The ornamental design for a light transmitting panel, as shown and described.

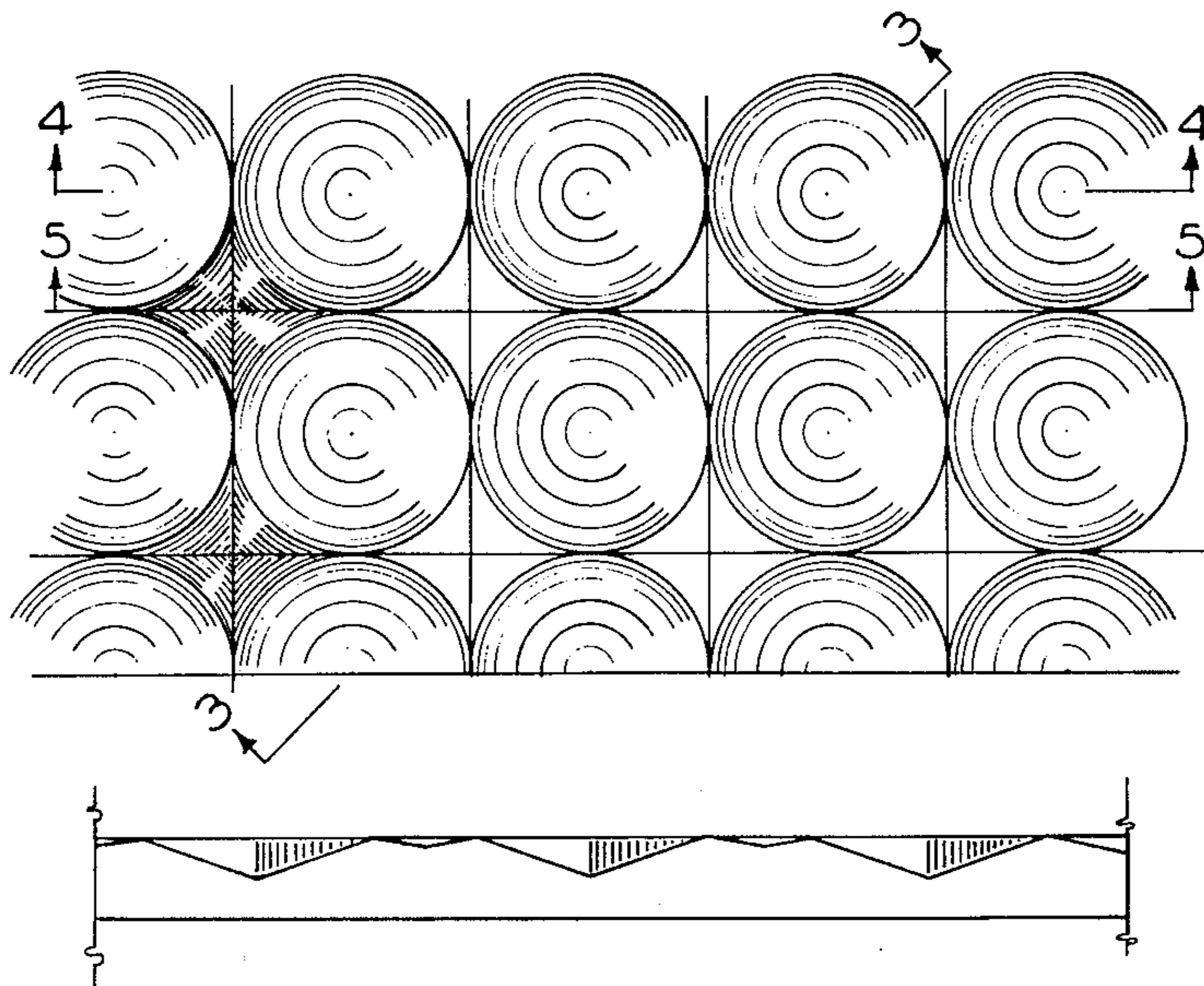
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a nominal one foot by two foot light transmitting panel showing our new design, the broken lines being shown for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary view of a portion of the panel shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along the line 3—3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along the line 4—4 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 2.



