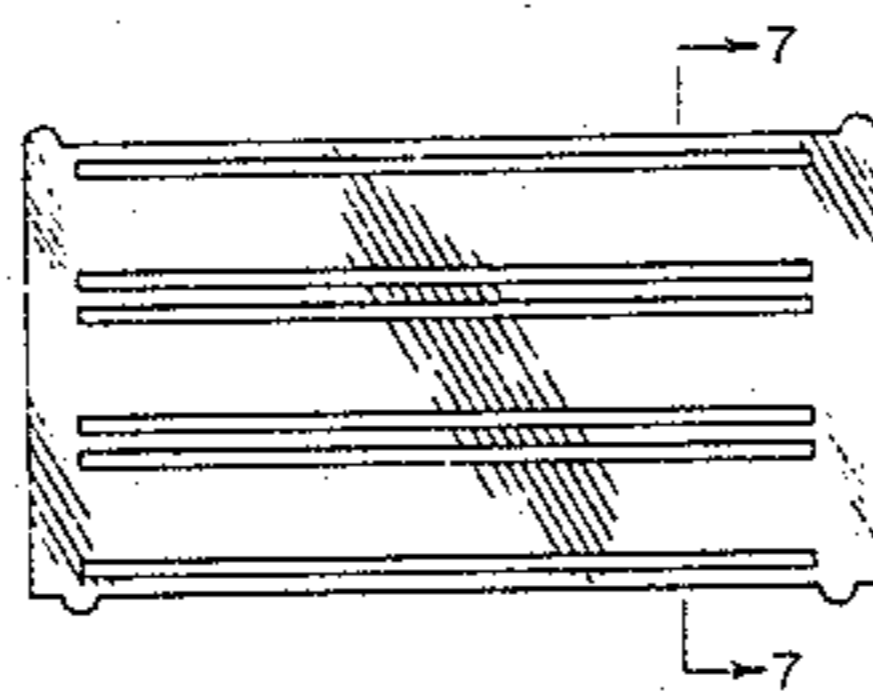
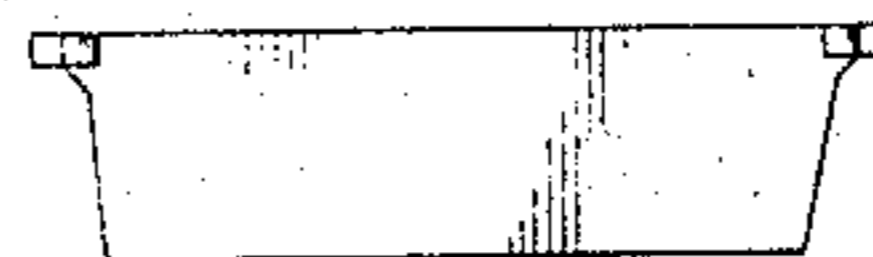

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a holder for cassette tapes, showing my new design.

 FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 5.



