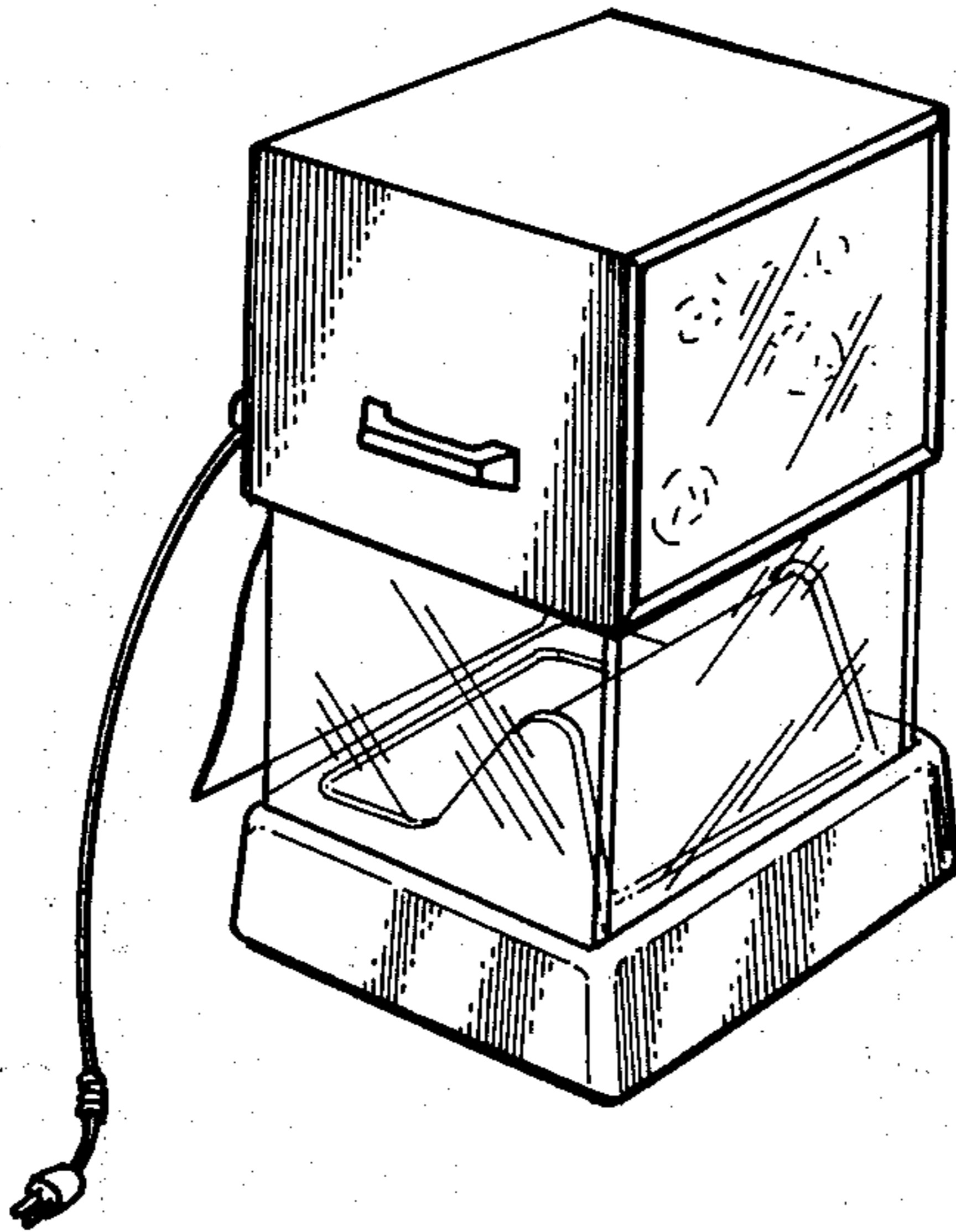
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a