FIG. 1 is a front view of a compound bow according to the invention.

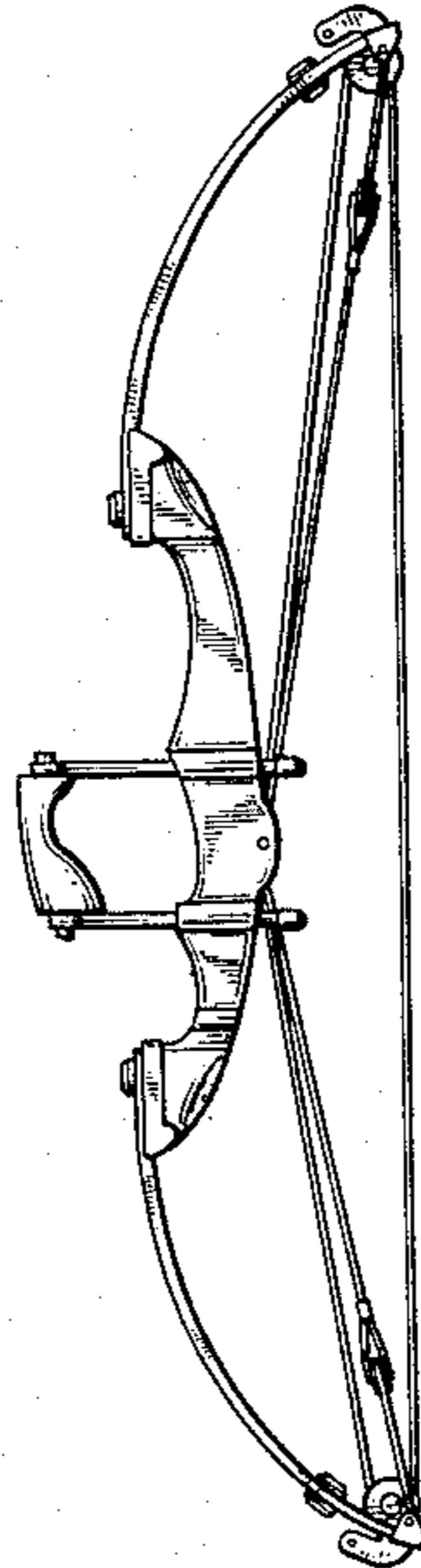
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof.

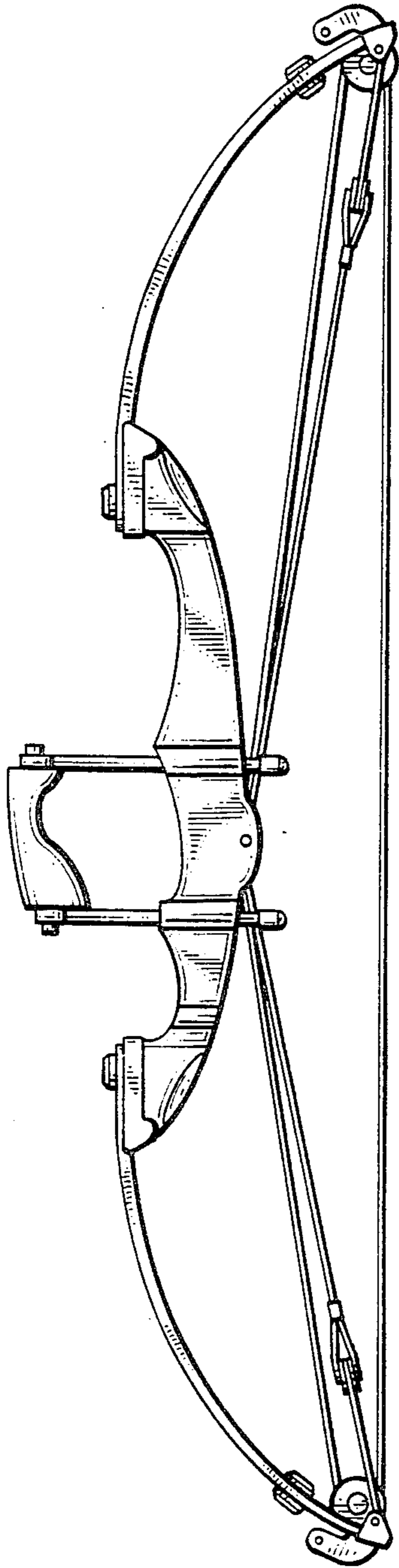
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

