The ornamental design for a bromine dispenser for hot tubs, as shown and described.

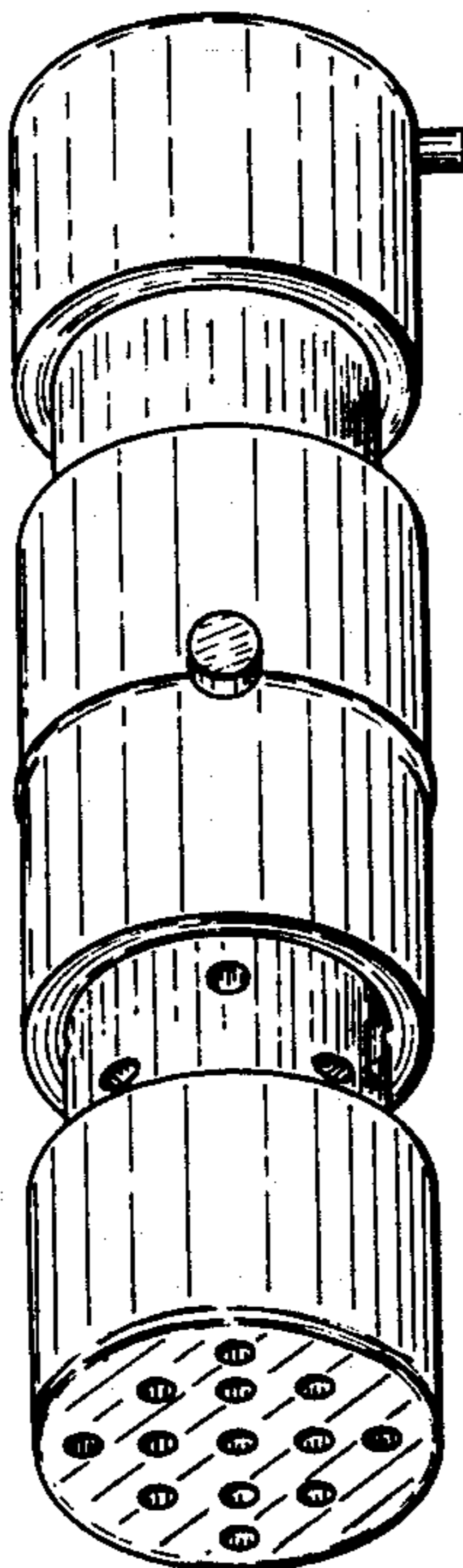

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the bottom and front of a bromine dispenser for hot tubs showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



