DESCRIPTION

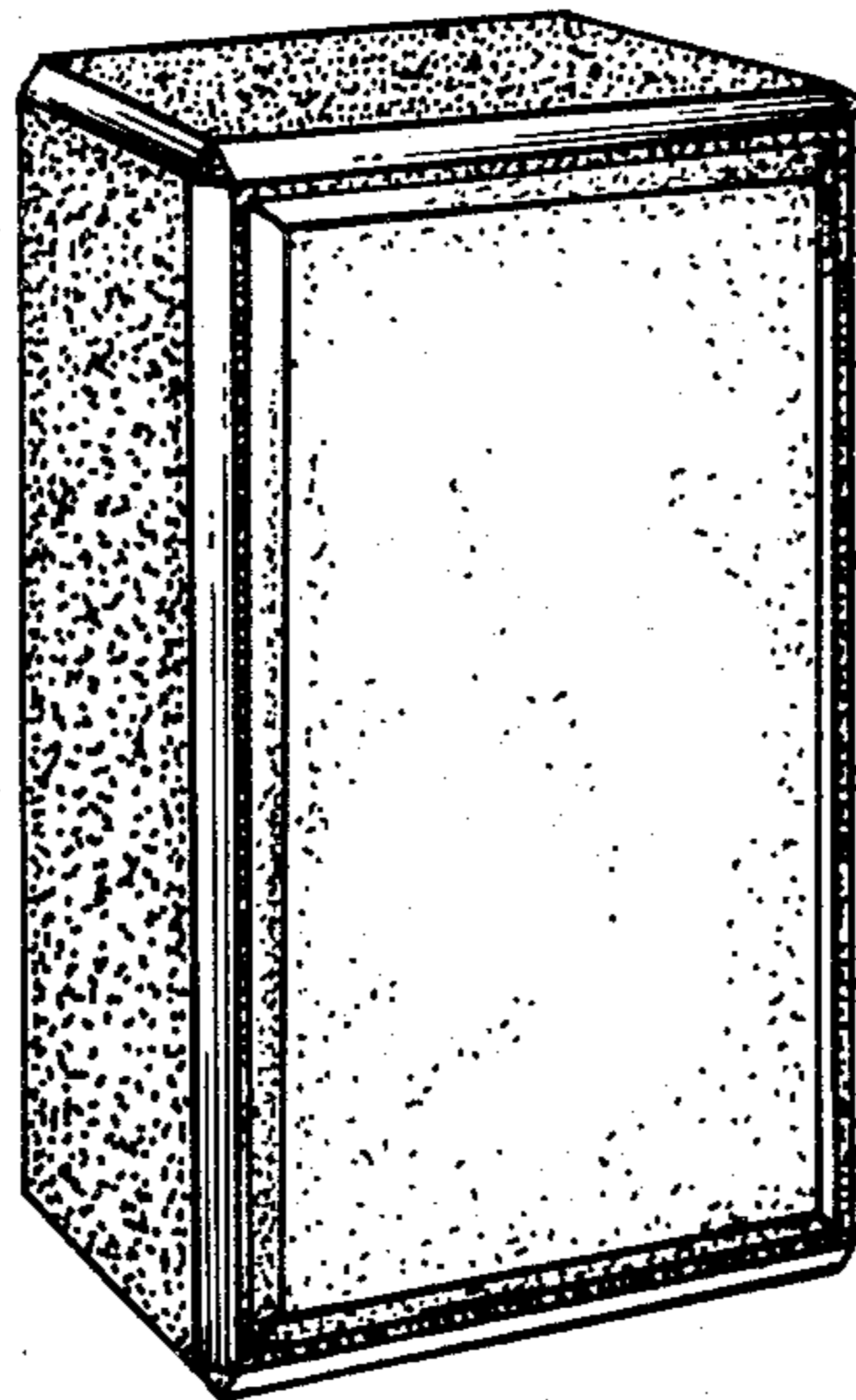
FