The ornamental design for a folder with clock and memo pad or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view, in a closed position, of a folder with clock and memo pad or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top perspective view, in an open position thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof.

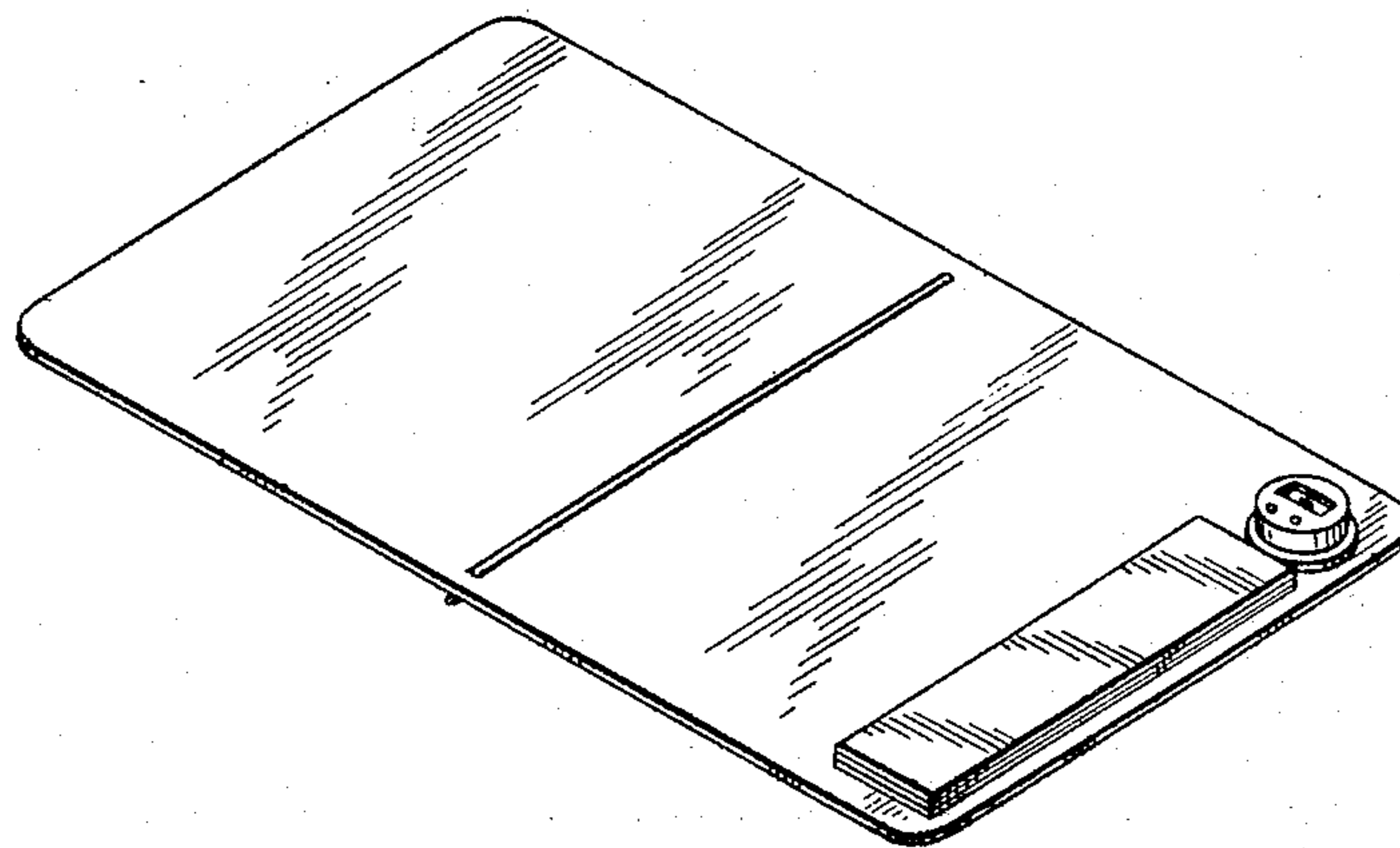

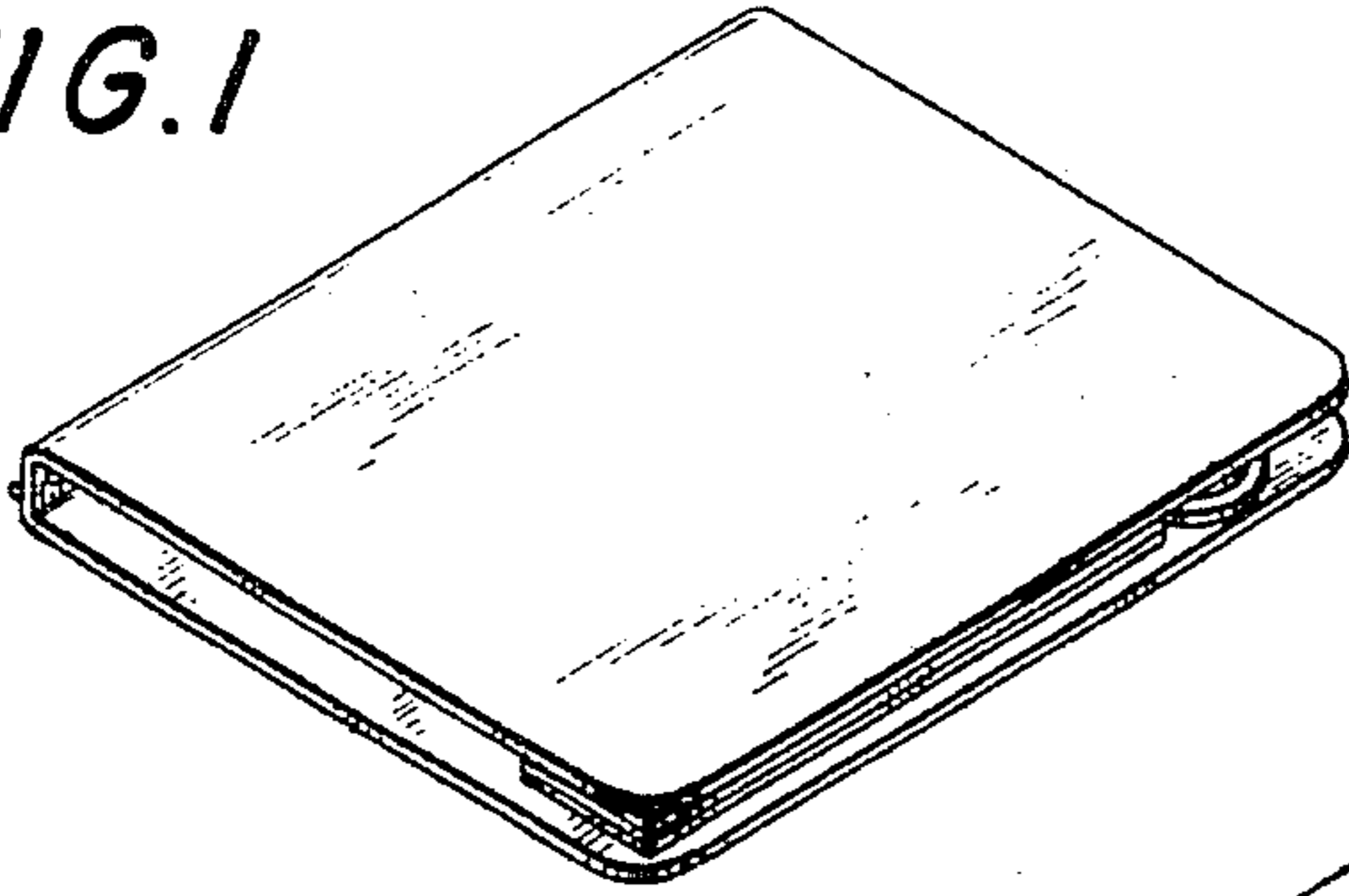

