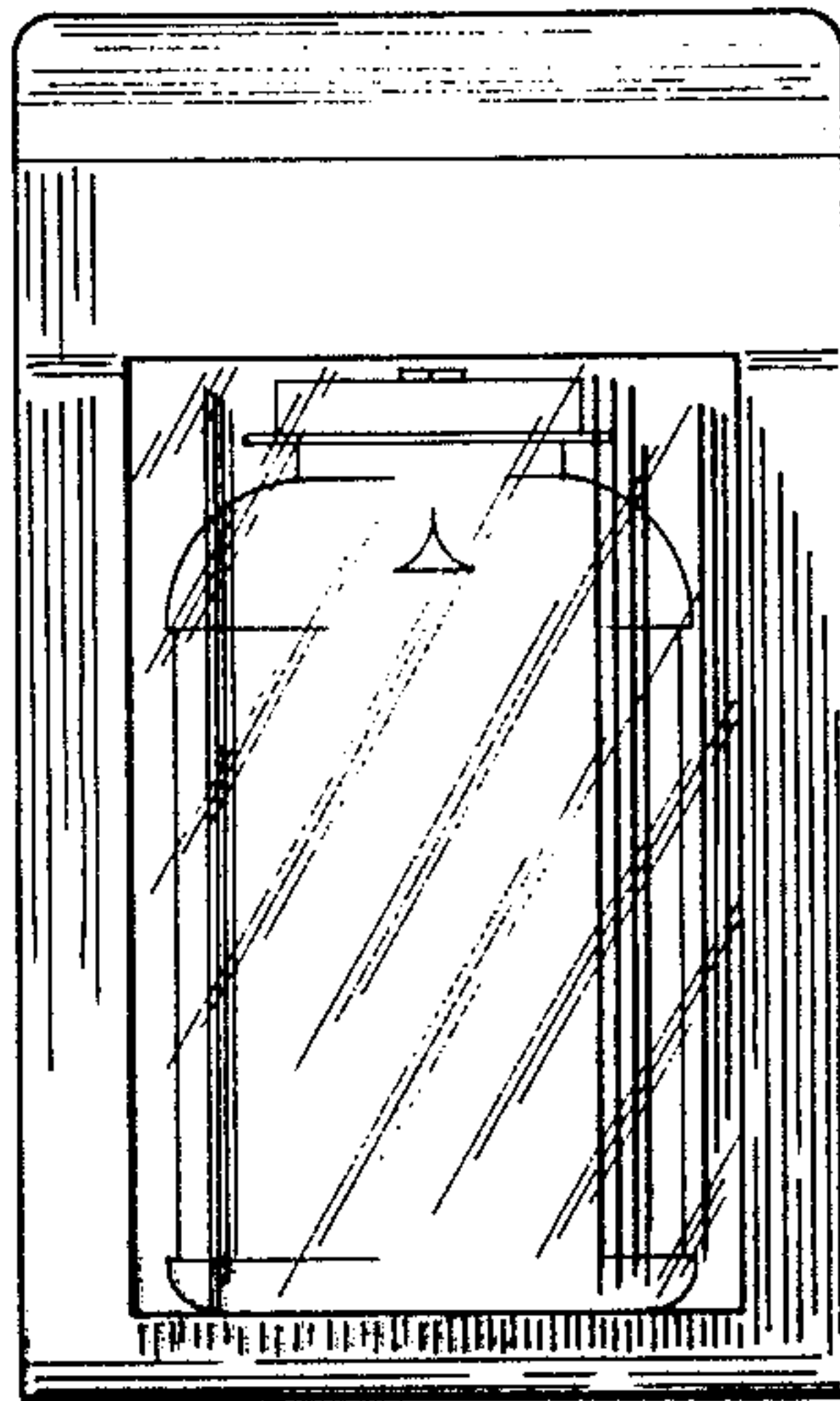

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a packaged bottle of pills showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 2.