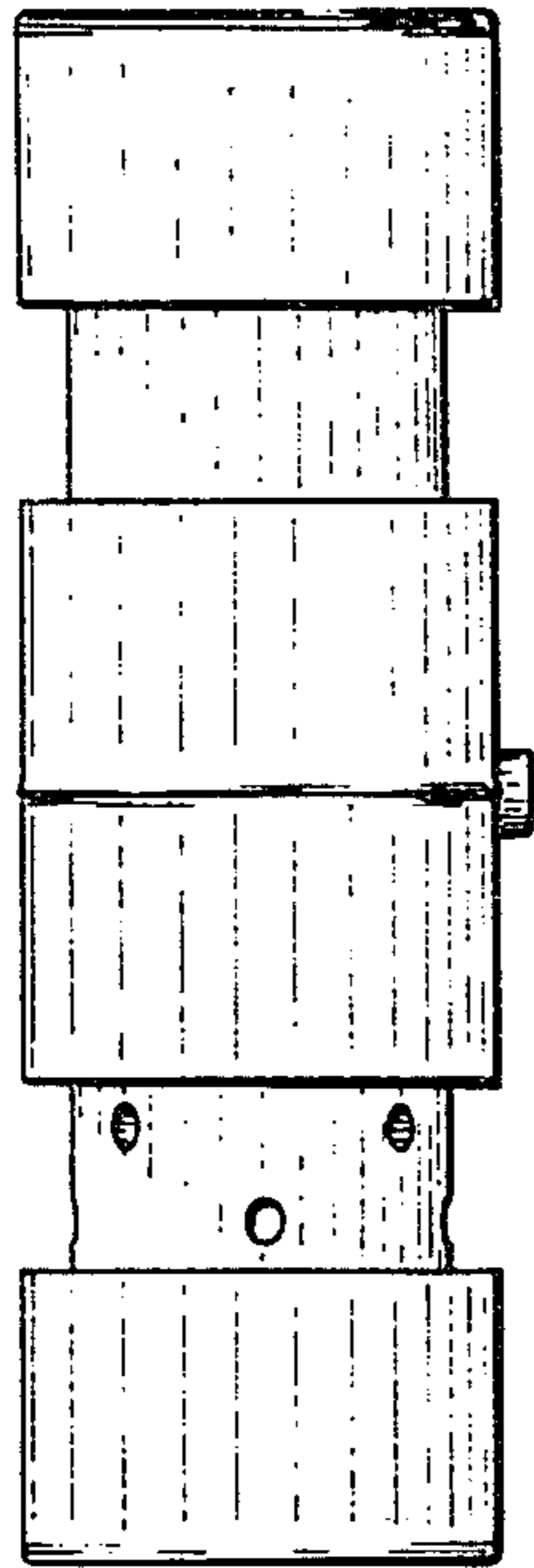

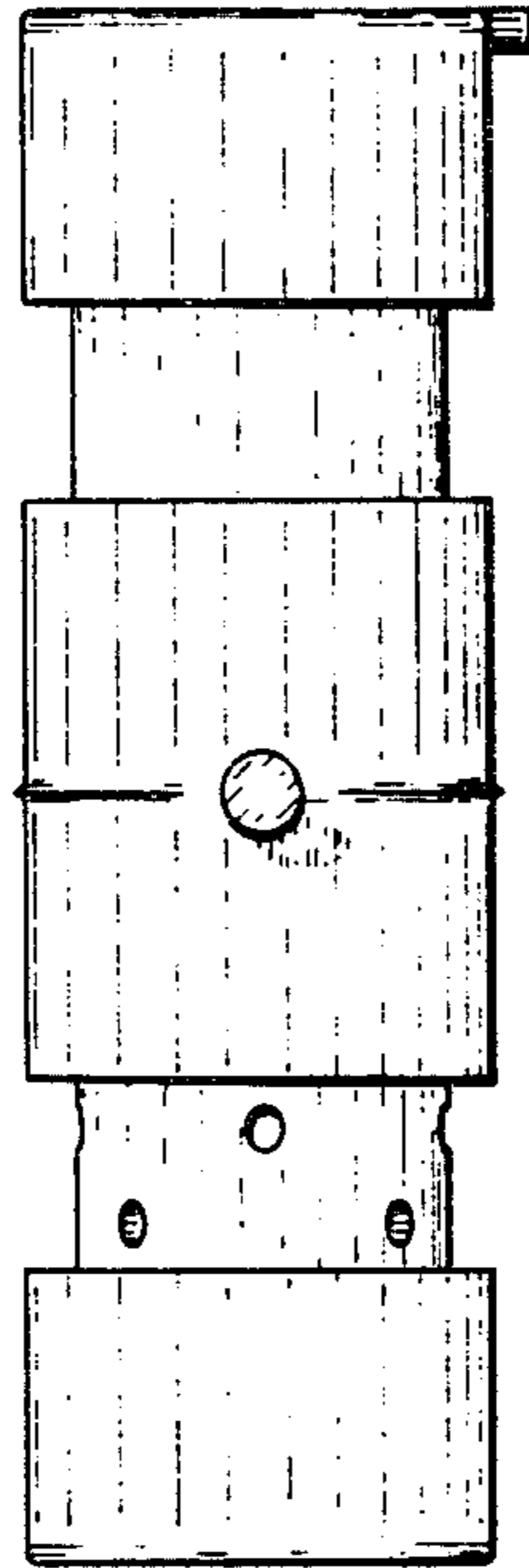

