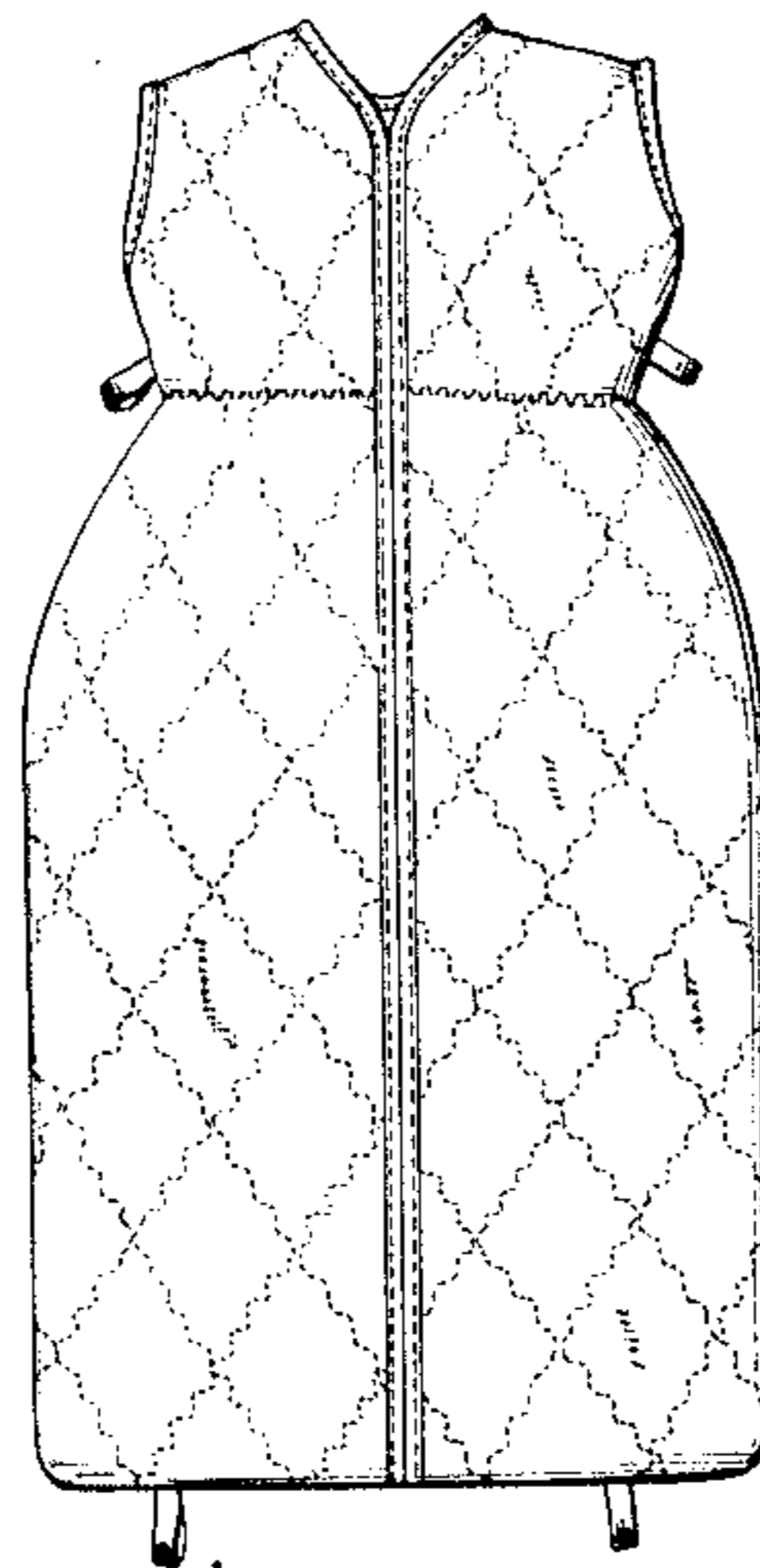

The ornamental design for a child's sleeping bag, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a child's sleeping bag showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of FIG. 1.