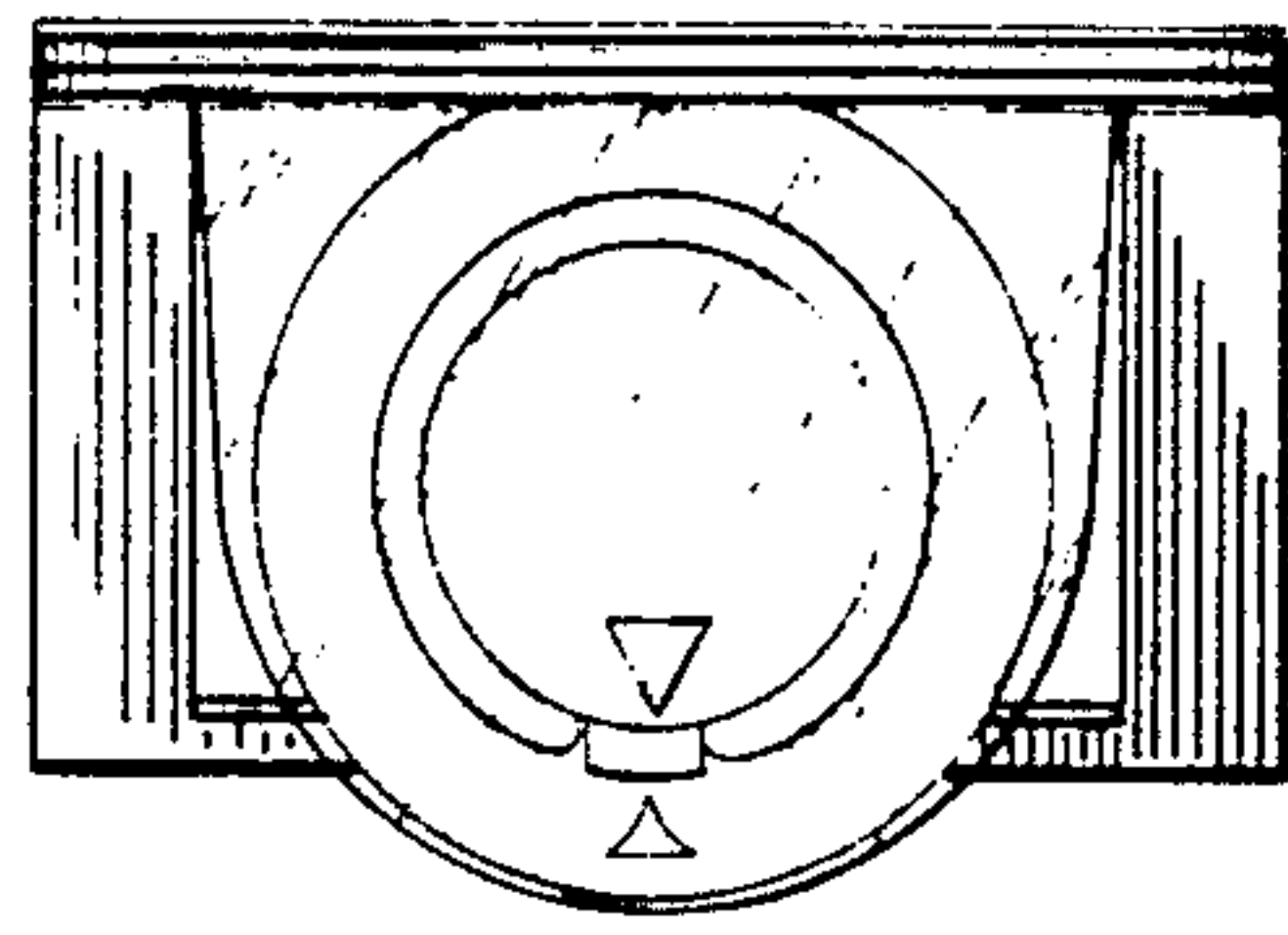

