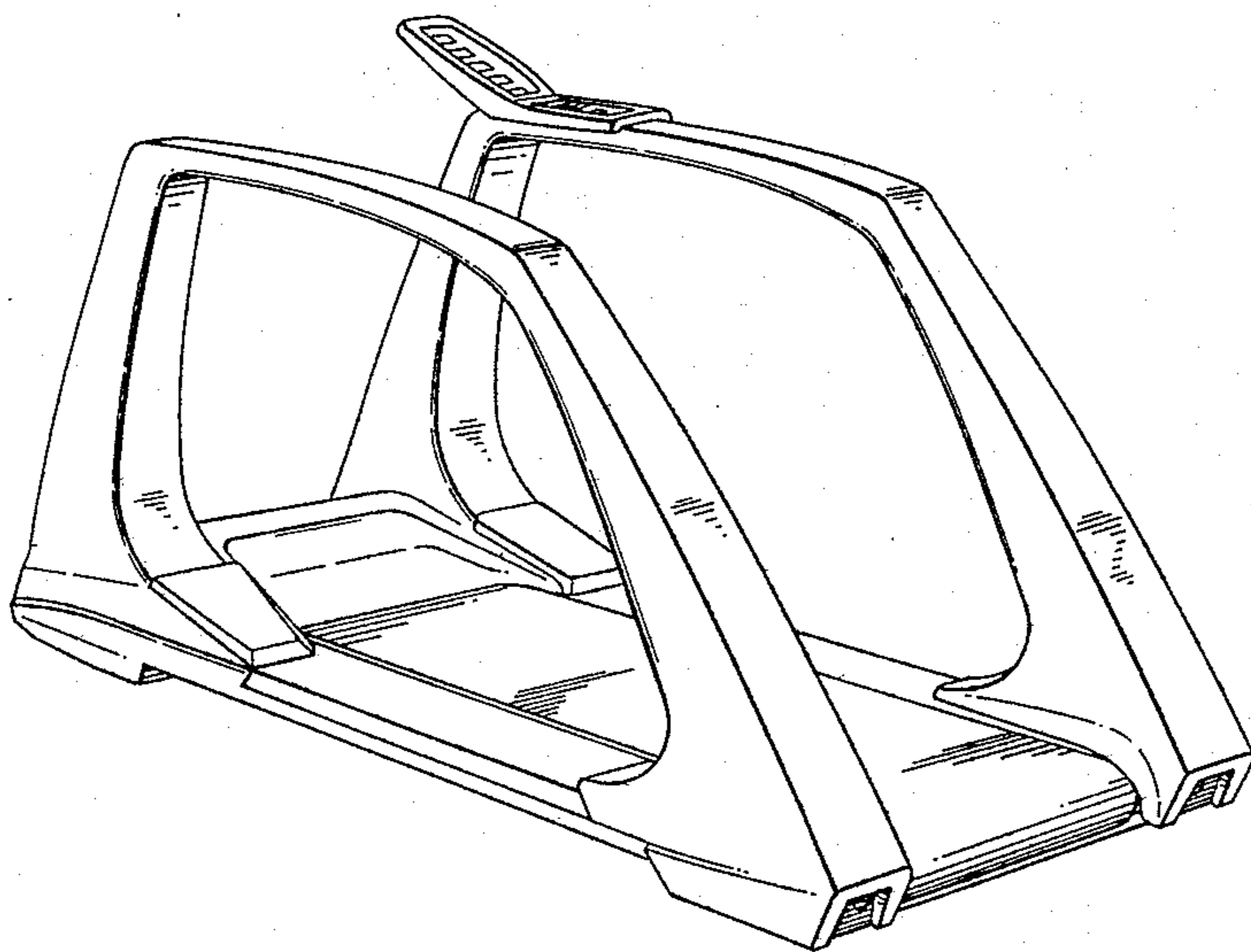

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a treadmill, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a treadmill showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image; and,
FIG. 6 is another side elevational view thereof showing the design in an alternate inclined position.



