The ornamental design for a suitcase, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a suitcase showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the suitcase;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the suitcase;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the suitcase; and
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of one end of the suitcase, which end is similar in appearance to the other end.

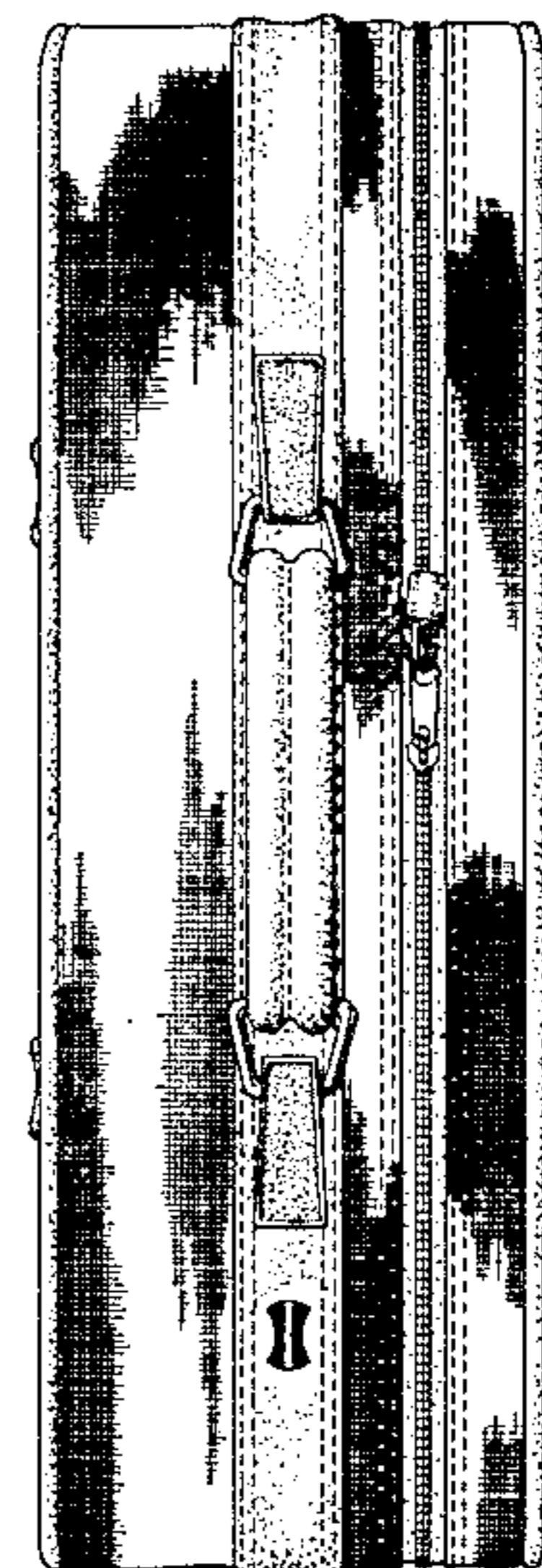
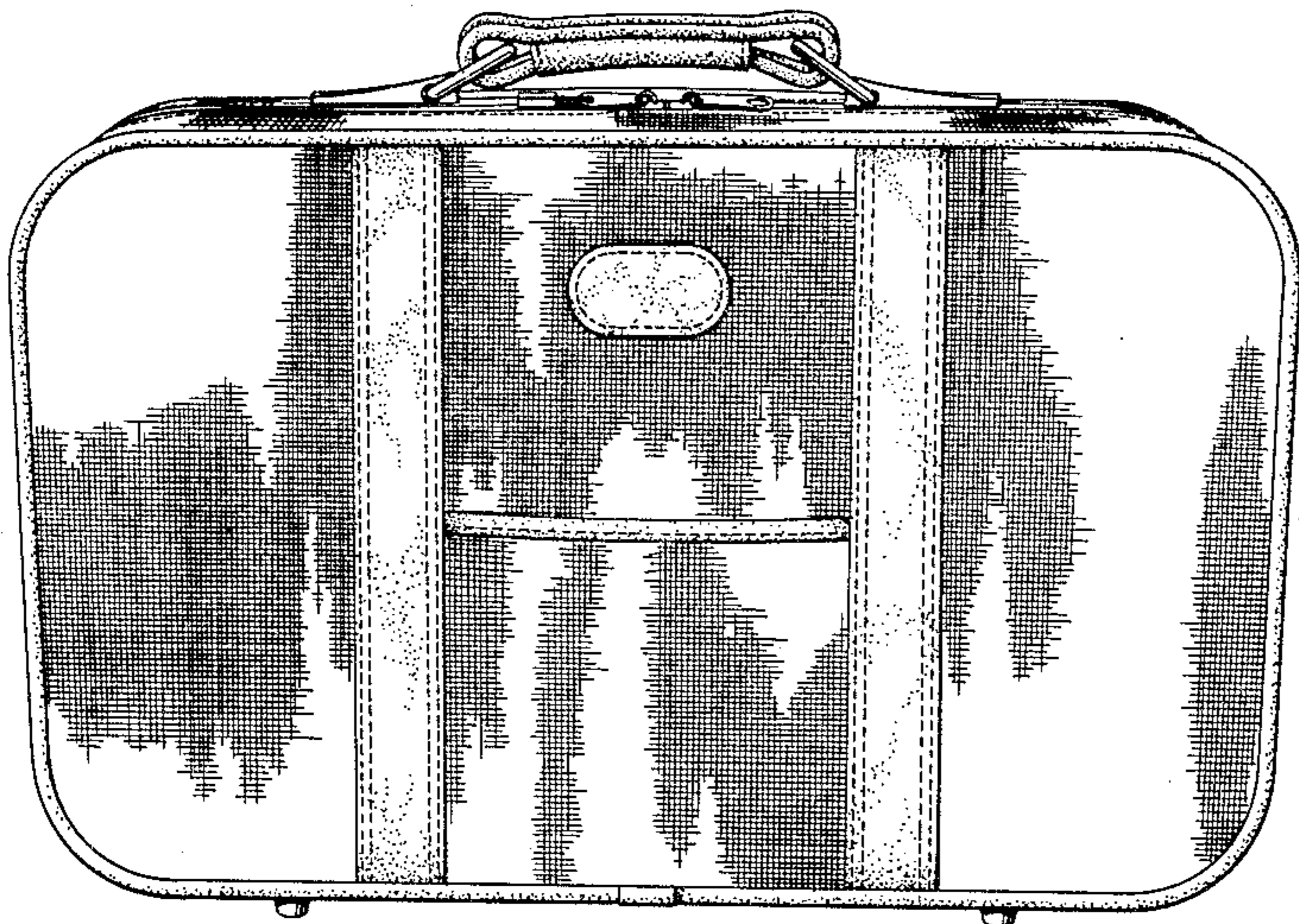

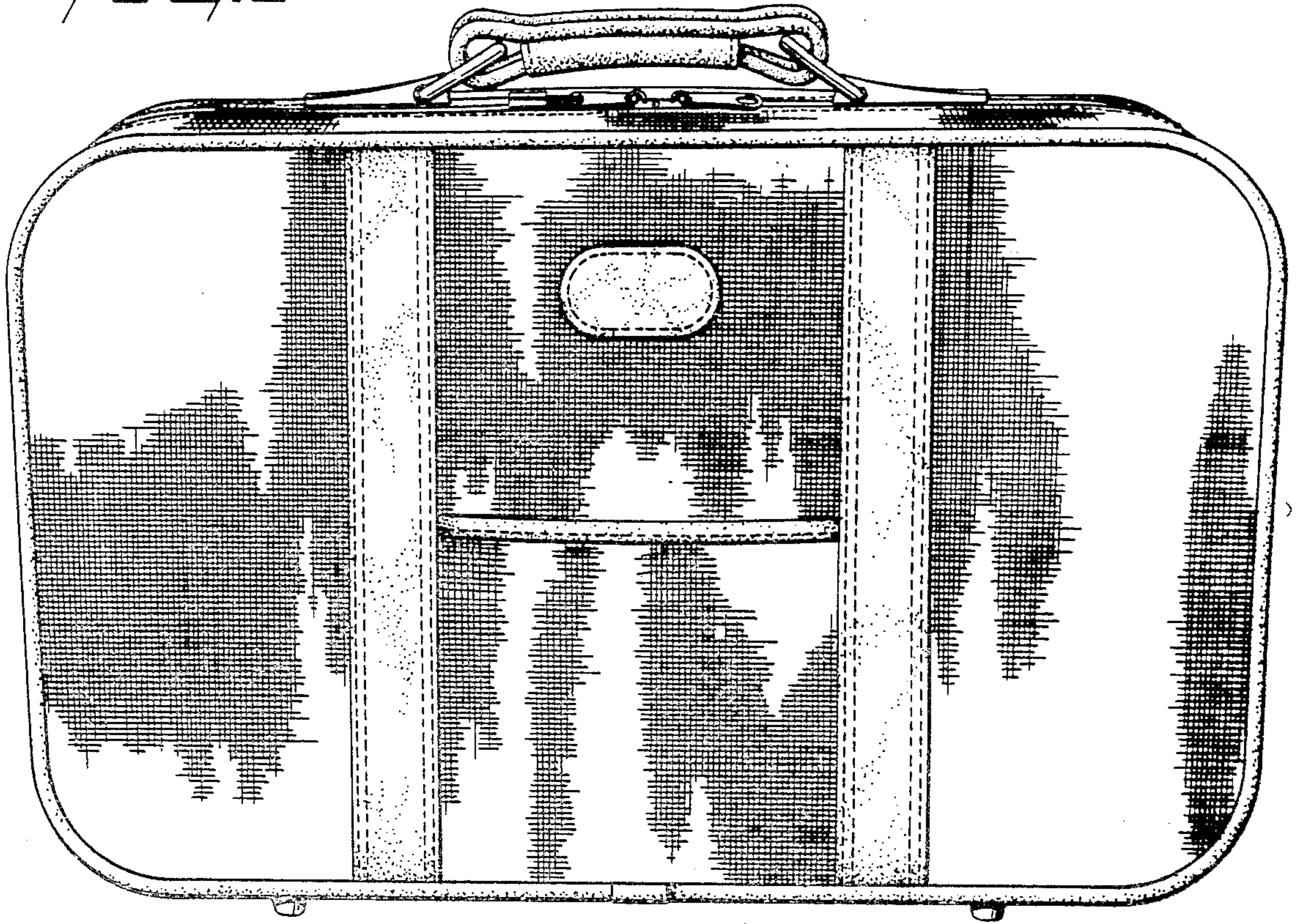