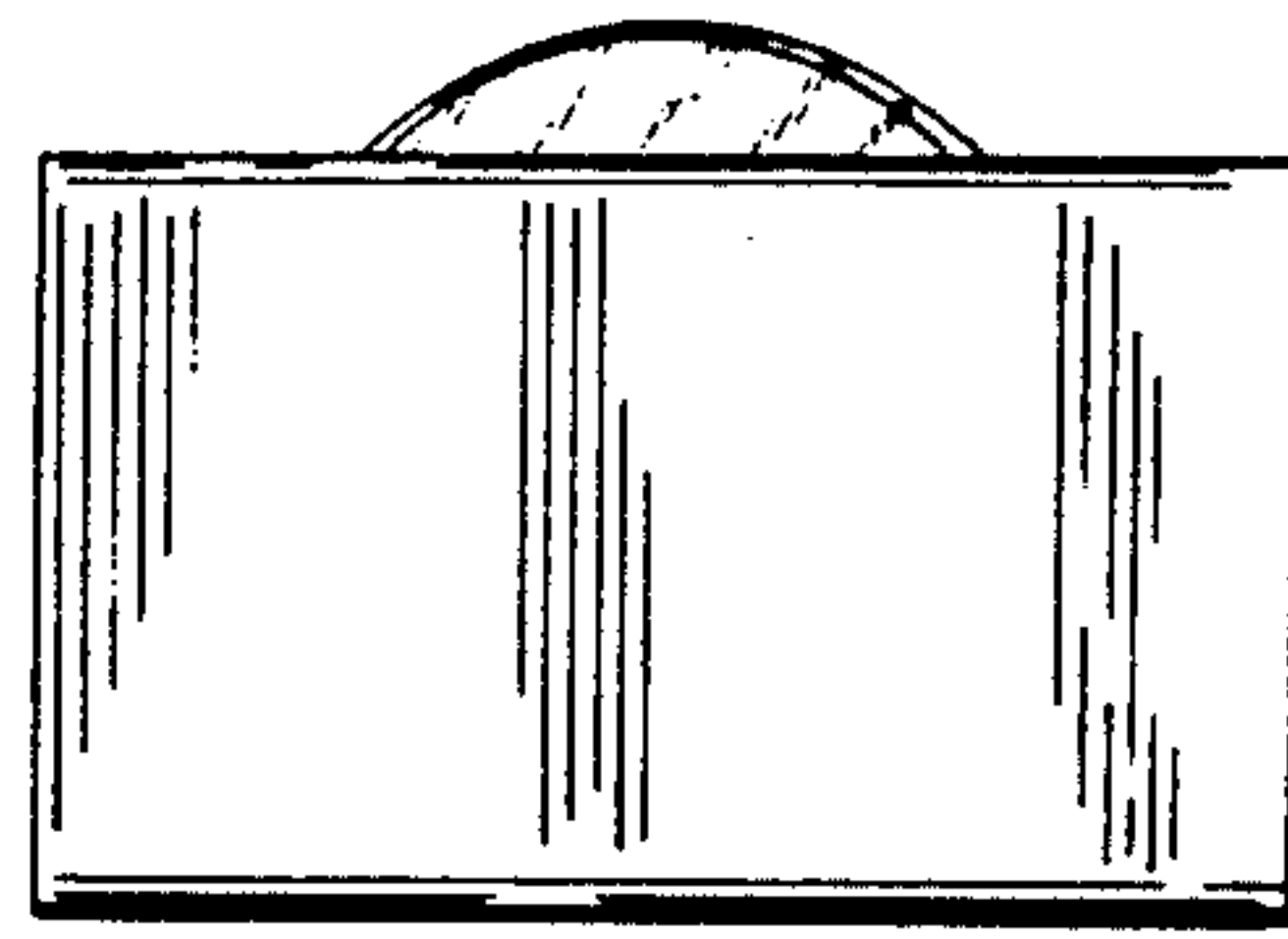

