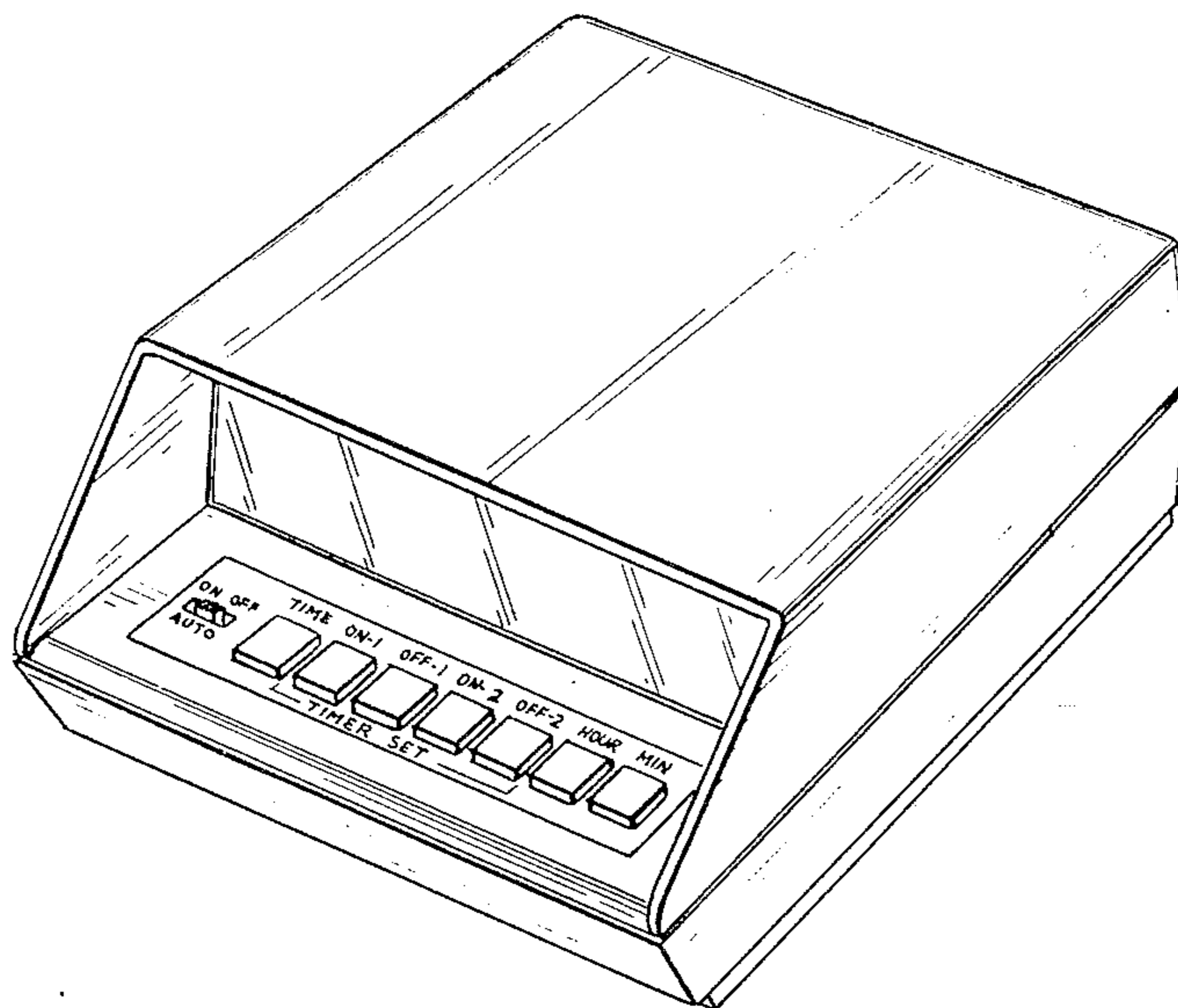
The ornamental design for an electric timer, substantially as shown and described.