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a loudspeaker enclosure showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



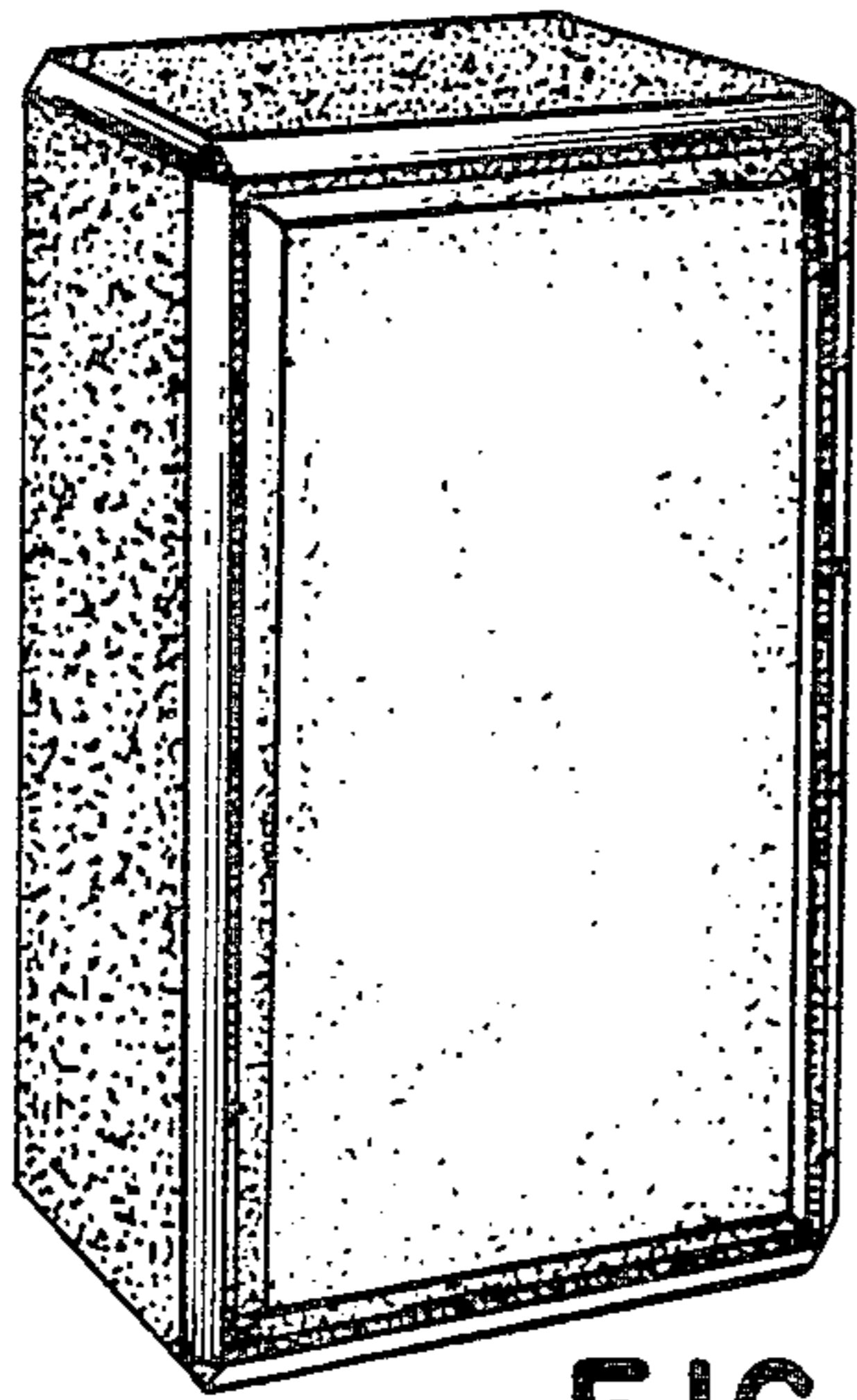