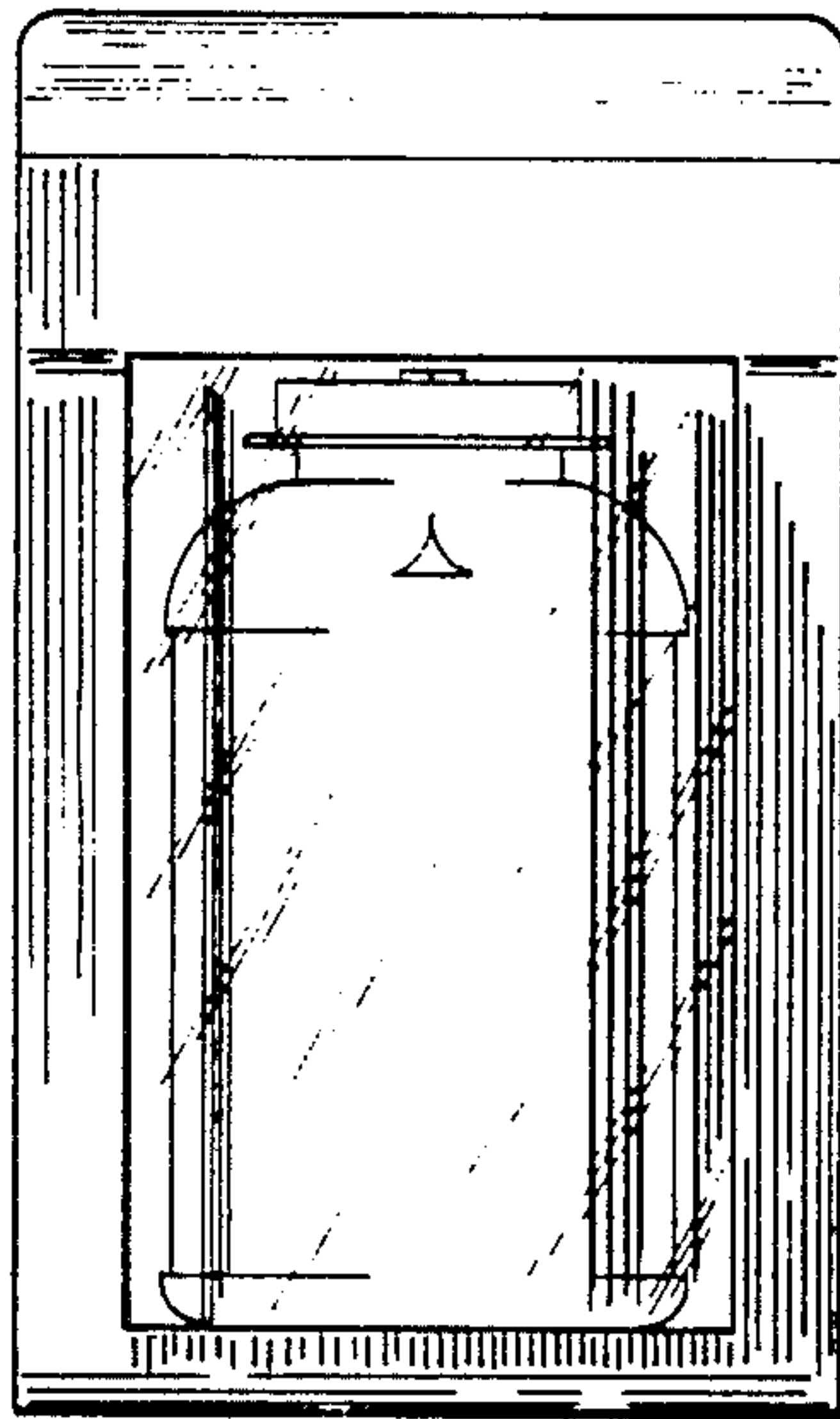

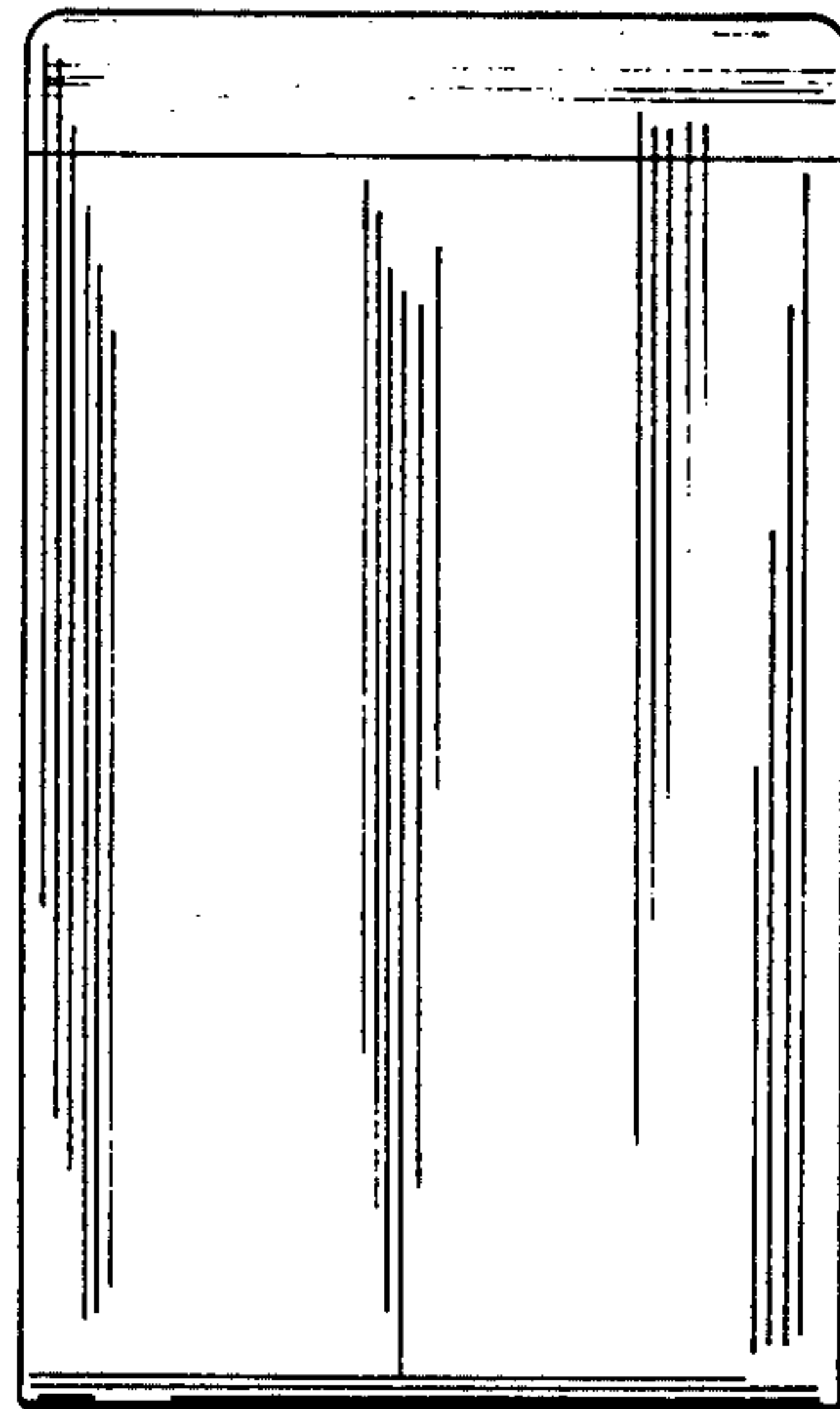