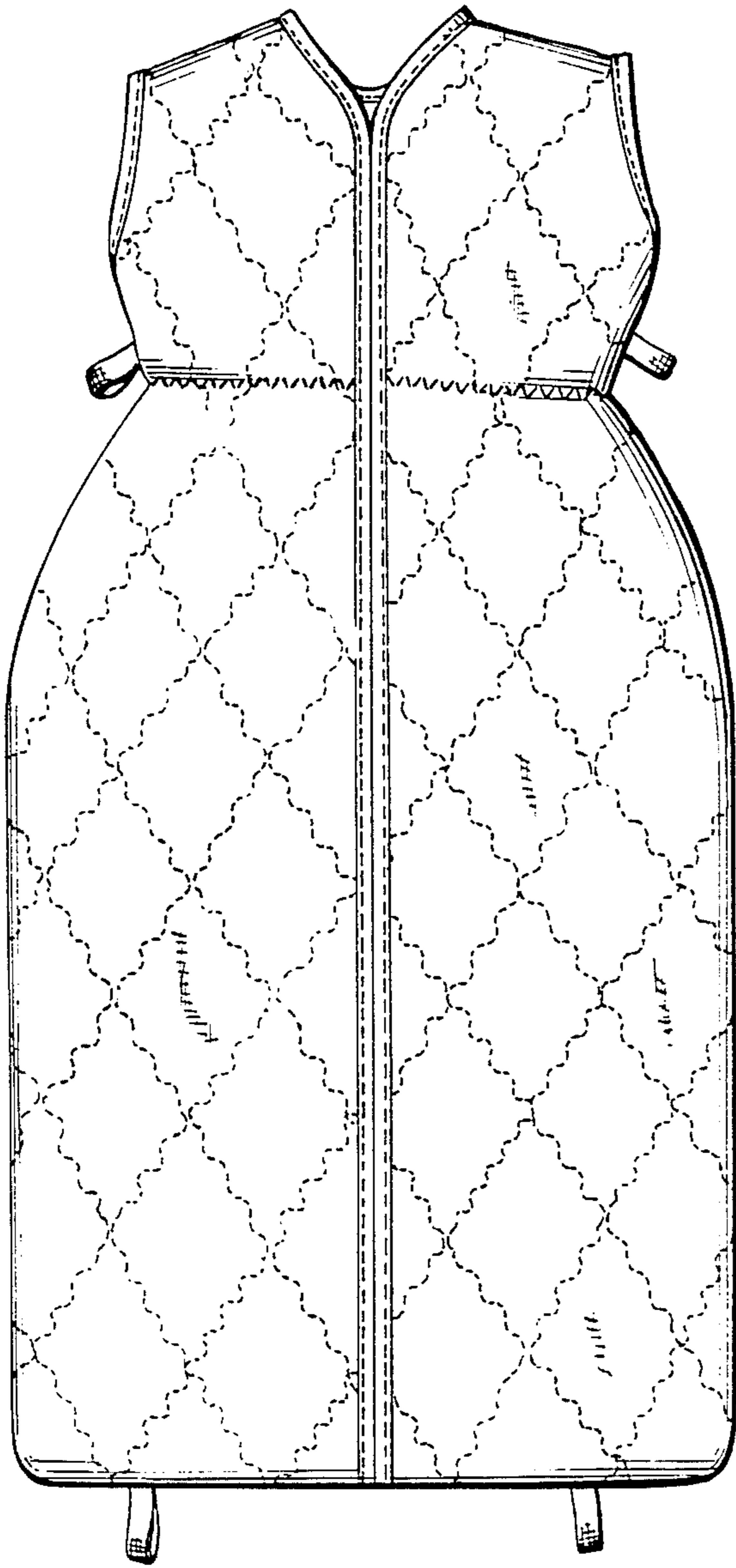

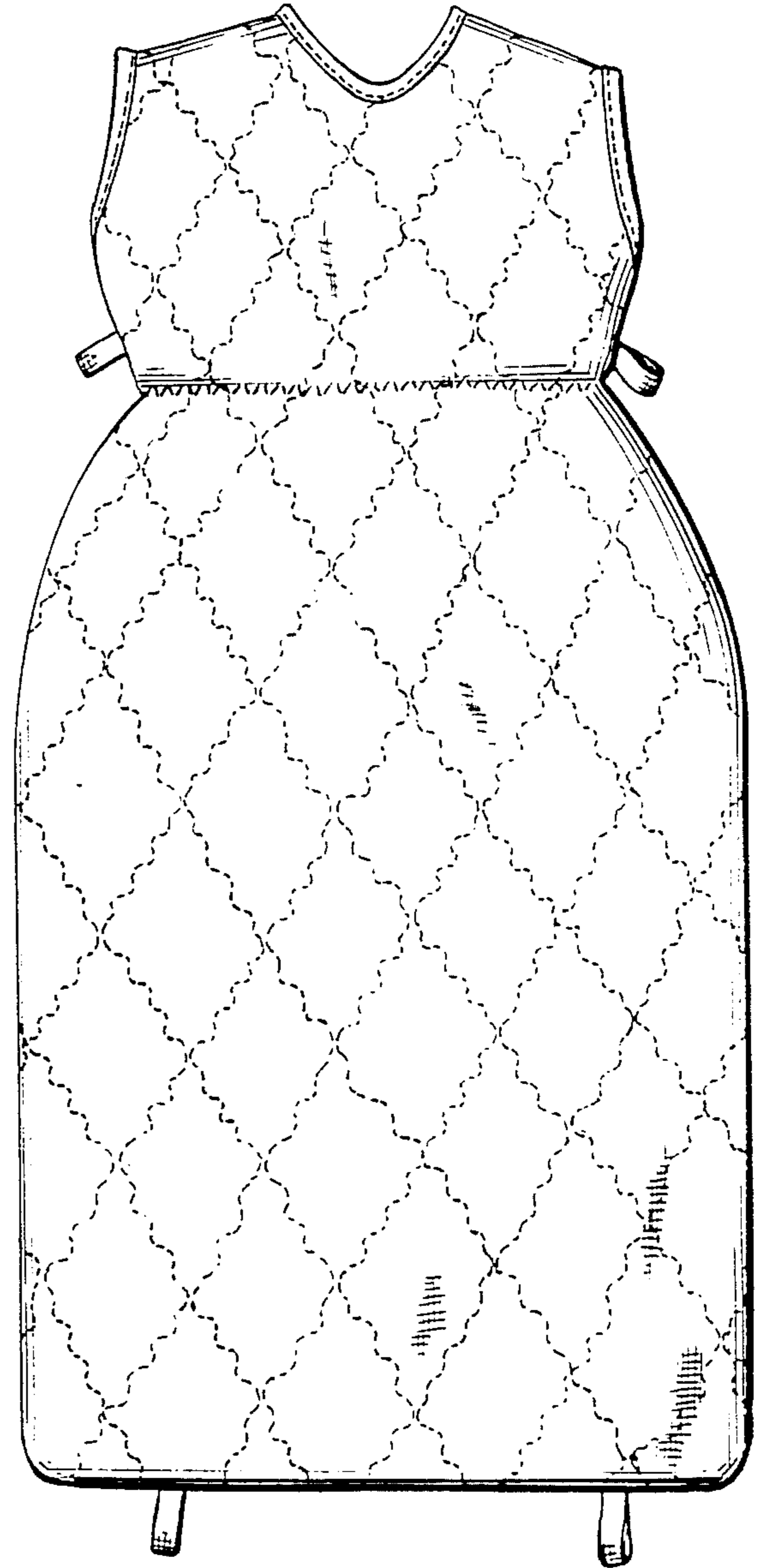