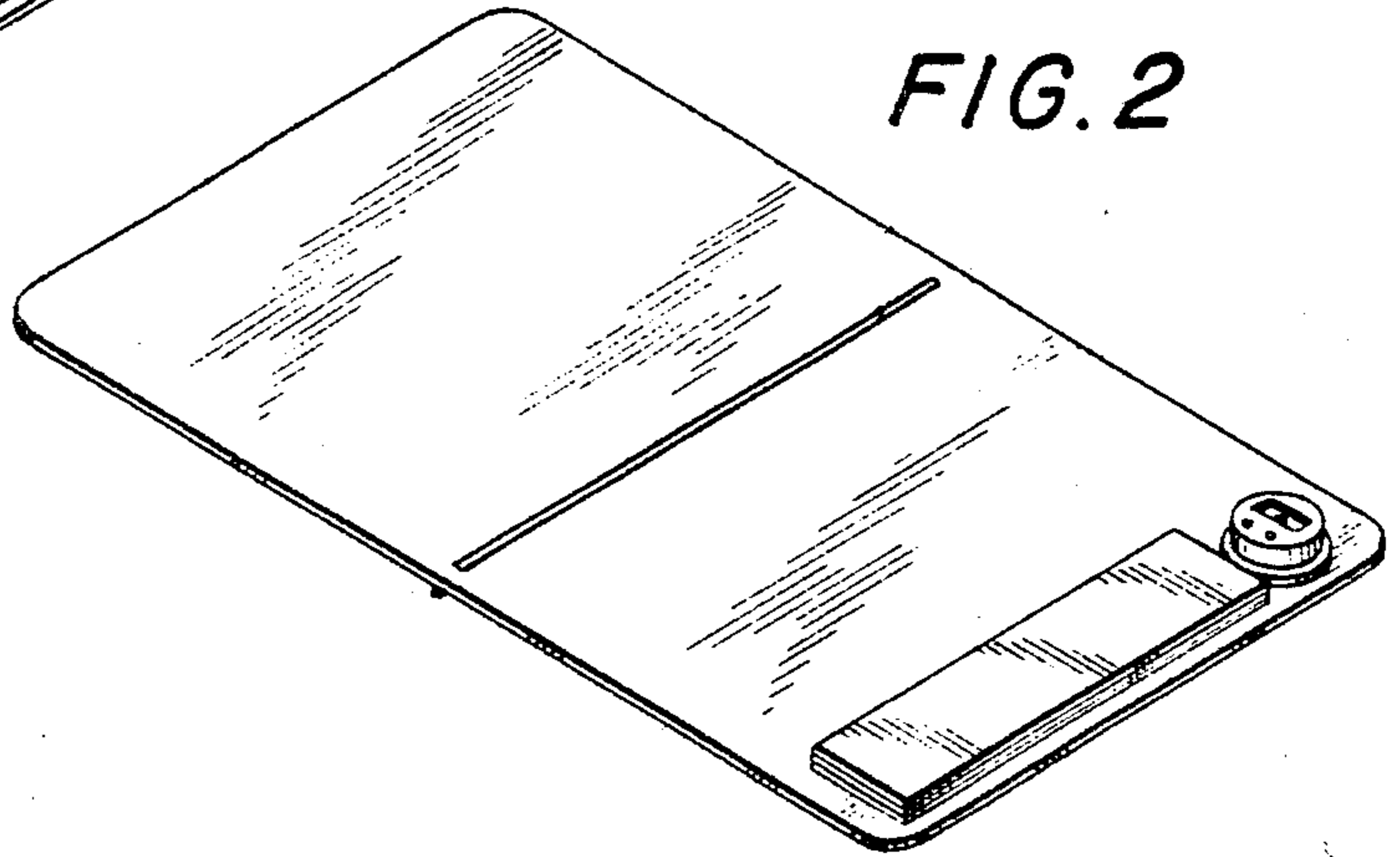

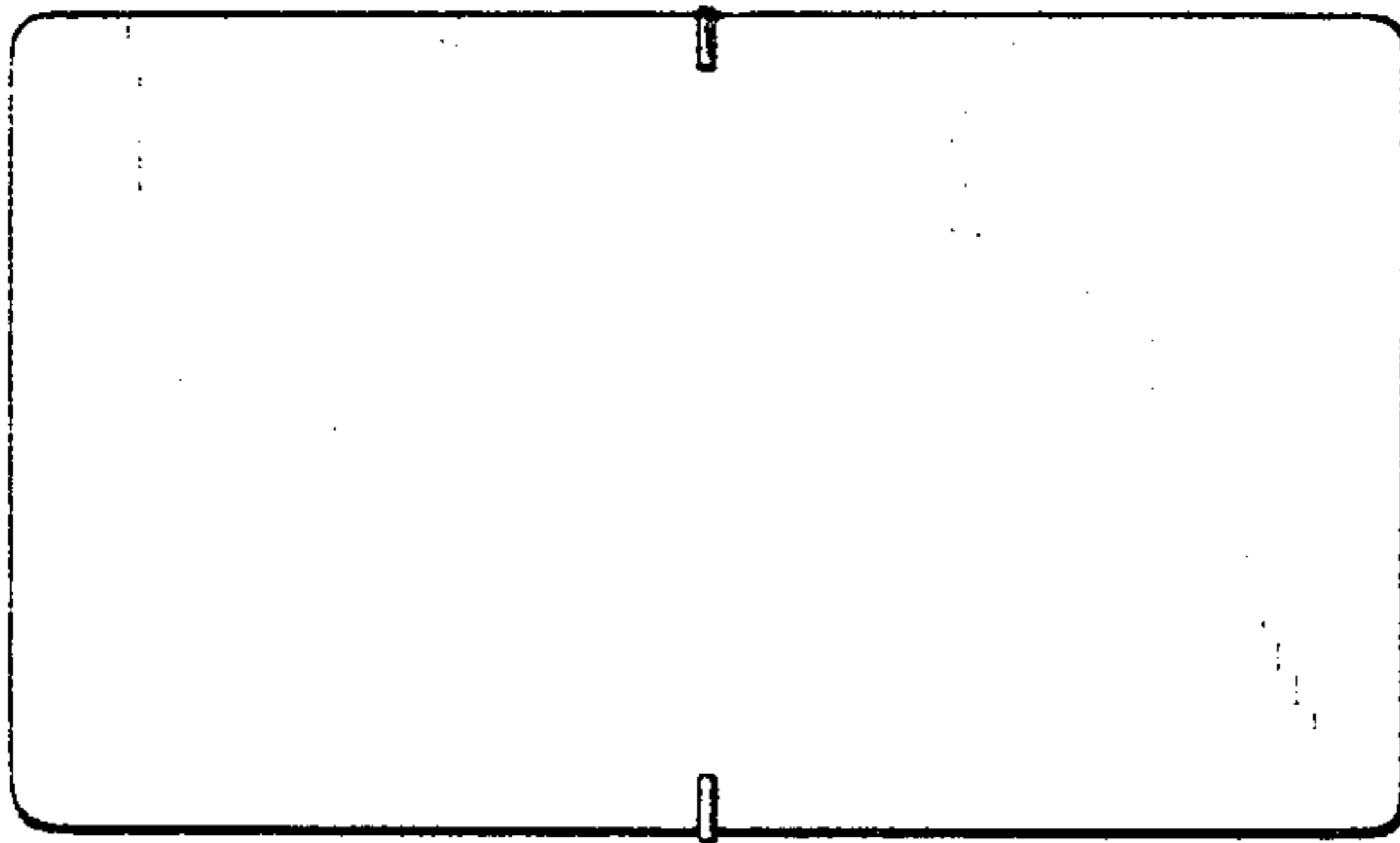

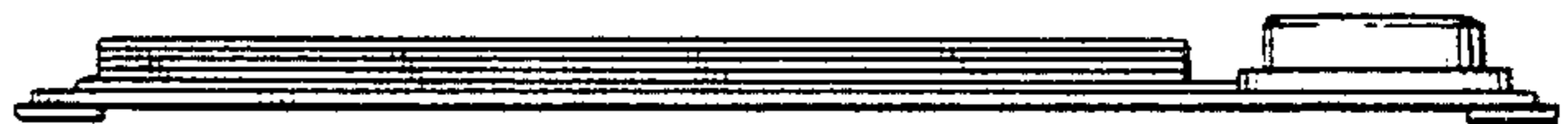