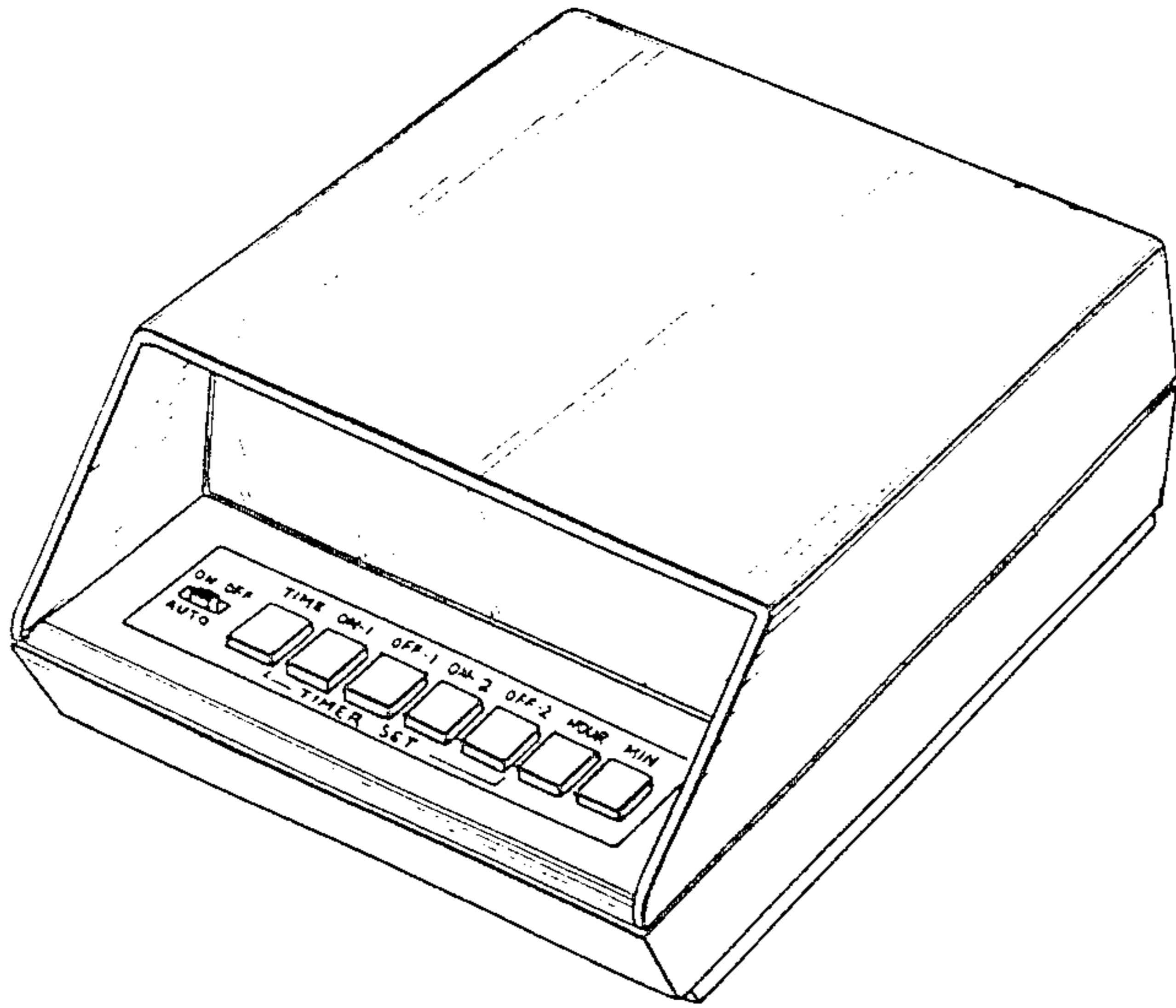