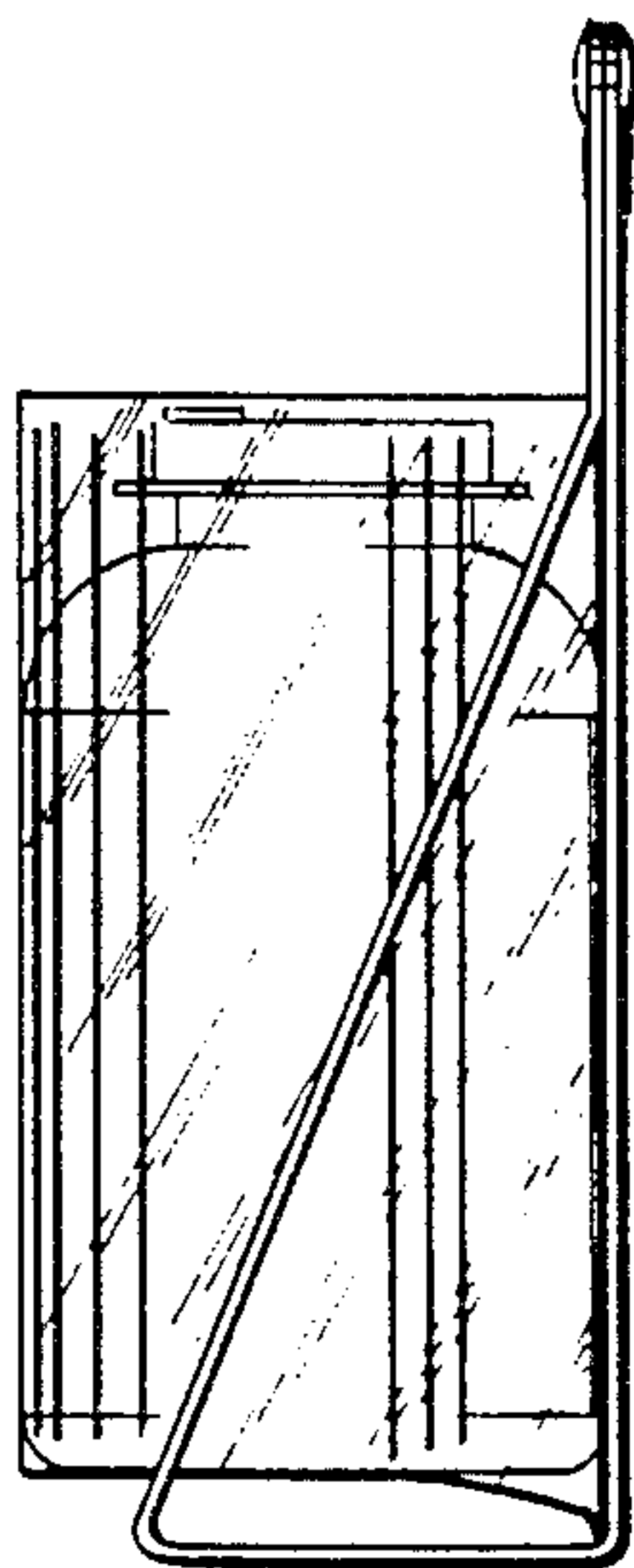

