The ornamental design for a arm for rescue tool, substantially as shown and described.

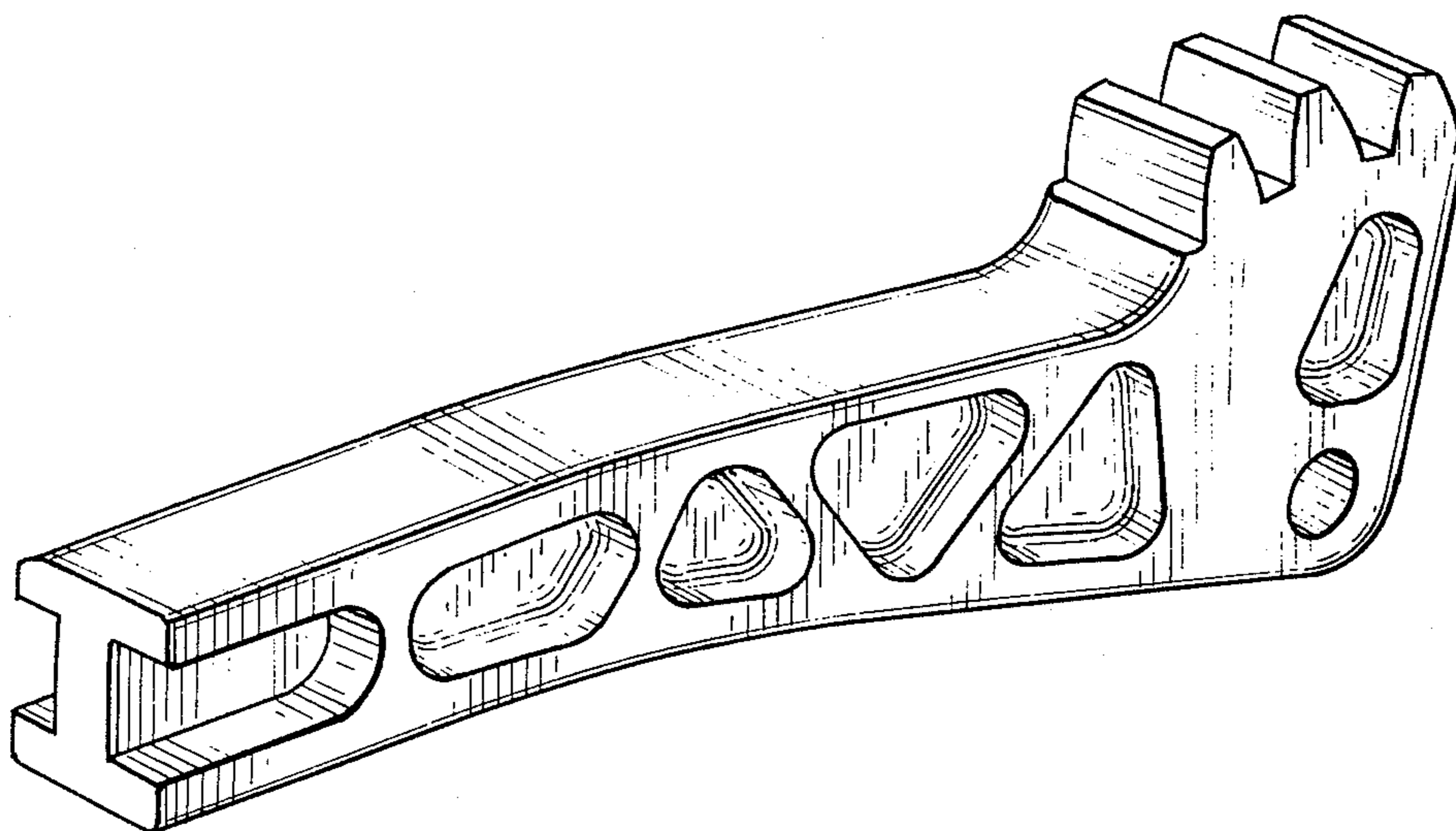
DESCRIPTION

