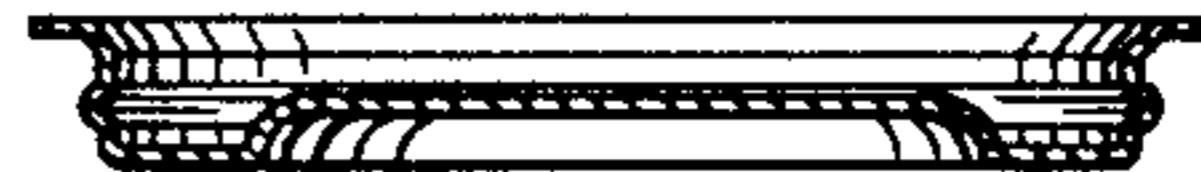
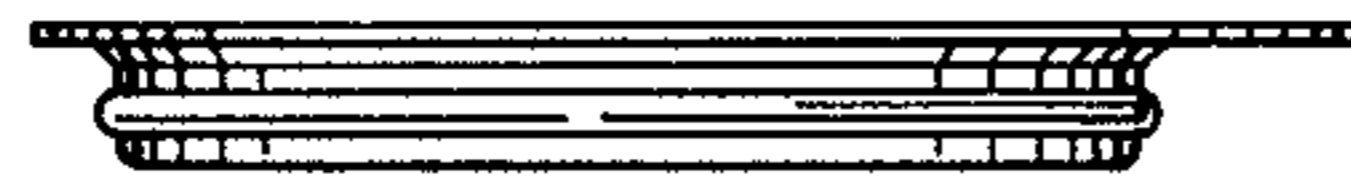
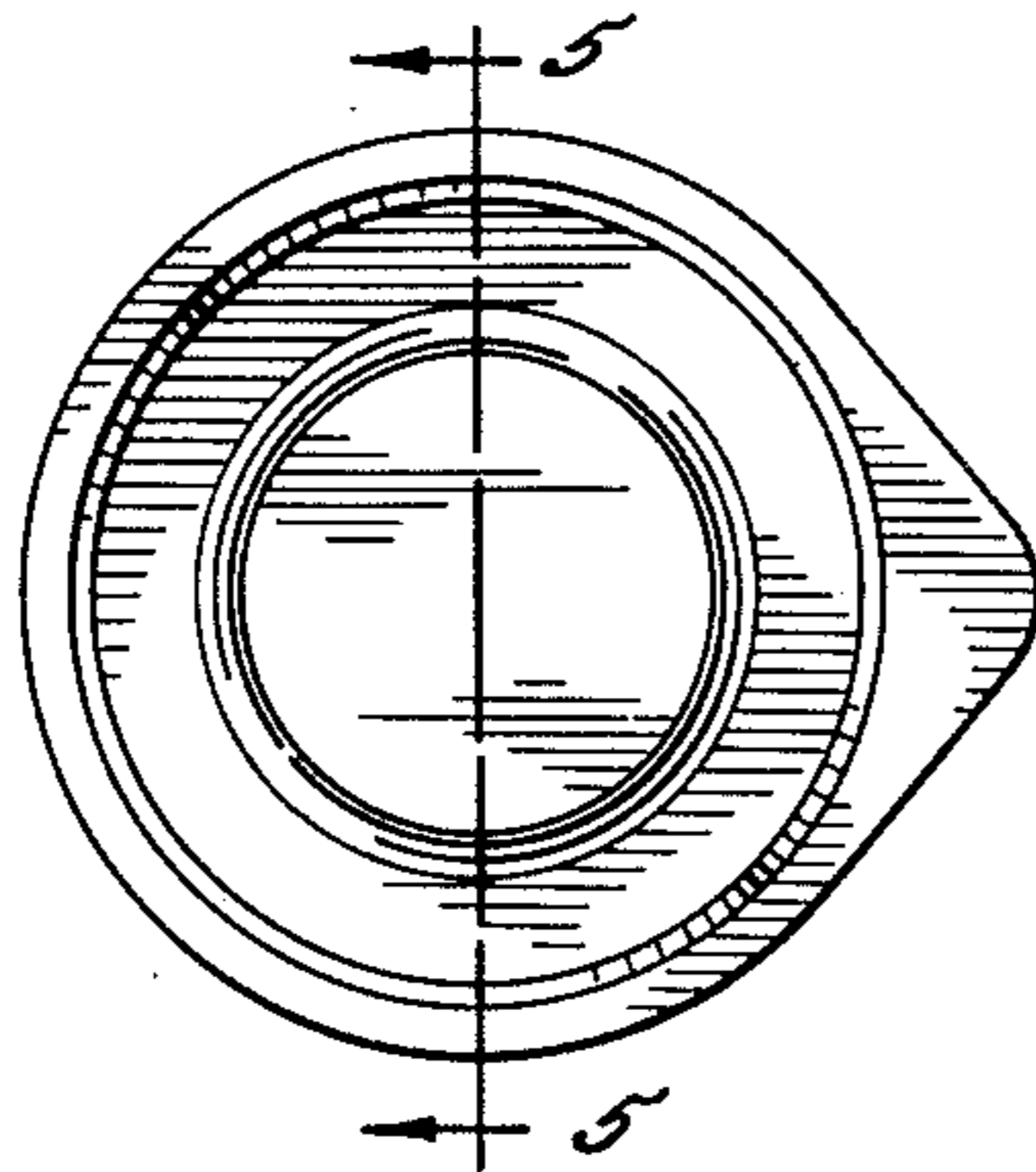

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a snap-on lid