display case for elongated pastry products showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view, partially broken away to illustrate the shape of the troughs in the base; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

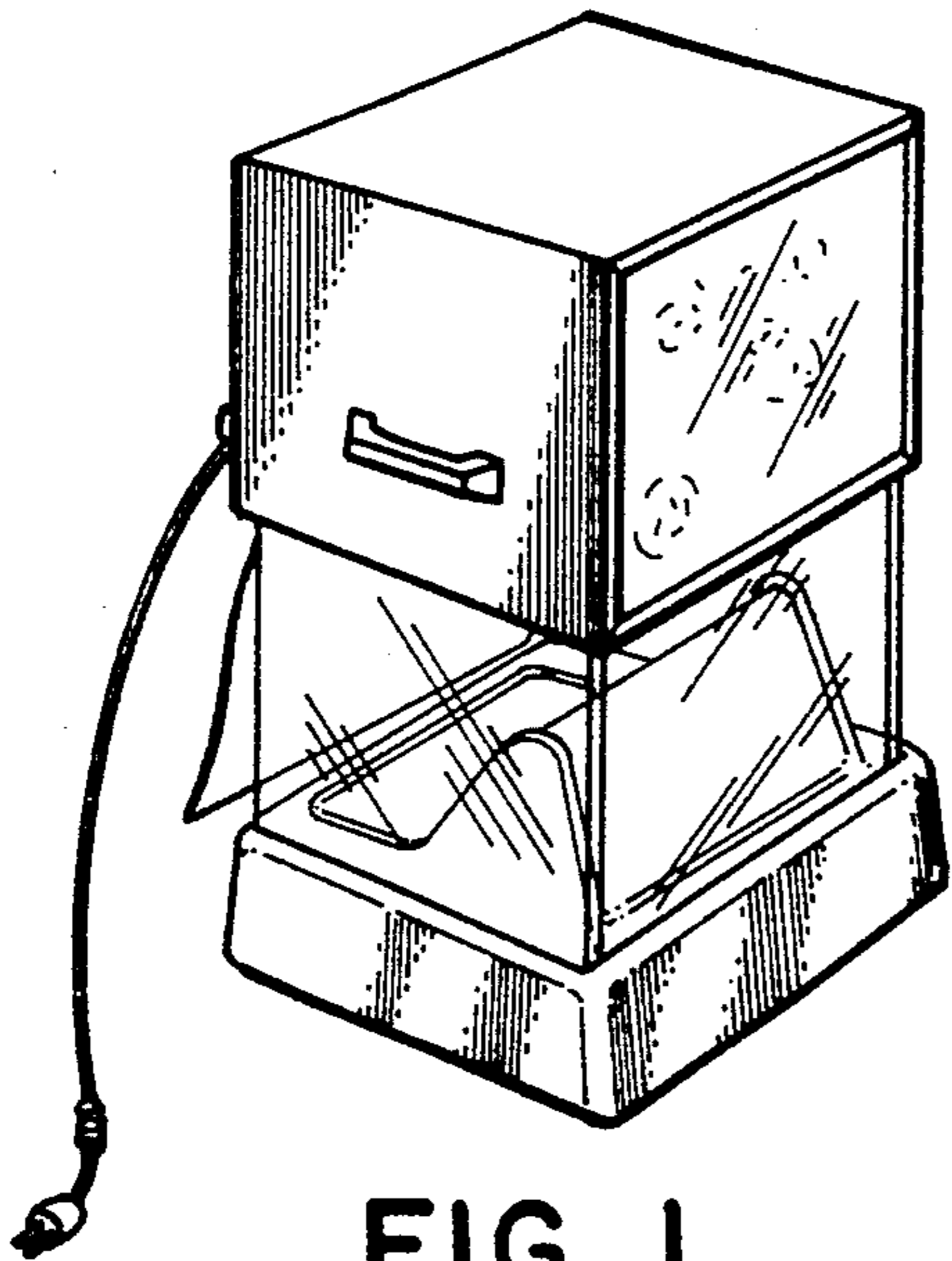

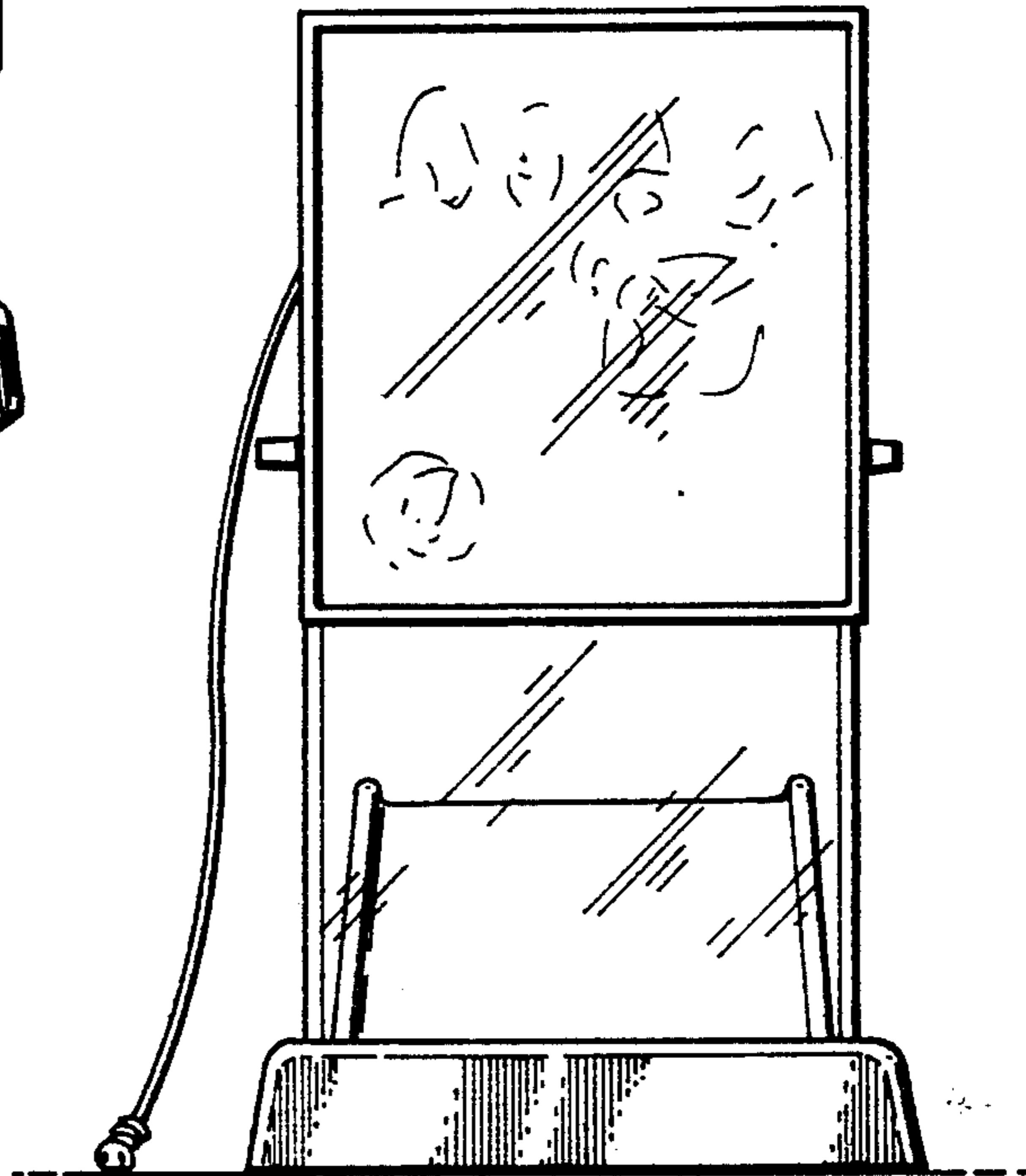

