The drawing is shaded schematically to indicate contrasting color.

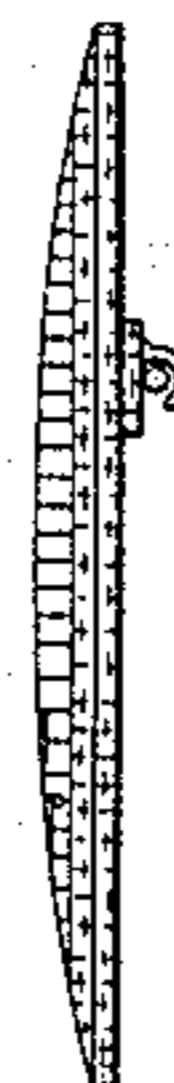
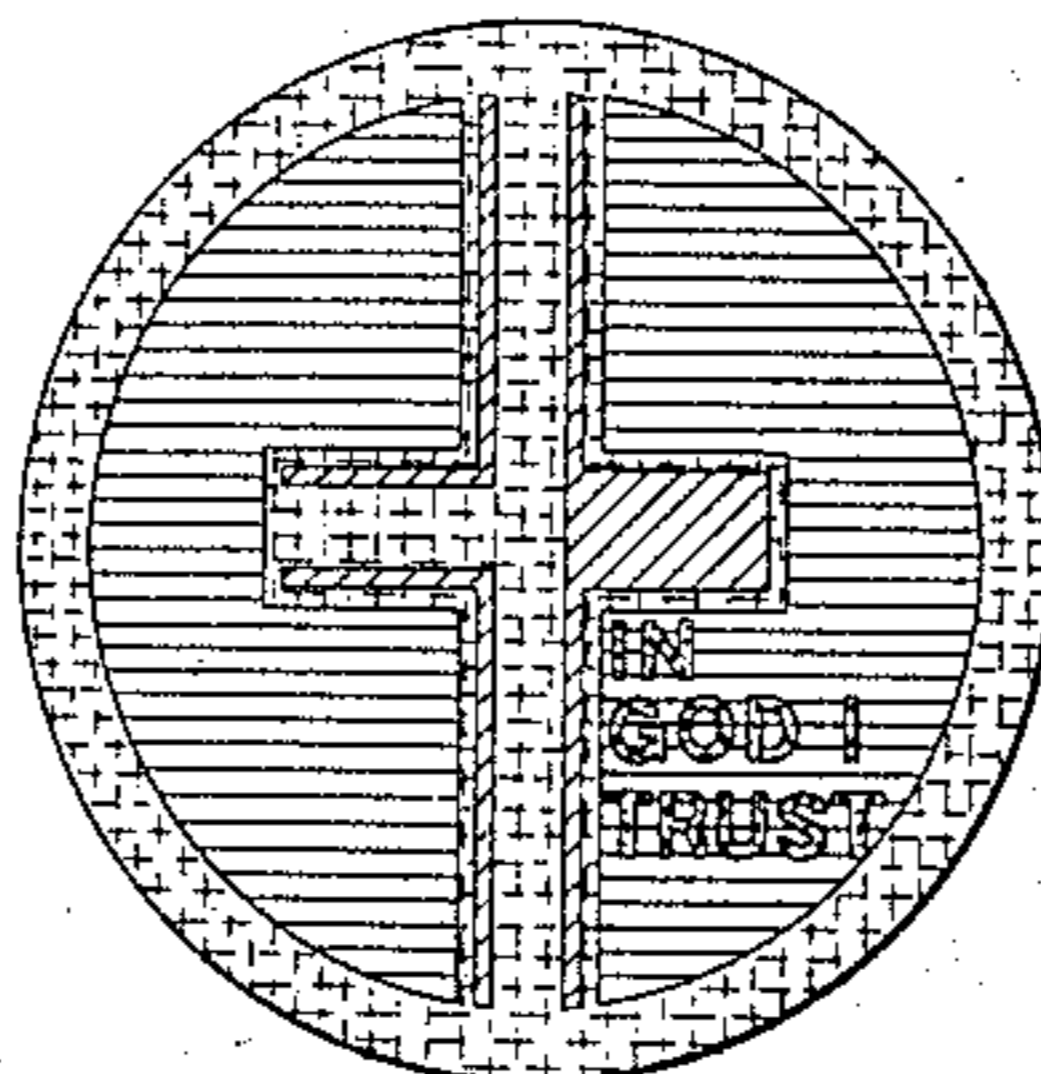

