FIG. 2 is a mirror image of FIG. 1.

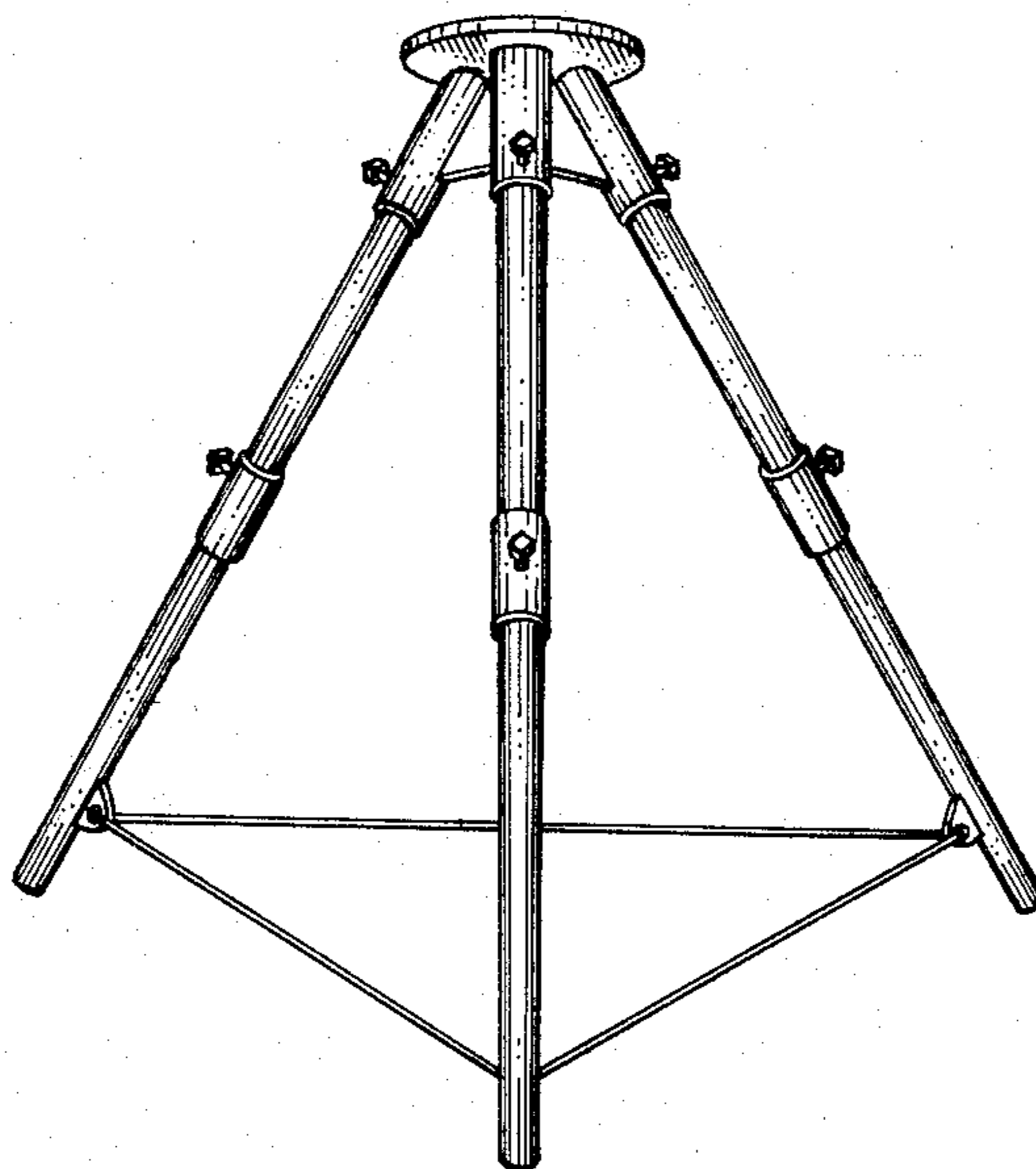