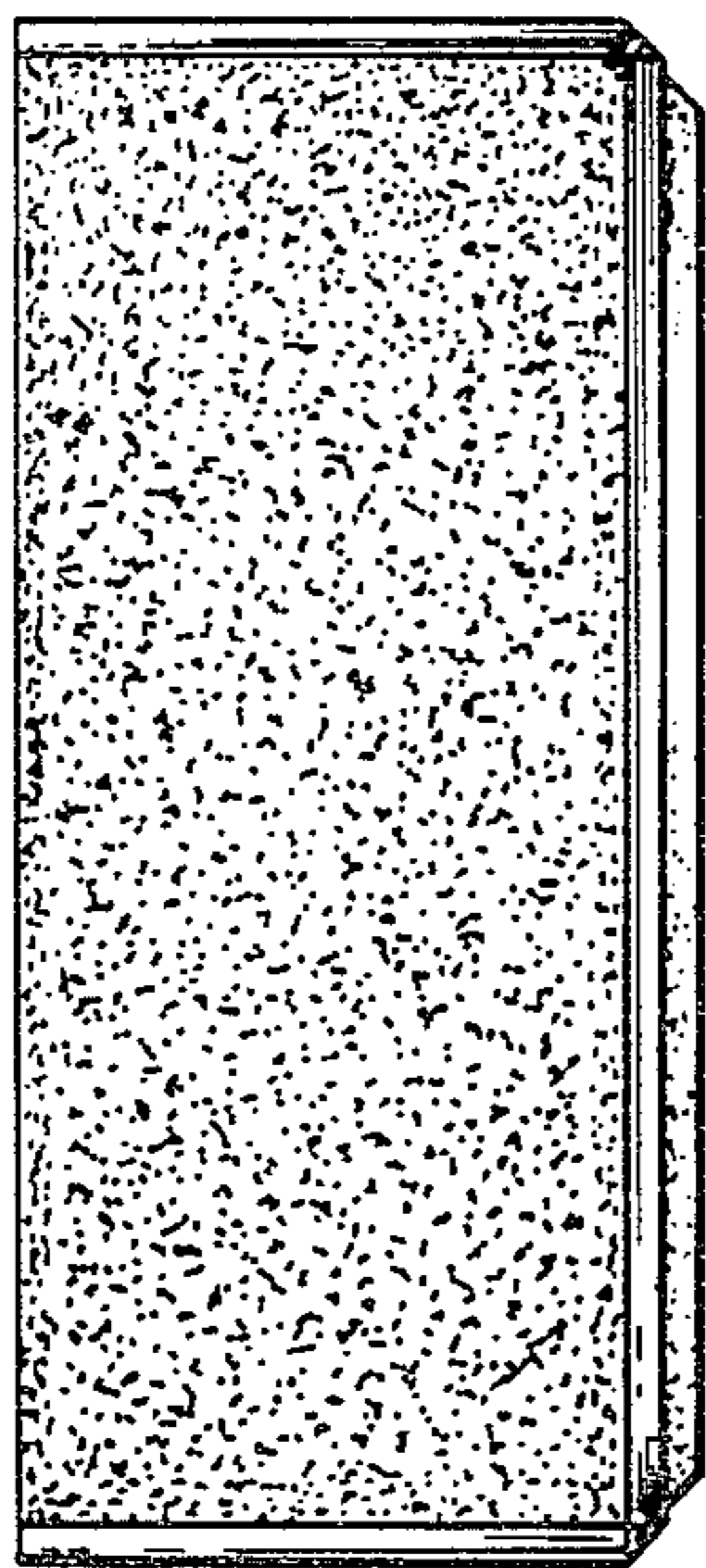

