DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair frame, embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, and
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.
The side opposite that which is illustrated in FIG. 2 is a mirror image of FIG. 2.

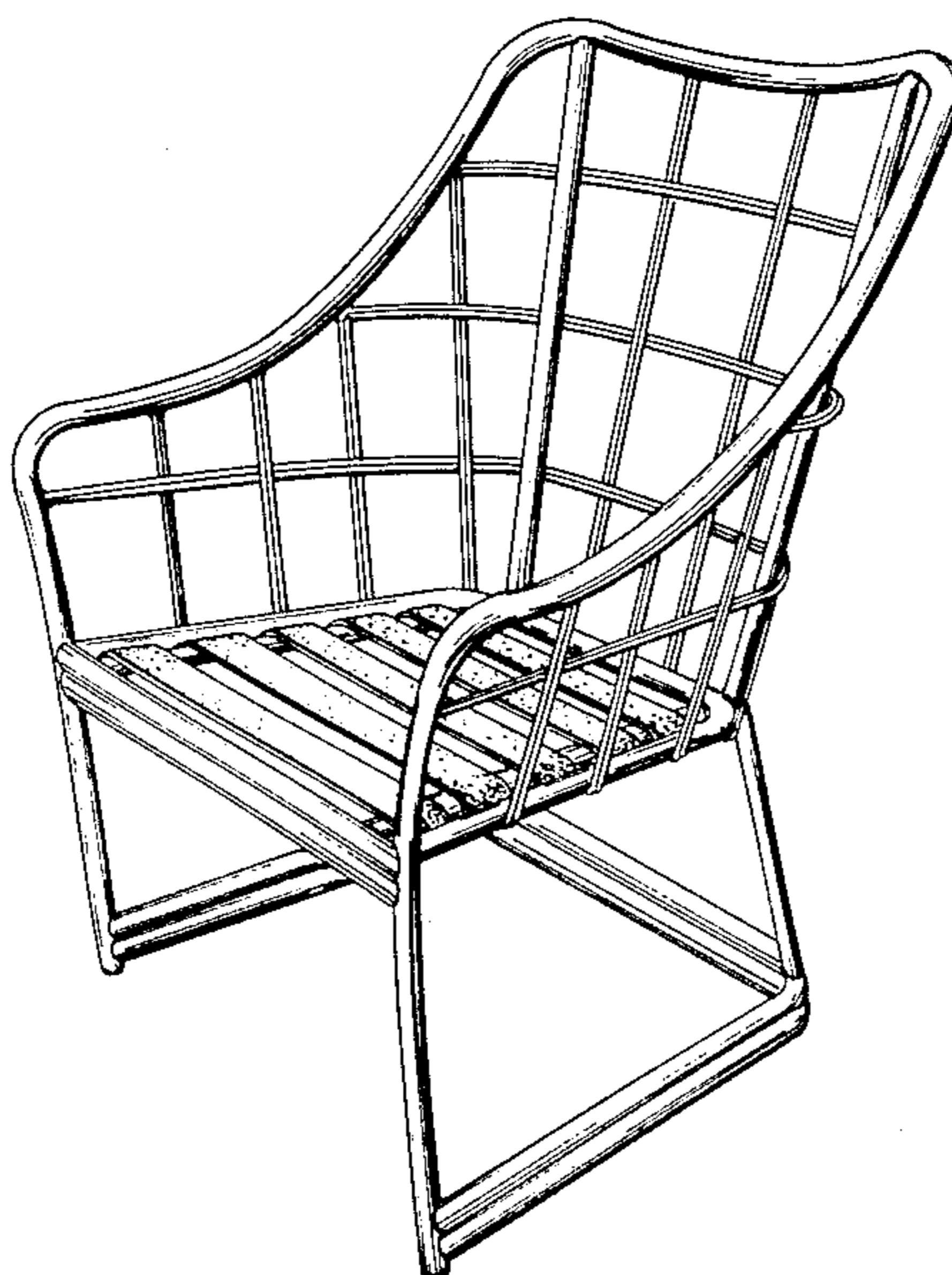

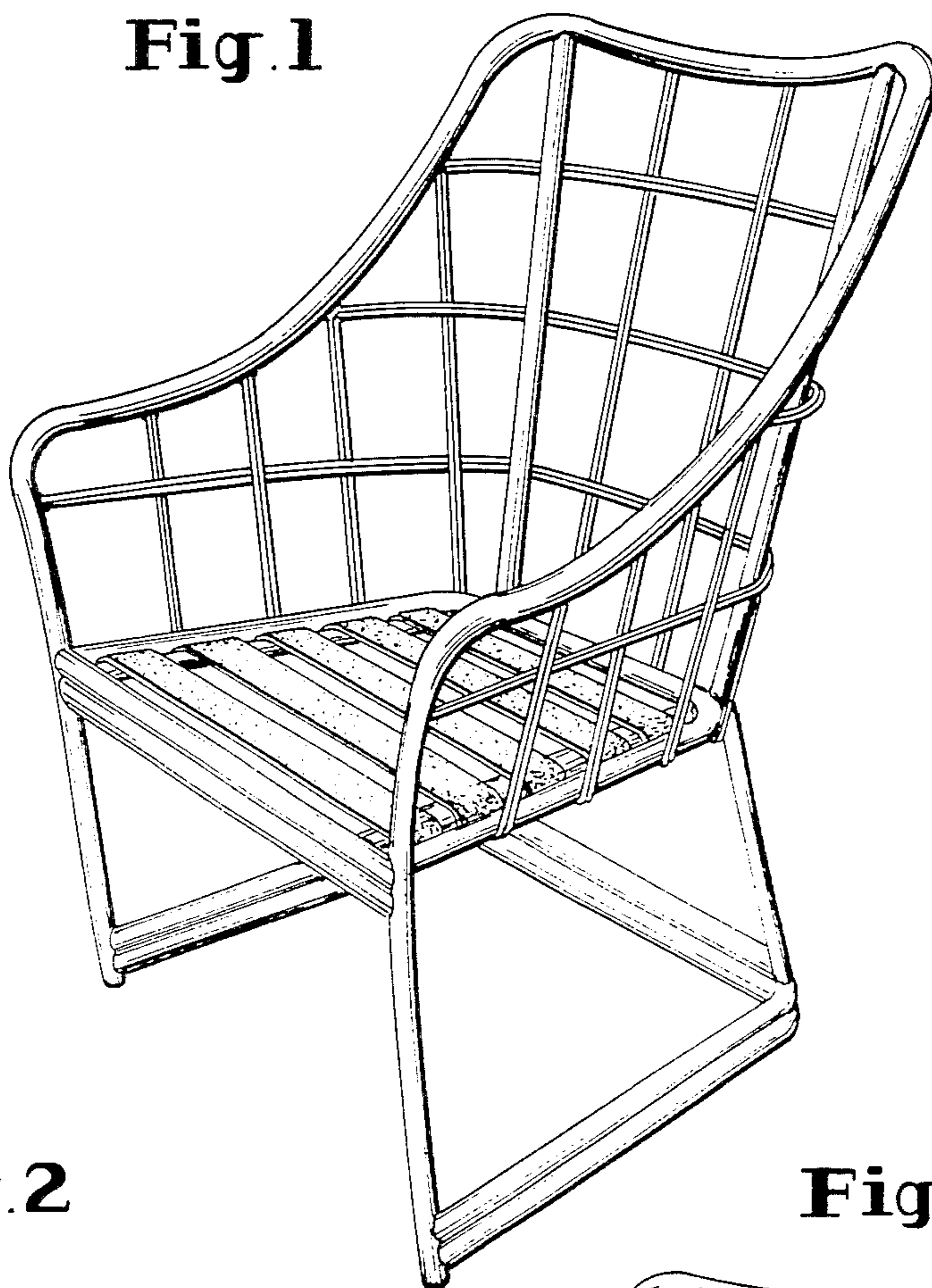

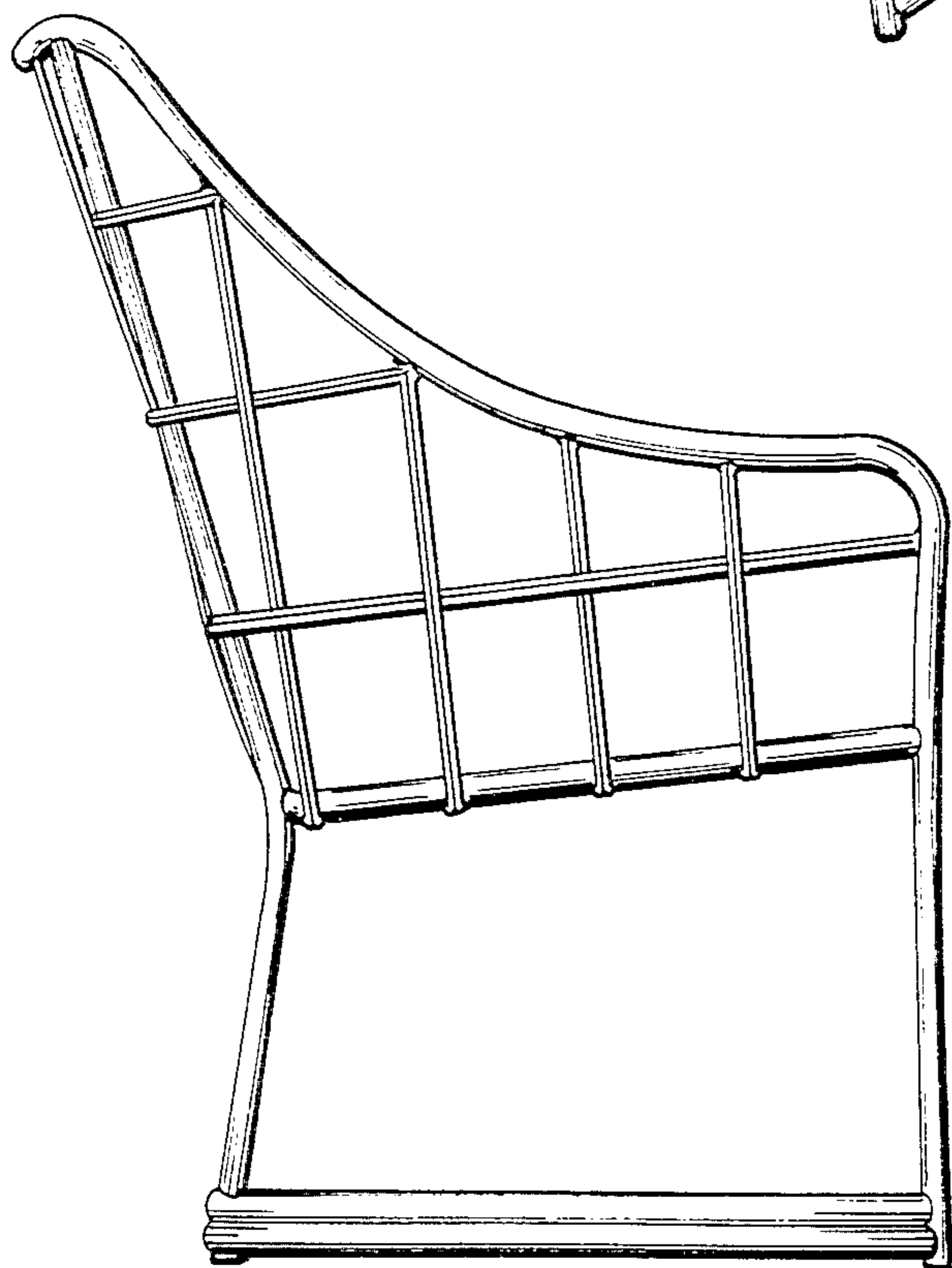