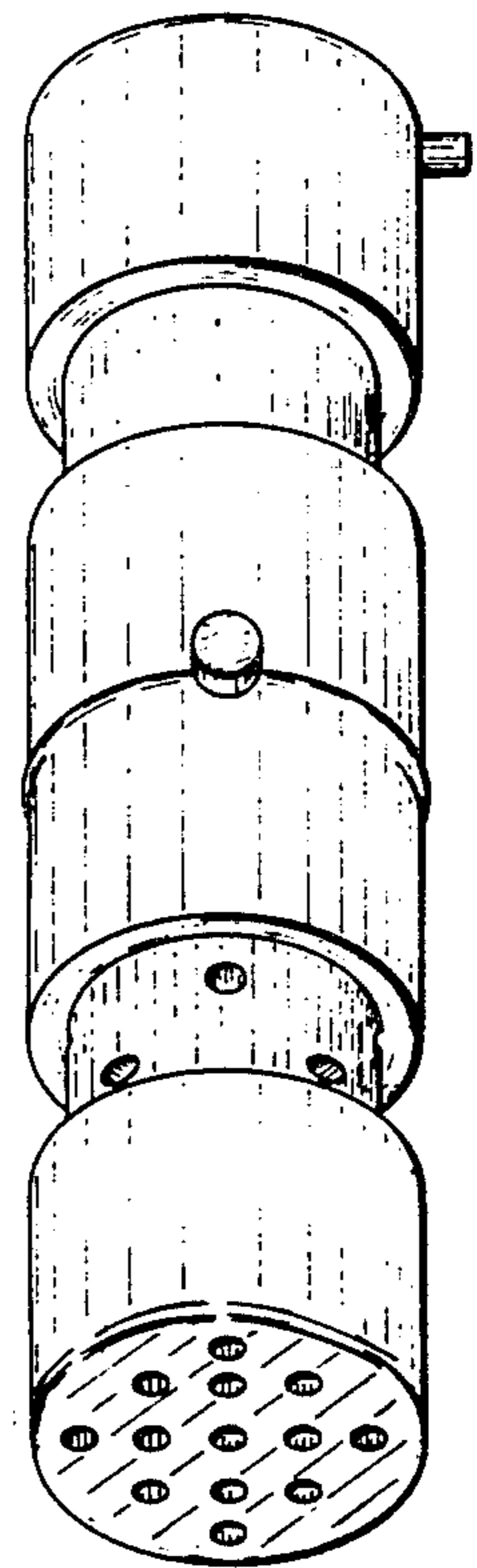

