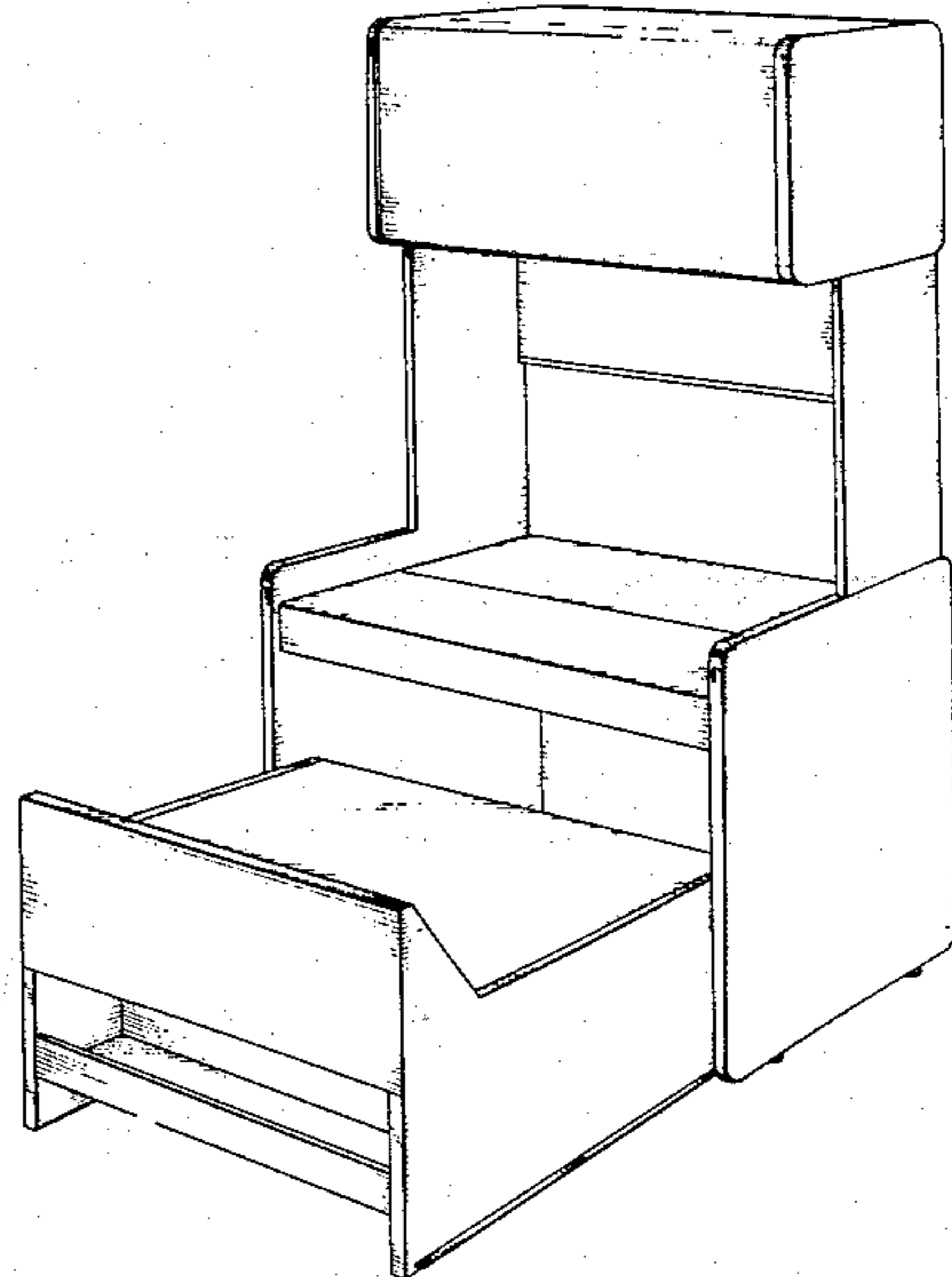
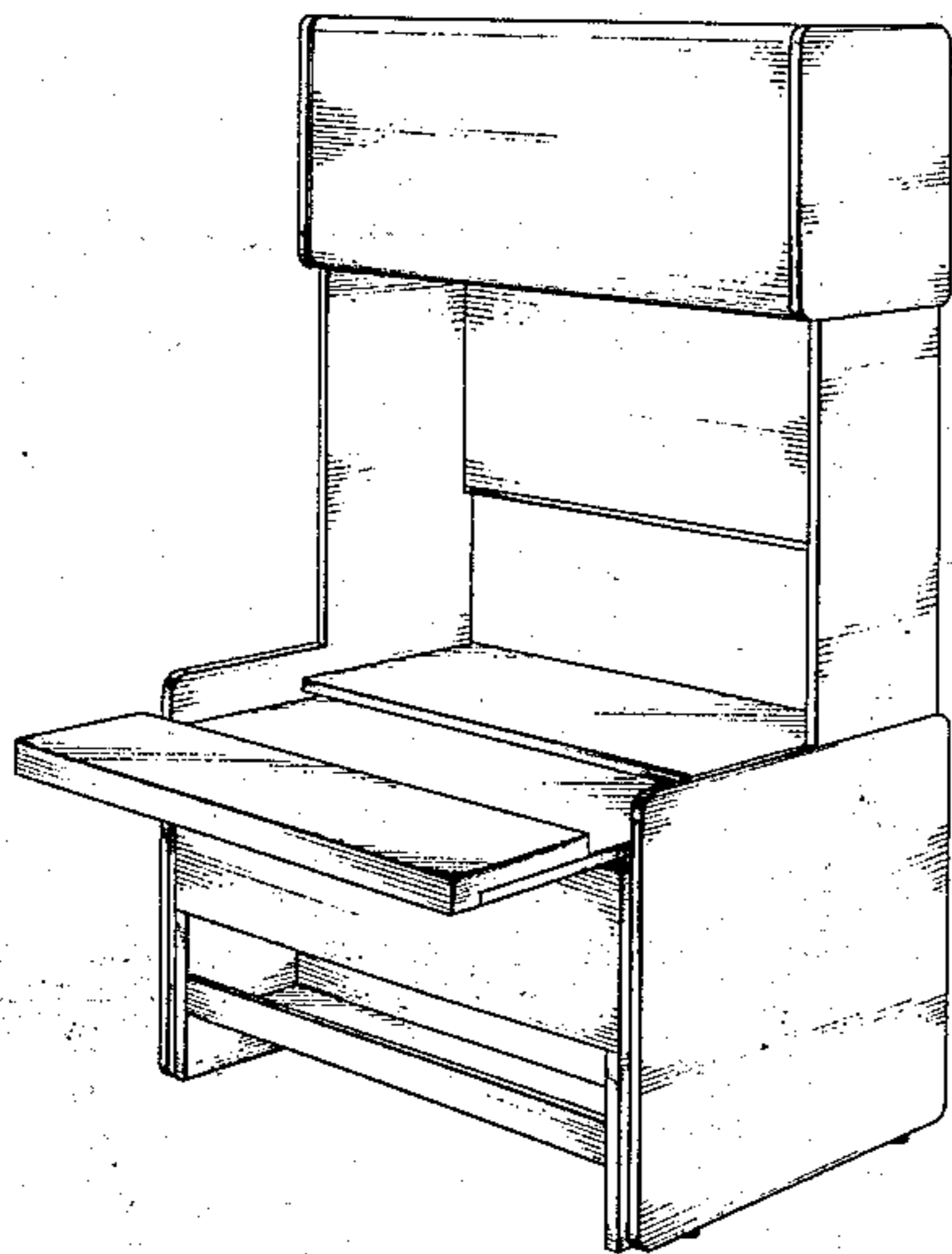

