[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container body for liquids and the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a container body for liquids and the like embodying our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1; and FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof. Broken lines showing the neck finish are for the purpose of illustrating the environment of use.

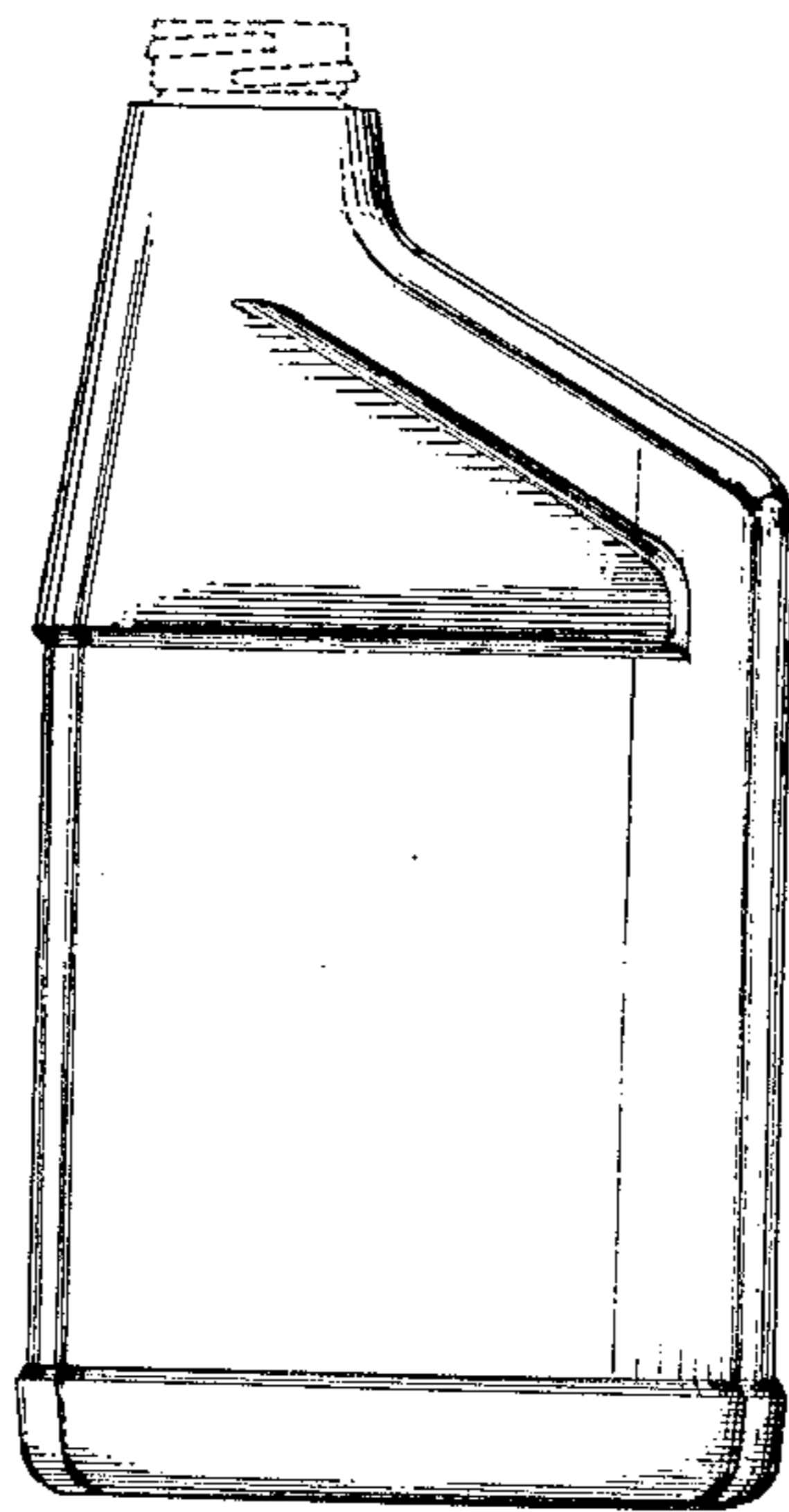

