The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my design in the form of a sofa; FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof showing the design in the form of a loveseat; FIG. 3 is a perspective view of a seat showing my design in the form of a lounge chair; and FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the design shown in the form of a recliner. The sides of the seat forms not shown are mirror images of the sides shown while the undisclosed rear surfaces are conventional in appearance.