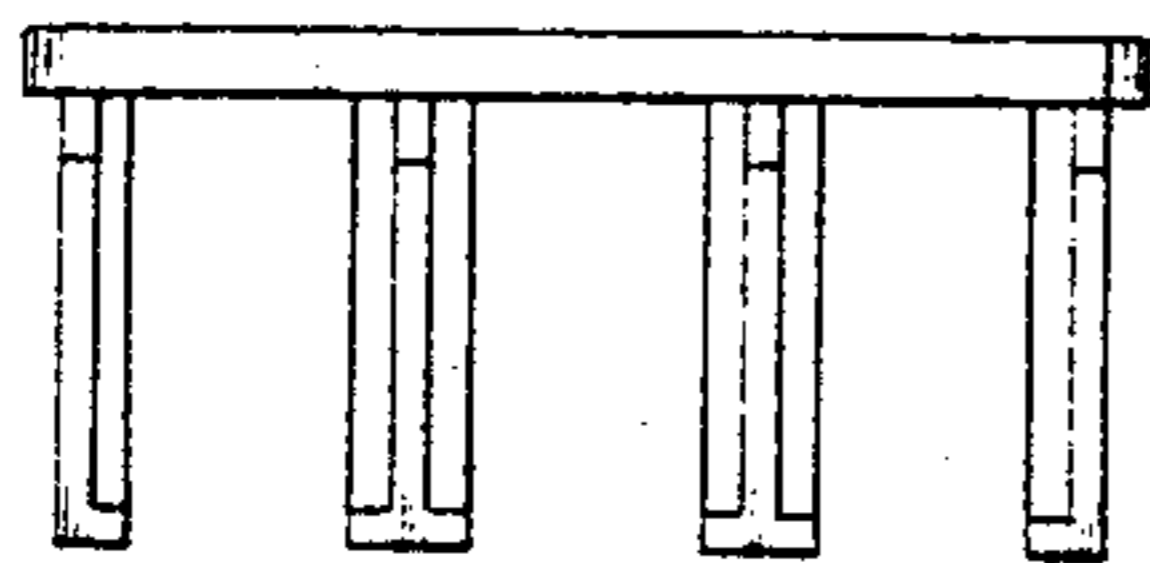

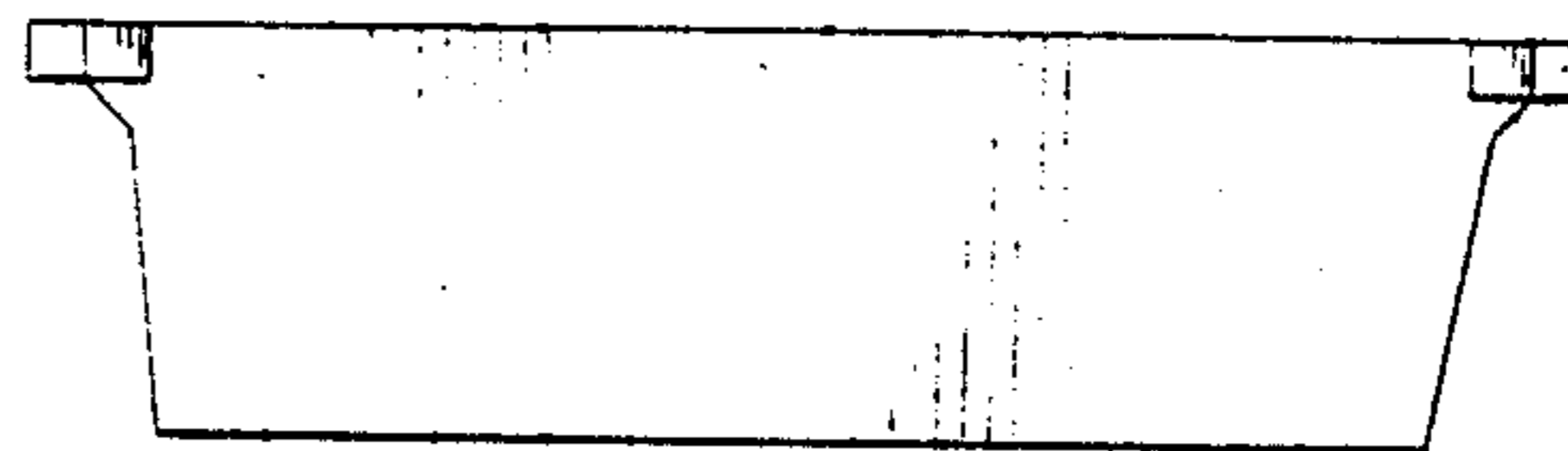