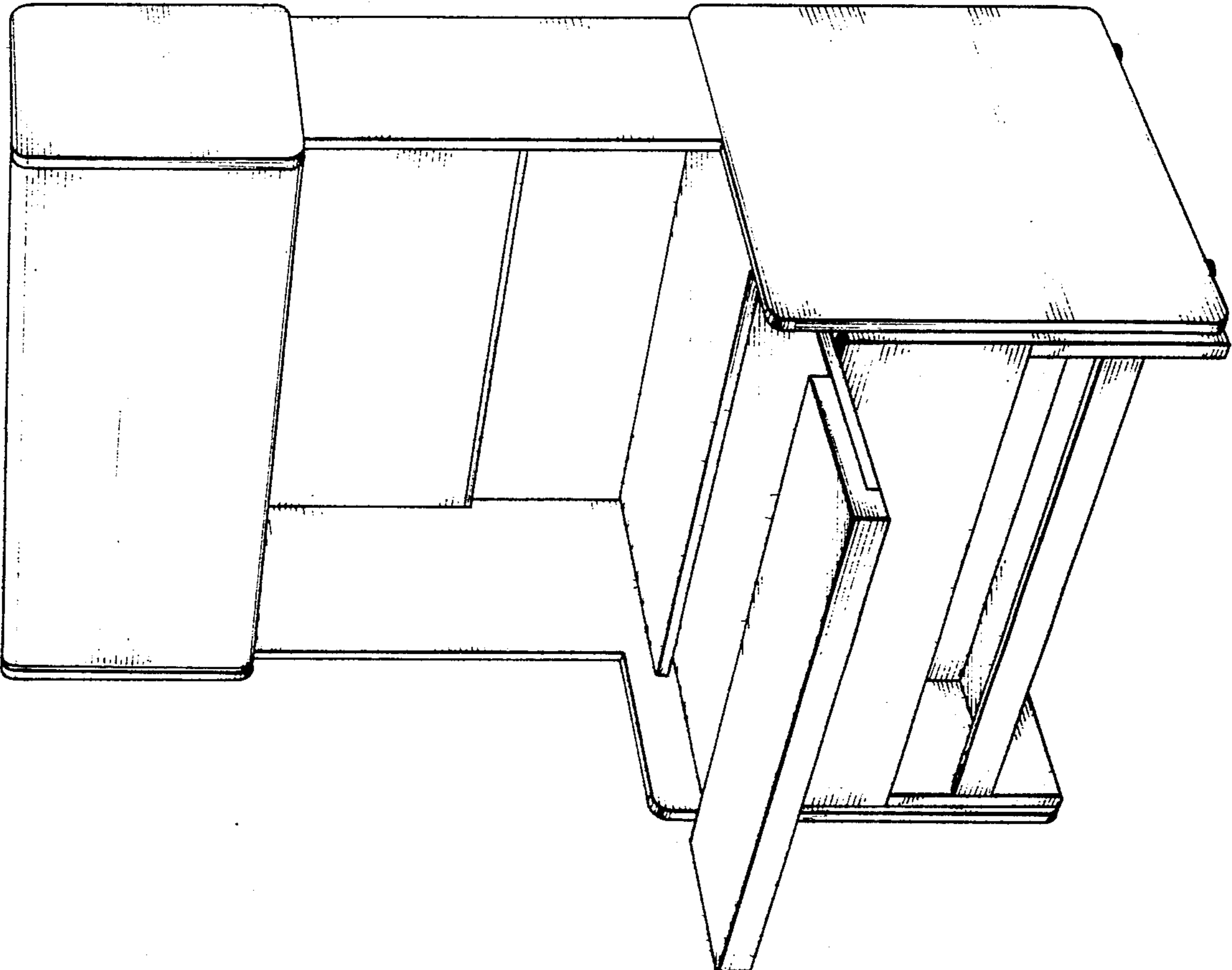
The ornamental design for a workstation, