[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container body for liquids and the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a container body for liquids and the like embodying our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof. Broken lines showing the neck finish are for the purpose of illustrating the environment of use.

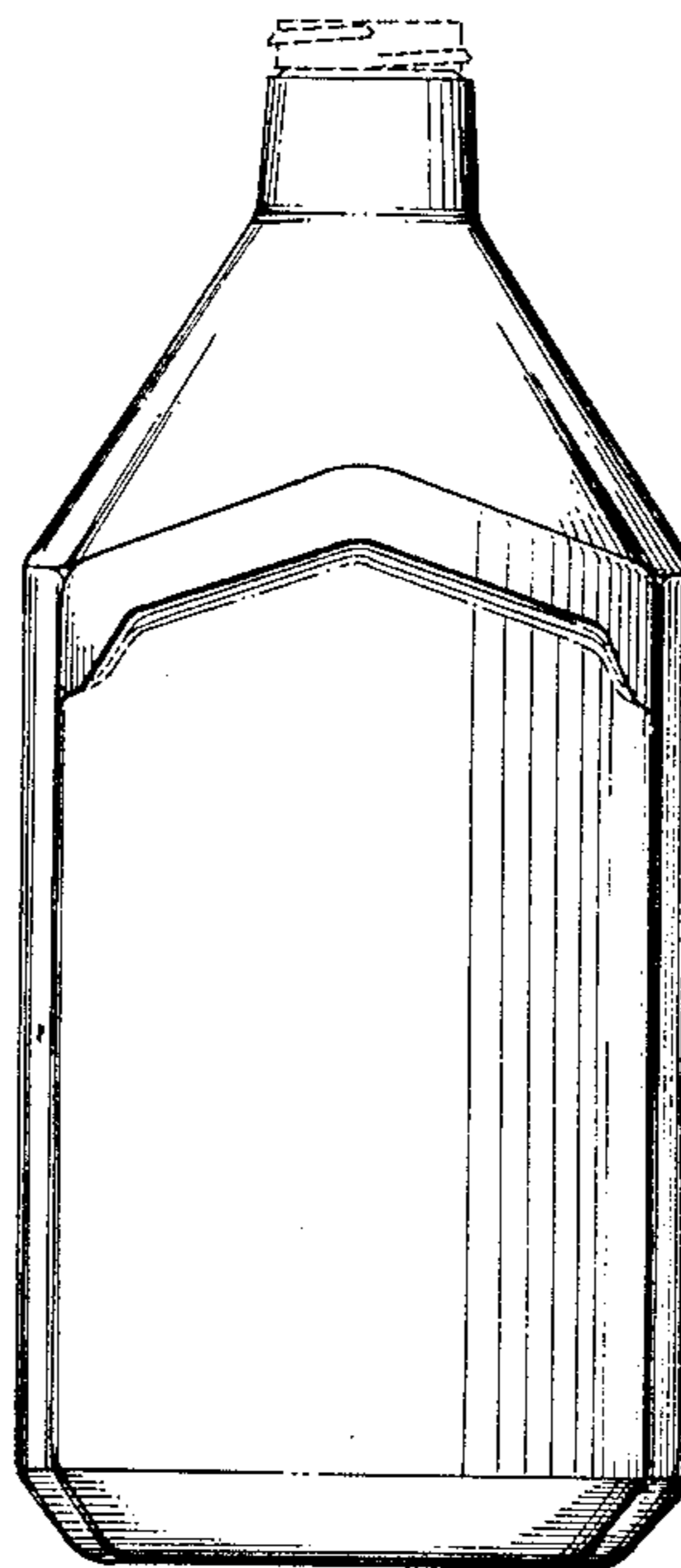

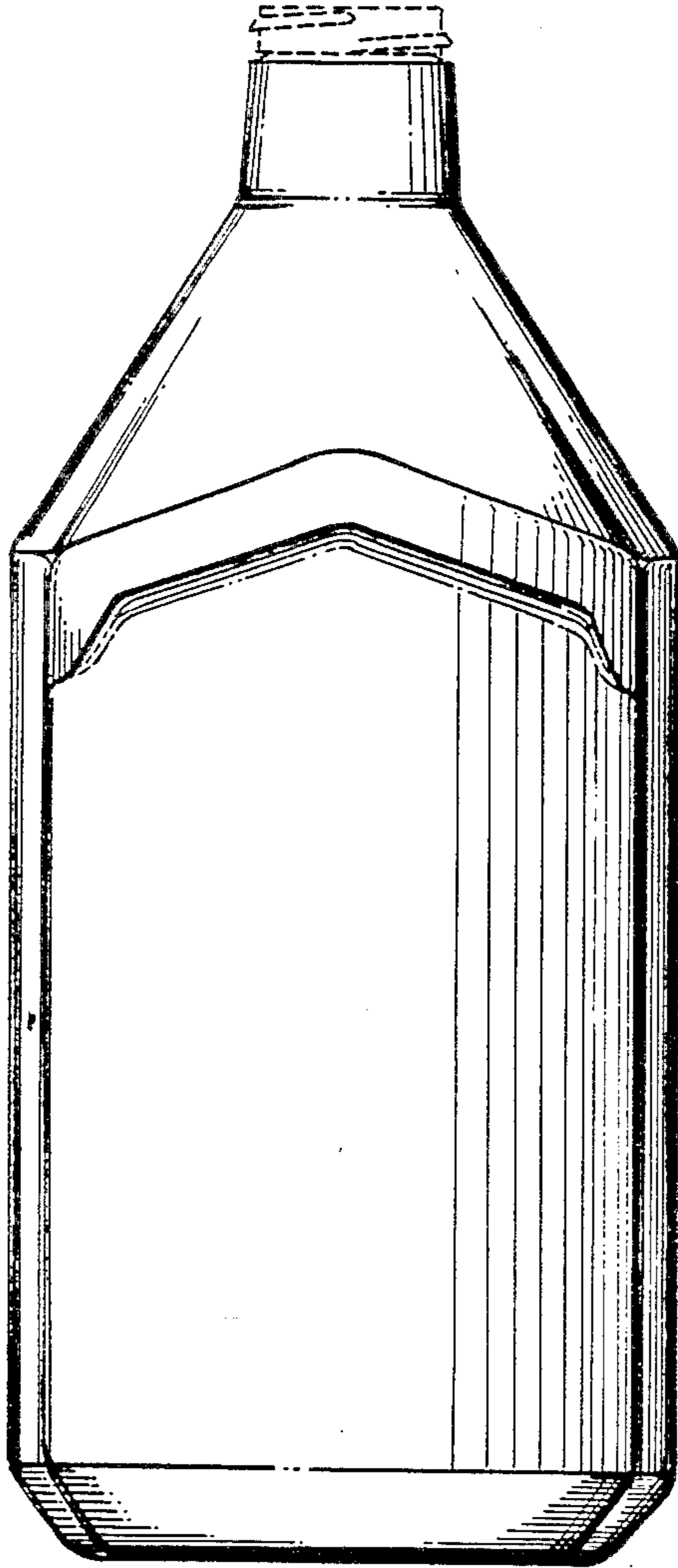

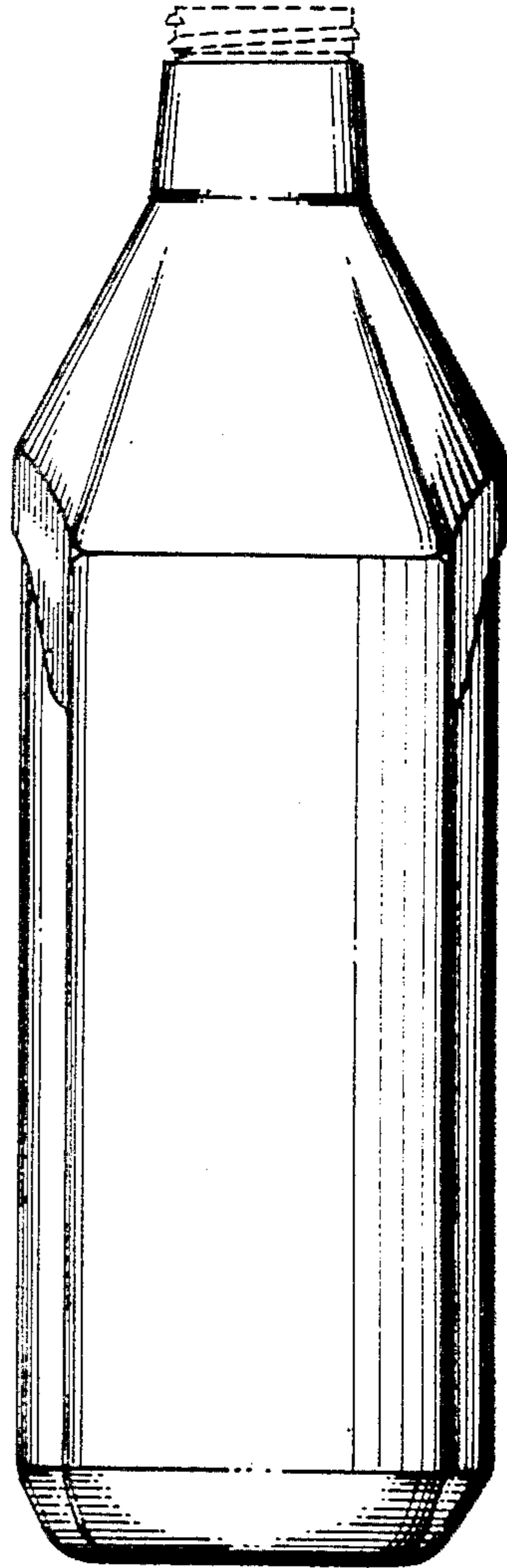

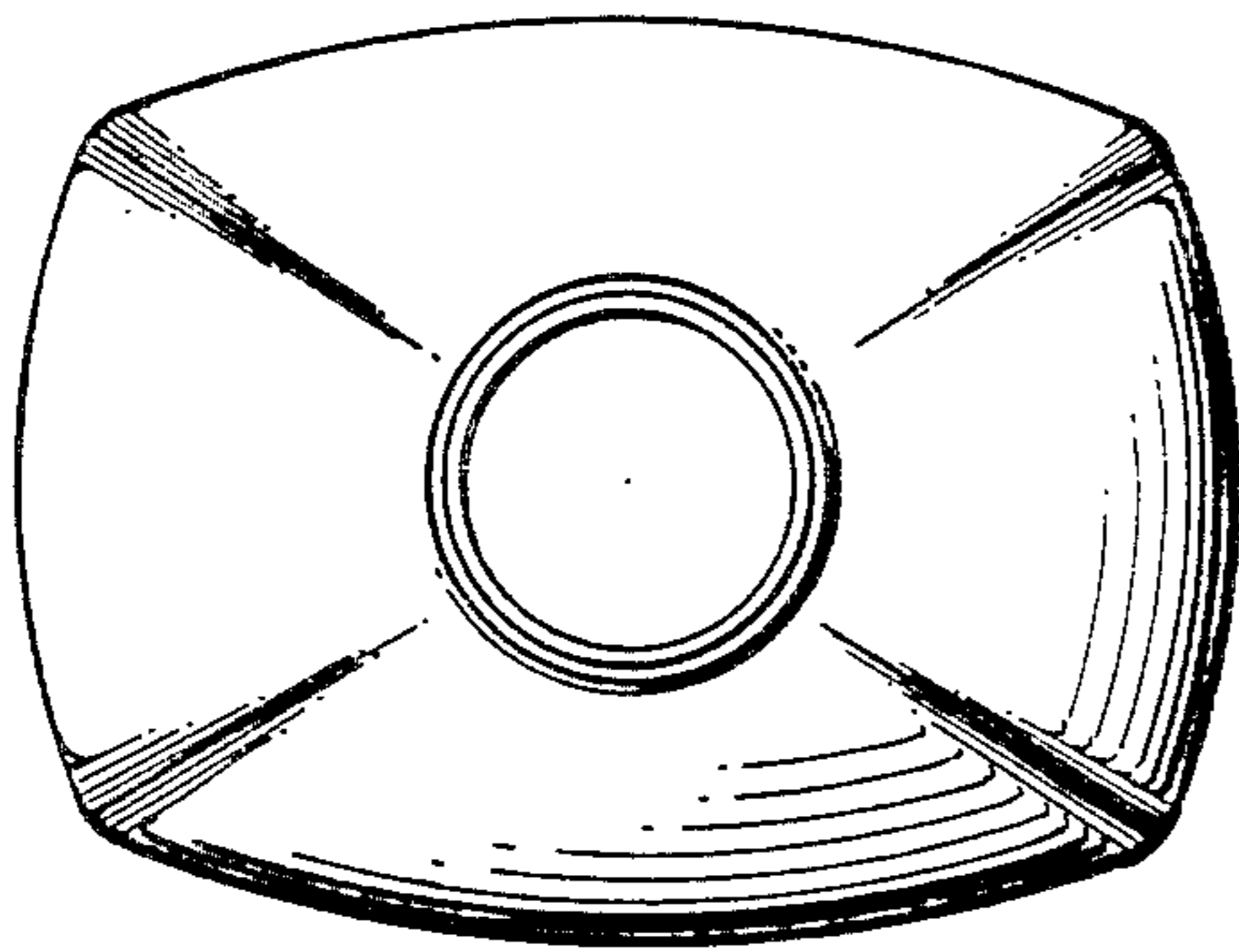