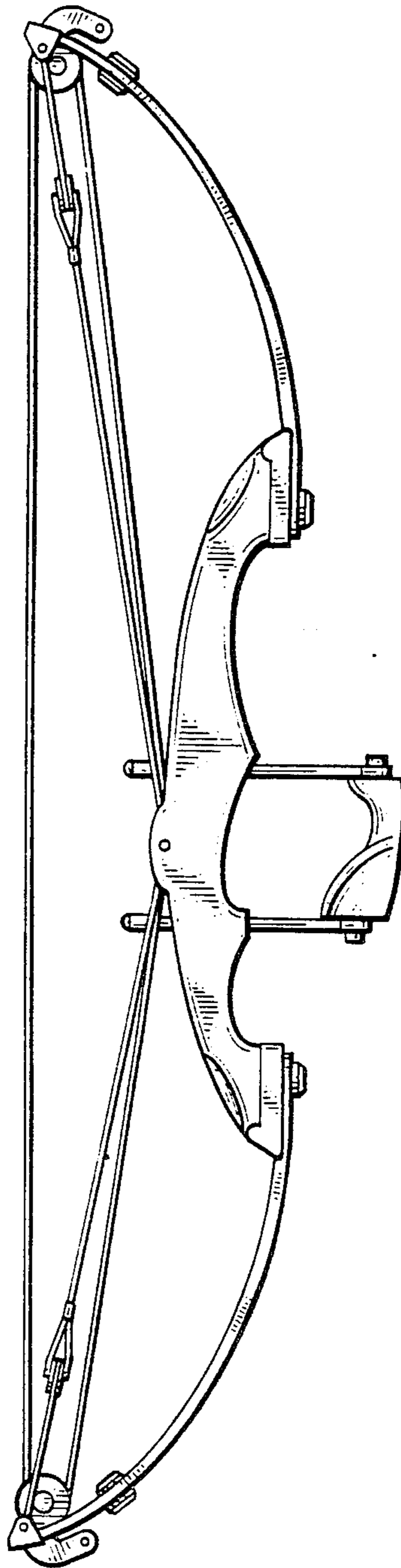

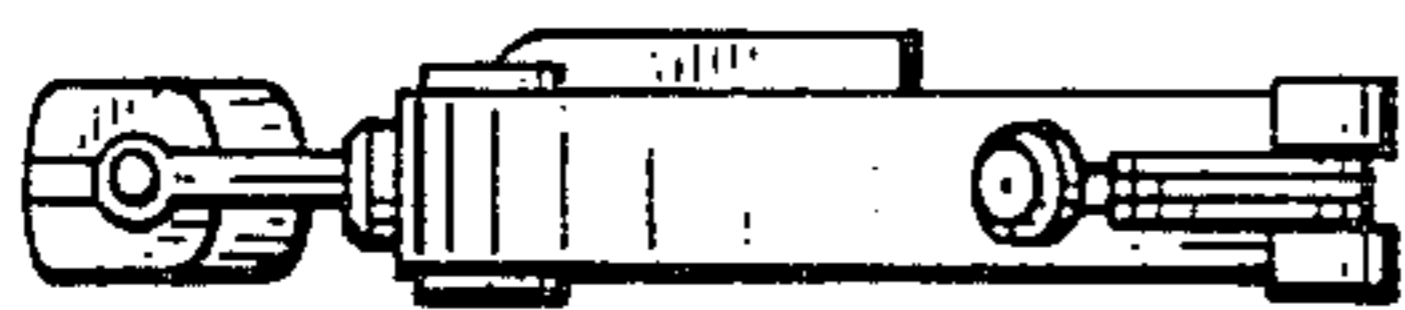

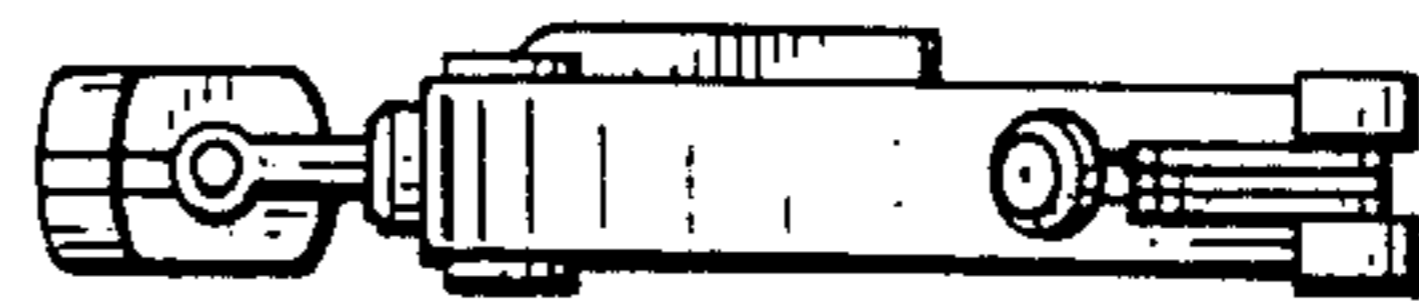