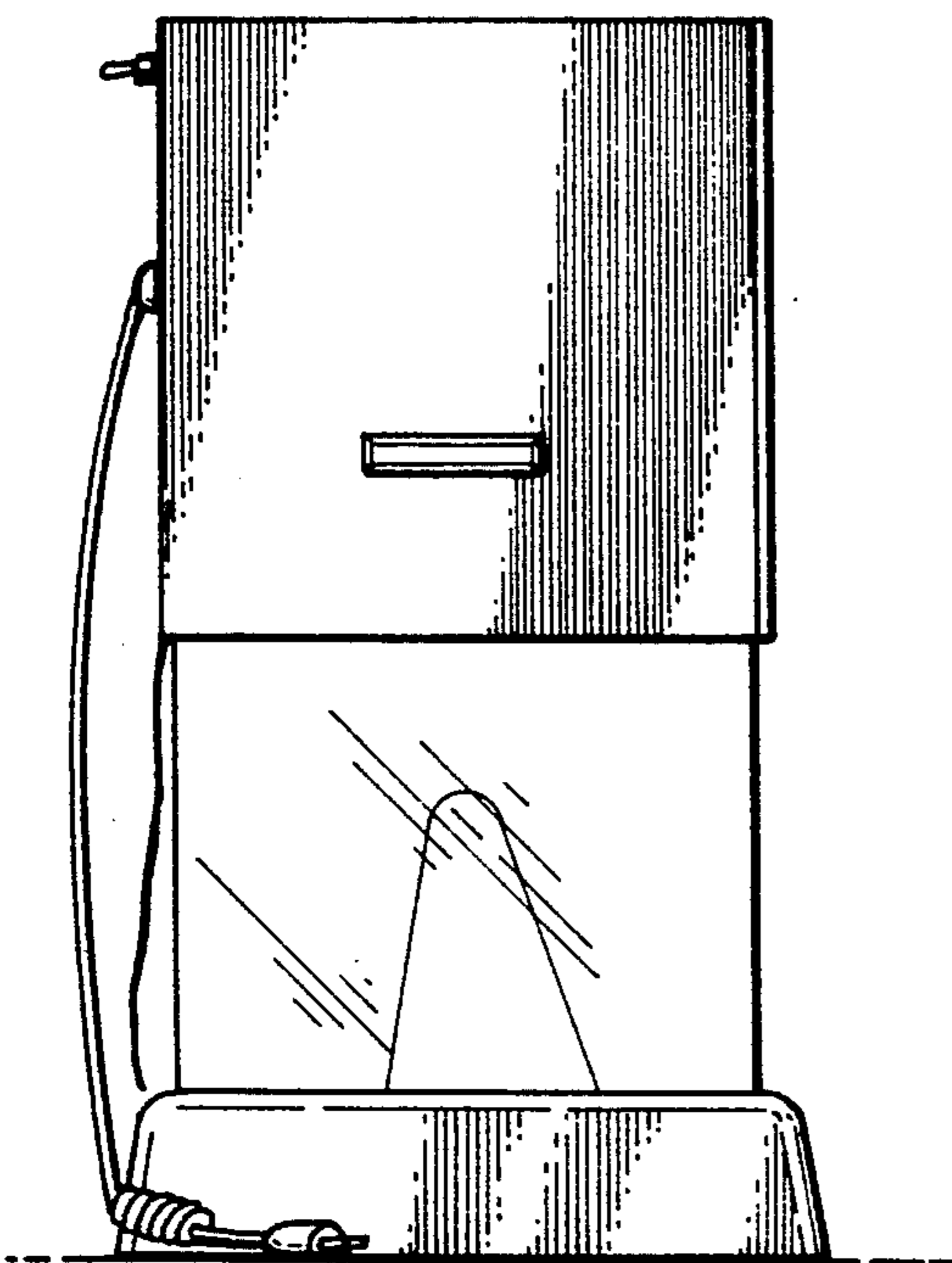

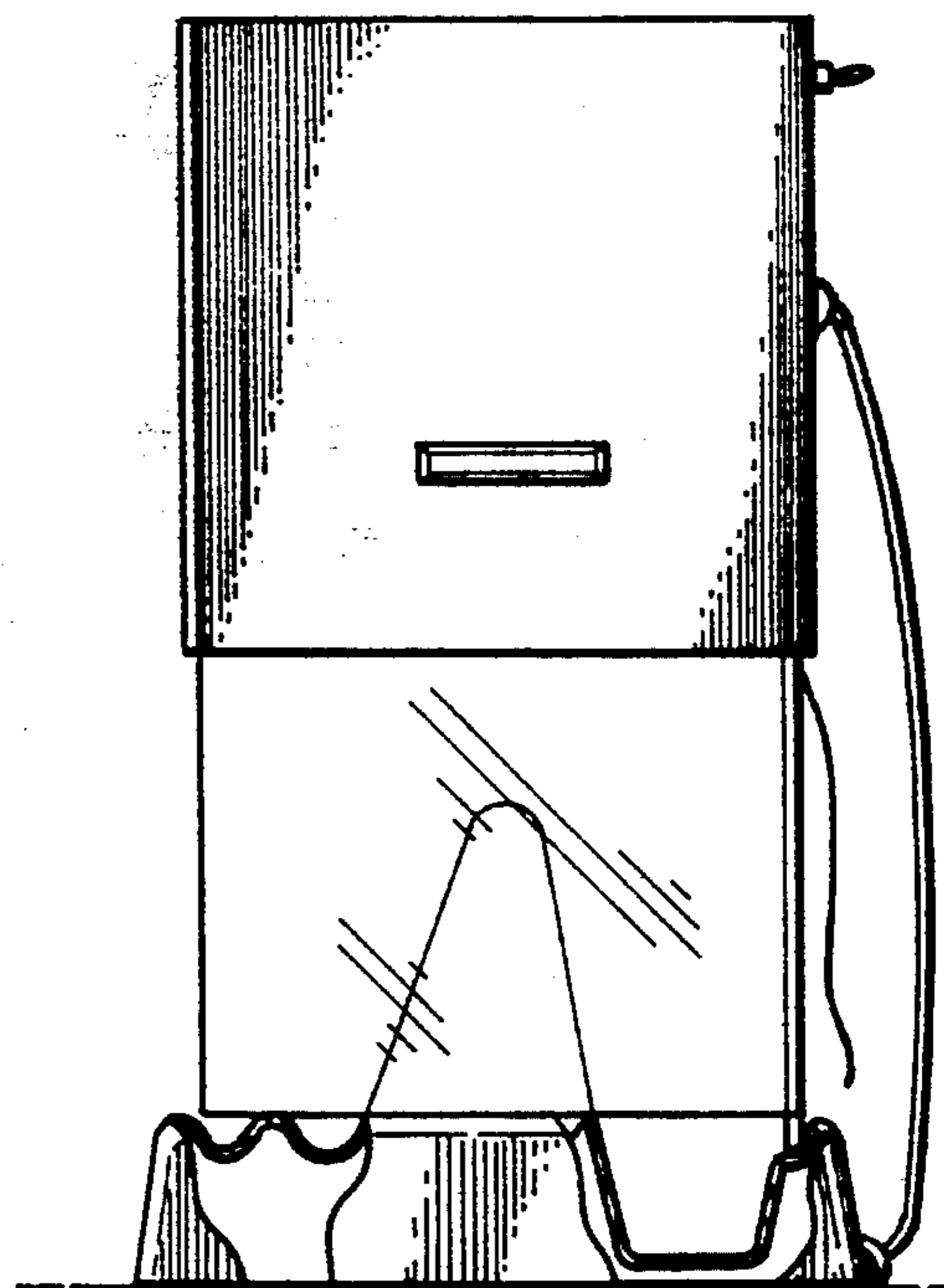