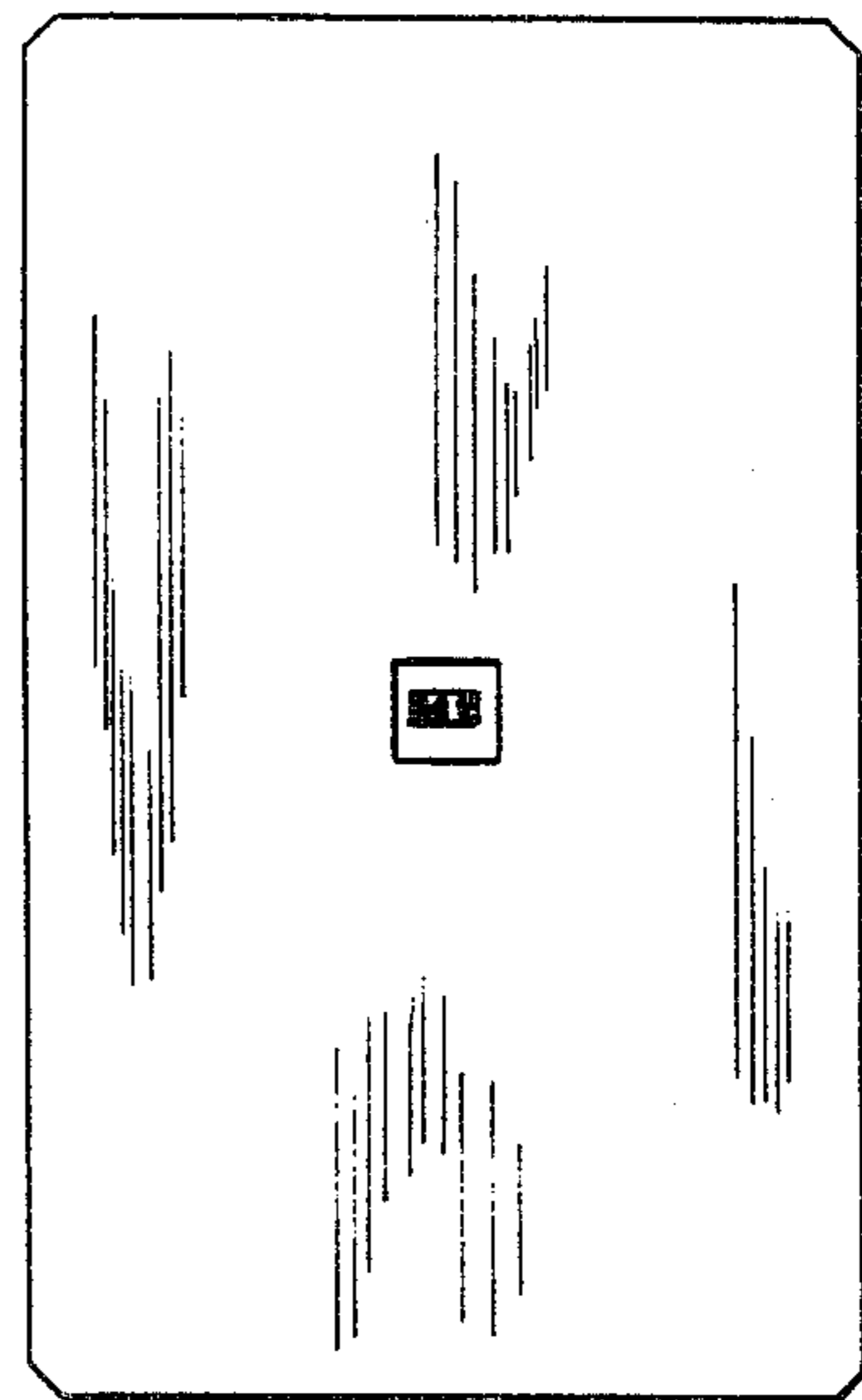

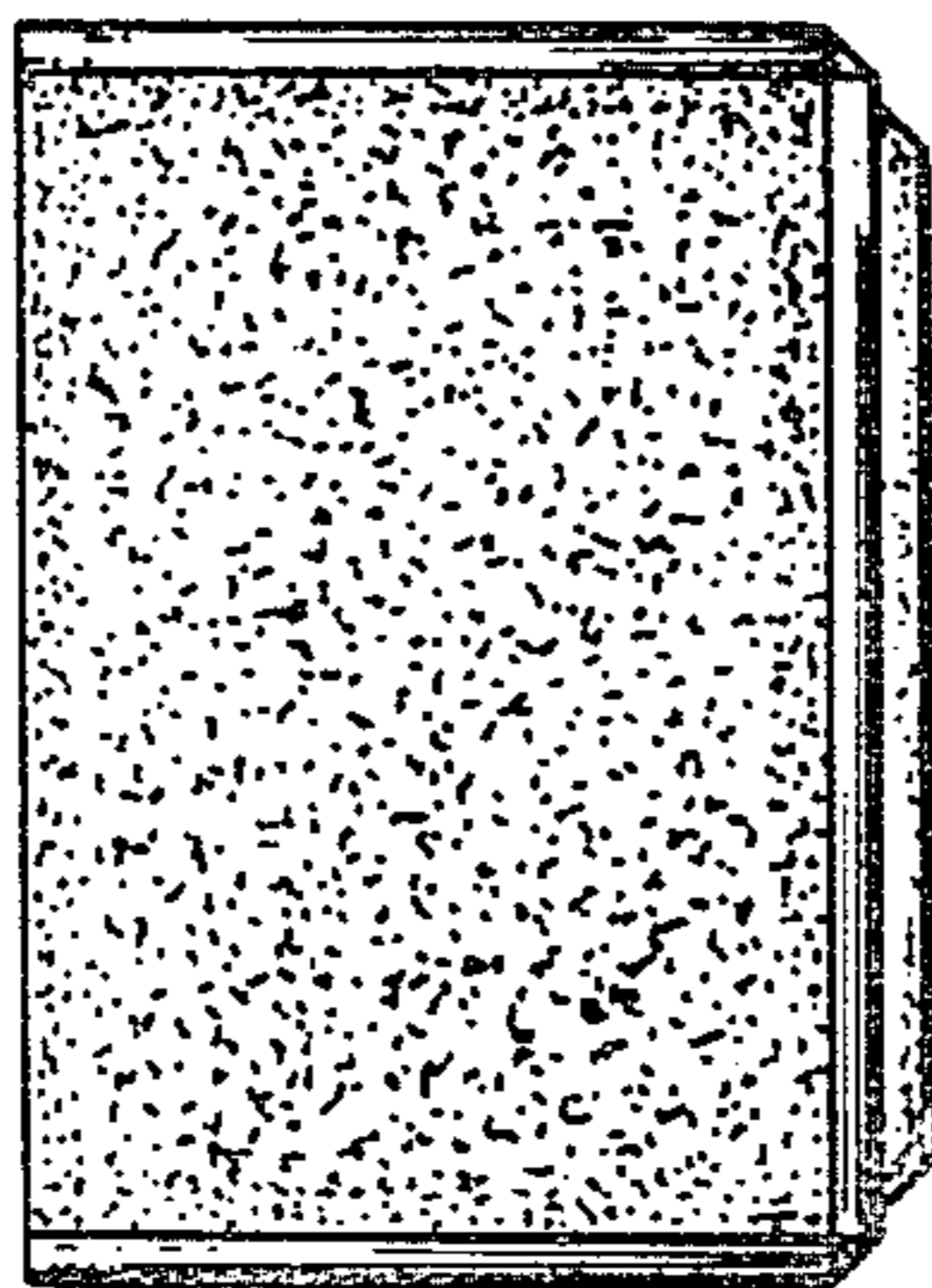