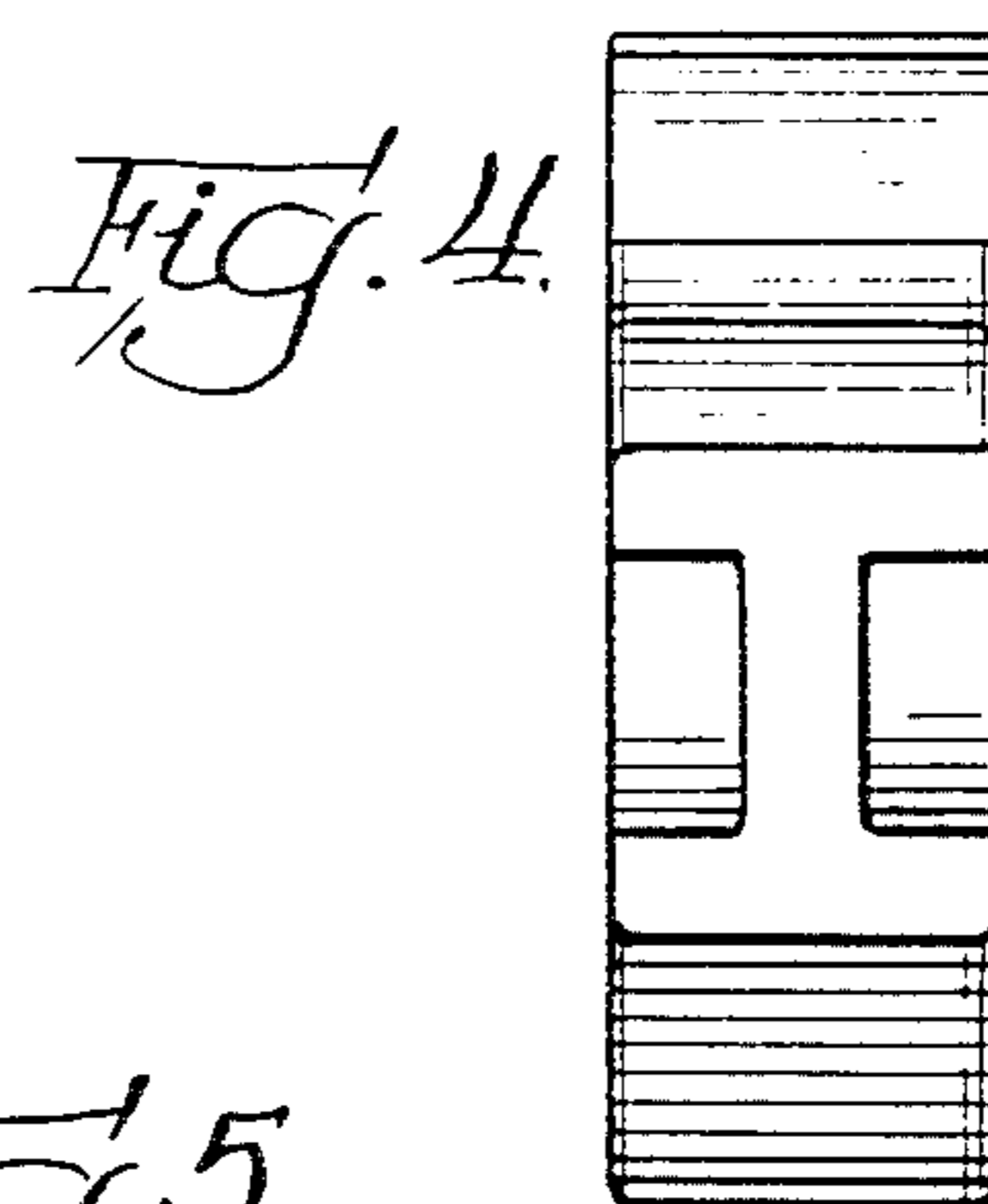
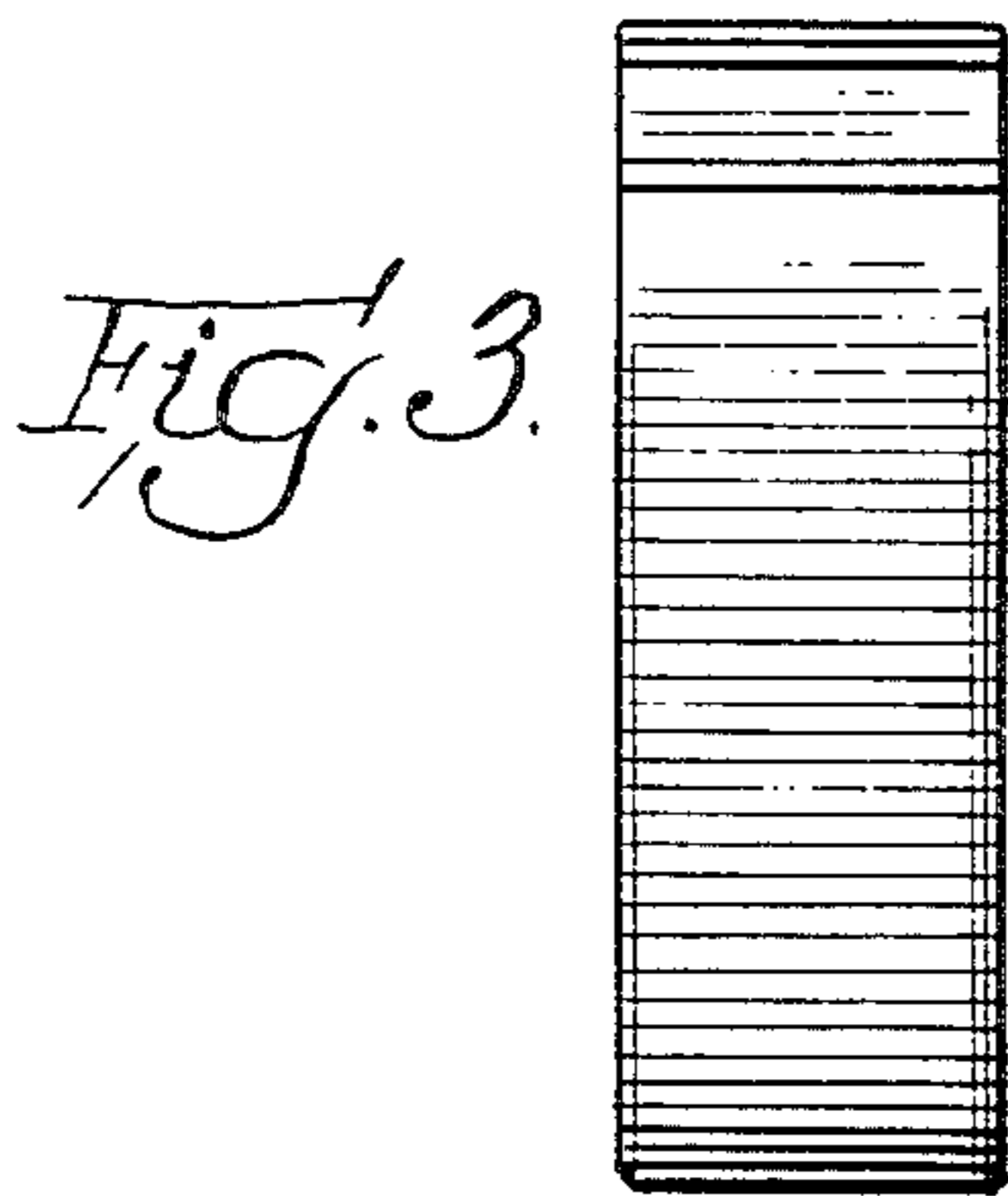