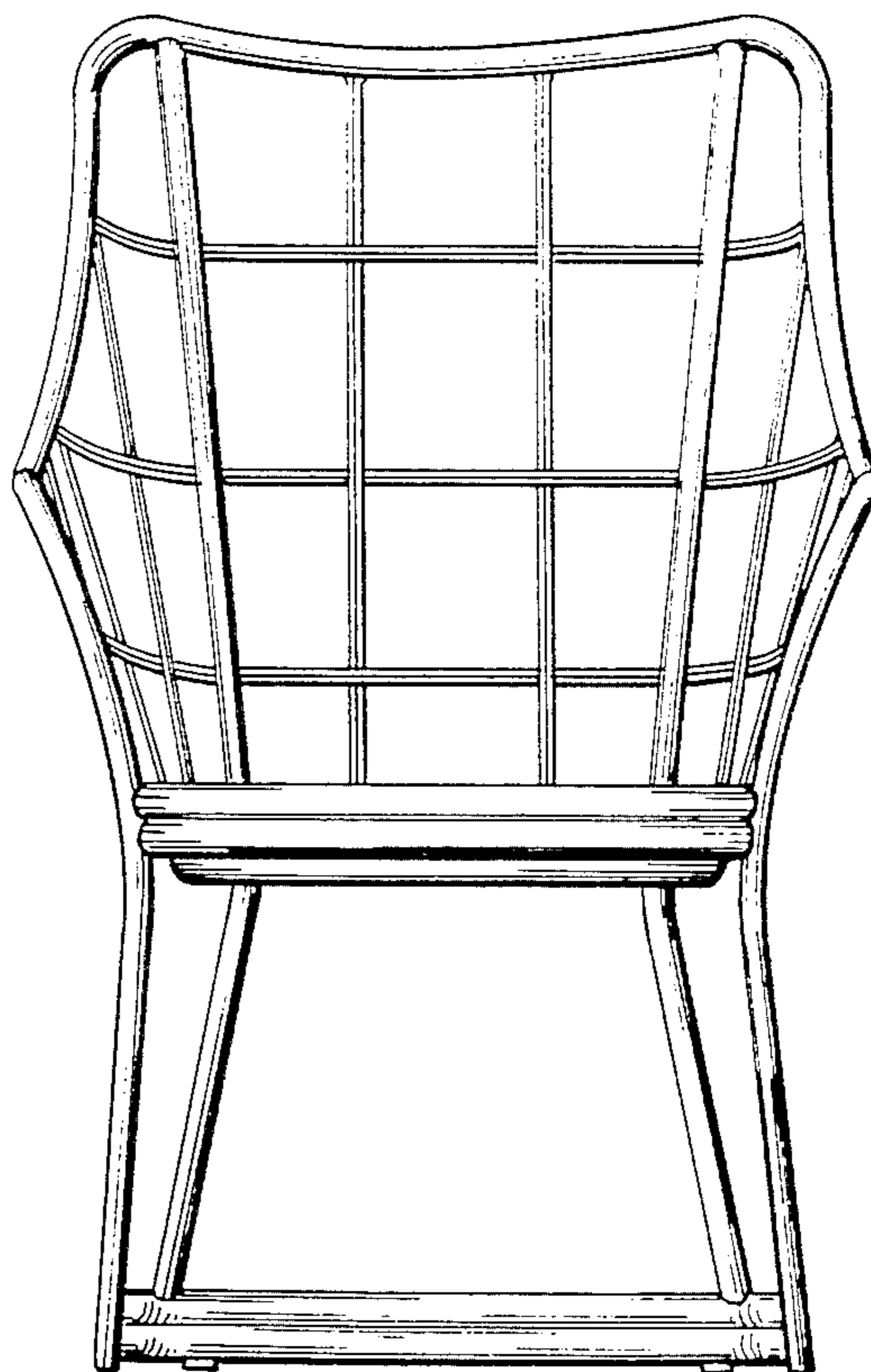

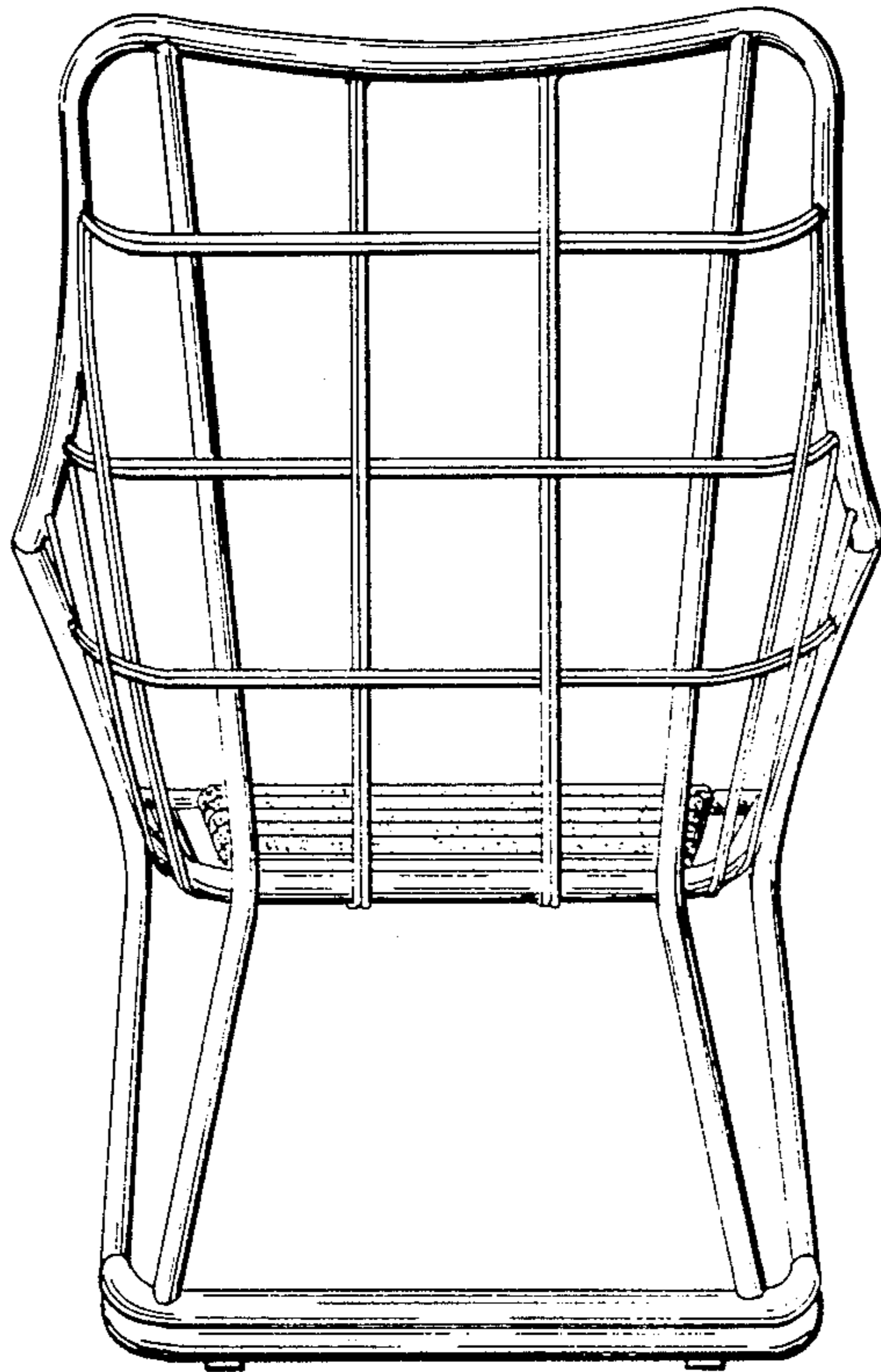