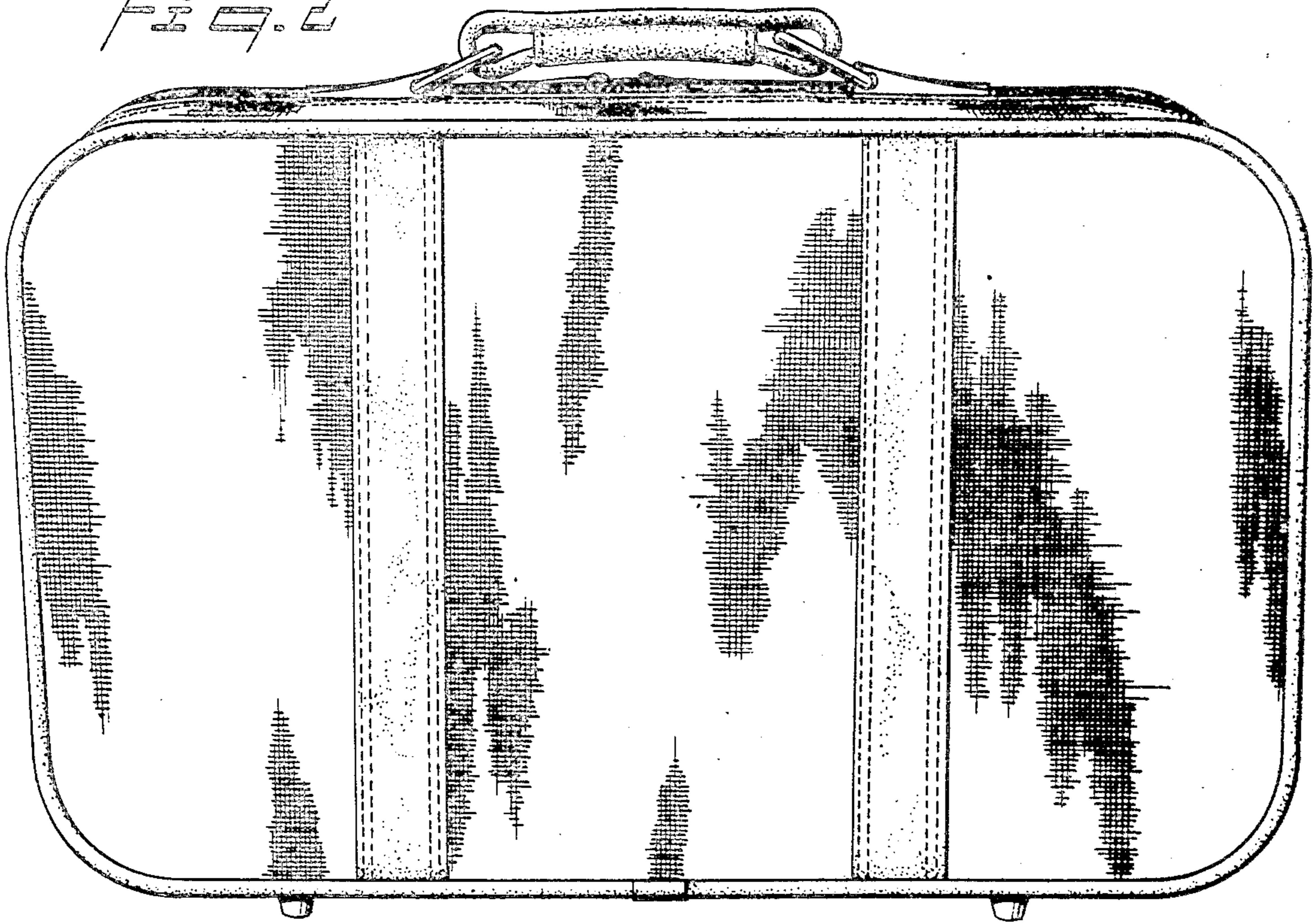

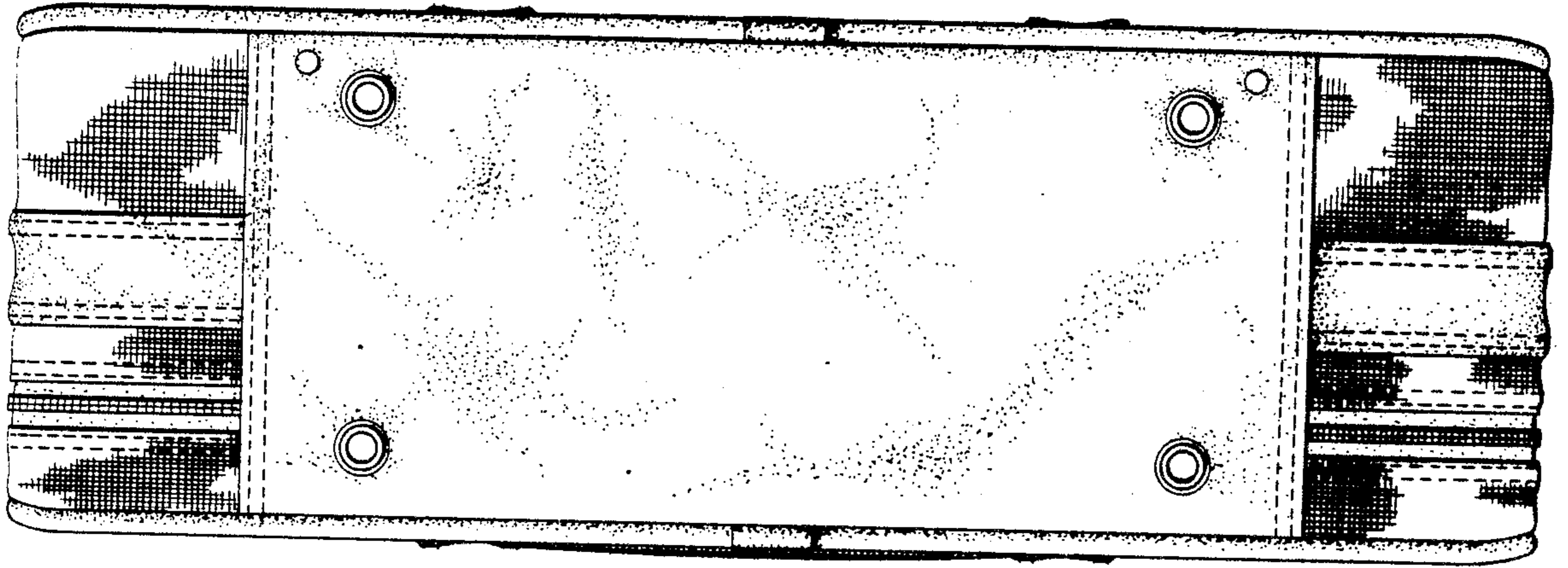

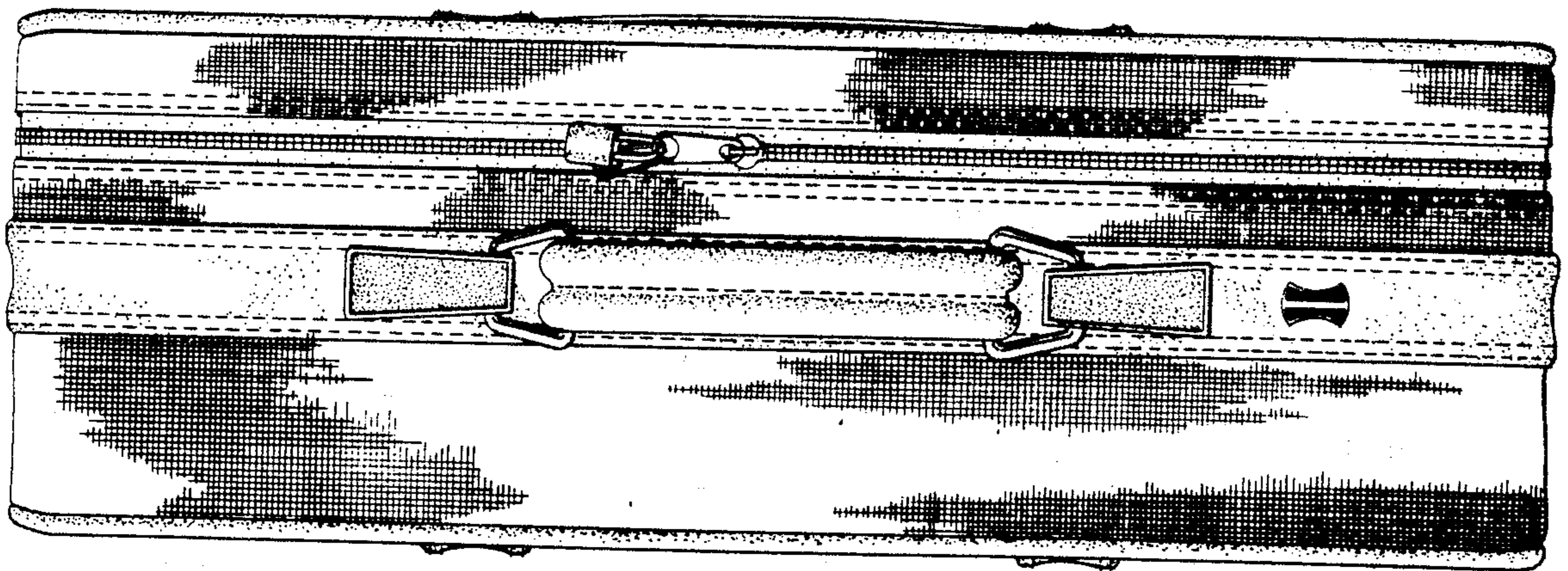