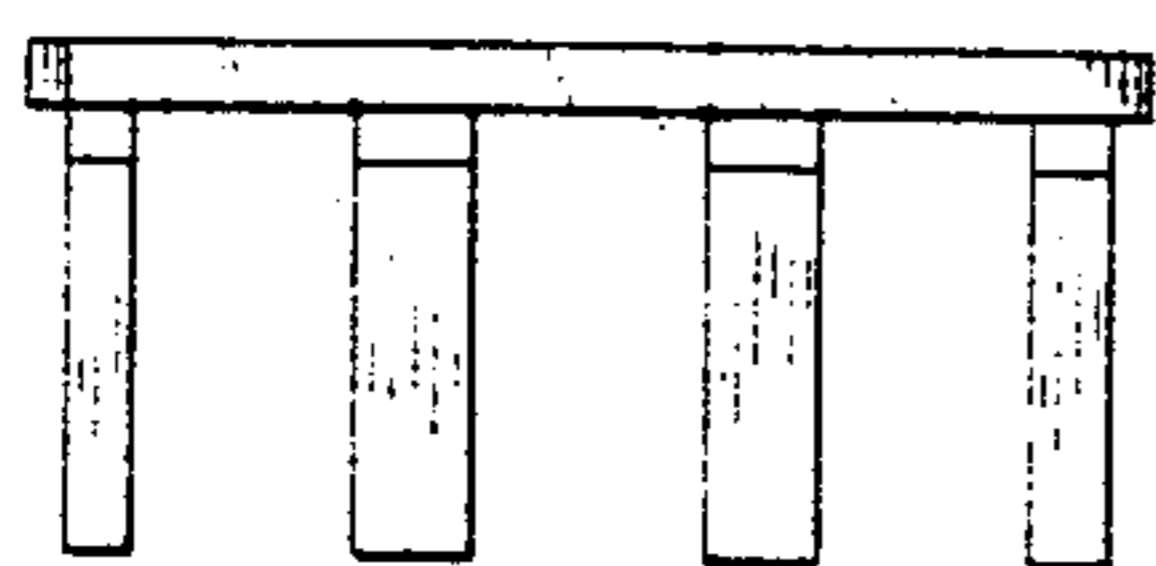

