FIG. 19 is a perspective view of a fourth chair showing my new design;


FIG. 20 is a top plan view of said fourth chair;


FIG. 21 is a bottom plan view of said fourth chair;


FIG. 22 is a right end elevational view of said fourth chair, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof;


FIG. 23 is a front elevational view of said fourth chair; and

FIG. 24 is a rear elevational view of said fourth chair.

