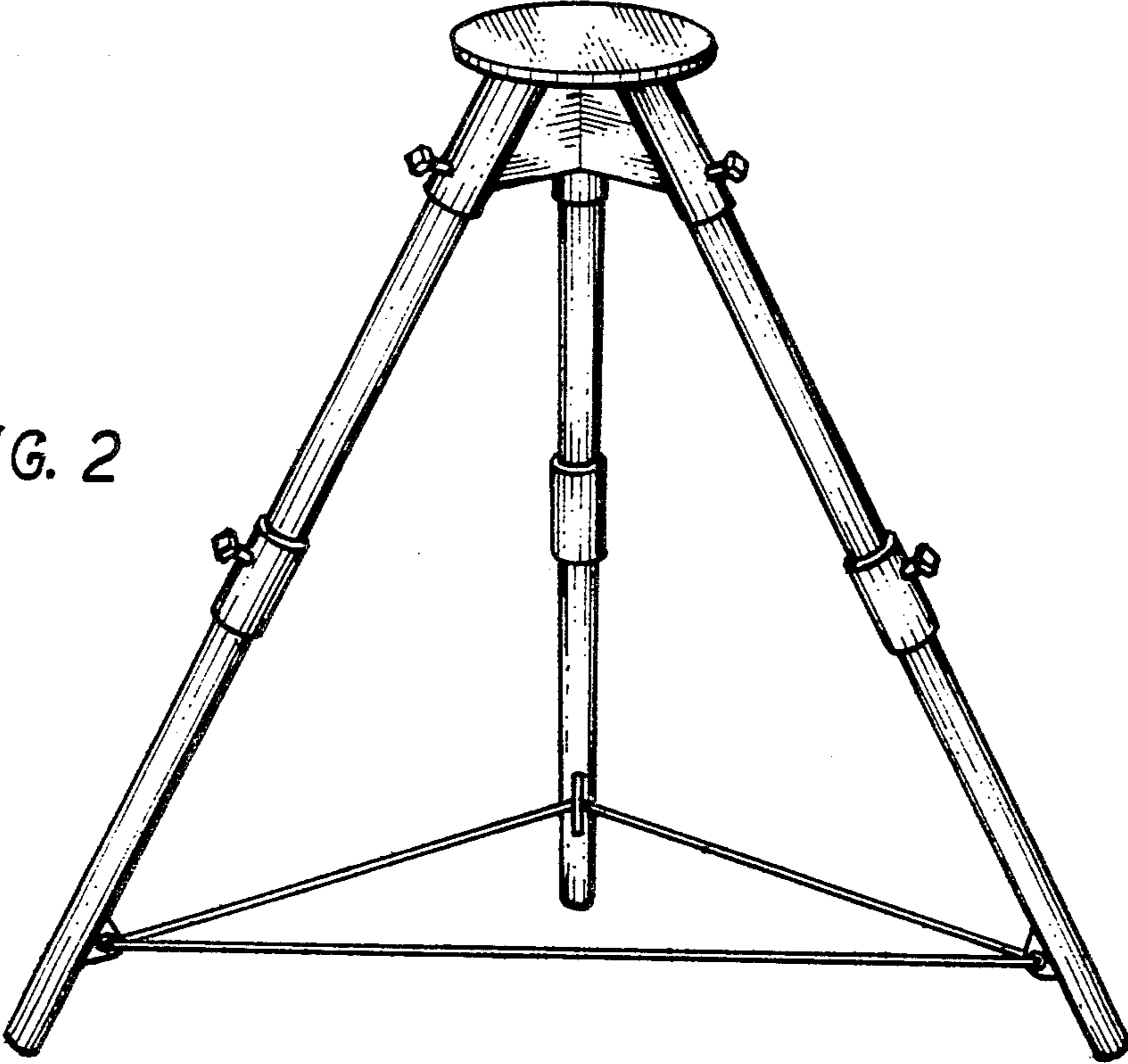