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

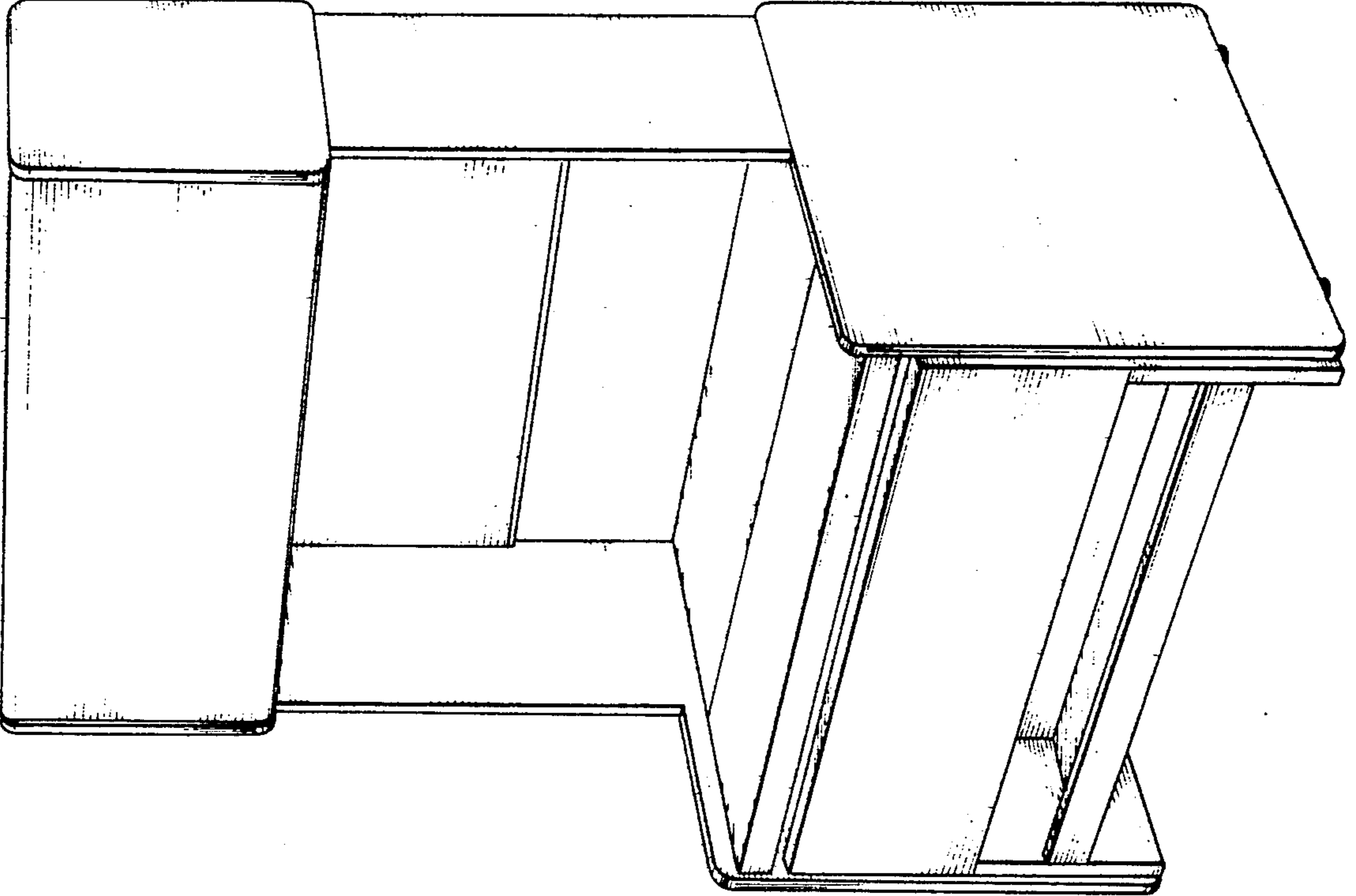