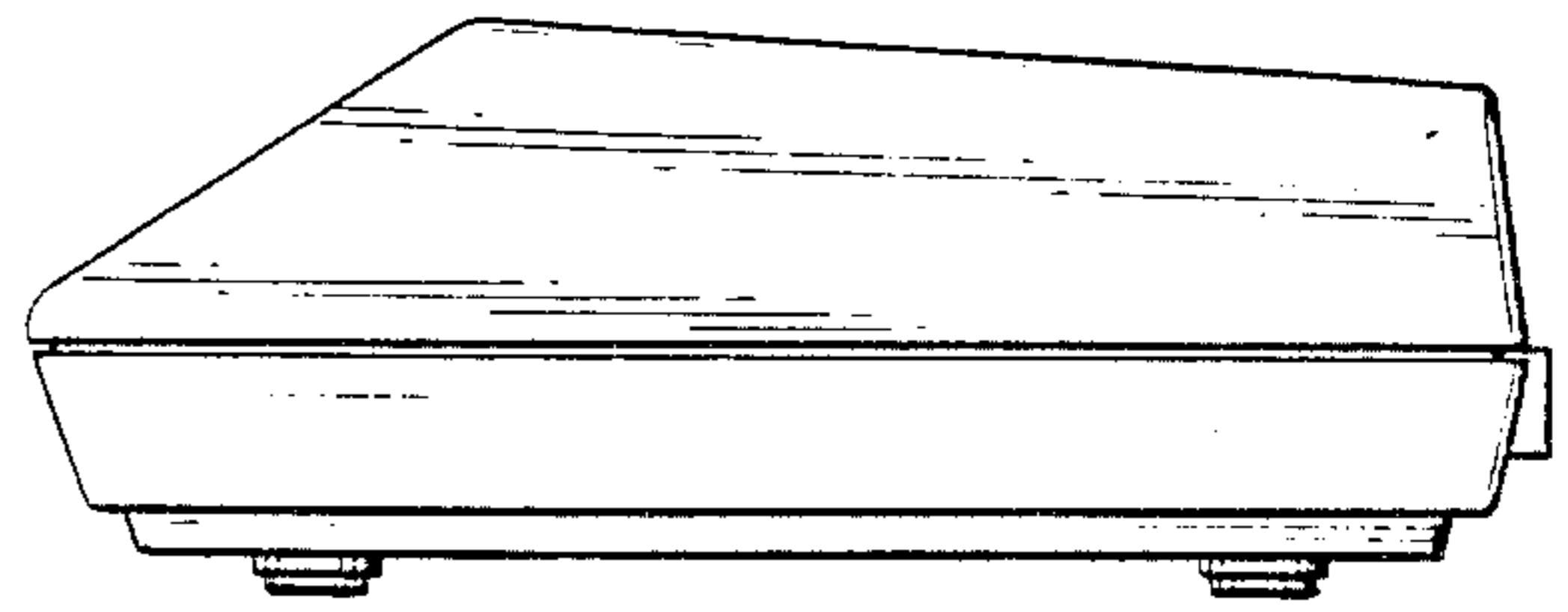

