The ornamental design for a seat, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my design in the form of a loveseat;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; and
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of the seat shown in the form of an armchair.

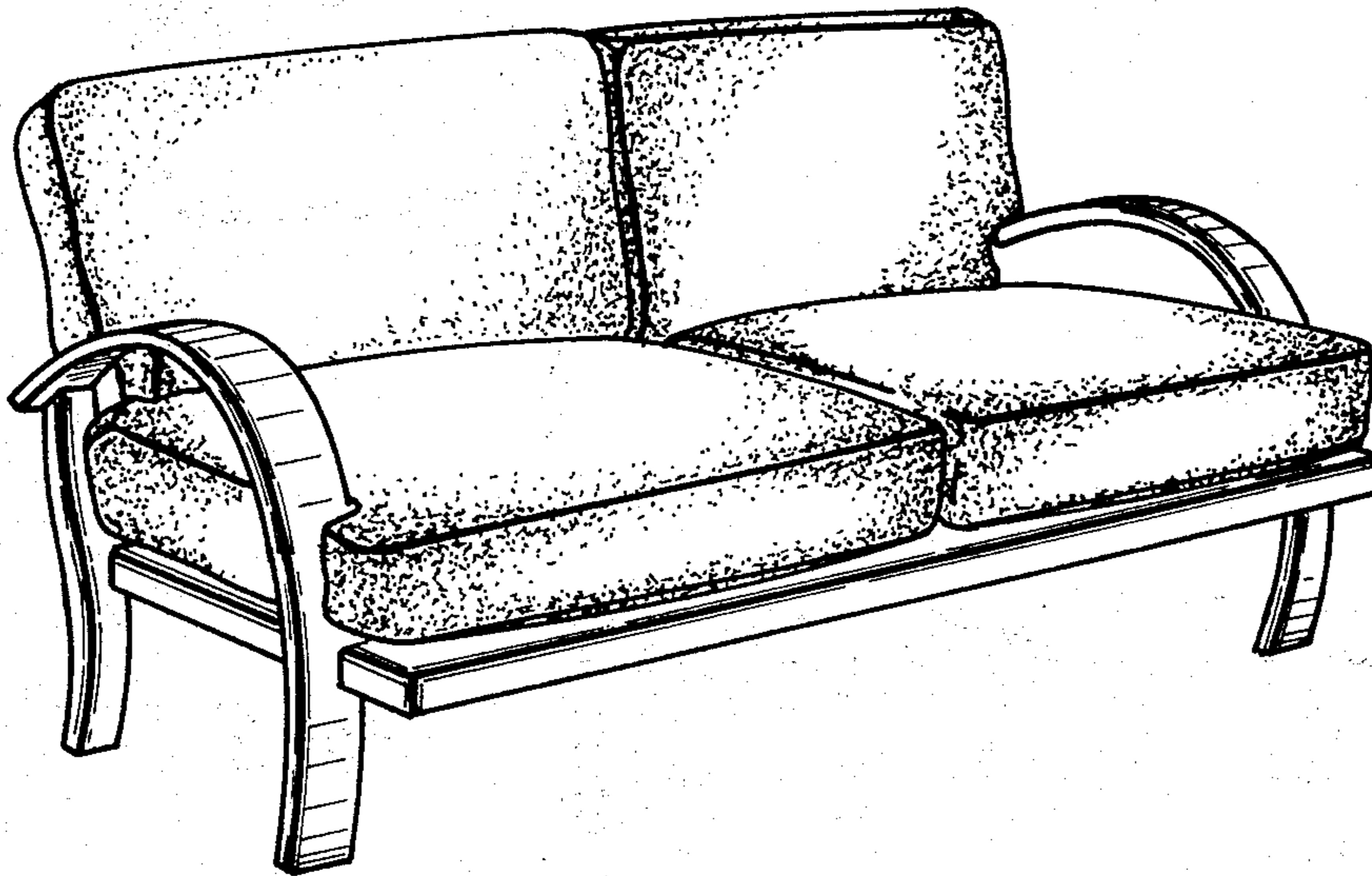

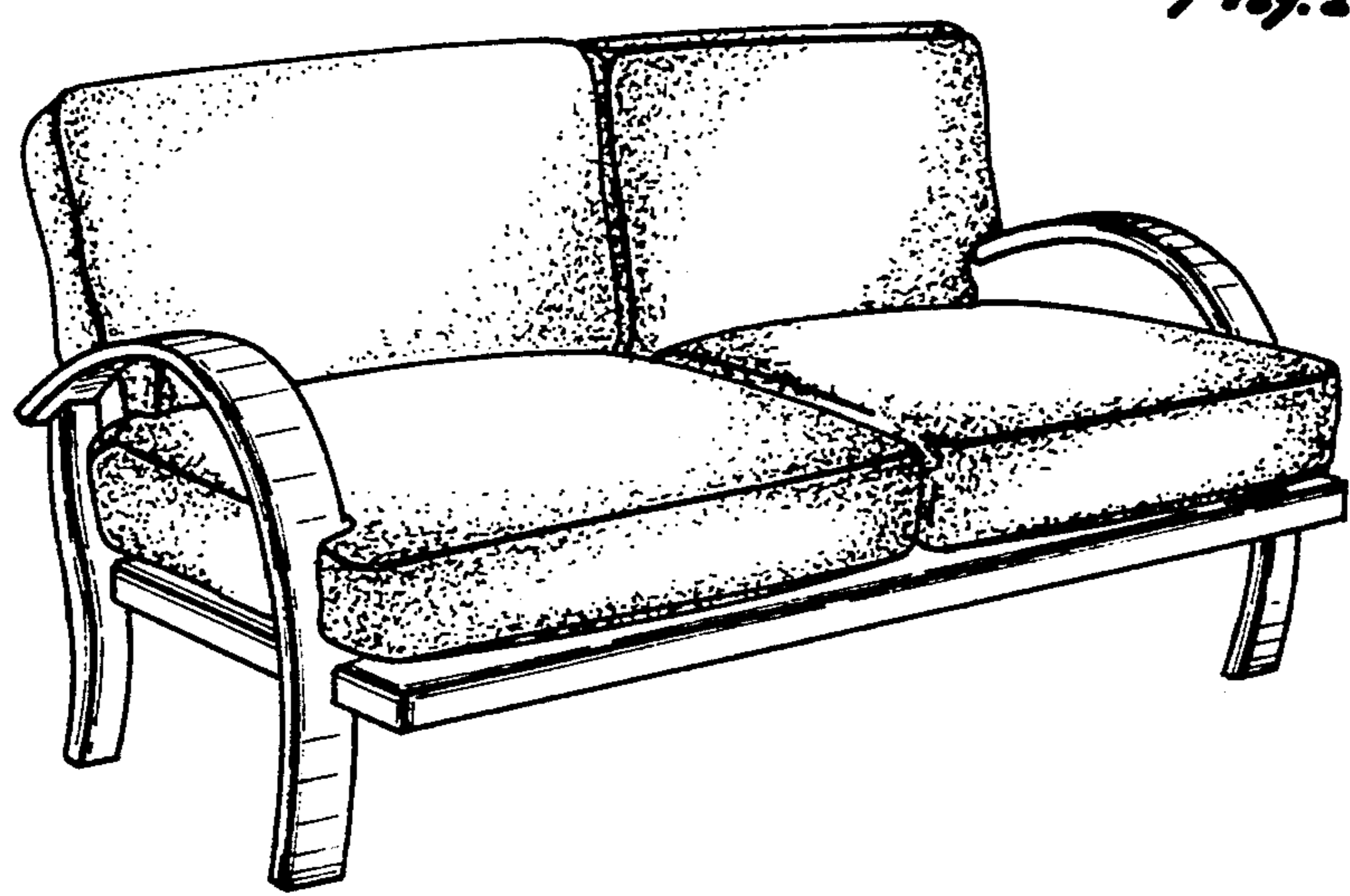

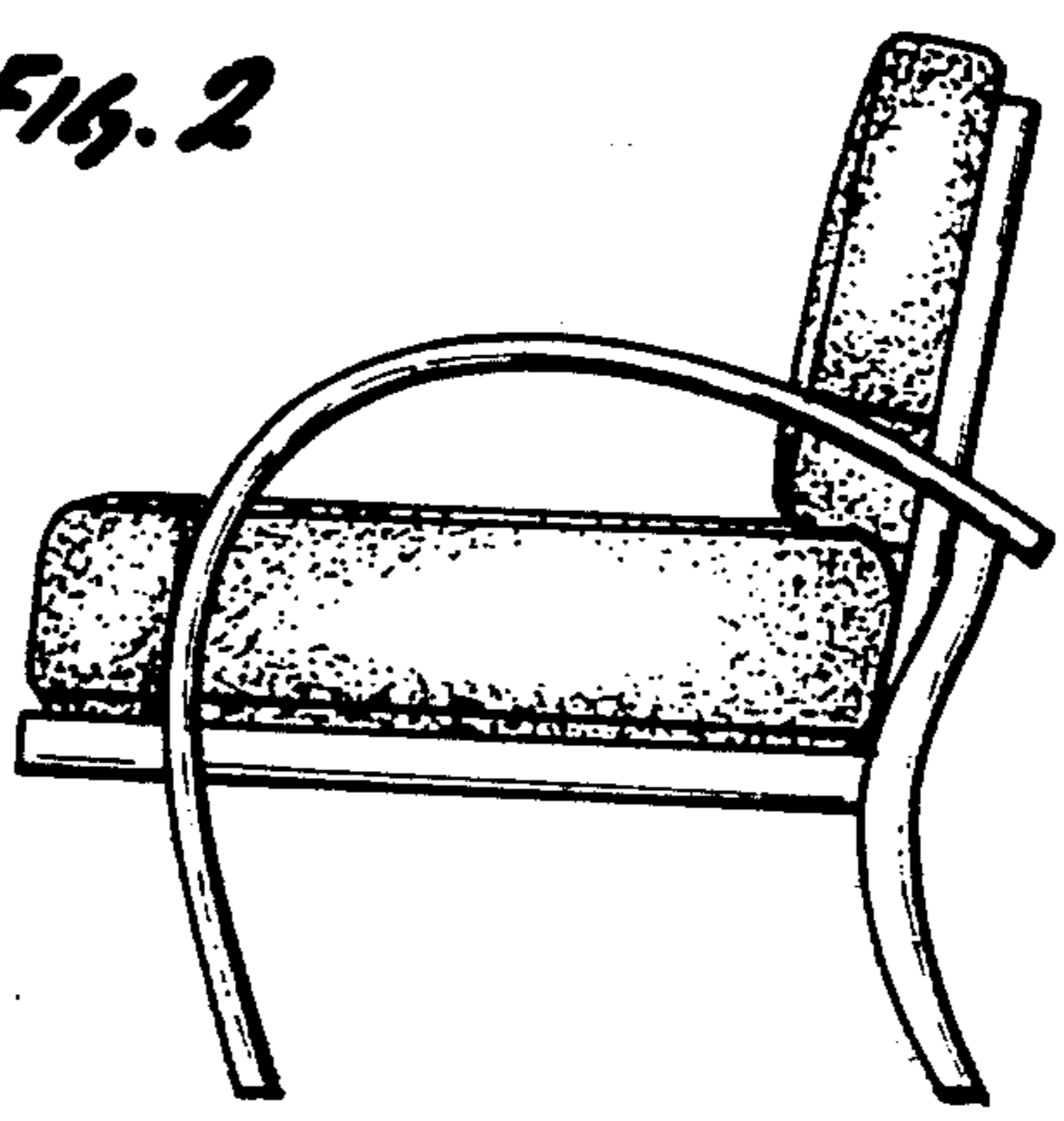
