[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a writing instrument with a striped body, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a writing instrument with striped body showing my new design, the instrument being generally circular in cross-section throughout;
FIG. 2 is a greatly enlarged, fragmentary cross-sectional view taken along the line 2—2 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is an enlarged end view of the writing instrument shown in FIG. 1, taken from the left hand side thereof; and
FIG. 4 is an enlarged end view of the writing instrument shown in FIG. 1, taken from the right hand side thereof.

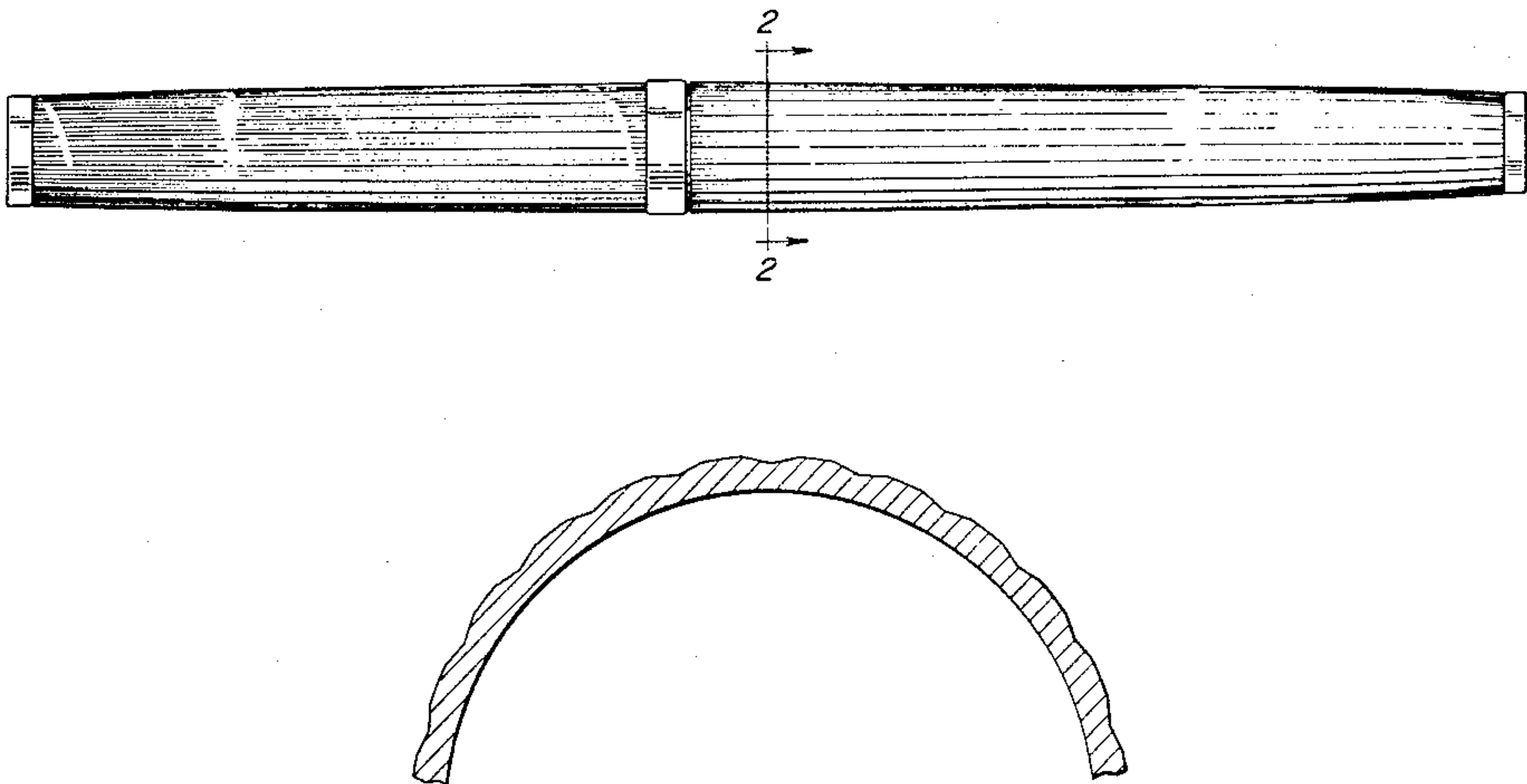

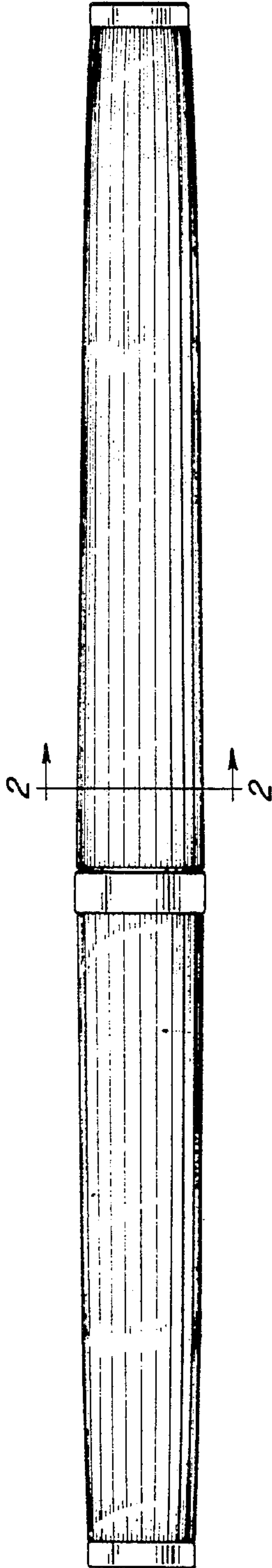

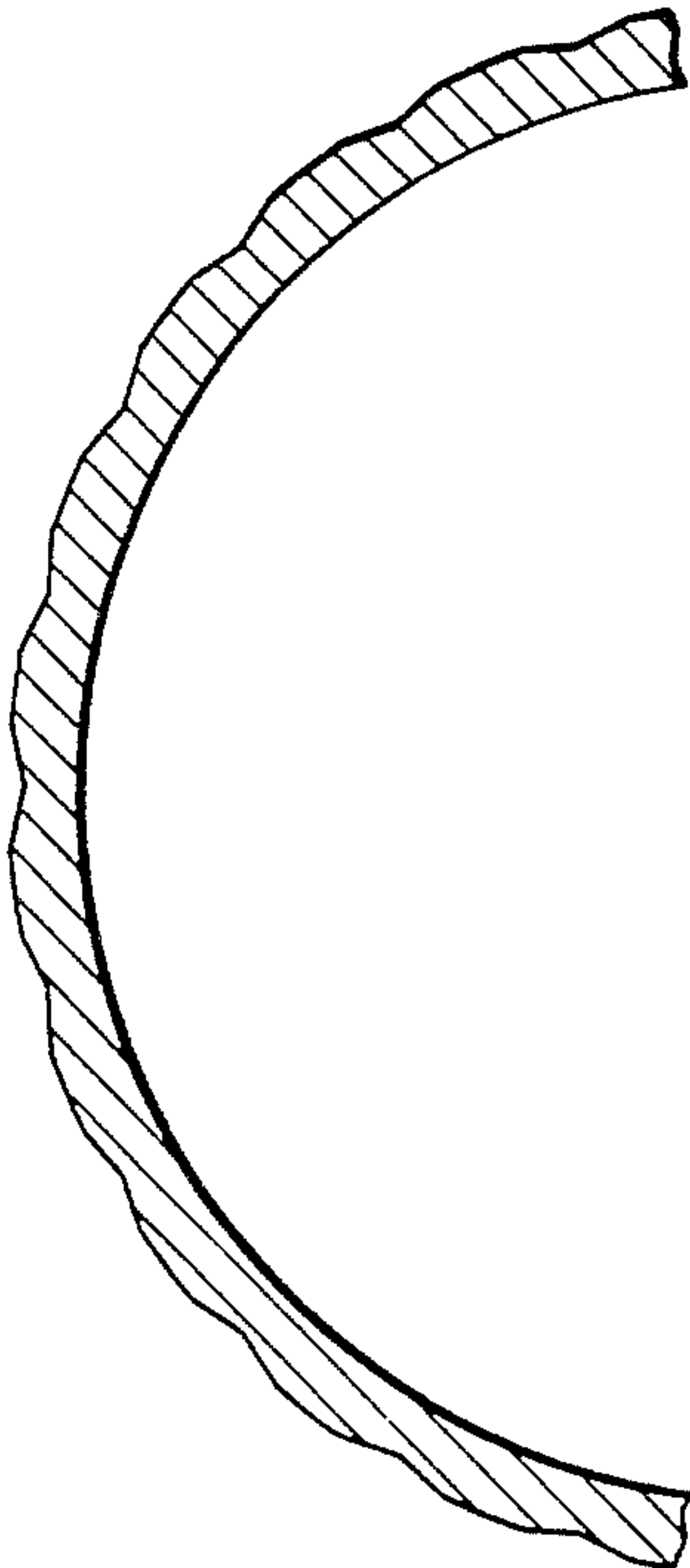

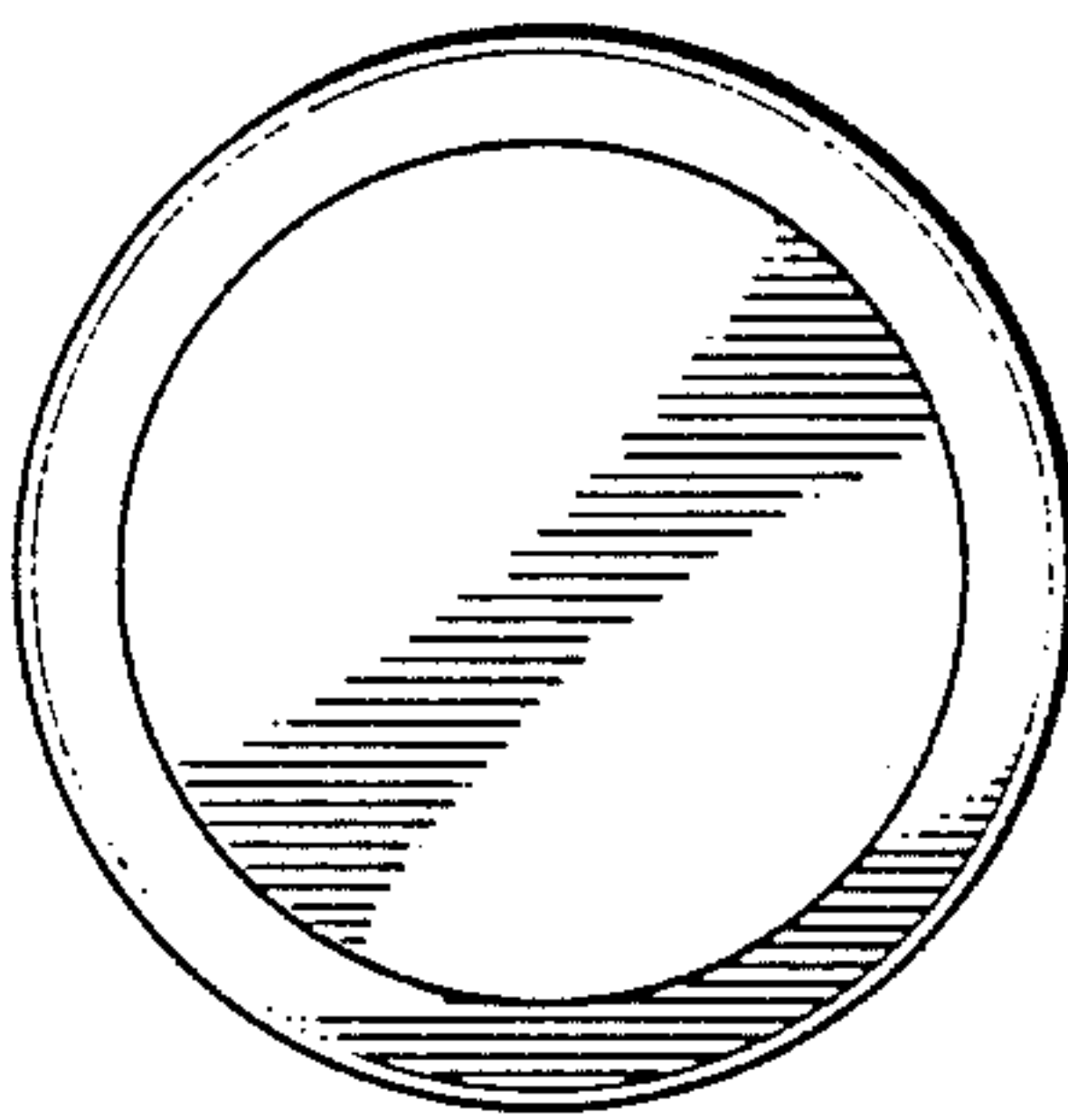