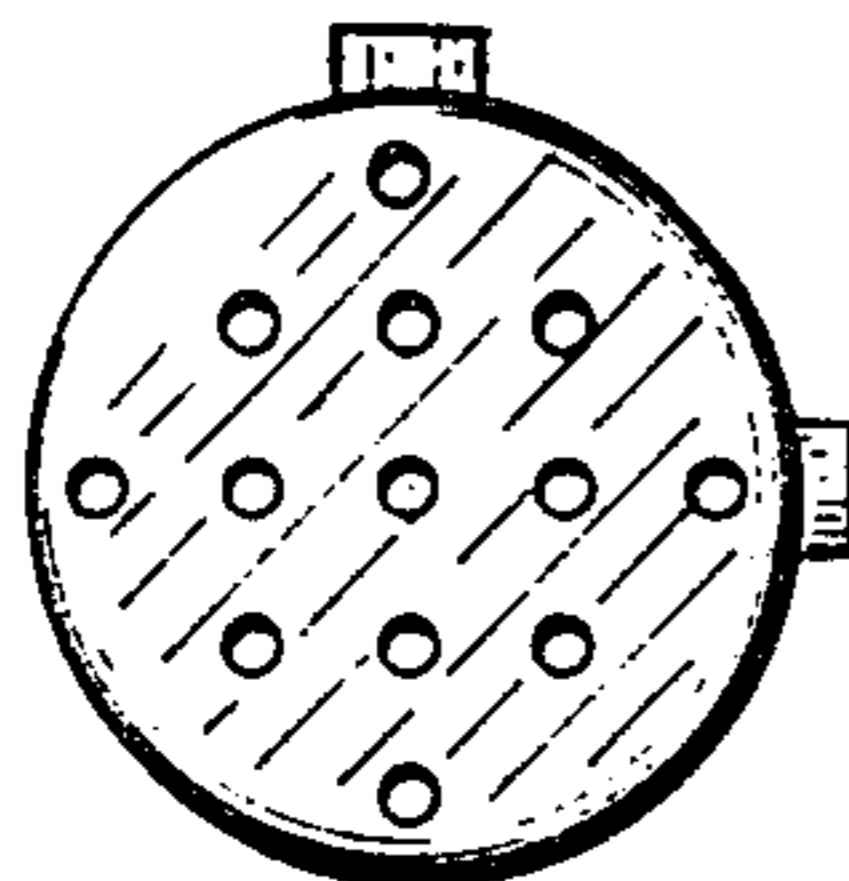

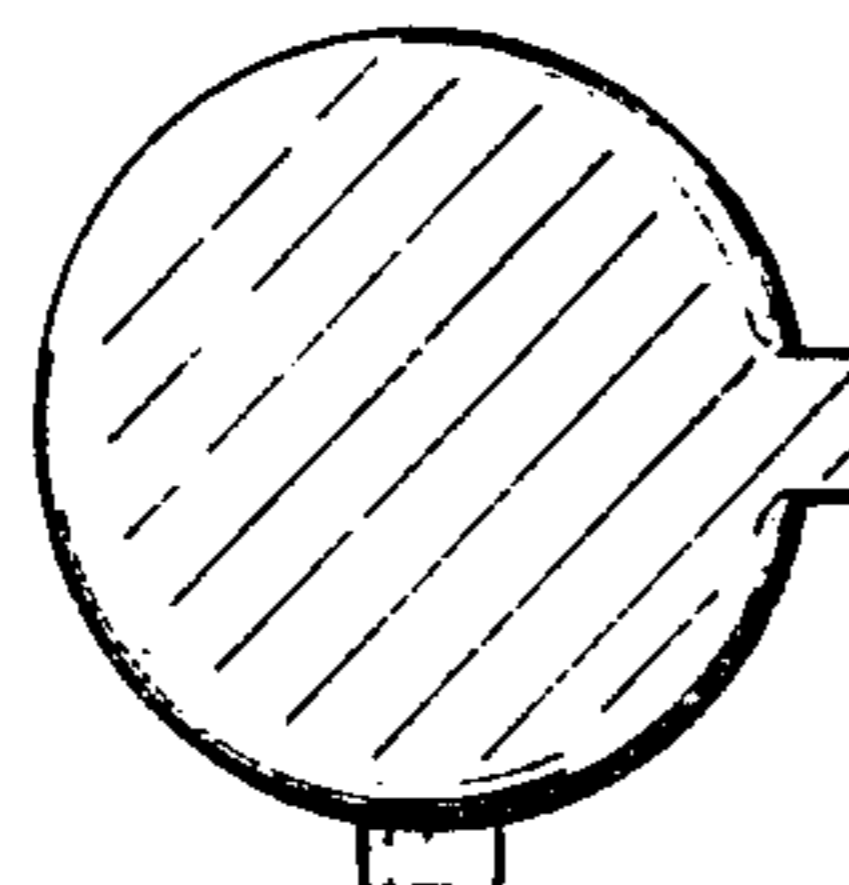
