The ornamental design for a soft-sided shoulder bag, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a soft-sided shoulder bag showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left end perspective view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right end perspective view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a top perspective view thereof.

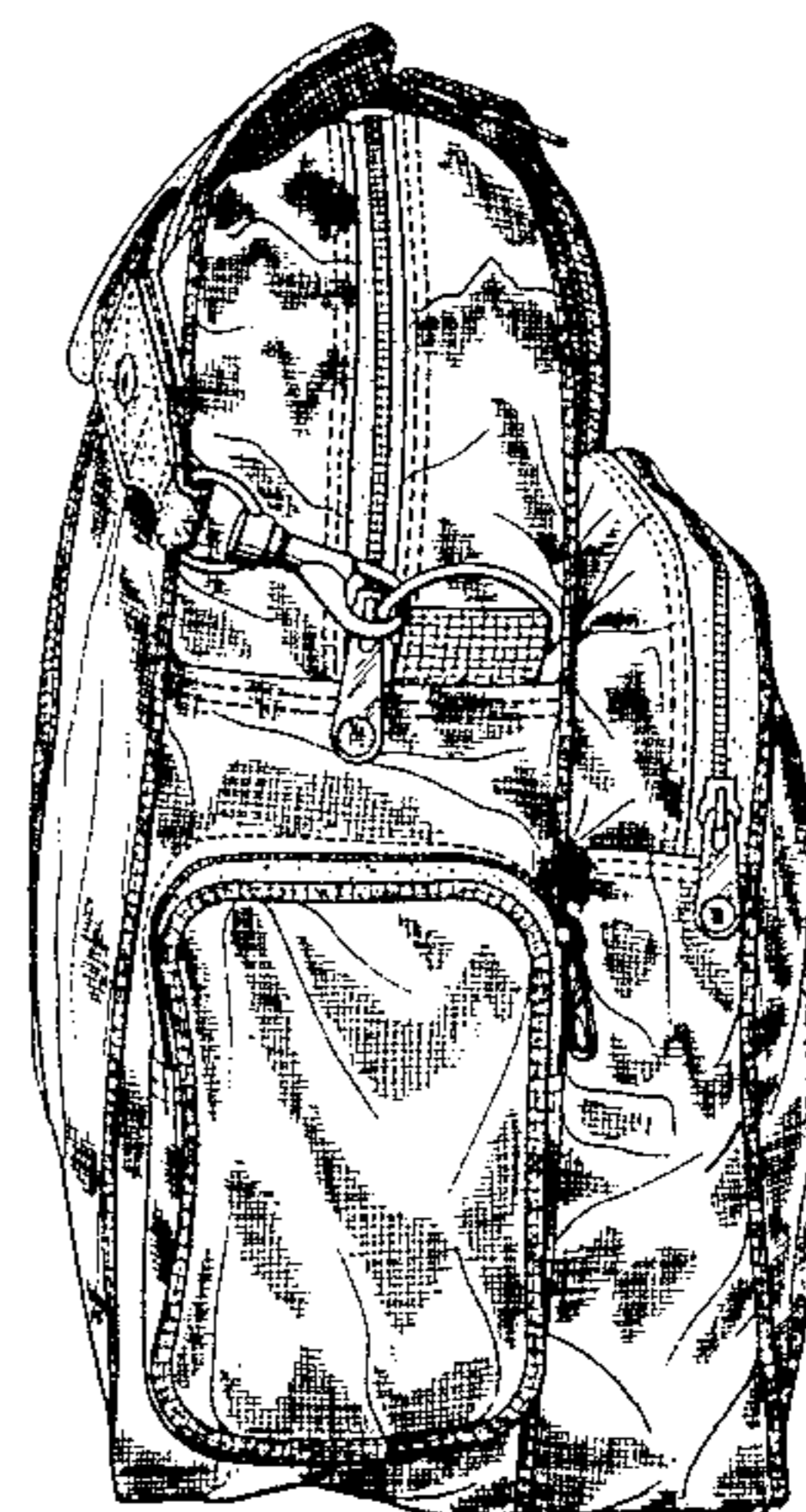

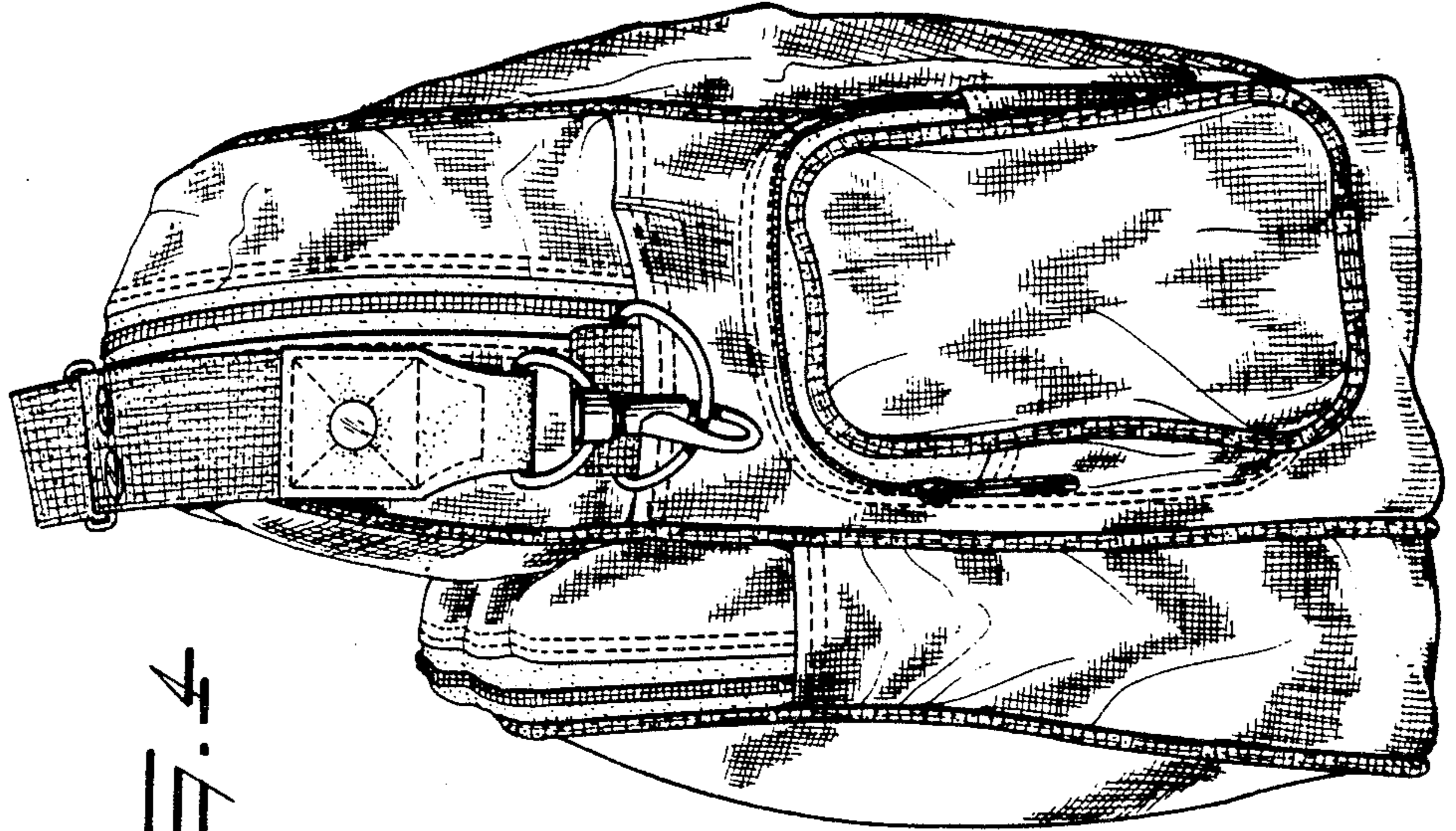