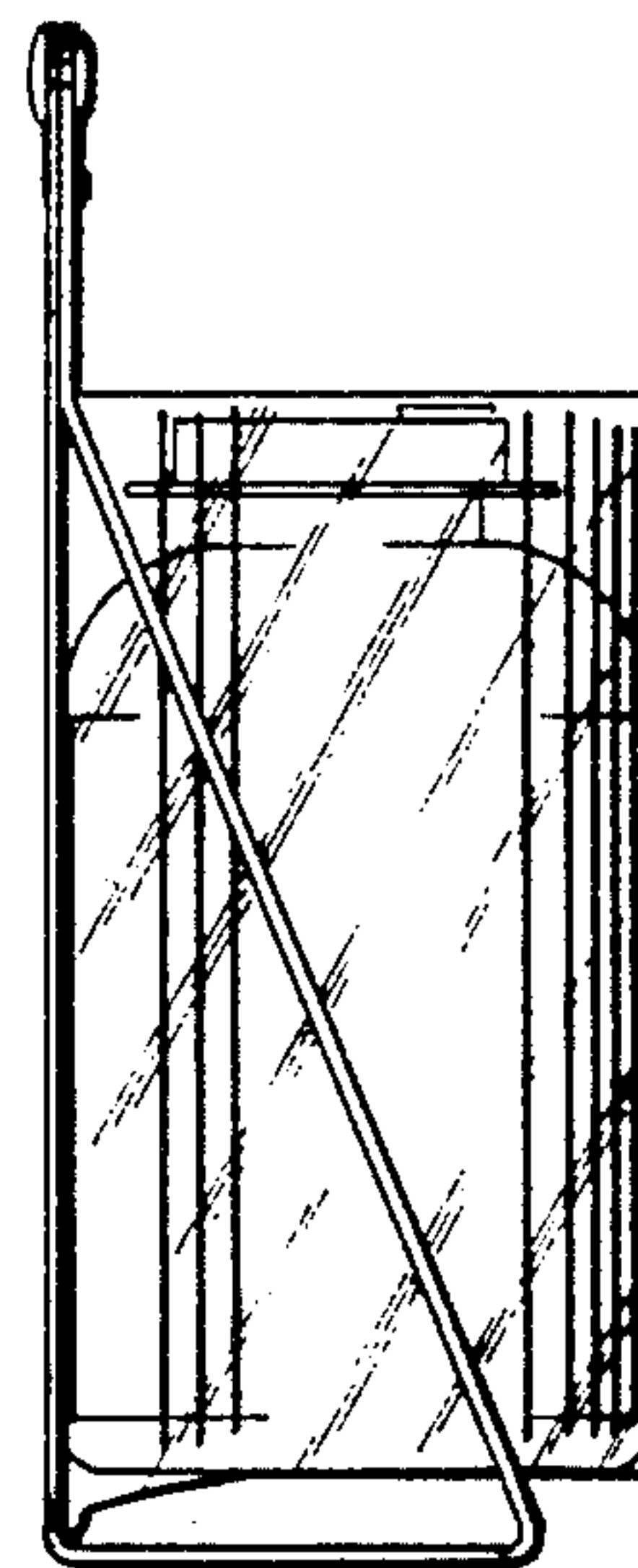