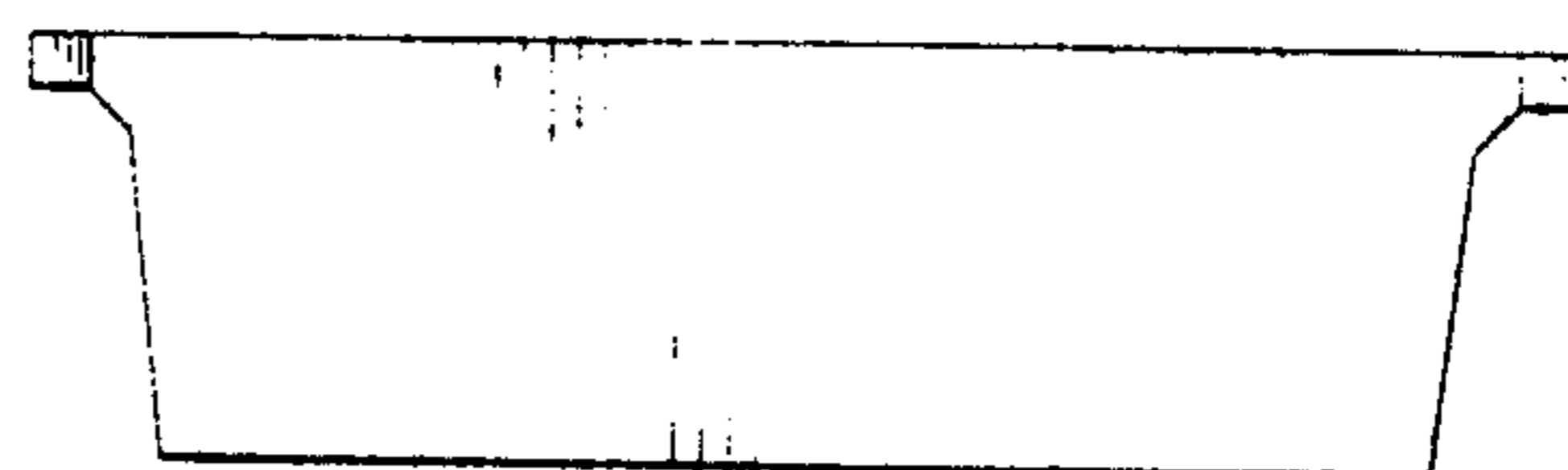

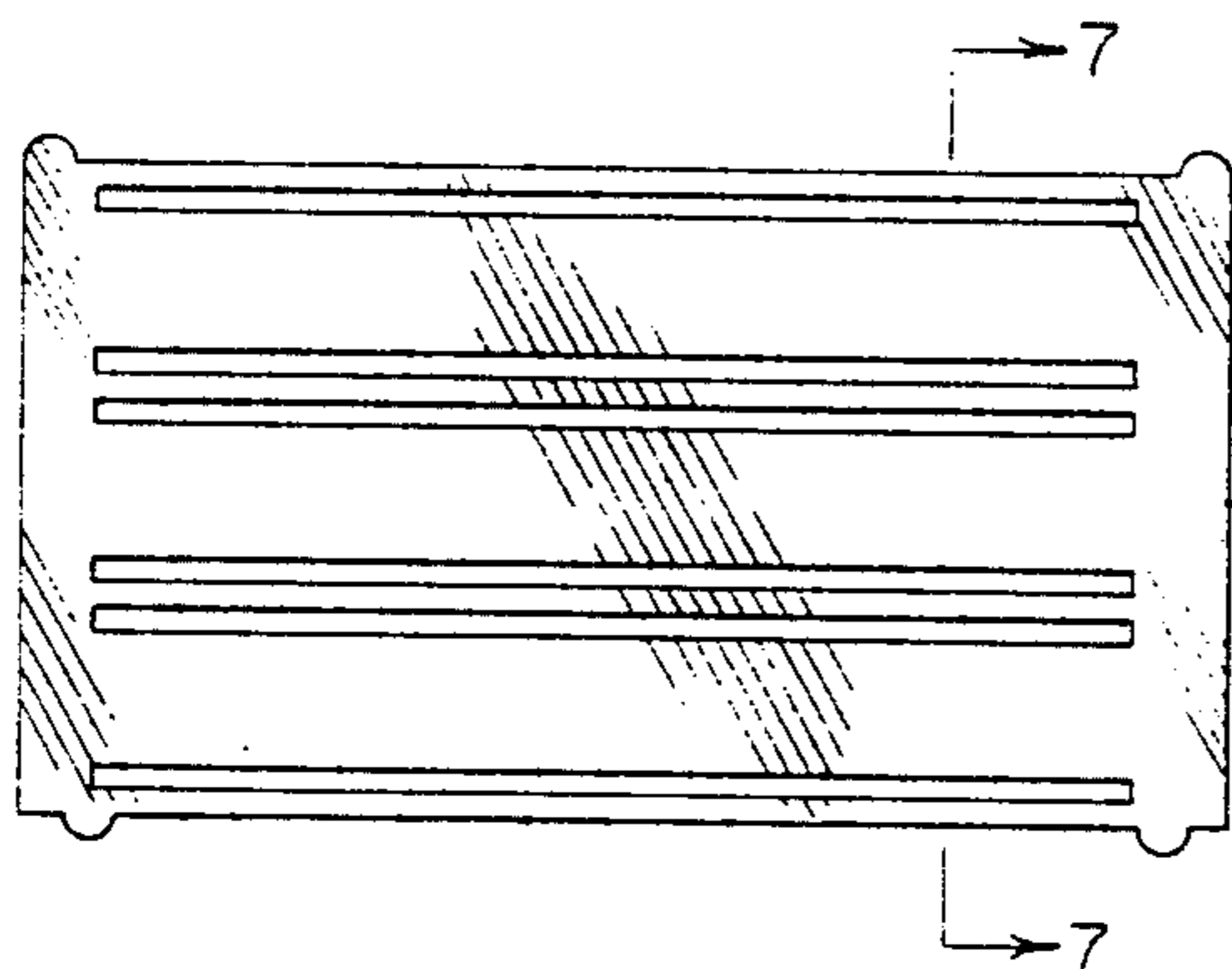