for a food dish or the like showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is an end view as viewed from the right of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a side view as viewed from the bottom of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view;
 FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along the line 5—5 in FIG. 1.



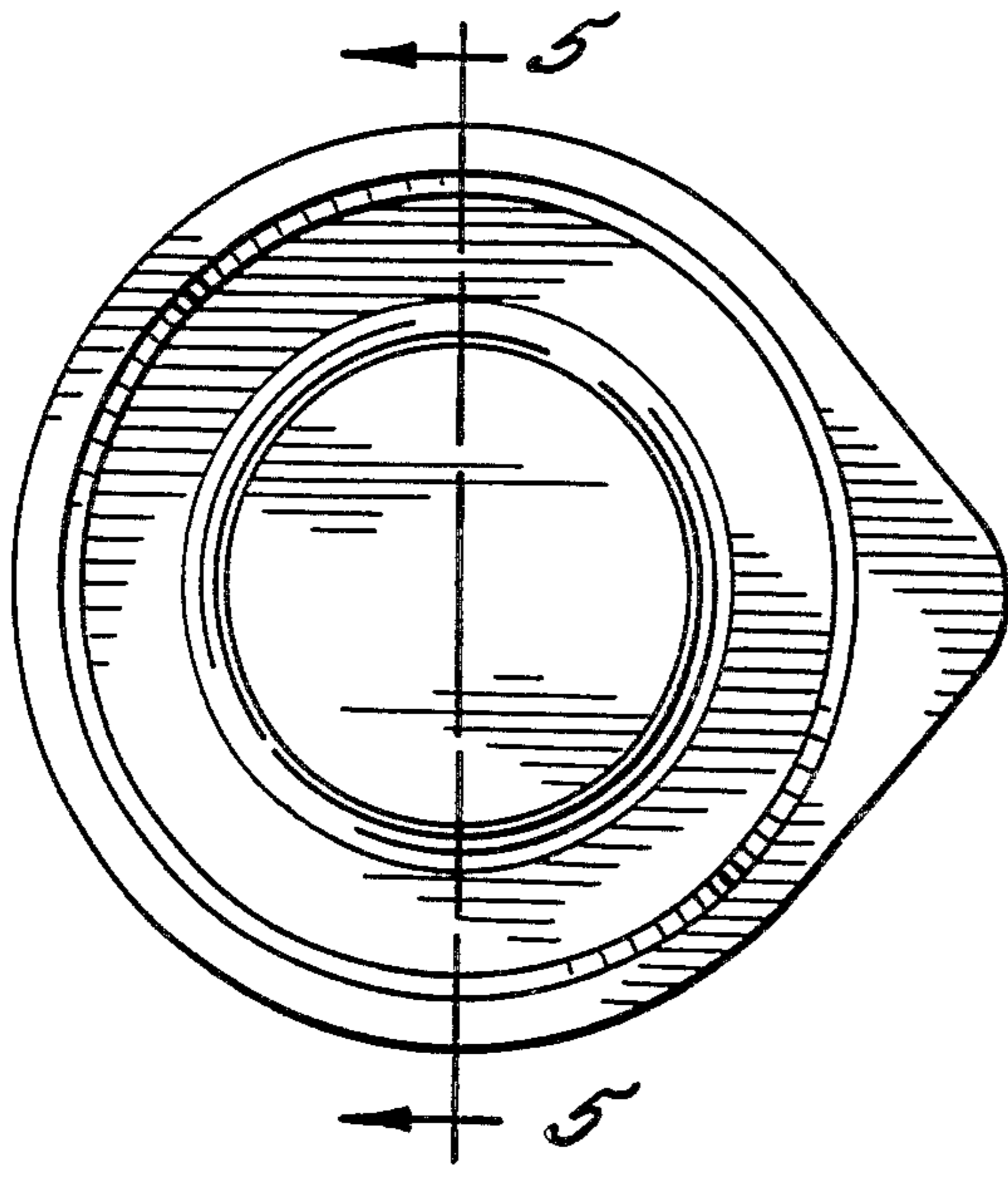

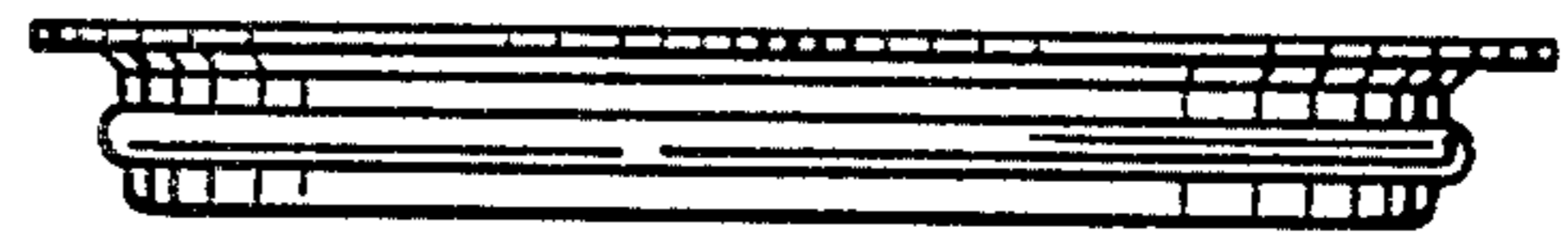

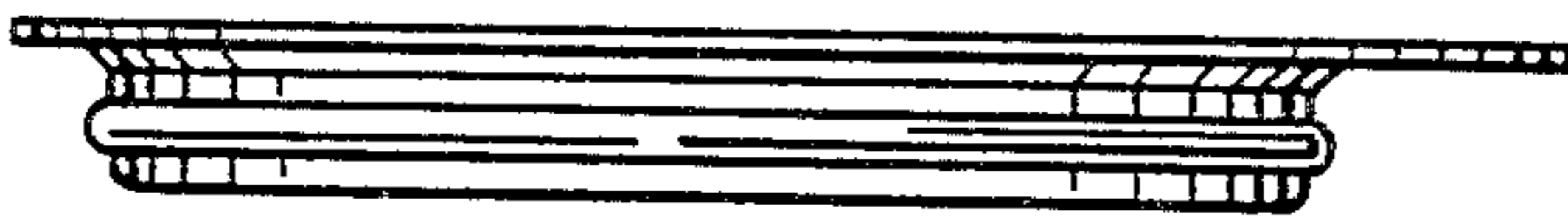

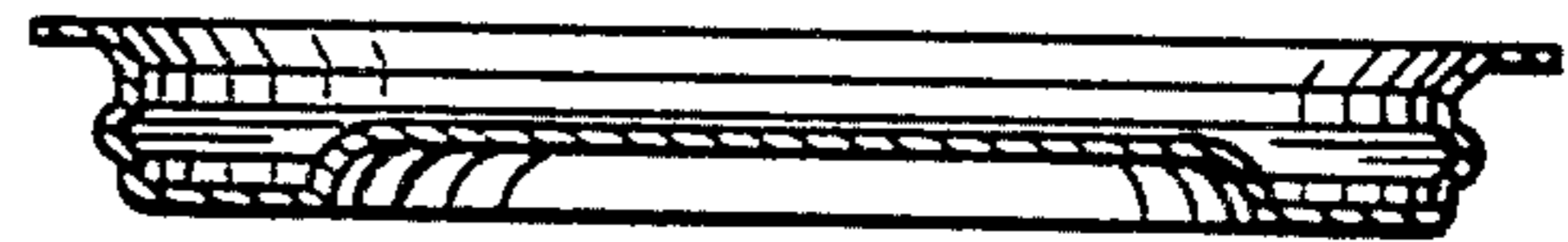

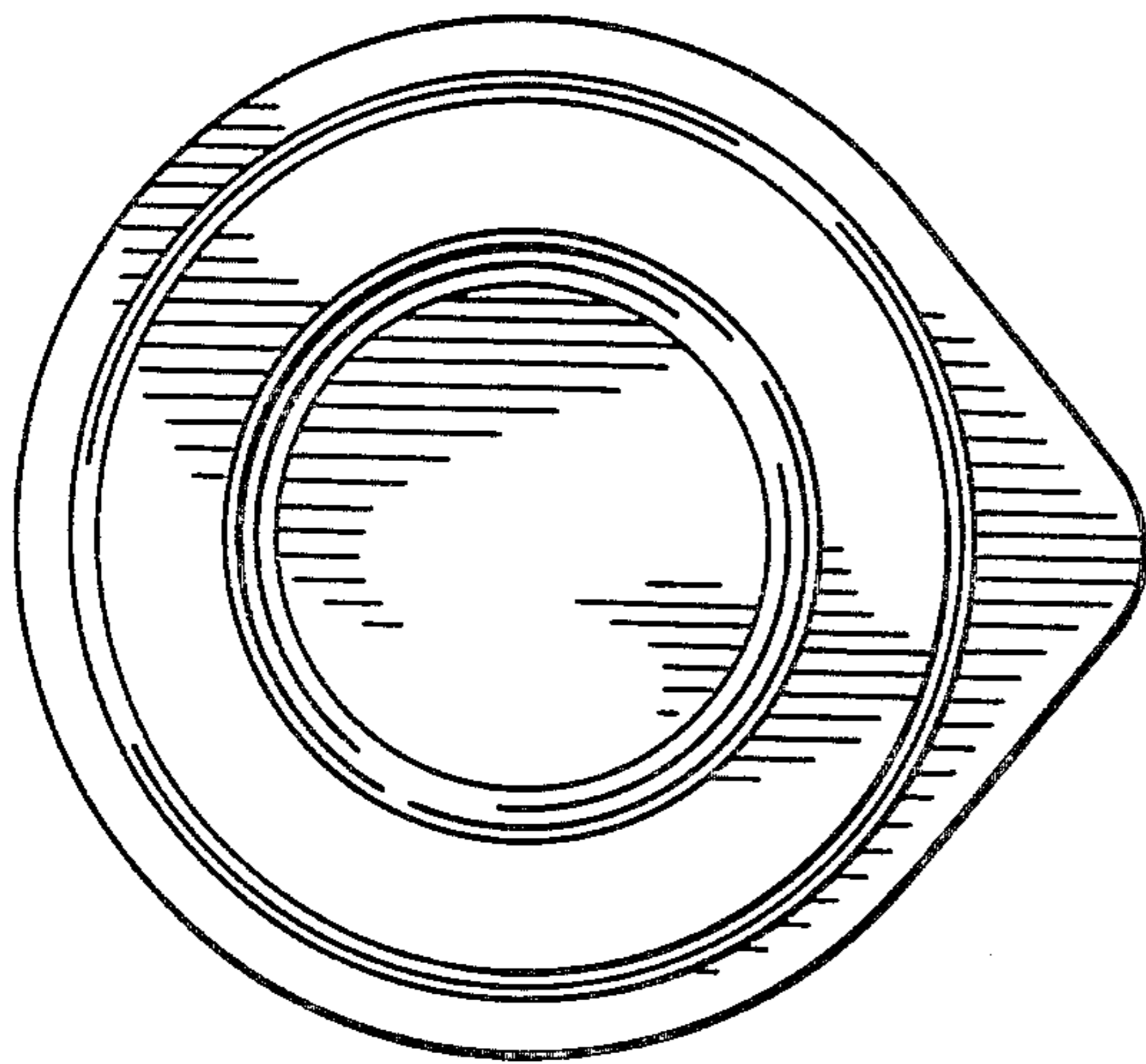