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a Workstation showing our new design;

 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



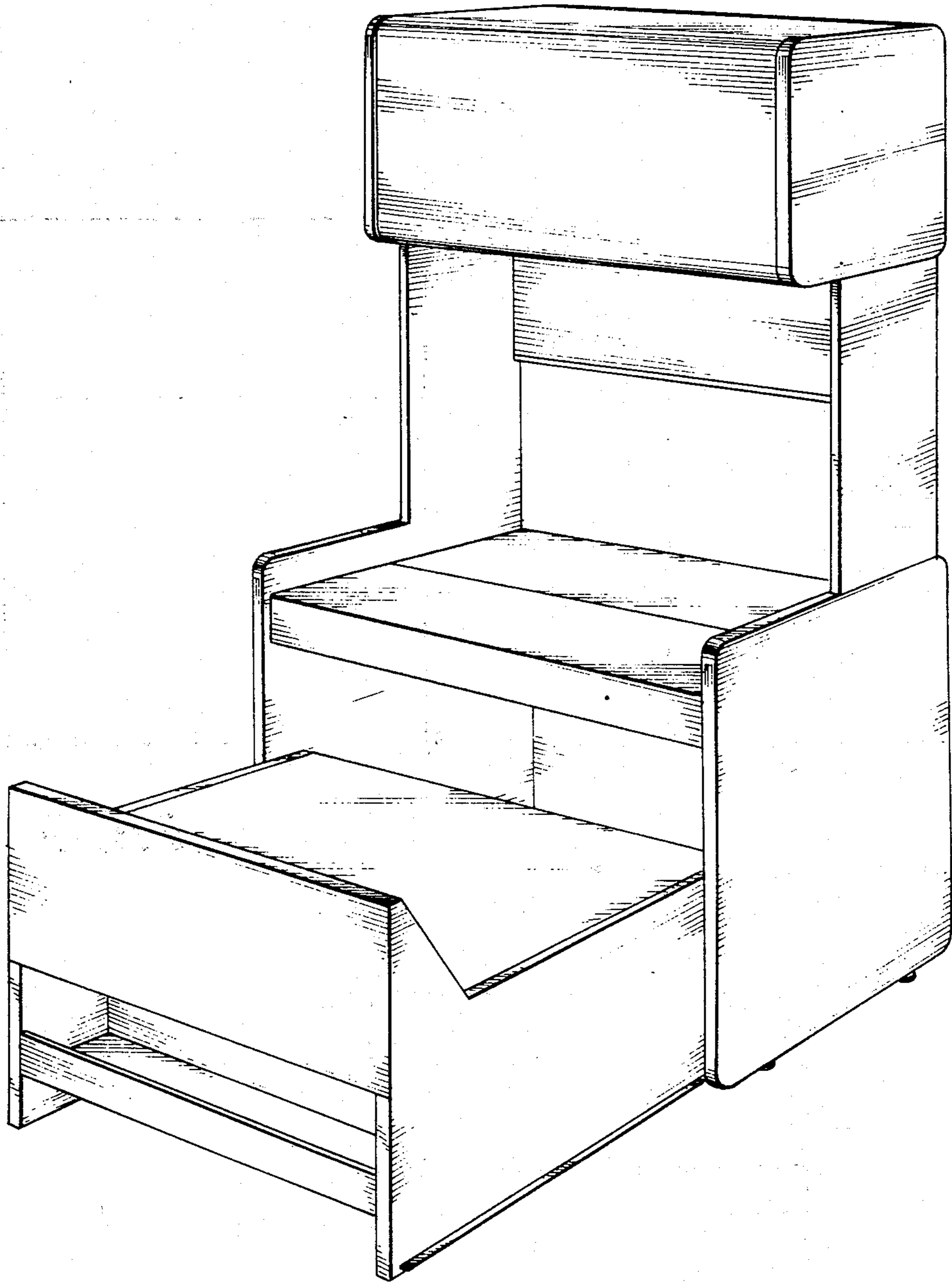

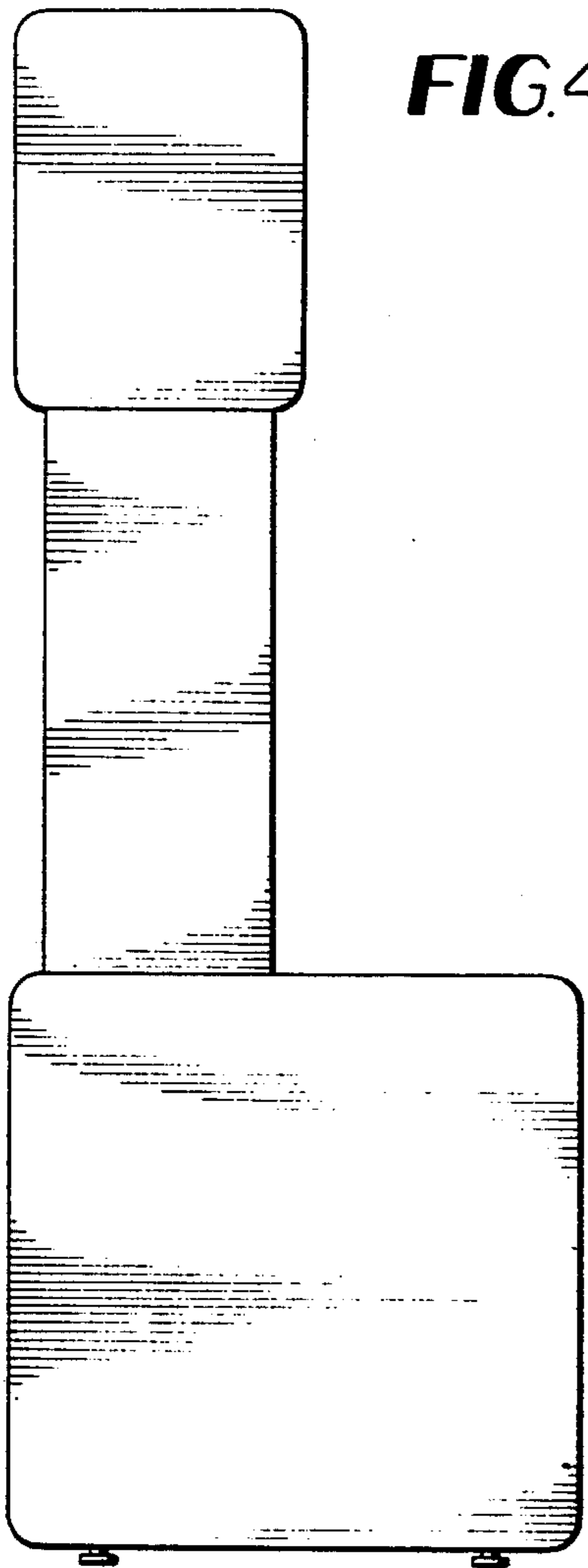

