[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container body for liquids and the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a container body for liquids and the like embodying our new design; and FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof, the opposite side being the same in appearance.

Broken lines showing the neck finish are for the purpose of illustrating the environment of use.

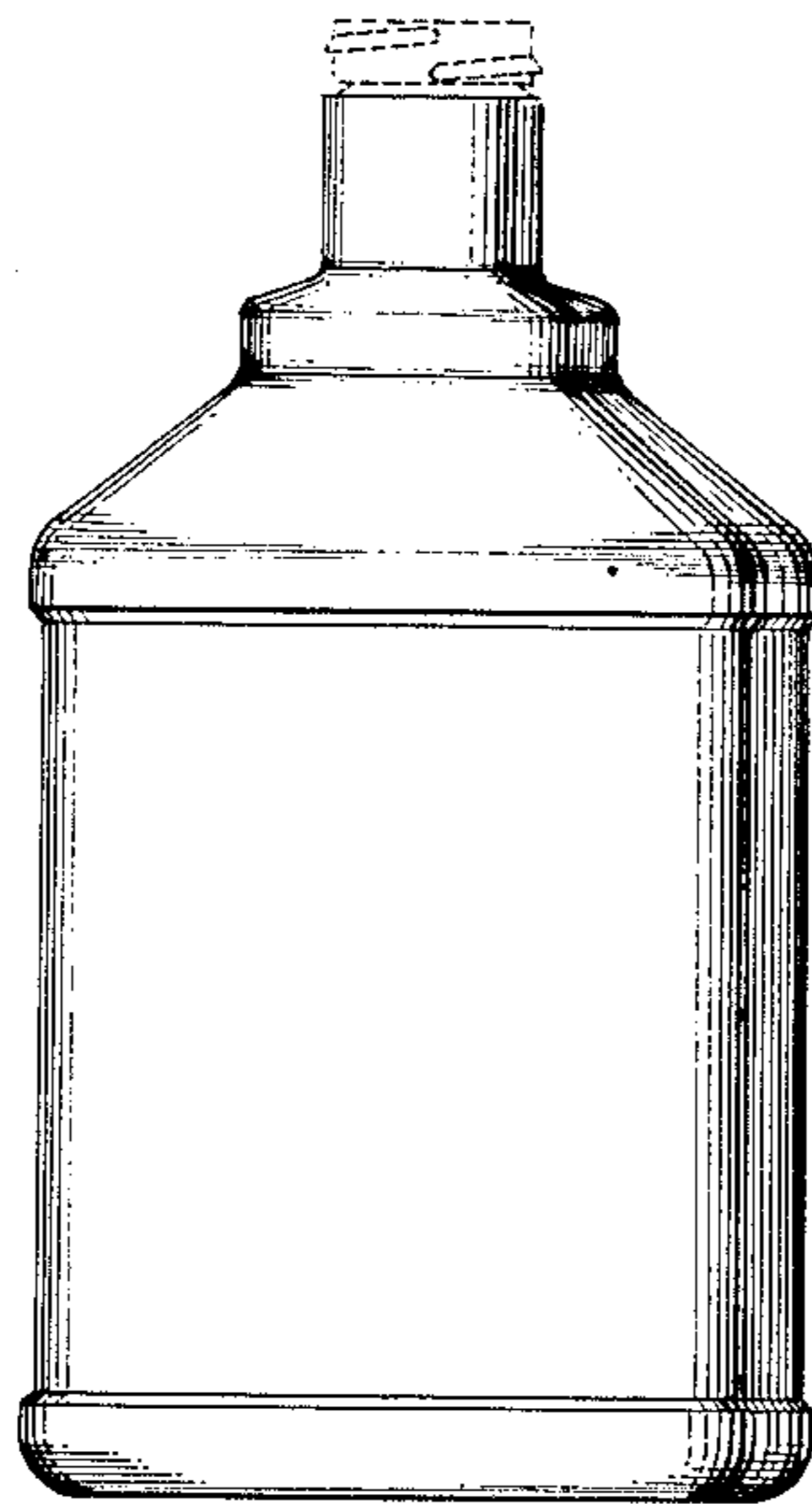

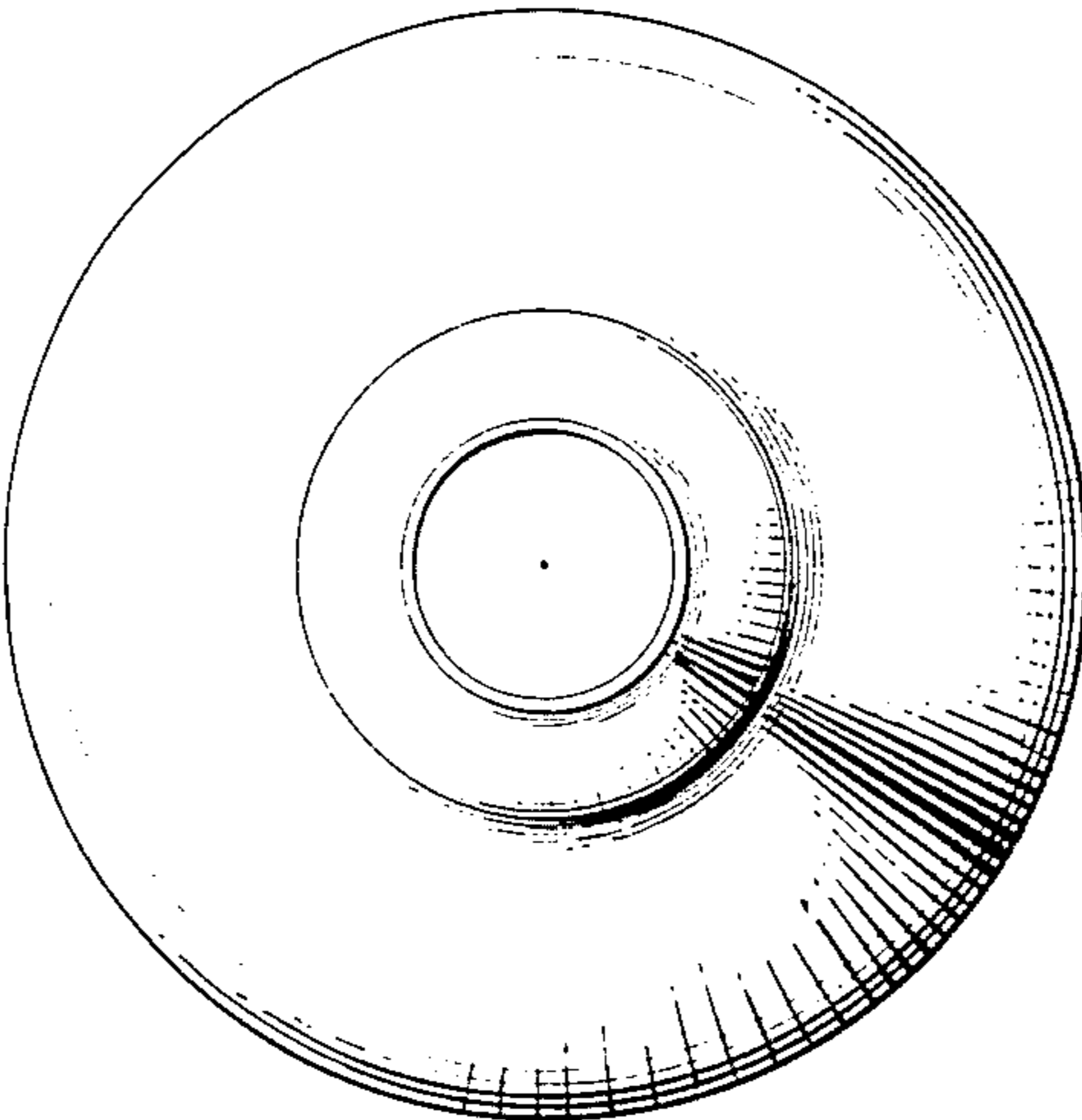