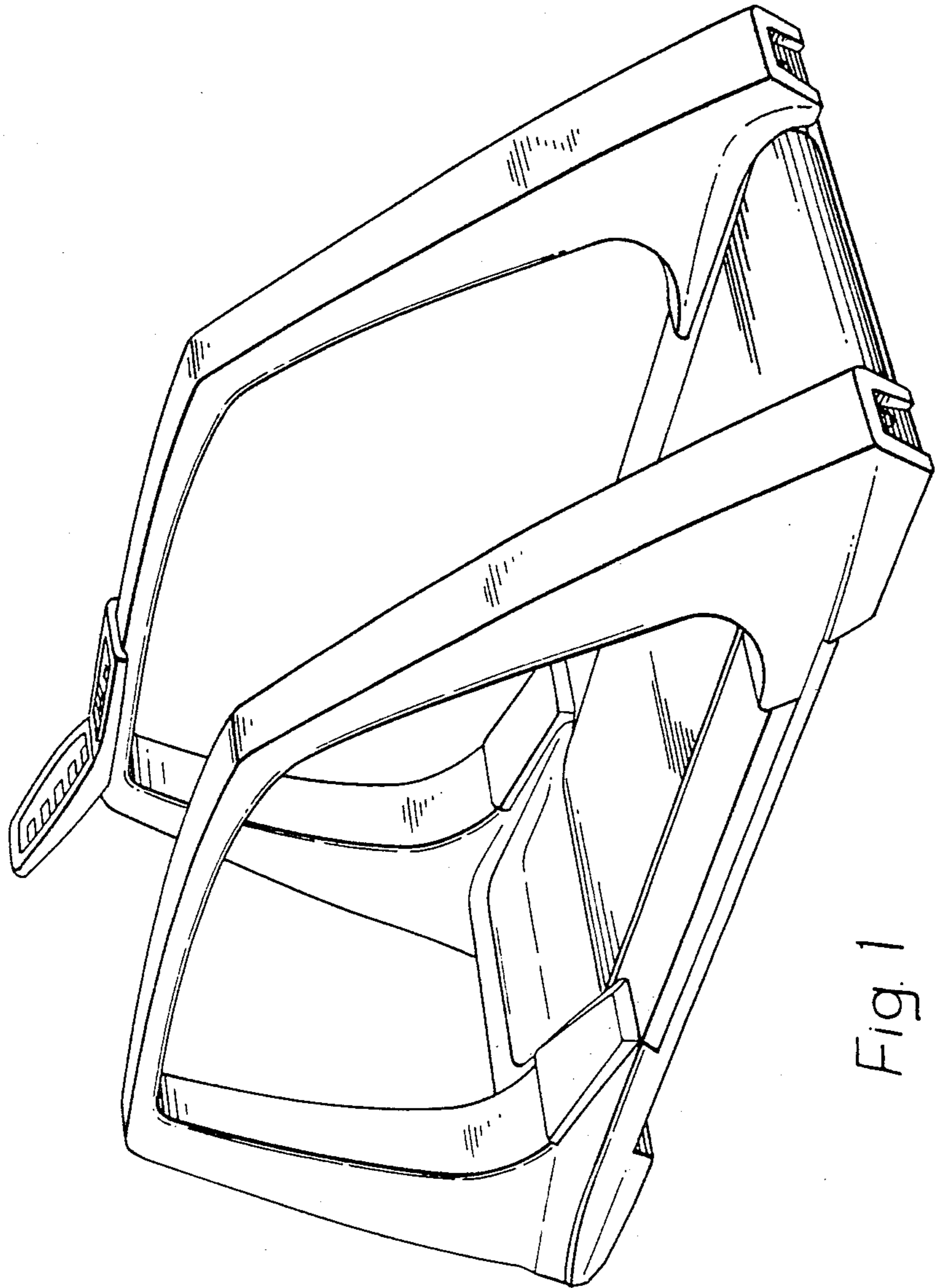