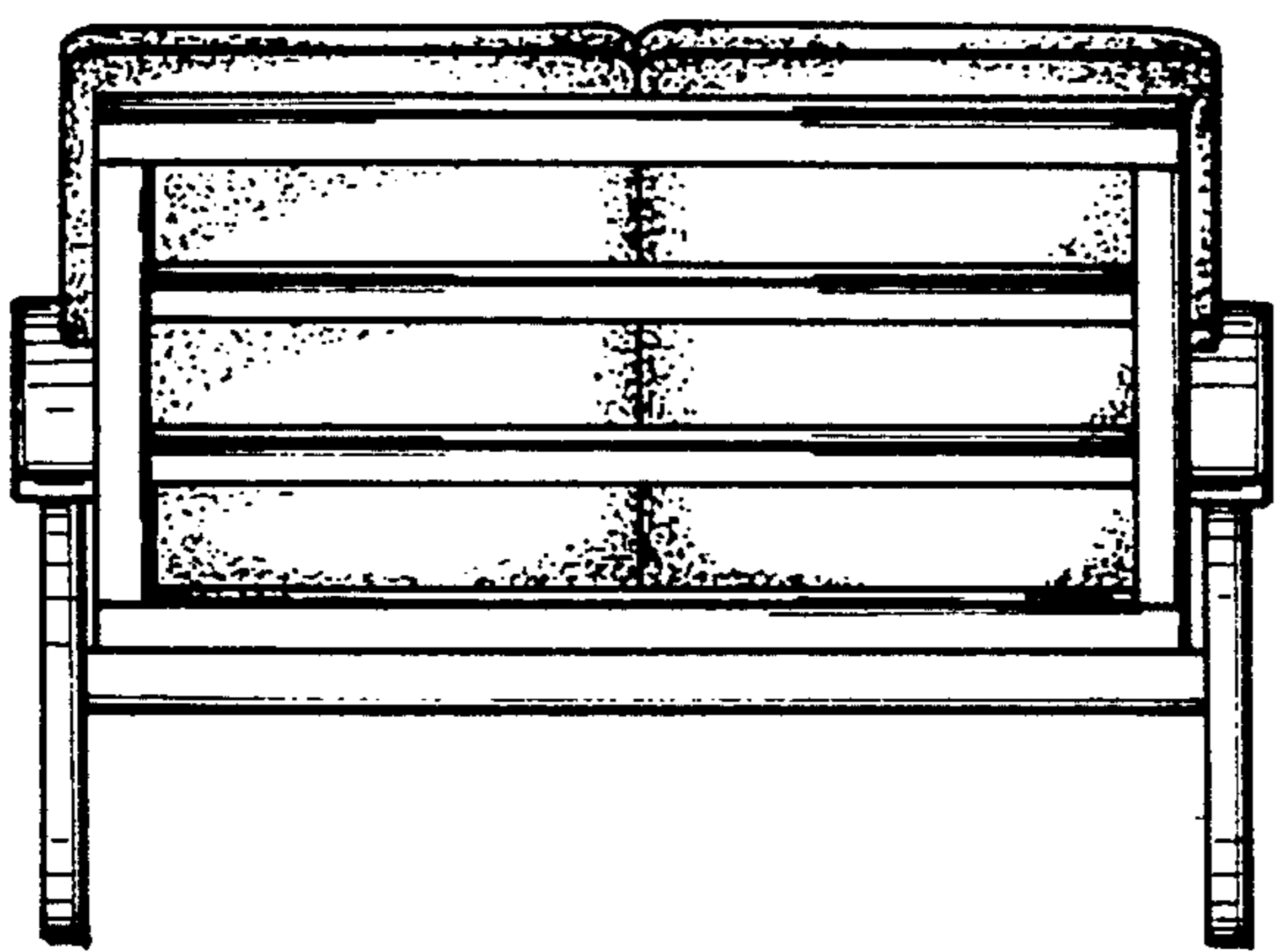

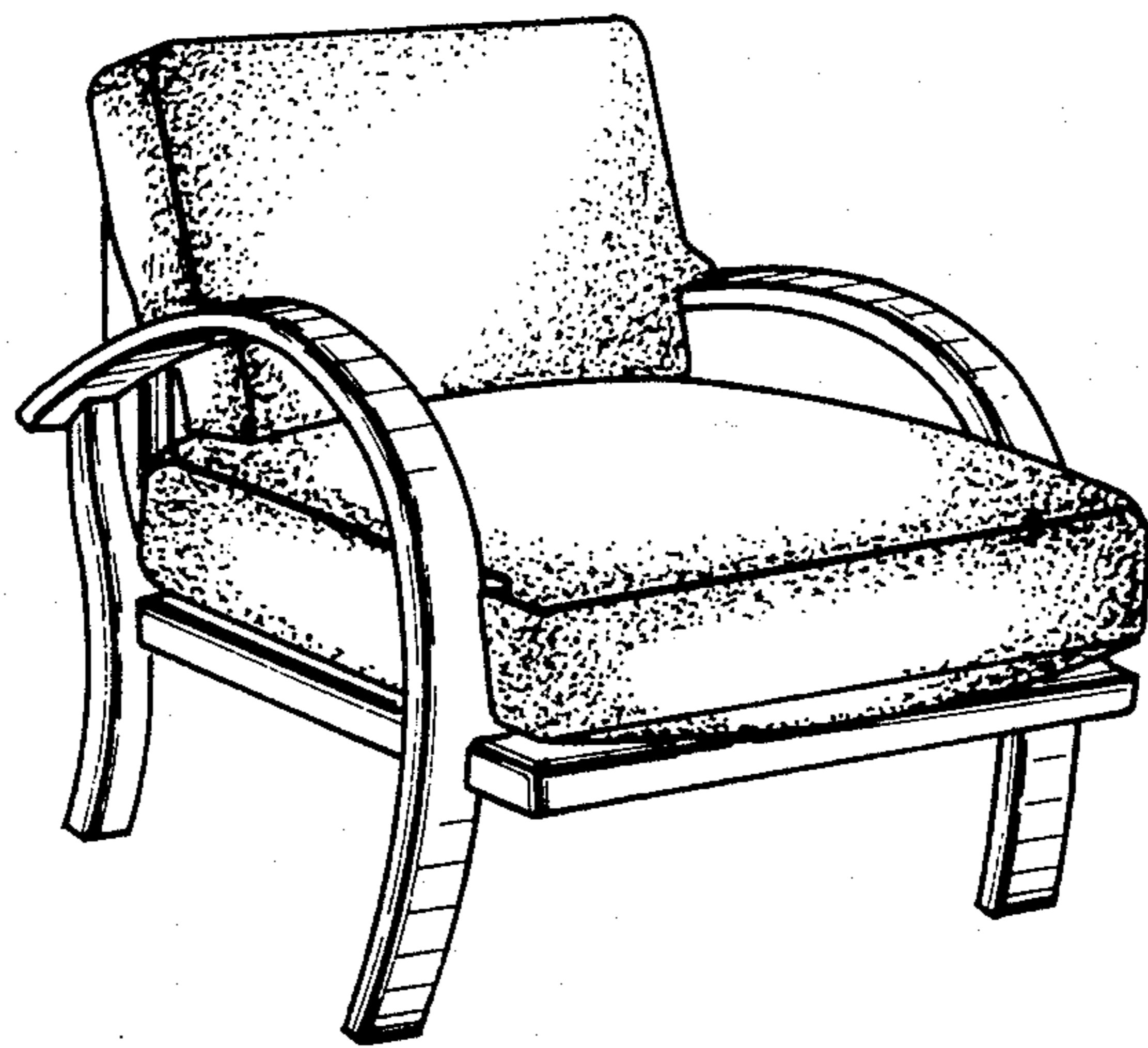