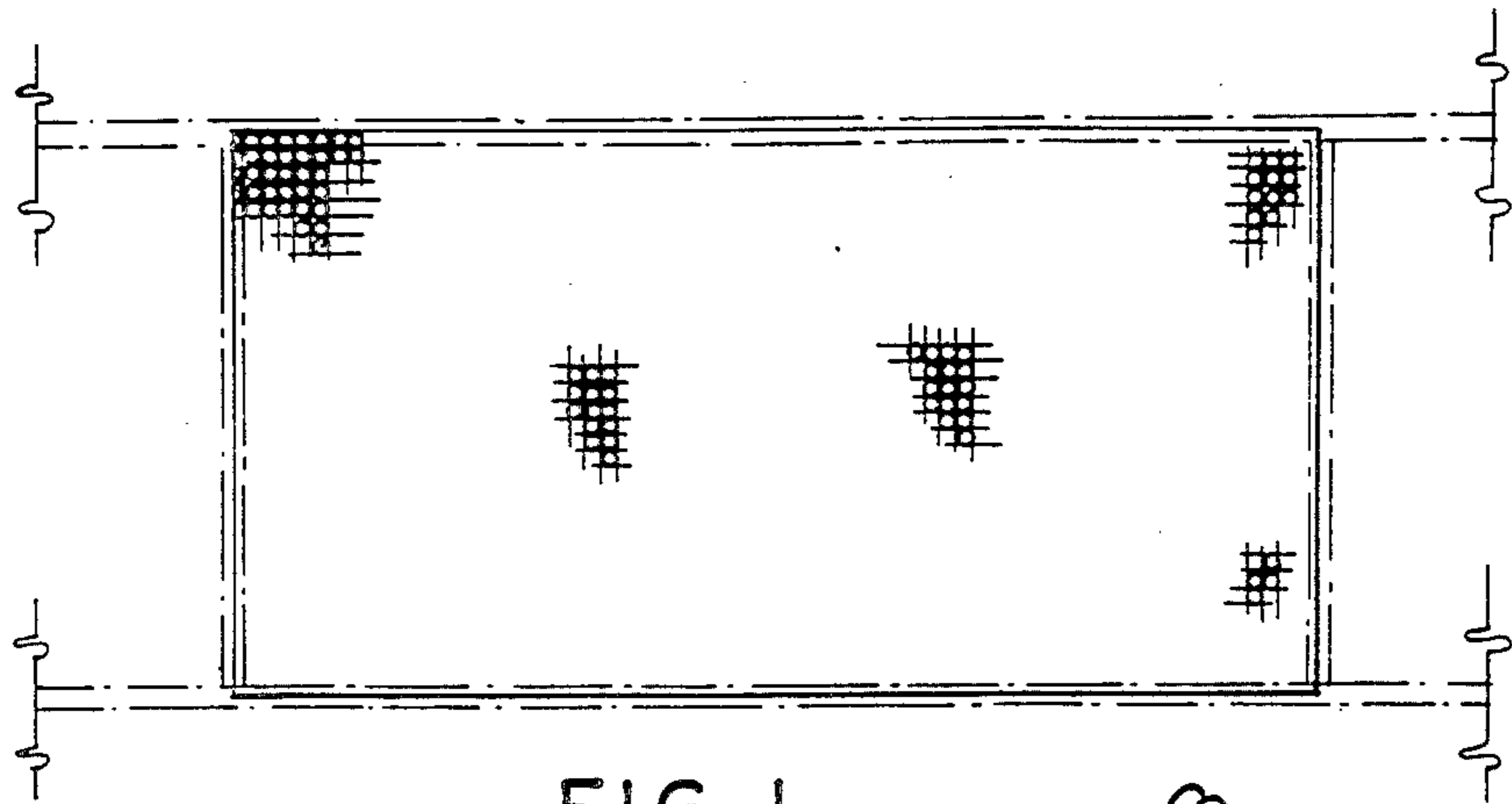

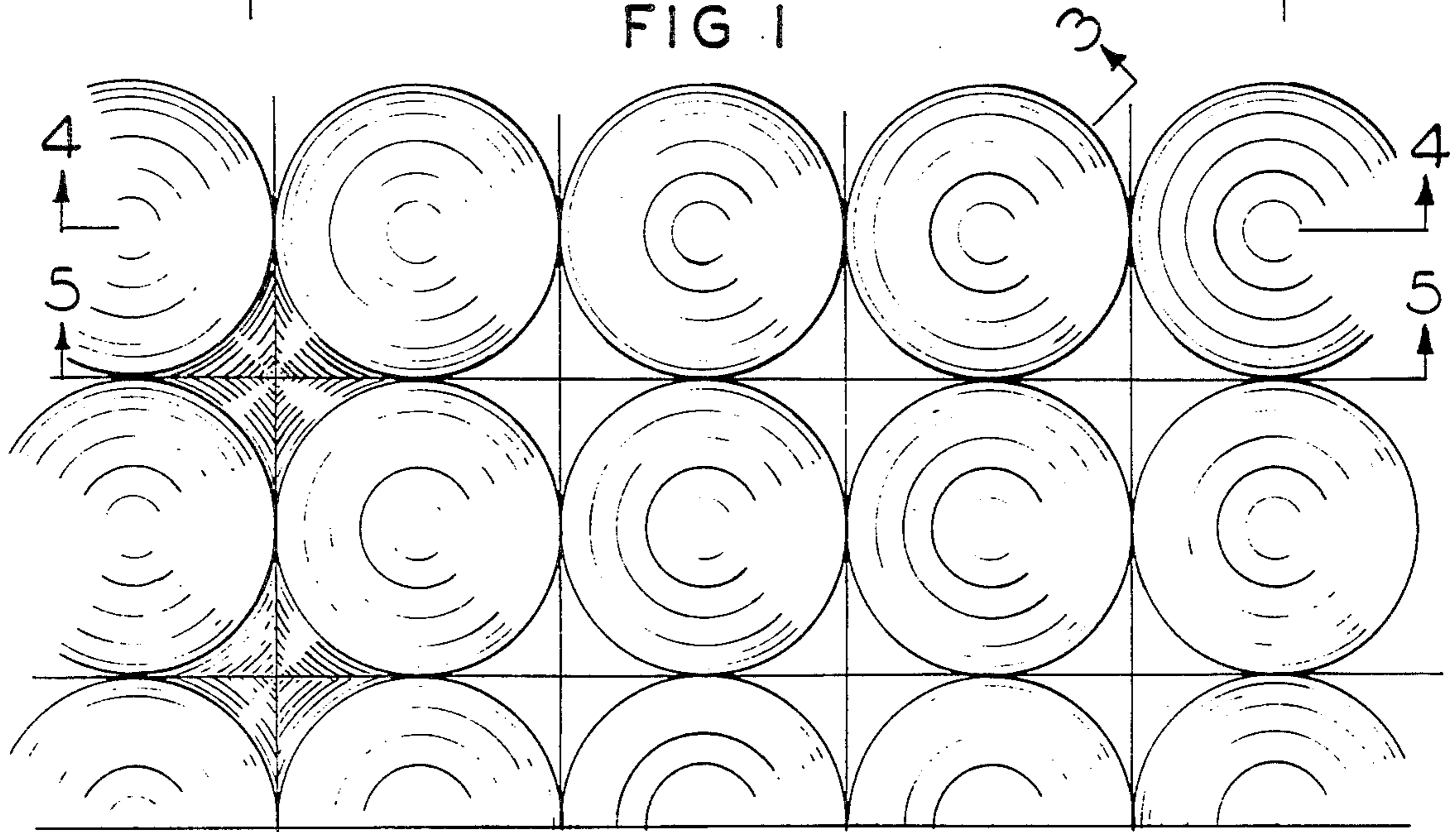