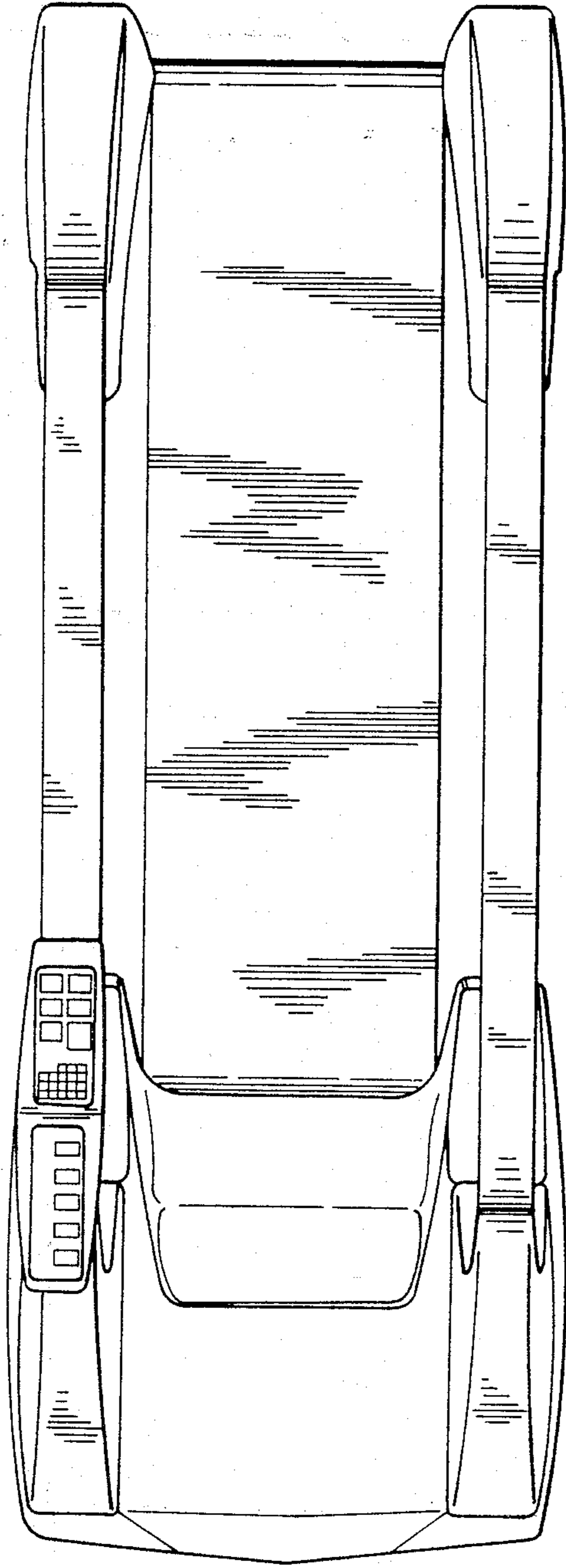