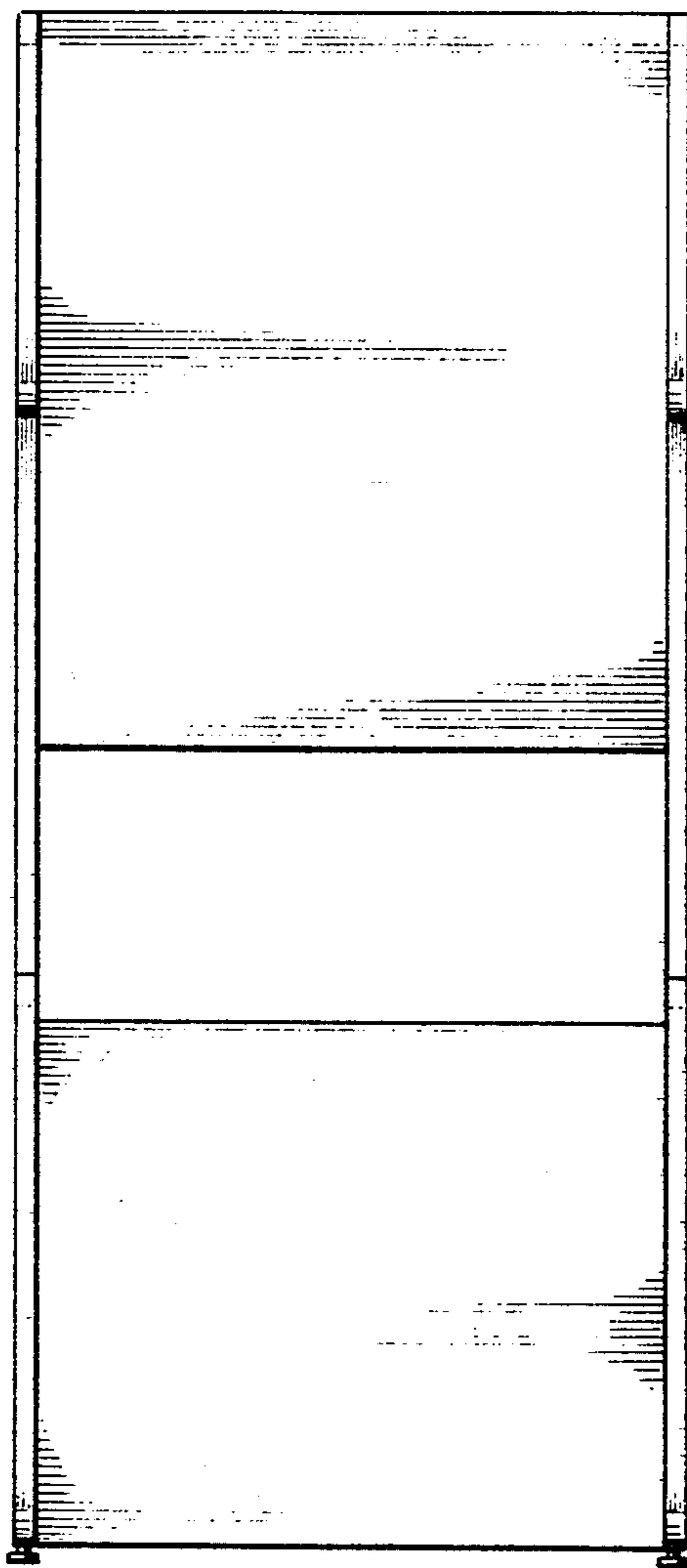

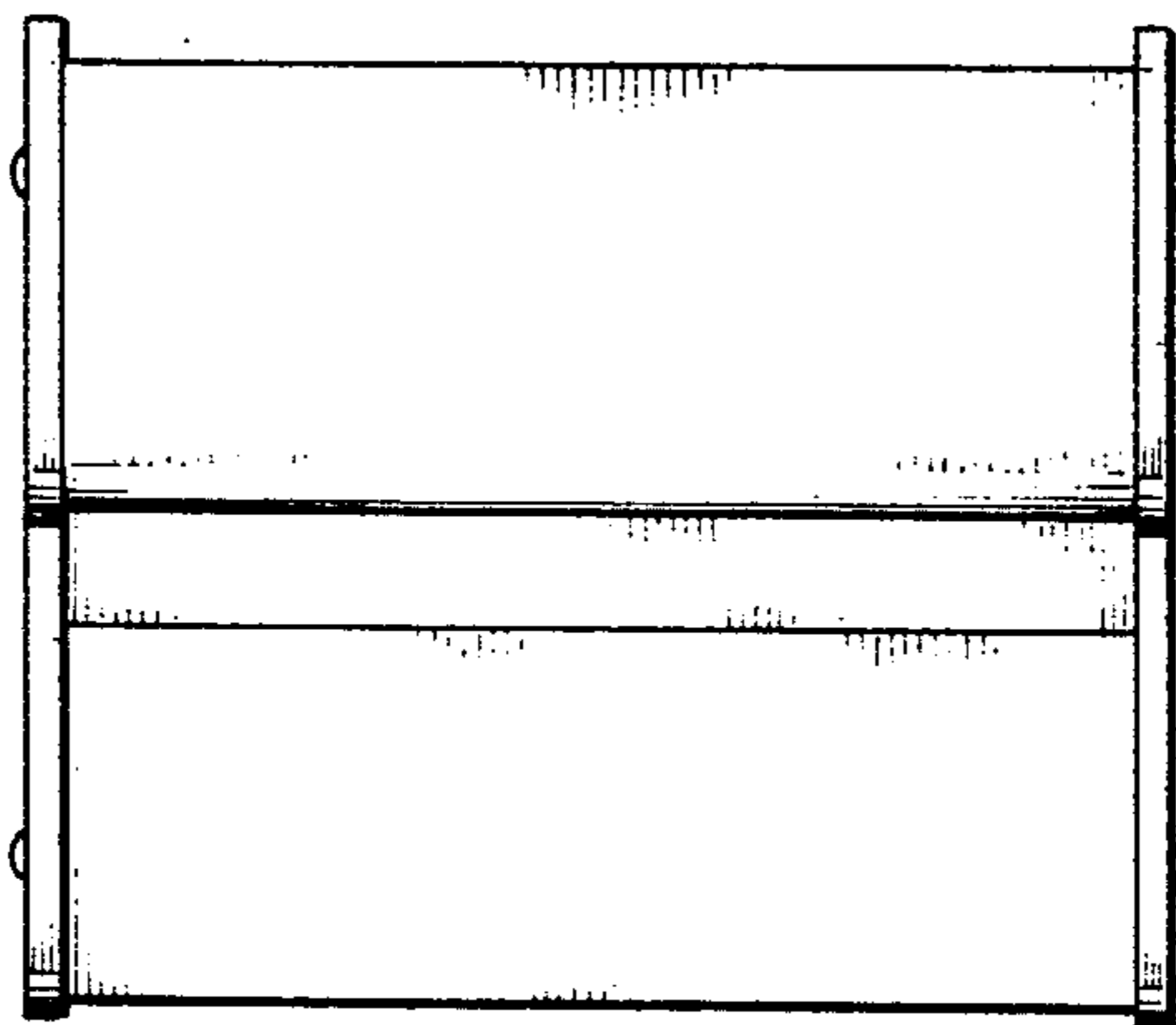