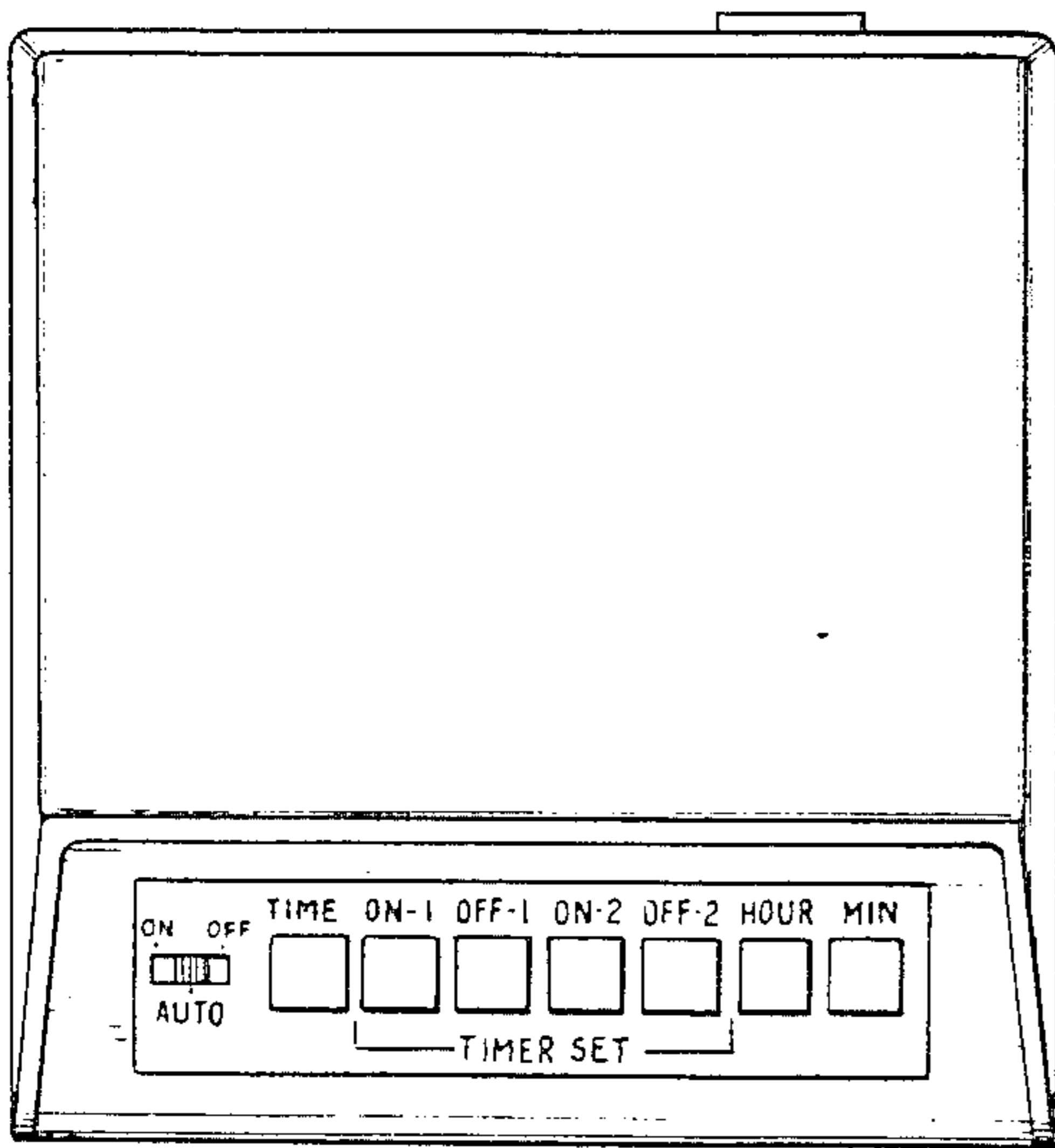

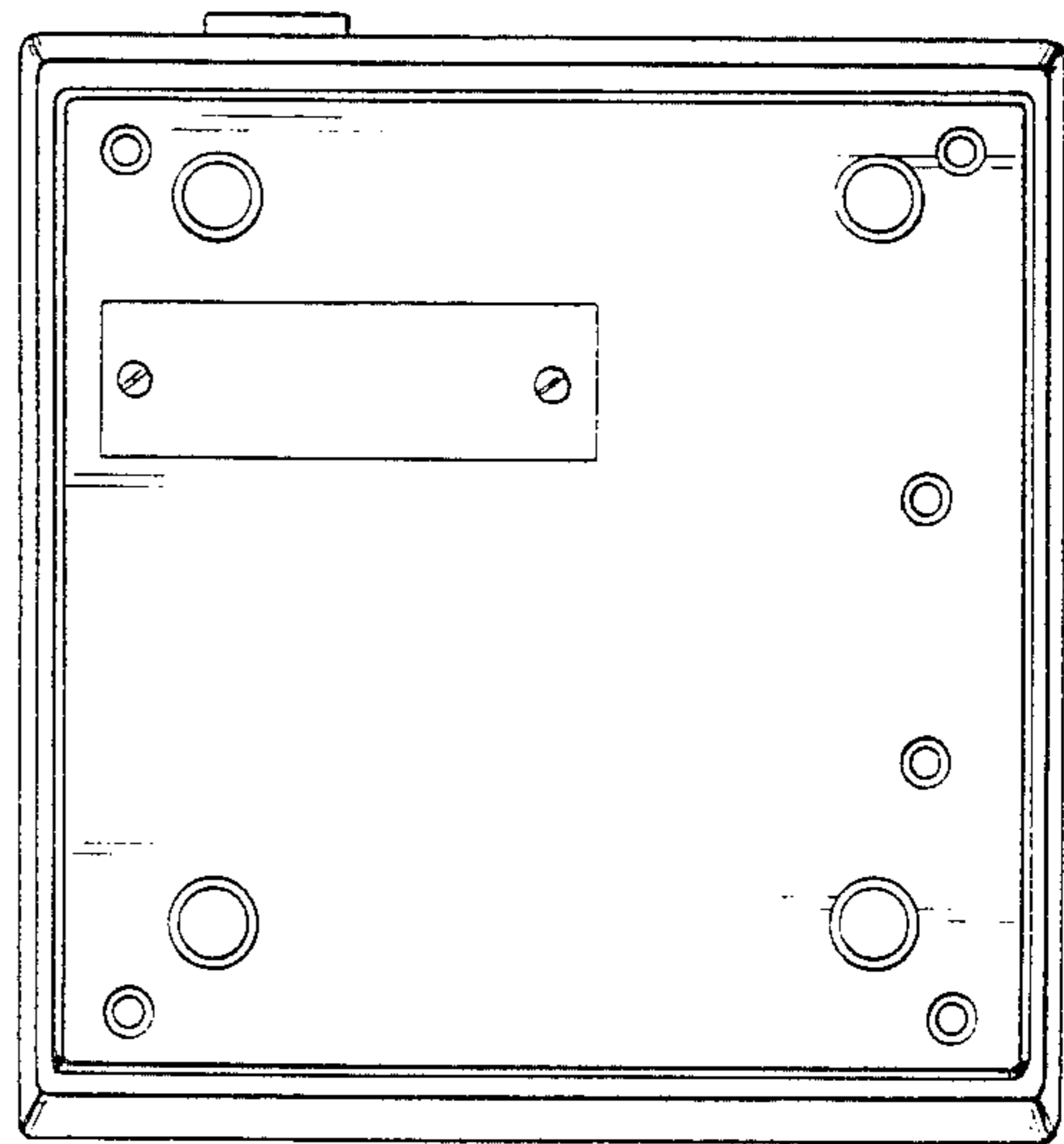