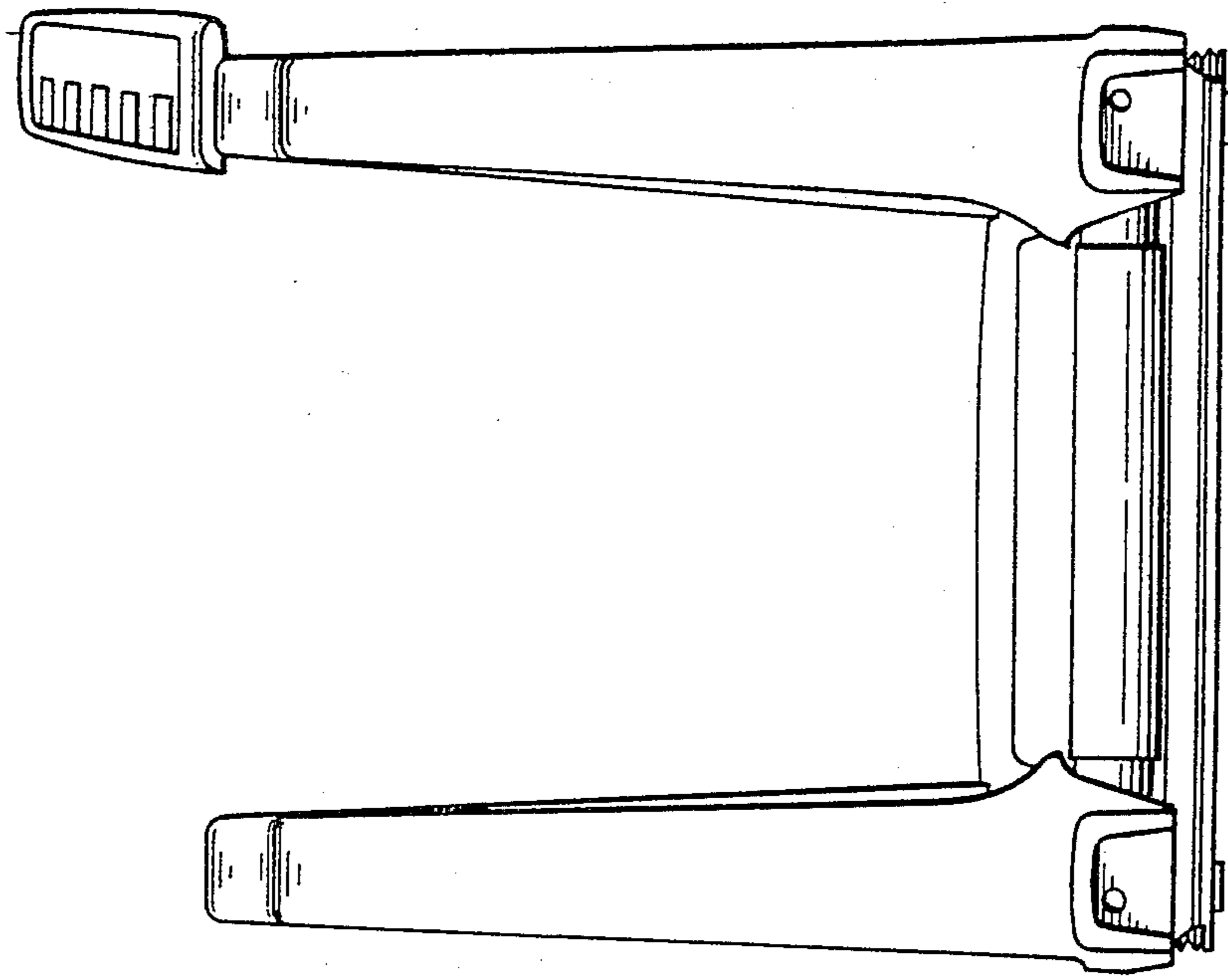

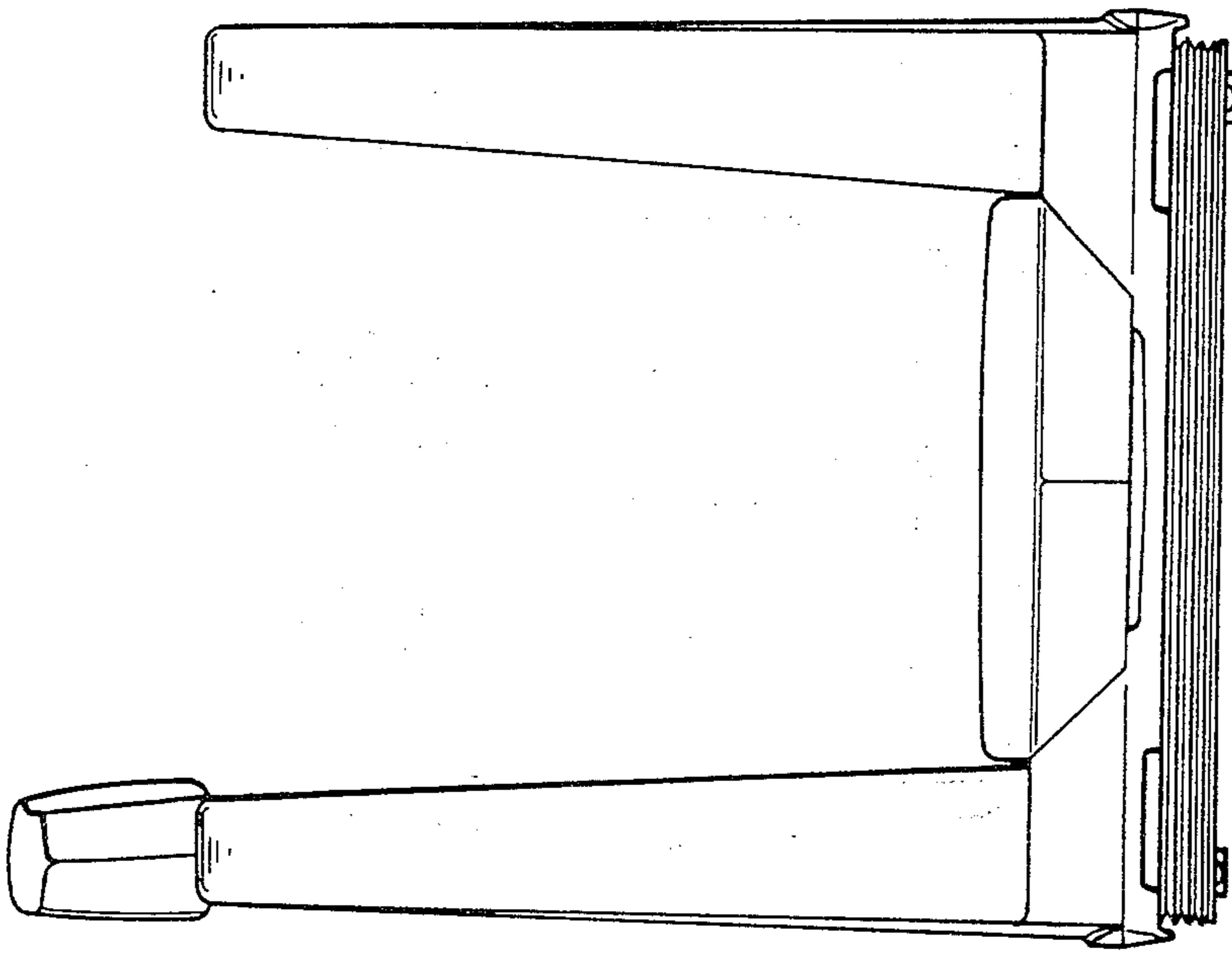

