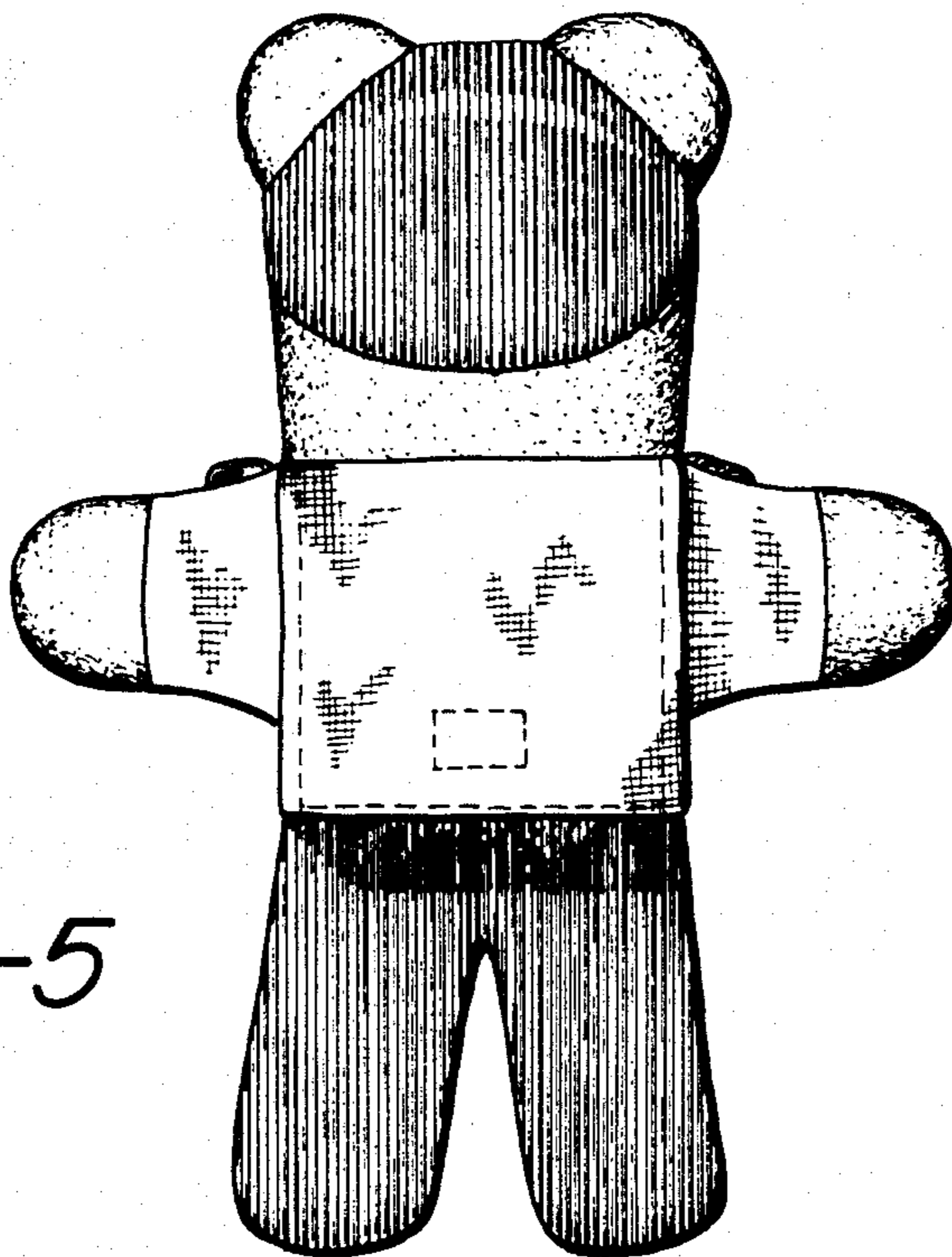
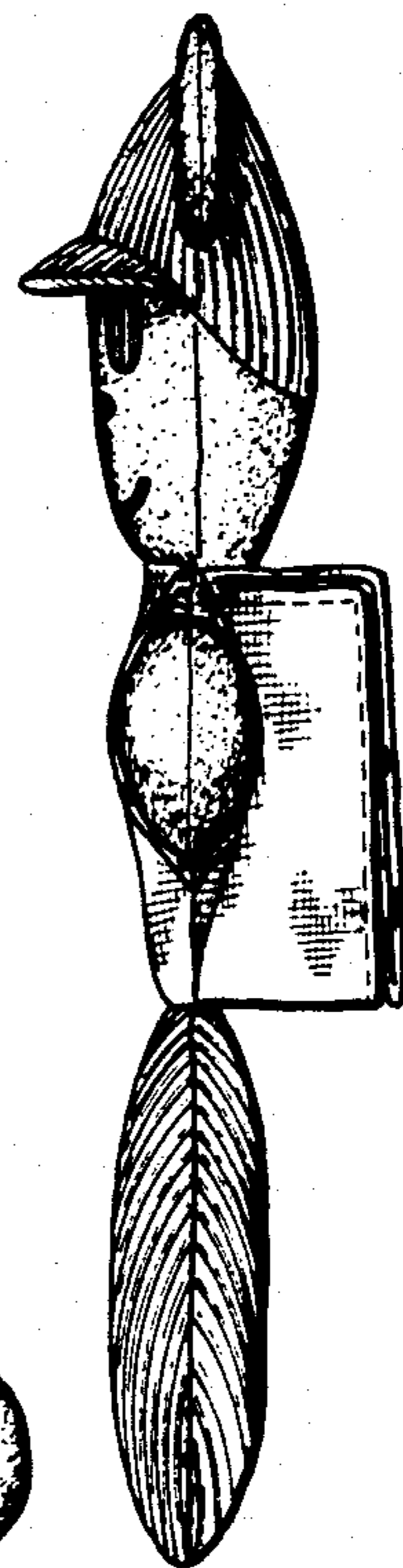