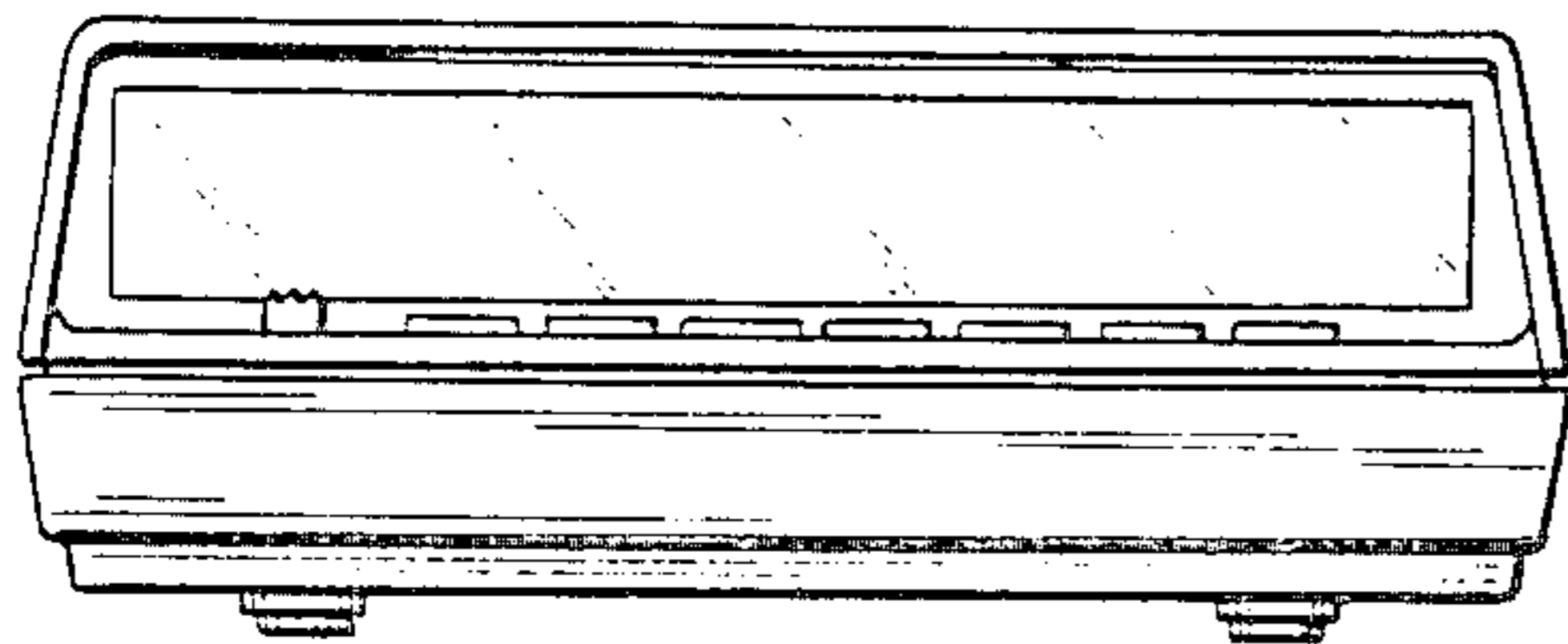