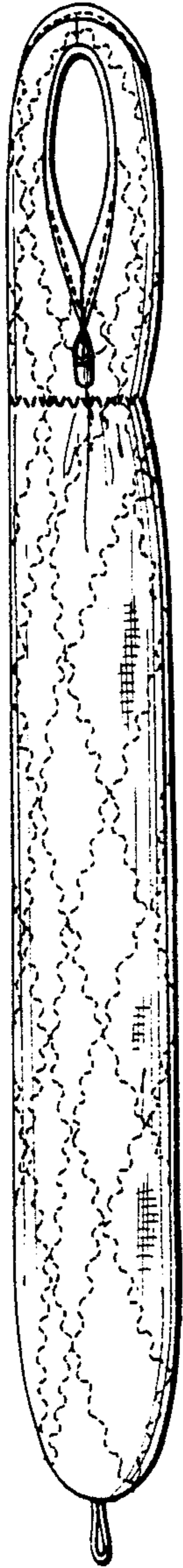

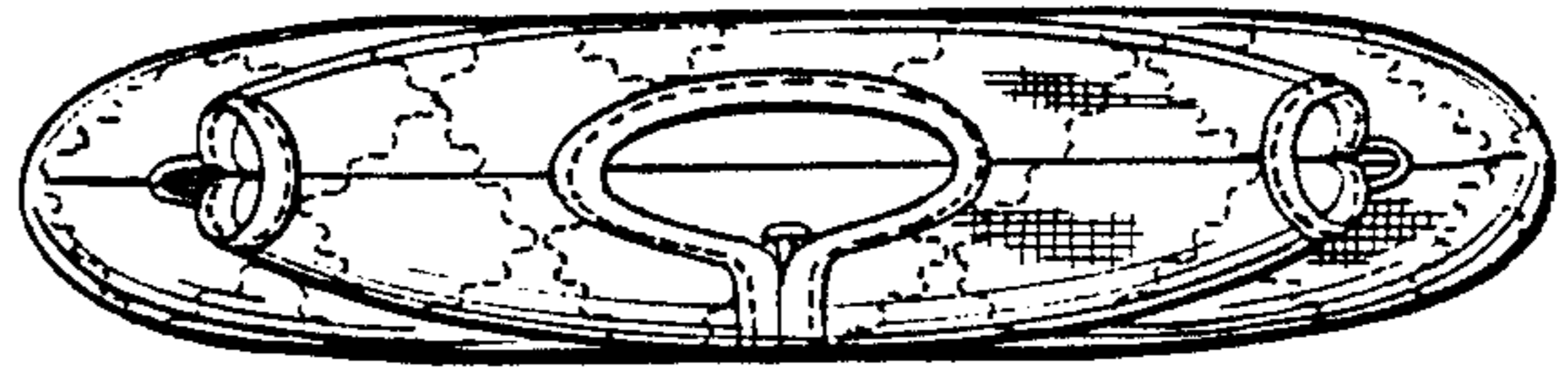

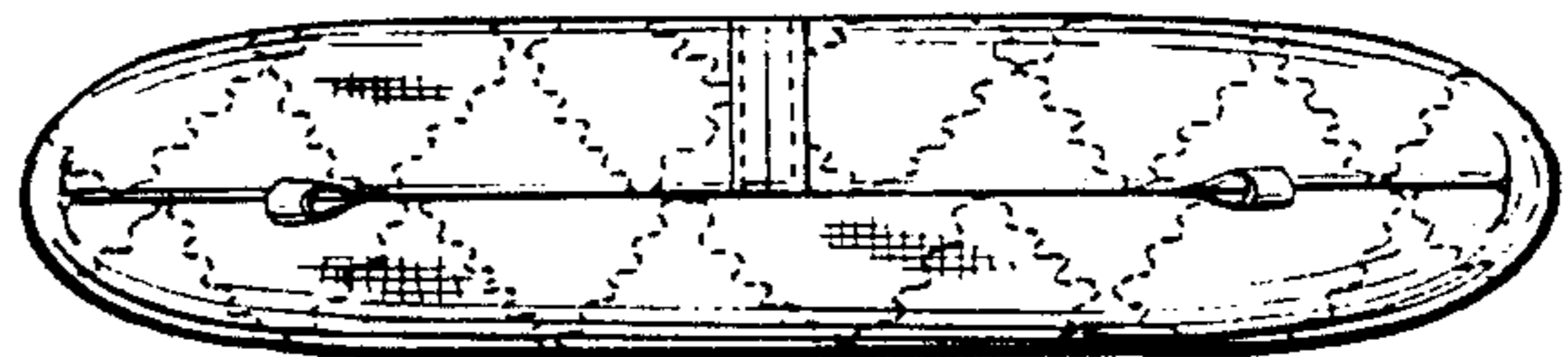