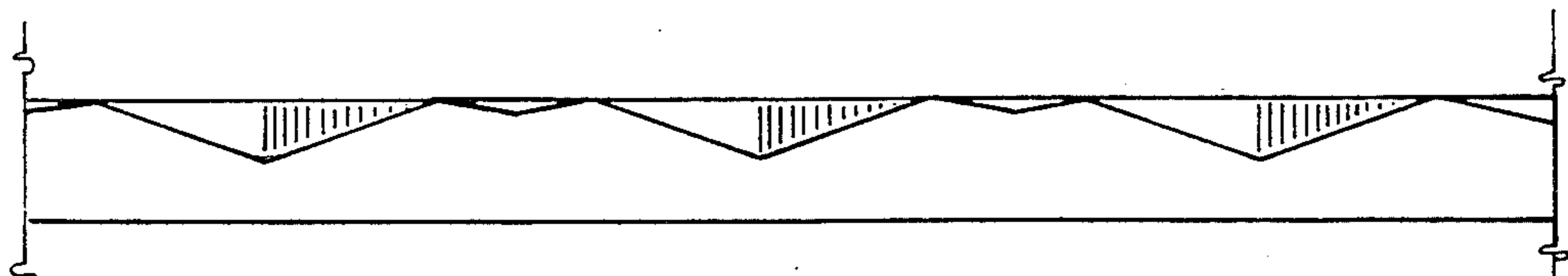