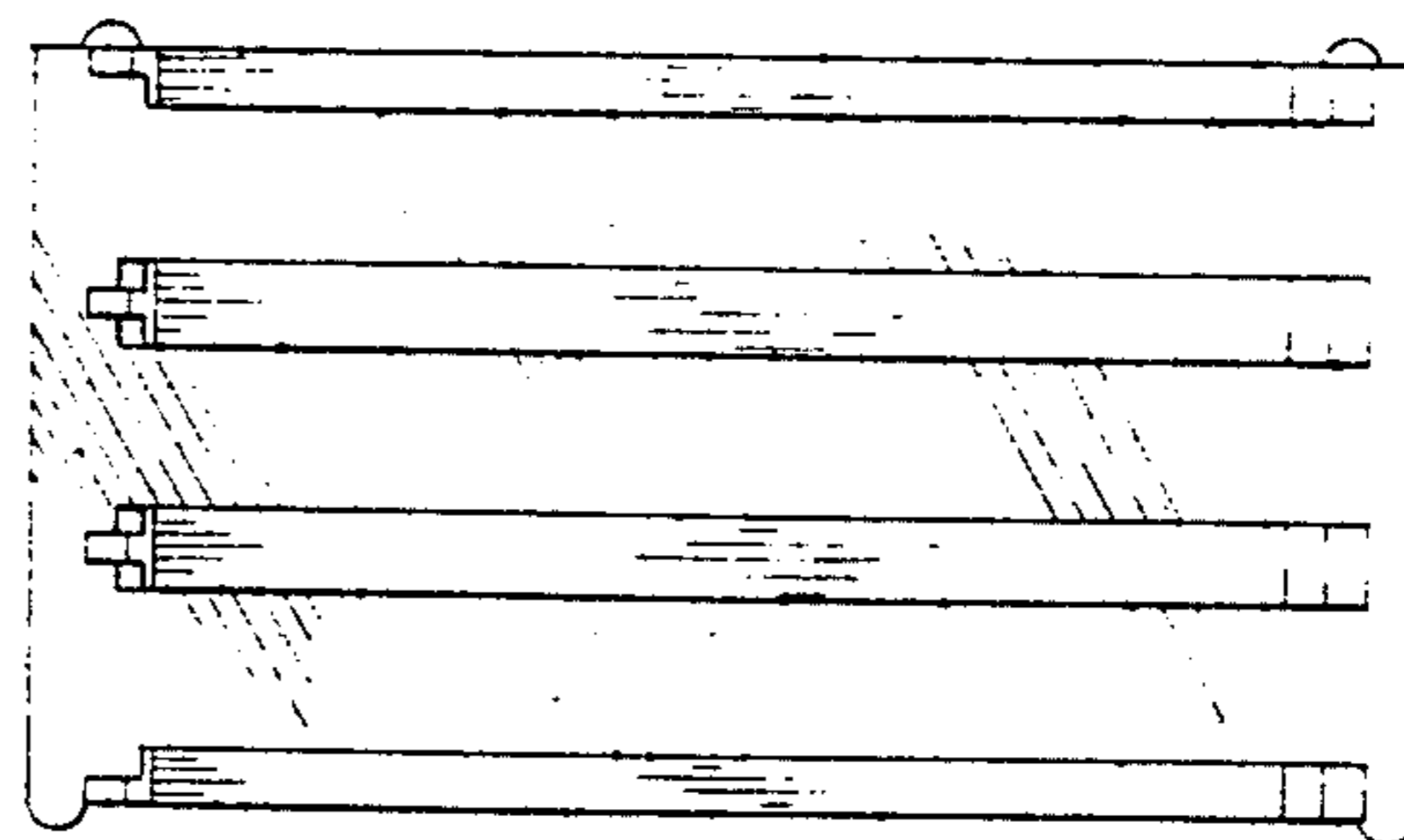

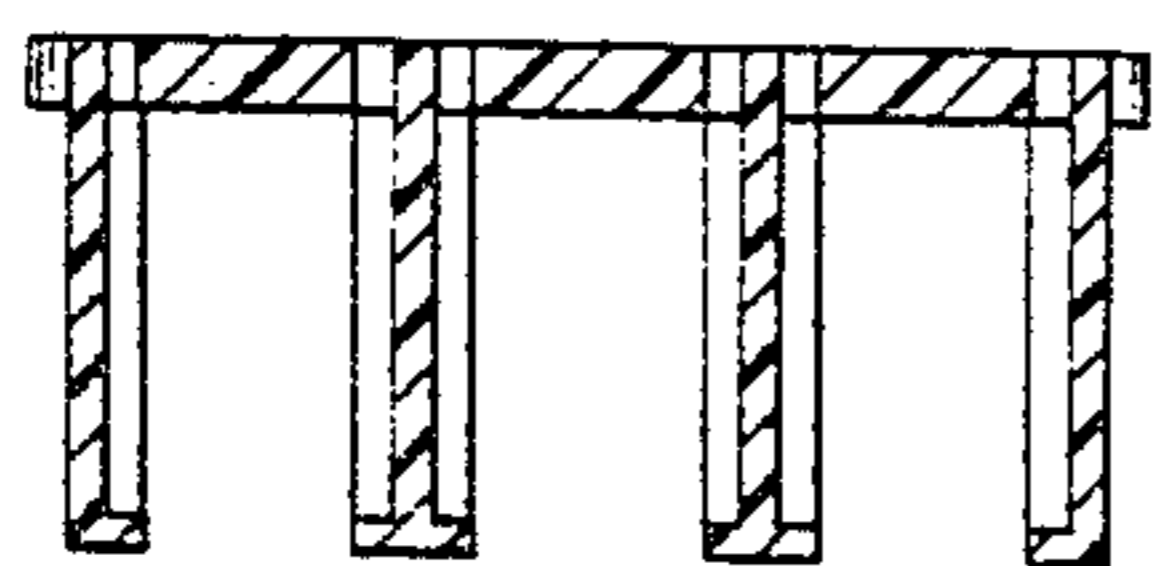