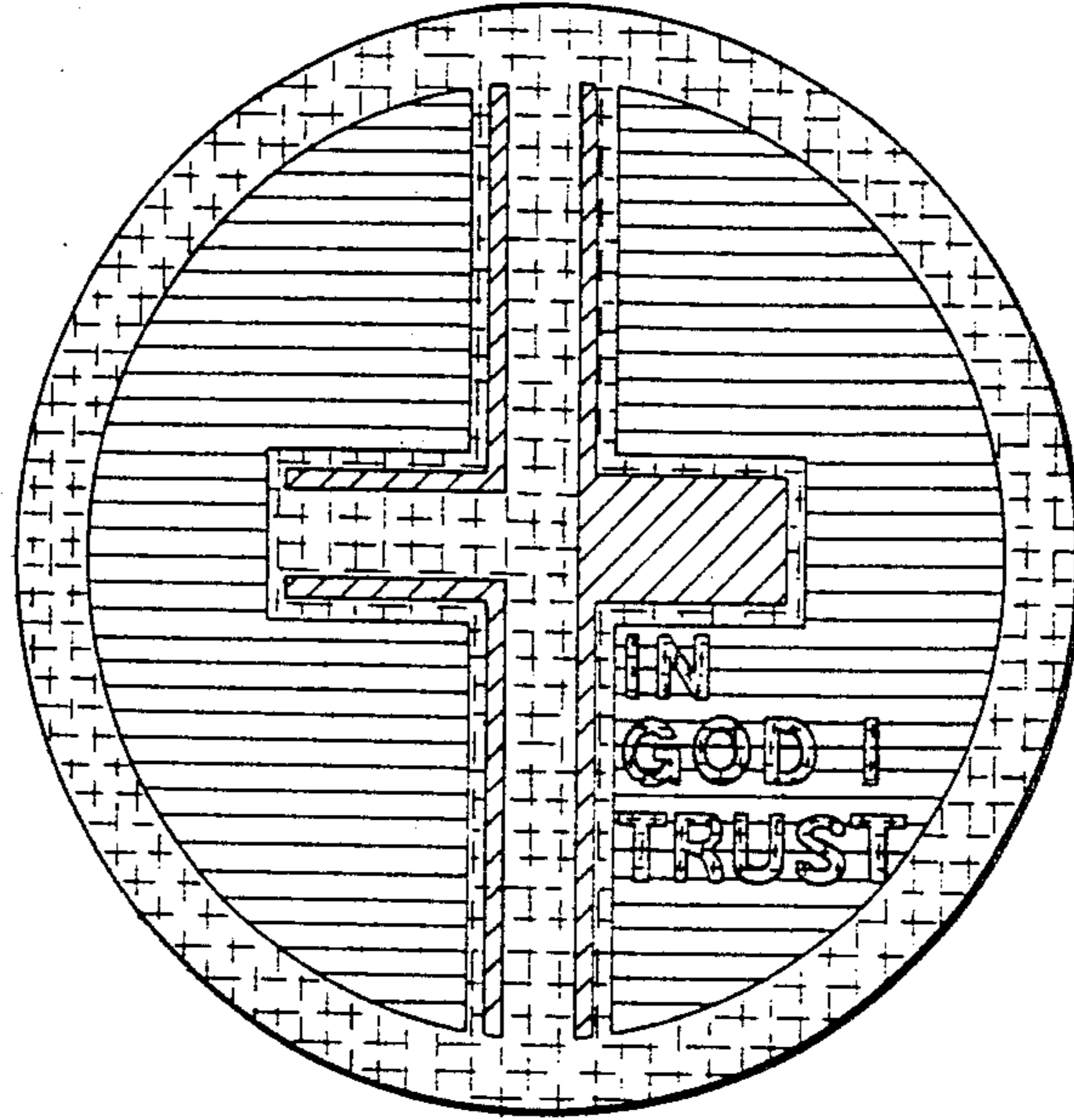

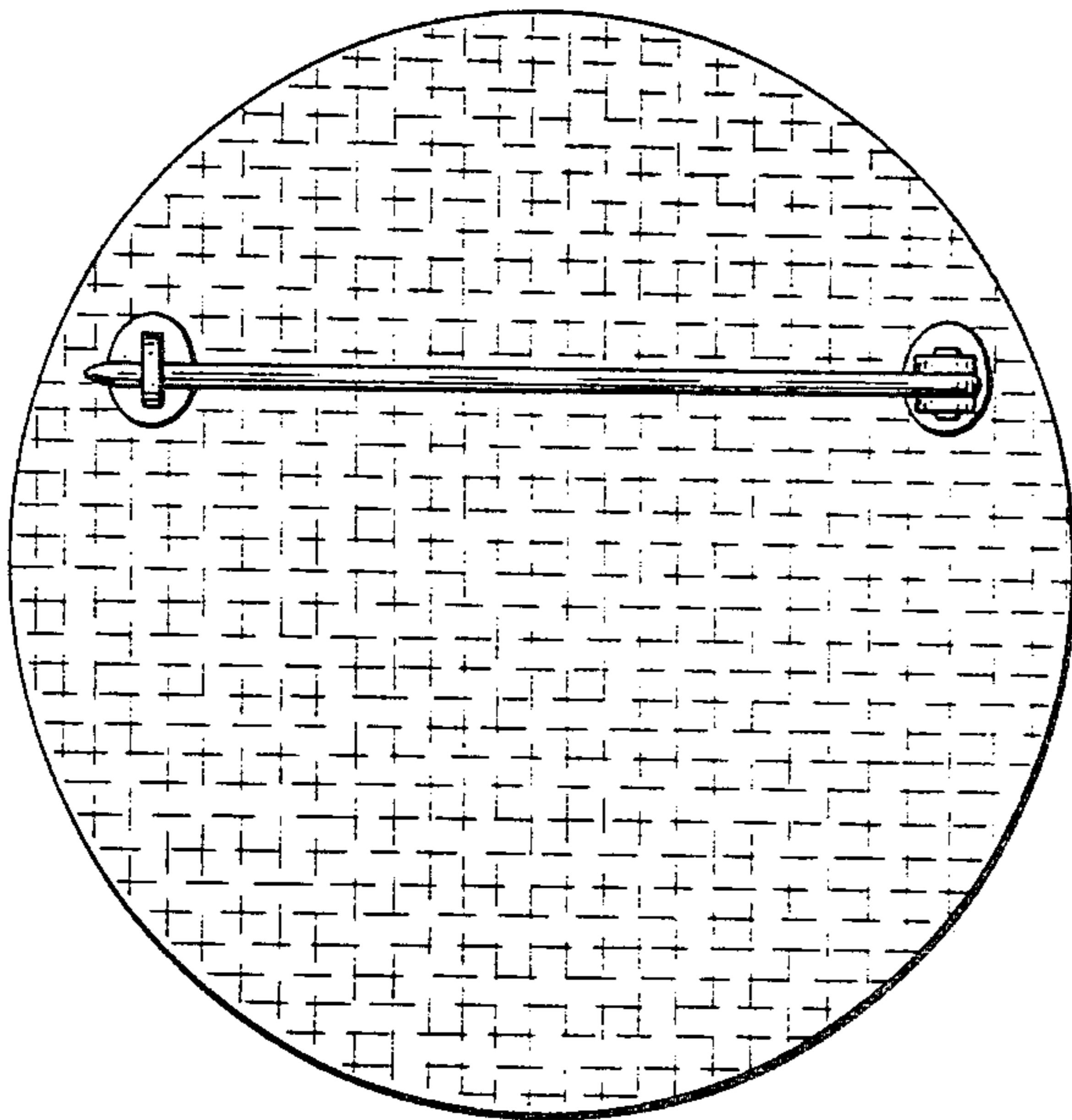