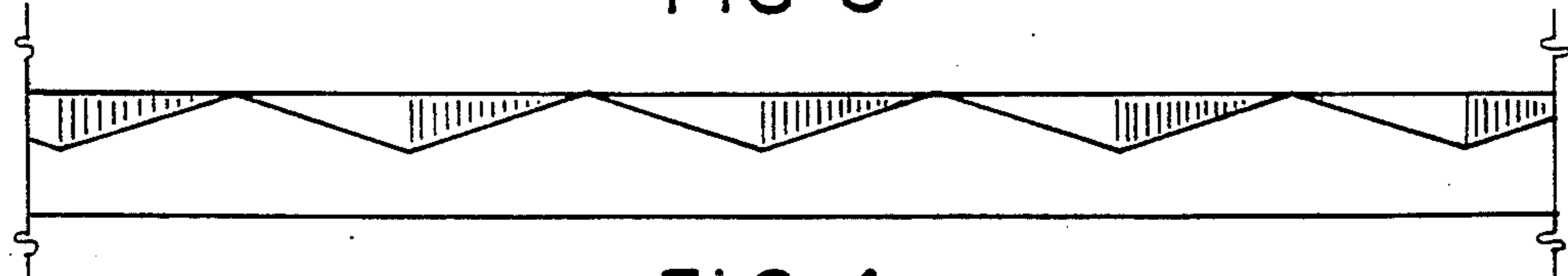

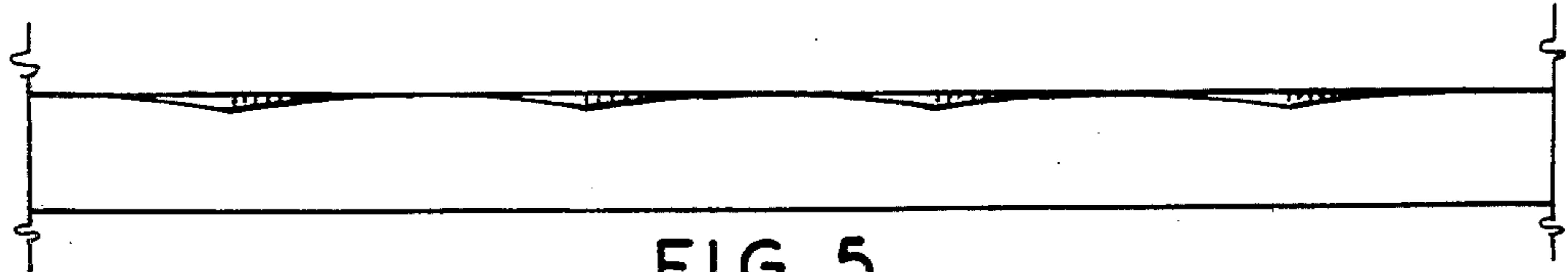