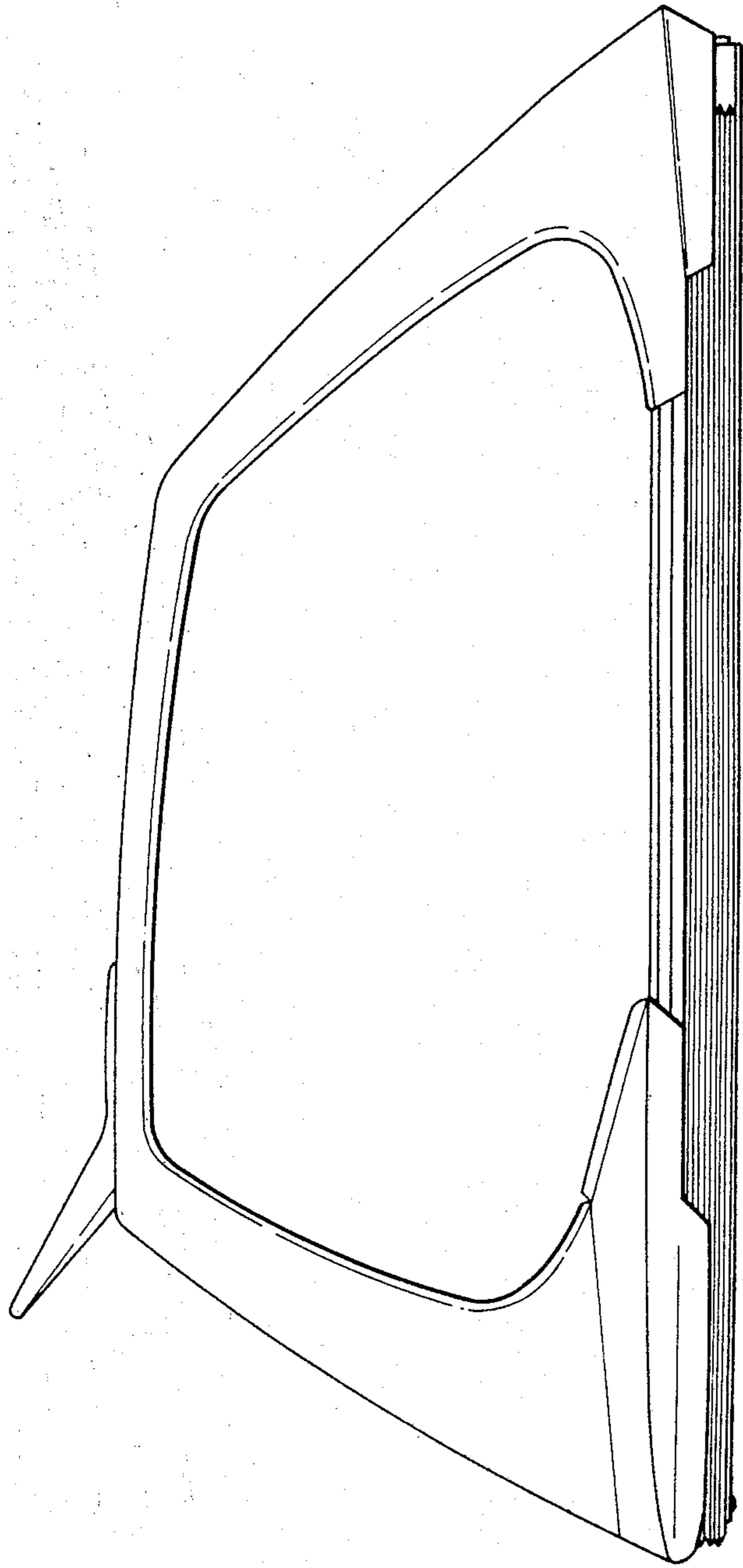