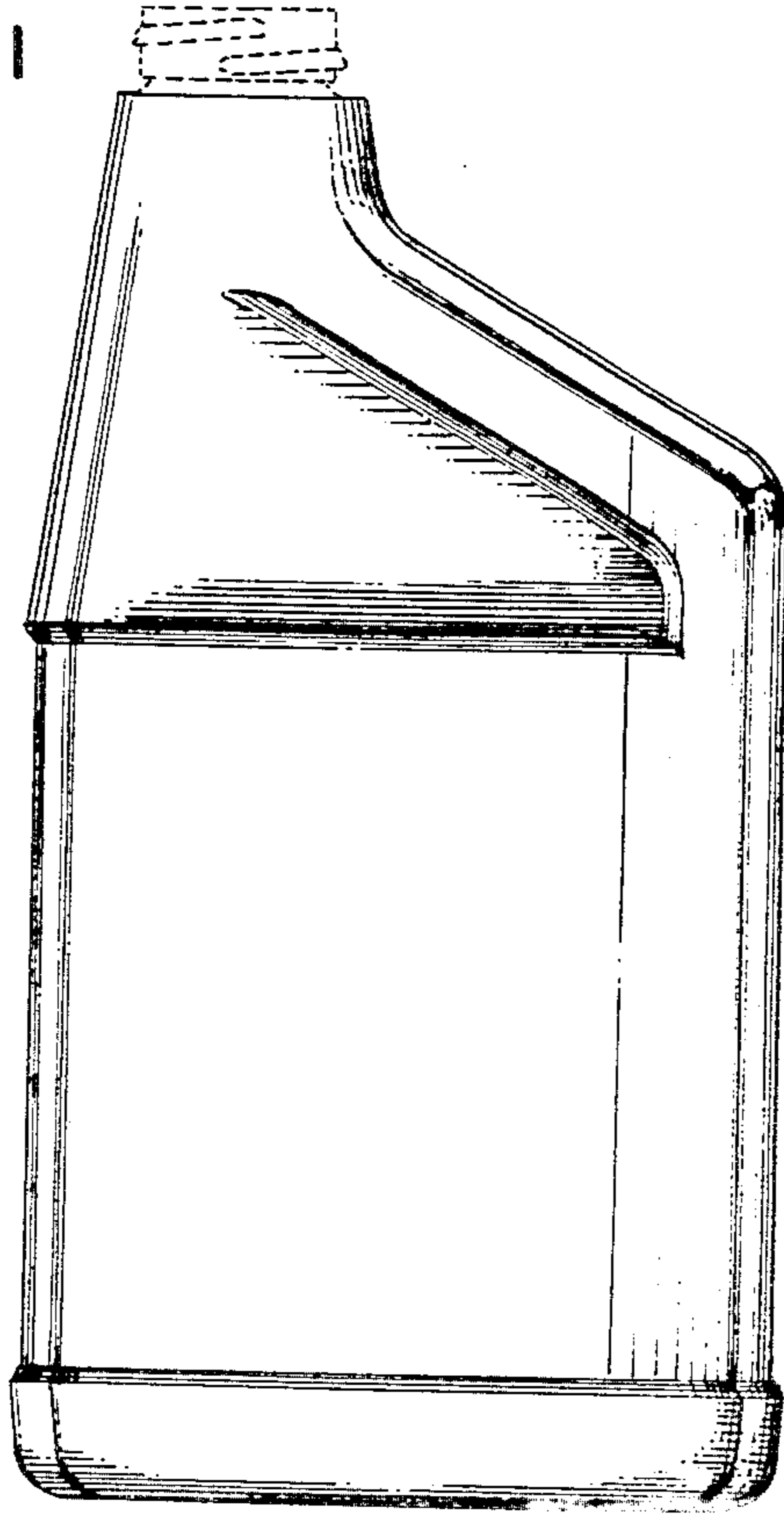

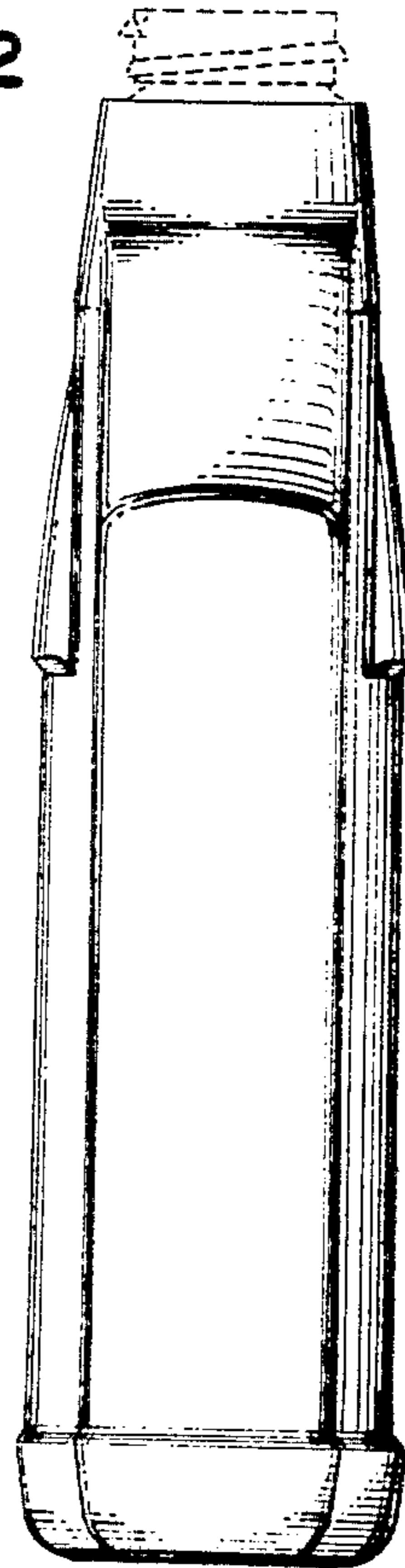

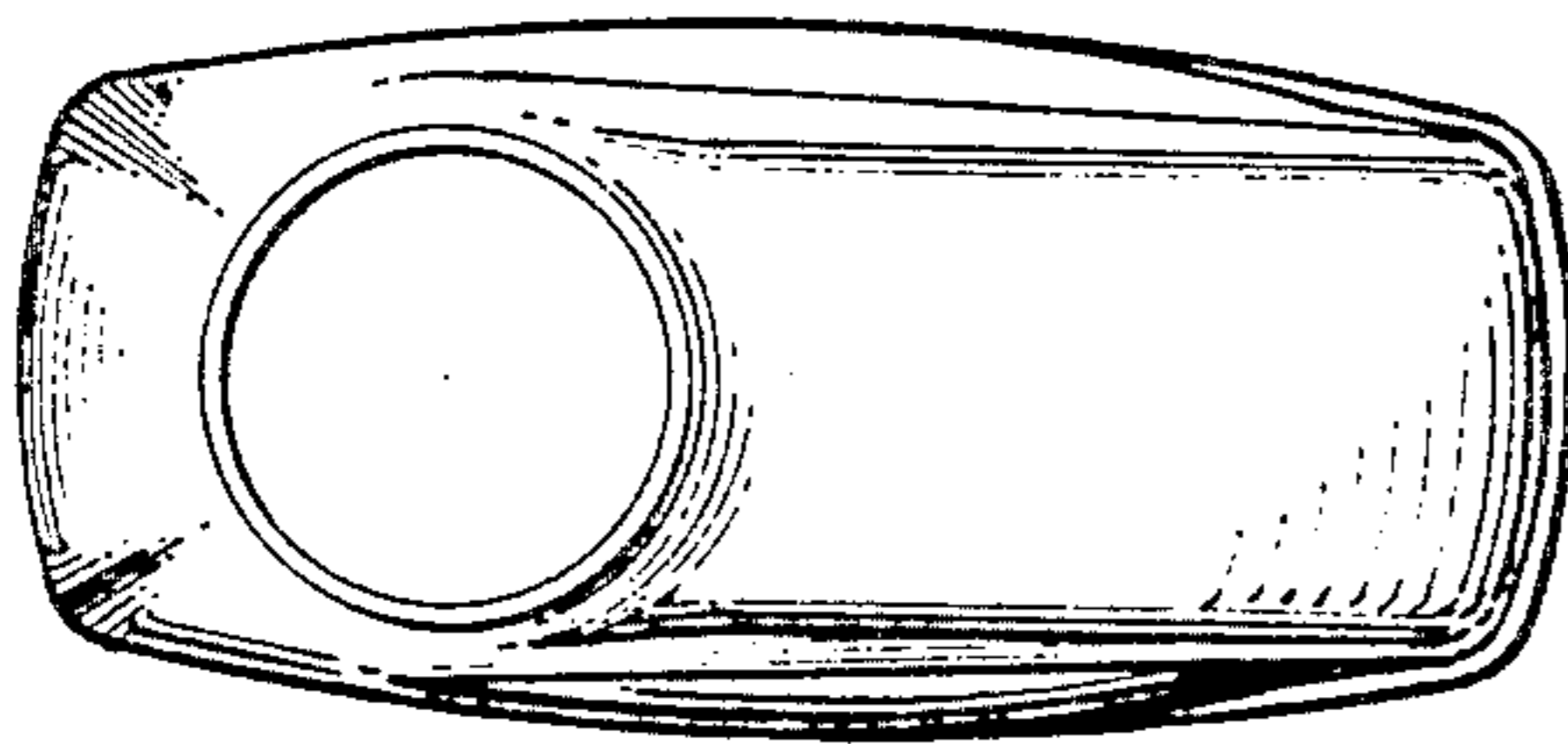
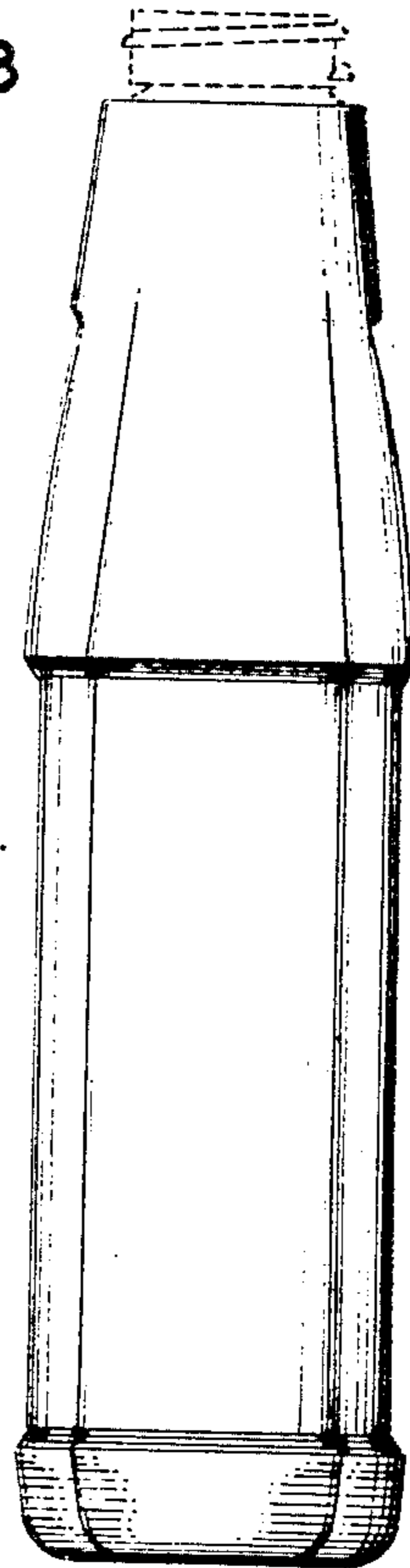