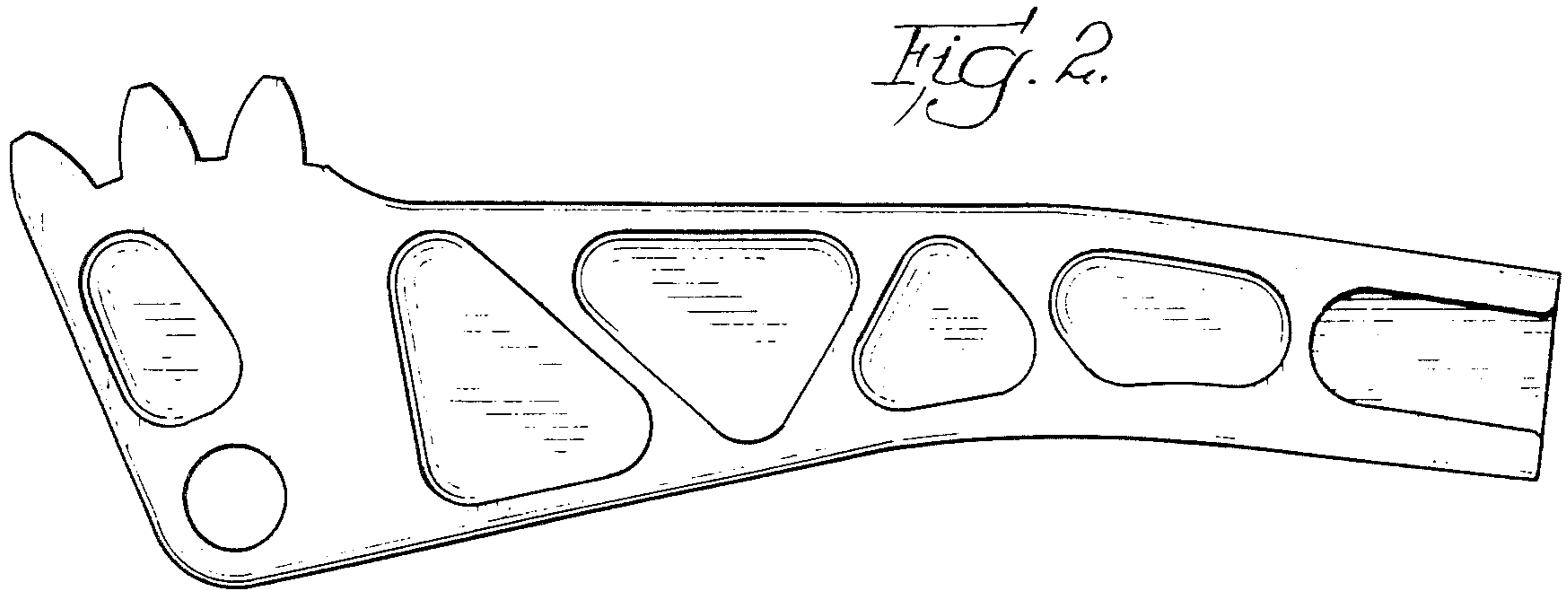
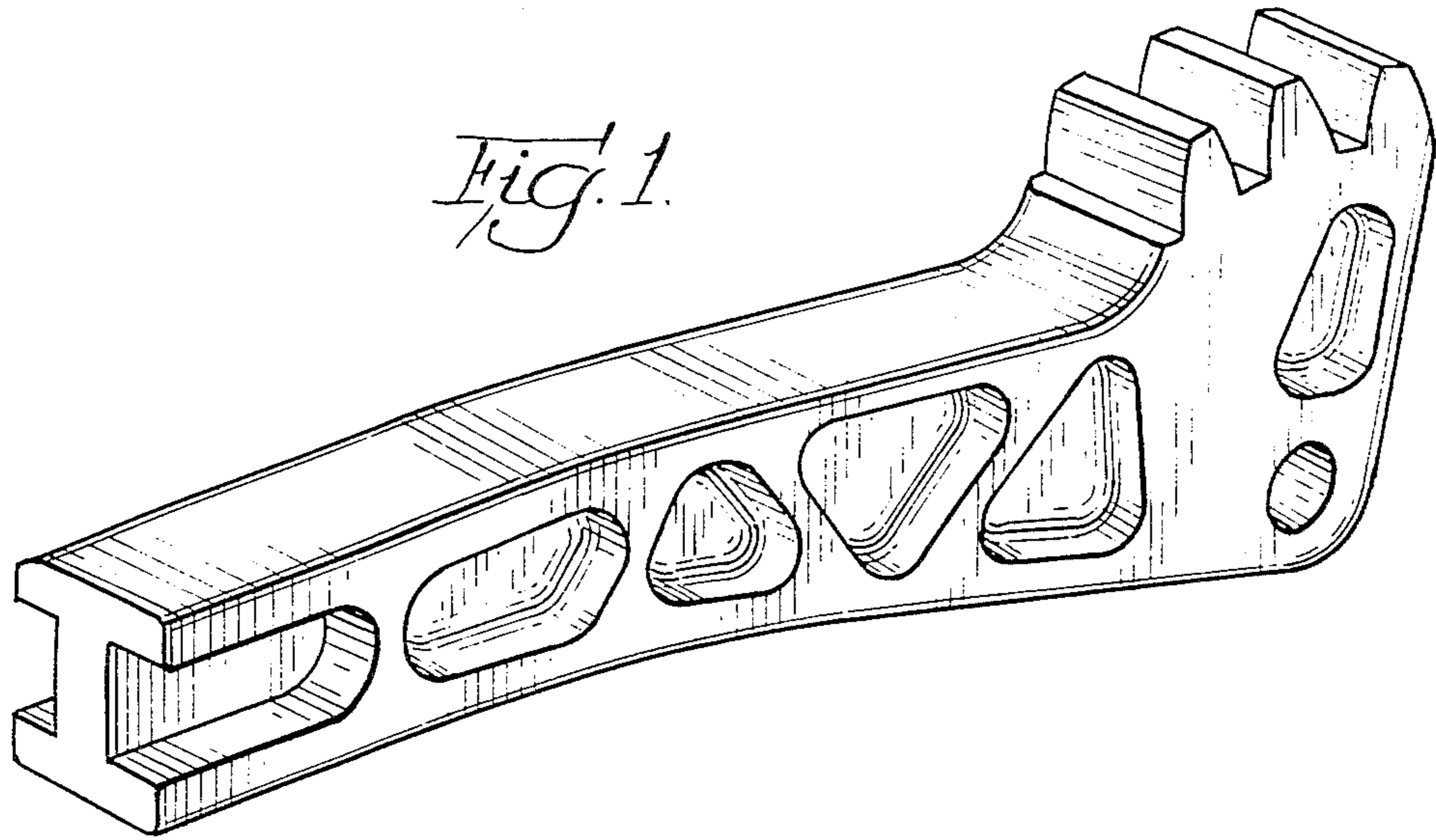