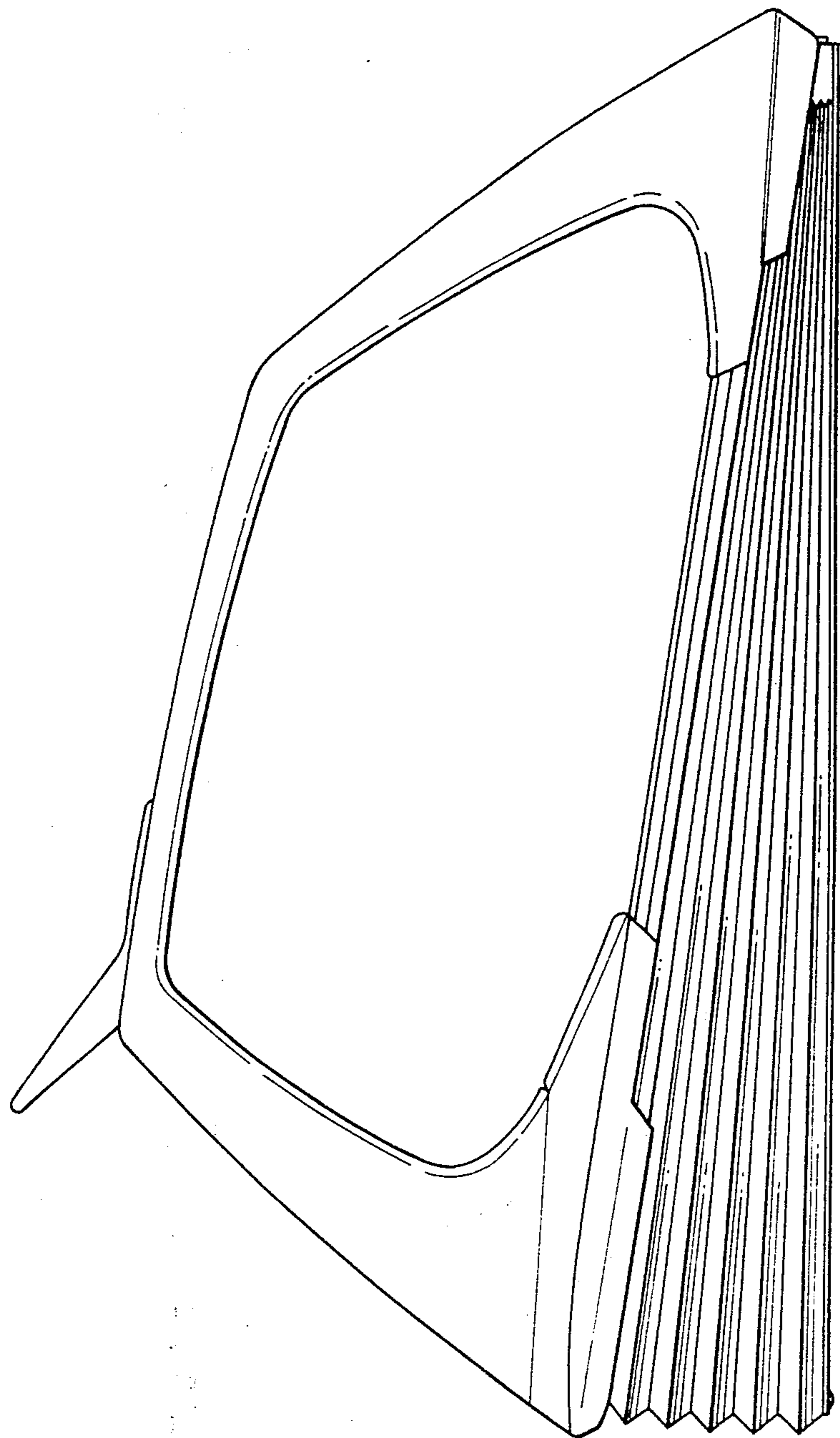
